TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Royals open a two-game series tonight with the third of four meetings between the clubs this season....Kansas City took both games at SunTrust Park, July 23-24.

A Atlanta has played Kansas City 15 times, tied for the fewest games the Braves have played against any one franchise...They have also played Oakland, Los Angeles (AL), and Cleveland 15 times.

A The Braves have dropped their last three games and five of their last six with Kansas City following the Royals' sweep earlier this season.

A This series marks the Braves' third ever trip to Kauffman Stadium...They split a two-game series in 2013, before dropping two-of-three games in 2016.

A RHP Julio Teheran is set to face the Royals for the third time in his career and for the second time this season...He dropped a 2-0 decision on July 24 of this season, allowing two unearned runs over 6.0 innings...Teheran also lost a $5-1$ decision to Kansas City on May 13, 2016, despite allowing two runs, one earned, over 7.0 innings.

A LHP Danny Duffy is scheduled to make his third career start against Atlanta, and the lefty is $0-0$ with a 1.00 ERA (1 ER/9.0 IP) in his previous two turns against the Braves...Duffy earned a $5-4$ win on July 23 of this season at SunTrust Park after going 6.0 innings and allowing one run, earned, with 11 strikeouts.

100 WINS?: The Braves won their 96th game of the season on Saturday, and need to go 4-1 or better over their final five games to reach triple-digit victories in a single season for the ninth time in franchise history and for the first time since 2003.

A The 2003 club went $101-61$ on their way to a five-game NLDS loss to Chicago...It marked the team's second-consecutive season of 100 wins; the 2002 also won 101 games.

A The Braves won triple digits in three consecutive seasons from 1997-1999, while the ' 93 went 104-58.

A The other two 100 -win seasons came prior to the modern era in 1892 (102-48) and 1898 (102-47).

A One more win would give the Braves their most single-season victories since that 2003 team won 101.

ON THE ROAD: The Braves begin their final road trip of the year tonight, and will finish the regular season on Sunday in New York...The Braves have the best road record in the National League at $46-30$, and trail only Minnesota ( $50-25, .667$ ) for the major league lead.

A The Braves finished 47-34 (.580) away from SunTrust Park last season, tied for the best road record in the National League with Los Angeles.

OZZIE HITS: 2B Ozzie Albies collected his 183rd hit of the season on Sunday to tie the single-season Atlantaera record for most hits by a second baseman...Felix Millan also had that many in 1970.

A Albies' 183 hits are the second most in the NL, trailing Ketel Marte's 187...With Marte out for the remainder of the season, Albies is looking to become the fifth Atlanta-era player to lead the league in hits, joining Freddie Freeman (2018), Terry Pendleton (1991 and 1992), Ralph Garr (1974) and Felipe Alou (1966 and 1968).

A The Braves are looking to become the first National League team to have consecutive hit leaders since Chicago in 2005-2006...Derek Lee had 1999 in 2005 before Juan Pierre had 204 in 2006.

RUNS: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. enters tonight's game with 127 runs this season, and is within four of tying the franchise modern-era record for a single season...OF Dale Murphy scored 131 times in 1983.

A Acuña Jr. is tied for the third most runs in a single season in the franchise's modern era...Hank Aaron also had 127 in 1962.

A Rafael Furcal is in second place with 130 in 2003.
40-40?: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. needs three steals to become the fifth player in baseball history to collect a 40-homer, 40-steal season.

A OF José Canseco was the first player to go 40-40, reaching 42 home runs and 40 steals in $1988 \ldots$ Barry Bonds then matched those numbers in 1996 , while Alex Rodríguez had 42 homers and 46 steals in 1998...Alfonso Soriano then had 46 and 41 in 2006.

A Prior to Acuña Jr., those four players were the only ones to go 40/35....Bonds did it twice, going 40/37 in 1997, a year after his $42 / 40$ season.

INTERLEAGUE: The Braves are 12-6 against the American League this season, and will finish the year with their second-best interleague record of all time regardless of what happens in these two games.

A They went $15-3$ in 2002 against the AL.
A This year marks the Braves' first winning season against the American League since going 11-9 in 2013...From 2014 to 2018, the Braves went $38-62$ (.380) in interleague play, the third-worst record in the National League.

TEHERAN INNINGS: RHP Julio Teheran needs 2.2 more innings to reach 175.0 for the seventh consecutive season, and join RHP Mike Leake as the only two pitchers in baseball to have such a streak....Teheran's streak dates to 2013, his first full season in the majors.

A RHP Max Scherzer and LHP Jon Lester are also able to reach 175.0 innings for the seventh consecutive season this year.

A Teheran's 1,331.2 innings since 2013 are the ninth most in baseball.

## Tonight's Game

A Makes his 33rd start of 2019...Is the 229th appearance of his career, and his 226th start.

A The 33 starts match his career high, done for the third season...Also made 33 starts in both 2014 and 2015.

A No Atlanta pitcher has started 34 games since 2011, when Derek Lowe did so.
A Set for his third career start against the Royals, including his second this season...Is 0-2 with a 0.69 ERA (1 ER/13.0 IP) over his first two turns.
A Pitched against them on July 24 at SunTrust Park, and surendered two unearned runs over 6.0 innings...Allowed four hits and two walks while striking out six.
A Has taken the loss in each of his two career starts against Kansas City, despite allowing just one earned run in 13 innings...Has allowed four runs in total and received just a single run of support in the two games, losing by 5-1 and 2-0 scores.
Makes his fifth Interleague start of the season, and is 1-2 with a 2.91 ERA (7 ER/21.2 IP) in his four turns...Atlanta is 2-2.
A Since his first full season in 2013, Teheran is $7-14$ with a 4.93 ERA in Interleague Play, the eighth-highest ERA in the majors against the opposing league.
A No pitcher in baseball has lost more than Teheran's 14 games in Interleague Play in that span.
Allowed just two unearned runs in his last start against Kansas City, one of 17 starts this season in which he allowed one earned run or less.
A The 17 starts allowing one earned run or fewer are tied for most in the majors among traditional starters...Houston's Gerrit Cole and the Dodgers' Hyun-Jin Ryu also have 17 such starts.
A The Atlanta-franchise record for such starts is 20, set by Greg Maddux in 2002.

## 2019 Recap

( Made his 30th start of the season, $9 / 7 \mathrm{vs}$.WSH, and allowed three hits and one run over 6.0 innings to earn his 10 th win.

A Has made at least 30 starts in each of the last seven seasons dating to 2013, and is the only pitcher in the majors to do so...Mike Leake ( 29 starts this season), Jon Lester (28), Max Scherzer (24) and José Quintana (28) are the only other pitchers to make at least 30 starts in every season from 2013-2018.
Made his fifth start of the season against Miami, $8 / 21$, and pitched 7.0 scoreless innings...Allowed just one earned run in 32.0 innings ( 0.28 ERA) against the Marlins on the season.
$\mathcal{A}$ The 32.0 innings marked the most such innings in a season by a Braves pitcher against a single opponent allowing one earned run or less...Pat Jarvis held the previous record, holding Houston to one run over 31.1 innings in 1971.

A Became the 11th pitcher in the live-ball era to allow one or fewer runs in at least that many innings against a single opponent in a season... The last to do so was Chicago-AL's Britt Burns, who did not allow a run in 32.0 innings against the Indians in 1985
Started against the Mets on 8/15 at SunTrust Park and allowed eight hits and six runs over just 1.1 innings, the shortest start of his career.
A Was his 219th career start, which passed Rick Mahler for sixth most in Atlanta franchise history...Only Phil Niekro (594), Tom Glavine (518), John Smoltz (466), Greg Maddux (363) and Tim Hudson (243) have started more games.

A Started against the Marlins, $8 / 9$, and allowed five hits and one run over 7.0 innings.
A Allowed a home run leading off the seventh inning to snap a 24 -inning scoreless streak against Miami to open the season.
A Pitched exactly 6.0 scoreless innings in each of his three starts against the Marlins to open the season...Teheran's run was just the fourth time since 1908 that a Braves starter had three straight such starts against one opponent in a single season.
Allowed eight hits and six earned runs, $6 / 18$ vs. NYM...The outing stopped a streak of eight straight starts in which he allowed one earned run or less.
A His run of one-run starts spanned from May 5 to June 13, during which he ranked second in the majors with a 0.81 ERA (4 ER/44.2 IP)...Trailed just Hyun-Jin Ryu of the Dodgers (0.53 ERA).
$\mathcal{A}$ Teheran's eight-game streak was tied for the longest in the majors by a traditional starter this season, mathing a run by his rotation-mate Mike Soroka...TB's Ryne Stanek has a 14-game run while opening for the Rays.
Made his 200th career start, $4 / 30$ vs. SD...Allowed five hits and four runs over a season-most 7.0 innings.
A Became the ninth Braves pitcher to make 200 starts for the club since the team moved to Atlanta in 1966...Joins Phil Niekro (594), Tom Glavine (518), John Smoltz (466), Greg Maddux (363), Tim Hudson (243), Rick Mahler (218), Ron Reed (203) and Steve Avery (201).
