

# San Francisco Giants (47-51) at Colorado Rockies (35-63) RHP Logan Webb (7-7, 3.47) vs. LHP Kyle Freeland (1-3, 6.00)

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Giants will try to bounce back in game two of this three game set after dropping a tough loss last night to open the second half of the season here at Coors Field.

- ▶ San Francisco enters today 47-51, 10.0 games back of the NL West-leading Dodgers, and 3.0 games back of the third Wild Card spot.
- ► The Giants currently have 23.2% odds odds of making the Postseason according to FanGraphs.
- ▶ Per *Elias*, SF entered the second half of the season with the second-easiest remaining schedule in terms of opponent winning percentage (.479) behind only the Angels (.469).

**SCORELESS STREAK AT COORS: LHP Kyle Harrison** tossed 5.0-scoreless innings last night extending his scoreless innings streak here at Coors Field to 12.0 innings (also tossed 7.0-scoreless on May 7), which is the fifth longest scoreless innings streak at Coors Field in Giants History (see chart).

According to *OptaSTATS*, Harrison is the first visiting pitcher ever to have two scoreless starts of 5.0+ innings at Coors Field in the same season.

**HOME AWAY FROM HOME:** SF is 5-2 against the Rockies thus far in 2024, going 2-2 here at Coors and 3-0 at Oracle Park.

➤ Since the start of the 2021 season, SF is 20-10 against the Rockies at Coors Field, outscoring them 191-145 (+46).

**WEBB SLINGER:** 2024 All-Star **RHP Logan Webb** will take the mound tonight for the 21st time for San Francisco this season.

- Webb struggled in his last start against the Blue Jays before the break, matching his career-high with seven earned runs allowed
- ▶ Over his last three starts against the Rockies, he's posted a 2-0 record with a 0.39 ERA (1er, 23.0ip) and allowed just one walk...the last Giants pitcher to have at least 23.0 innings pitched while allowing one or zero runs and one or zero walks over a three-game span against a single opponent was **Gaylord Perry** vs. Braves in 1970 (*Stats, LLC*).

**BACK IN ACTION:** The Giants have not fared well coming out of the All-Star break in recent seasons.

- After starting off last season's second-half with a threegame sweep of Pittsburgh followed by two wins at Cincinnati, SF would go on to lose the final two against the Reds, get swept by Washington and lose a one-gamer in Detroit to go 5-6 with a -14 run differential (41-55).
- ▶ In 2022, SF came out of the break with a winless road trip and a -25 run differential (19-44), going 0-4 at Los Angeles-NL and 0-3 at Arizona.

**I LOVE IT HERE: OF Mike Yastrezmski** has a .985 OPS in 38 career games at Coors Field...since 2019, the .985 OPS is tied for the fourth-best among players with at least 35 games at Coors Field.

► Since July 11, Yastrezmski is hitting .529 (9-for-17) with three doubles, triple, home run and three RBI in five games.

**ON THE MEND: LHP Robbie Ray** made a rehab start for Triple-A Sacramento last night and threw 5.1-scoreless innings, allowing just one hit and two walks with seven strikeouts...he threw 78 pitches (46 strikes).

**LA ESTRELLA DE MAUNABO:** Since being called up on May 8, All-Star **OF Heliot Ramos** is tied for the most RBI (46) in the NL and ranks among the top in home runs (14, T-4th), SLG% (.523, 8th) batting average (.297, 9th), and OPS (.886, 9th).

- ► The 24-year-old has started 60 of SF's 61 games since being recalled and has started in 59 consecutive games.
- ▶ Ramos leads SF with 14 homers and 46 RBI...his 2.4 fWAR is tied with **IF Matt Chapman** for second-most among Giants position players behind the 3.5 fWAR by **C Patrick Bailey**.

**LET'S FIND SOME SHADE:** The Giants are 6-7 in July despite slashing .221/.296/.389 with a .686 OPS this month.

▶ The .221 batting average is the lowest in the NL and third-lowest in the Majors.

**A QUICK LOOK AT NEXT YEAR:** The San Francisco Giants released their 2025 regular season schedule on Thursday.

- ▶ The Giants will open the season on Thursday, March 27, at the Reds before finishing the opening road trip at Houston.
- ▶ Following the road trip, the Giants will head back to San Francisco to host the Mariners and Reds, holding their home opener on Friday, April 4 vs. Seattle.
- ▶ SF is on the road for all the major holidays in 2025, including Mother's Day (Sunday, May 11 at Minnesota), Memorial Day (Monday, May 26 at Detroit), Father's Day (Sunday, June 15 at Los Angeles-NL), Fourth of July (Friday, July 4 at Athletics) and Labor Day (Monday, September 1 at Colorado).

**CONGRATS!:** Giants' minor leaguers, **OF Angel Guzman** and **C Jesus Alexander** were named to the DSL All-Star team...**Juan Ciriaco** was also selected as an All-Star and **Osiris Matos** was selected as an All-Star pitching coach.

#### LOGAN WEBB RHP #62 2024 RECORD: 7-7, 3.47 ERA

ALL-STAR: Earned his first career All-Star selection, joining OF Heliot Ramos as the two Giants in the Midsummer Classic...Webb threw 31 pitches and worked the 3rd inning for the NL team on Tuesday (3h, 3r, 3er, bb, k)...he became the first homegrown (drafted and developed) Giants pitcher to be named to an All-Star Game since **LHP Madison Bumgarner** was selected to the team in 2016.

LAST TIME OUT: Had his toughest start of the season on July 10 vs. Toronto and suffered his seventh loss of the season...matched a career-high seven earned runs and surrendered eight hits with four strikeouts over 5.0 innings of work...the outing marked just Webb's fourth time failing to reach 6.0 innings this season.

VS. COLORADO: Is slated to face the Rockies tonight for the 16th time in his career...Webb is 8-2 with a 3.05 ERA (30er, 88.2ip) and 1.09 WHIP in the 15 outings (14 starts)..his eight wins against Colorado are tied for fourth-most among active pitchers, trailing only Clayton Kershaw (27), Patrick Corbin (11) and Wade Miley (9).

ROCK CLIMBING: Webb has been particularly successful against the Rockies in recent outings, sporting a 2-0 record with a 1.58 ERA (5er, 28.1ip) and 23 strikeouts in four starts against Colorado in 2023...thew his first career shutout on July 9 at Oracle Park in SF's last game before the All-Star break, striking out 10 Rockies batters in the outing...in his last three outings vs. Colorado dating to his shutout, Webb has given up just one run on 23.0 innings (0.39 ERA) and held batters to a .179 clip (14x78) with 20 strikeouts.

**DADDY LONG LEGS:** Webb has finished at least 7.0 innings on 11 different occasions so far this season, most of any pitcher in the Majors...only two other Giants starters this year have finished 7.0 innings (Jordan Hicks did so on April 5 vs. San Diego and Kyle Har**rison** has done so twice)...SF's ace enters this outing having thrown 124.1 innings so far this year, second-most in the NL behind PHI's Aaron Nola (124.2) and tied for fifth-most in the Majors.

GOIN' DEEP (IN THE GAME): Since the start of 2022, Webb has thrown 532.2 innings, most in the Majors in that time ahead of Aaron Nola (523.1), Corbin Burnes (520.1), Miles Mikolas (516.0) and Logan Gilbert (508.2).

**BOOTS ON THE GROUND:** Through 20 starts this year Webb owns a 57.9% ground ball rate, fourth-best in the Majors behind HOU's Framber Valdez (62.3%), PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (59.9%) and ATL's Max Fried (59.3%).

I'VE WATCHED A CHANGE IN YOU: Webb's changeup has a +3run value in 2024 after having +28 run value last season (the second-most valuable pitch in the league behind AL Cy Young Award winner Gerrit Cole's fastball)...his most valuable pitch this year thus far (in terms of run value) has turned out to be his sinker, which has a +6 run value.band together: The Giants are 64-48 (.571) in Webb's 112 regular season starts since 2021...SF is 9-11 in his 20 starts in 2024...he's received three or fewer runs of support in 14 of the 20 starts.

STAY IN THE PARK: Webb allowed three homers in June (40.0 innings) after allowing two homers in his first two months of the season (72.1ip)...still, his 0.43 HR/9ip would be a careerbest...among starters with at least 15 starts this year Webb's 0.43 HR/9ip is third-lowest in MLB, trailing PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (0.17) and BOS' Tanner Houck (0.38).

CHECK 'EM: Opposing teams had early season success running on Webb in 2024, stealing 10 bases in his first nine starts this year...after a stretch of allowing just one steal in seven starts from May 15-June 18, the Cardinals swiped four bags off Webb on June 23...since that outing, basestealers are 0-for-1 off Webb..still, the 15 steals against him this year are tied for fifth-most in MLB.
