AROUND THE HORN

THE HONDO RODEO FEST RETURNS NOV. 13-15: The Hondo Rodeo Fest returns to Chase Field for its third year from November 13-15, featuring a weekend of elite rodeo action and full-length concerts by Tim McGraw with Miranda Lambert on Friday, Nov. 13, Blake Shelton with Turnpike Troubadours on Sat., Nov. 14 and Parker McCollum with Lynyrd Skynyrd on Sunday, Nov. 15...tickets go on sale Monday, June 1 at 12:00 p.m. AZ.

HERE'S THE STORY: Since May 9, the D-backs' 13 wins (13-4) are the most in the Majors (ahead of the Brewers' 12).

- The D-backs are 9-1 in their last 10 games and 10-2 in their last 12 games, their first 10-win, 12-game span since Aug. 4-16, 2024 (10-2).
- The D-backs are a season-high 6 games above .500...their first time at 6+ above since the end of 2024 (16 above on Sept. 29, 2024 at 89-73).
- Since May 10, **Ketel Marte** (1.222 OPS) and **Corbin Carroll** (1.182 OPS) rank first and second, respectively, in MLB, ahead of Gavin Sheets/SD (1.157 OPS), Juan Soto/NYM (1.147 OPS) and Kyle Schwarber/PHI (1.141 OPS).
- **Ketel Marte's** season-high 10-game hitting streak is tied for the Majors' longest active streak (with William Contreras/MIL)...is batting .524 (22-for-42)/1.506 OPS with 6 doubles, 4 homers, 17 RBI and 4 walks.
- **Ketel Marte**, who has posted 4 consecutive games with 1+ hits and 2+ RBI, is 1 shy of the club-record 5 straight games with 1+ hits and 2+ RBI (Paul Goldschmidt from April 21-26, 2017).
- **Corbin Carroll's** season-high 14-game on-base streak is the Majors' third longest active on-base streak (behind Nolan Arenado/AZ at 17 and Spencer Steer/CIN at 15) and the sixth longest of his career...has reached 2+ times in 12 of those games and is batting .404 (21-for-52)/1.266 OPS with 4 doubles, 4 triples, 2 homers, 8 RBI and 12 walks (10 K).

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 7-5 @ Giants for their fifth straight win vs. Giants.

- **Eduardo Rodriguez** earned his fifth win in his second consecutive quality bid (6.0 IP, 2 R, 2 BB, 6 K)...with his 1.60 May ERA, is the first D-back starter to post a May ERA of 1.60 or better (min. 5 GS) since Patrick Corbin in May 2013 (1.53).
- **Ketel Marte** launched his ninth homer (2-run in the seventh) and had his fourth straight multi-RBI game...his 452-foot blast was the ninth longest of his career, longest by a D-back (prev.: Corbin Carroll, 448 on May 17 @ Rockies) and longest at Oracle Park this season (prev: Ramón Laureano/SD, 447 on May 4).
- **Ildemaro Vargas** and **Gabriel Moreno** each tallied a hit and 2 RBI.

GIANT SWEEP: With a win, the D-backs will have multiple sweeps vs. Giants in a season (in 3 or 4 game series) for the second time all-time (also: July 25-27, 2008 and Sept. 15-18, 2008)...the D-backs last swept the Padres twice in a season (Sept. 2-4, 2019 and Sept. 27-29, 2019).

MARTE PART-AY: **Ketel Marte** (22 H, 17 RBI, 10 XBH) is the fifth D-back all-time to post a 10-game span of 20+ hits, 15+ RBI and 10+ extra-base hits, joining Steve Finley from May 30-June 9, 1999 (20 H, 19 RBI, 11 XBH), Luis Gonzalez from June 8-19, 2001 (21 H, 21 RBI, 13 XBH), J.D. Martinez from Sept. 4-14, 2017 (20 H, 15 RBI, 13 XBH) and Paul Goldschmidt from June 6-16, 2018 (20 H, 15 RBI, 12 XBH).

OFFENSE OUT OF THE GATES: In their last 12 games since May 15 from innings 1-3, the D-backs' 35 runs and 50 hits are the most in MLB, ahead of the Nationals (30 R, 41 H) and Yankees (41 H)...are batting .340 (50-for-147)/.957 OPS with 13 doubles, 4 triples, 4 homers and 14 walks.

SERIES WINS: The D-backs have won 5 of their last 6 series (W 2-1 vs. Mets, L 1-2 @ Rangers, W 2-1 @ Rockies, W 3-0 vs. Giants, W 3-1 vs. Rockies, W @ Giants/currently 2-0).

30+ WINS: The D-backs have reached 30+ wins thru 54 games or fewer for the third time since 2017 (31 in 2023 and 32 in 2017).

ERRORLESS: Since May 17 (ninth inning) @ Rockies, the D-backs are errorless in 82.0 consecutive innings, the Majors' longest active errorless streak...they had a season-high 84.0-inning errorless streak from April 13-April 25.

THE DIVISION SHOWDOWN: The D-backs are 10-2 in this stretch of 13 straight NL West matchups (2-1 @ Rockies, 3-0 vs. Giants, 3-1 vs. Rockies, 2-0 @ Giants)...also will face NL West opponents 17 of their next 20 (also: June 1-4 vs. Dodgers).

1-2-3: Since May 11 (15 G), D-backs' 1-3 batters have combined for an MLB-best .337 AVG (59-for-175) and .985 OPS...have combined for 14 doubles, 4 triples, 6 homers, 35 RBI and 27 walks (24 K).

STARTING STRONG: Since May 5, D-backs' starters have recorded an MLB-leading 16 quality starts in their last 21 outings, allowing 2 or fewer runs in 14 games.

- Since May 5, the D-backs' rotation ranks among MLB leaders in innings (1st, 137.2), IP/G (1st, 6.2), OBP (1st, .261), wins (T-1st, 14), WHIP (2nd, 1.00) and ERA (3rd, 2.48).
- It is the D-backs ninth season all-time with 16+ quality starts in the month of May (last: 16 in 2011)...has only had 1 season of 17+ quality starts in May: a franchise-best 18 in 2002.

UPCOMING MILESTONES: The D-backs are 3 wins shy (2,197) of 2,200 regular-season wins as a franchise.

- **Corbin Carroll** is 1 triple shy of tying Stephen Drew's 52 (773 G) for the club record.
- **Paul Sewald** is 1 save shy of 100 career.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** is 4 hits shy of 500 career.
- **Torey Lovullo** is 6 wins shy of 700 in his D-backs' managerial tenure.
- **Eduardo Rodriguez** is 1 win shy of 100 career.

VS. GIANTS: The D-backs have won 5 straight games and are 8-1 in their last 9.

• Have won 4 consecutive season series by a single game since 2022 (7-6 from 2023-25 and 10-9 in 2022).

- Seventh road series all-time...have won 2 of their last 3 road series (July 27-29, 2014 and Sept. 10-12, 2021).
- Swept their home series 3-0 from June 9-11, 2025.

NEXT STARTER: RHP ZAC GALLEN (3-4, 4.80)

- Earned his second consecutive win on May 23 vs. Rockies (3 ER in 5.1 IP, 6 H, 2 BB, 6 K).
- Took the loss in his last and lone road start on April 26, 2024 vs. Mariners (3 ER in 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 K).
