JUNE 27
2002 - Pinch-hitter Gregg Zaun hits a walk-off, grand slam with 2 outs in the bottom of the 9th off RHP Byung-Hyun Kim to defeat the Diamondbacks, 7-4, at Daikin Park. Zaun is one of four Astros to hit a walkoff grand slam in franchise history. The others: Milt May (May 22, 1974 vs. SD); Brian Bogusevic (Aug. 16, 2011 vs. CHC); Jose Altuve (June 15, 2021 vs. TEX).

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros and Tigers will play the 3rd game of their 4-game series this afternoon at Comerica Park in DET...RHP Kai-Wei Teng (4-6) will start for the Astros vs. Tigers LHP Framer Valdez (4-5)...tero (3-5).

ROAD TRIPPIN: Today is the 6th game (3-2 thus far) of a 7-game road trip for the Astros...they were 2-1 at TOR on the 1st stop of the trip...Road Recovery: The Astros are 13-8 in their last 3 road trips combined...they are 19-14 on the road since going 1-9 on their 1st road trip of the 2026 season.

ASTROS-TIGERS: The Astros are 3-2 vs. DET this season, having won 2 of 3 games from the Tigers last week at Daikin Park (June 15-17)...the 2 clubs will play all 7 of their scheduled games between June 15-28...in 2025, the Astros and Tigers finished with identical 87-75 records, with the Tigers earning the final AL Wild Card spot due to winning the season series vs. HOU...Recent Success: Since 2022, the Astros are 19-11 vs. DET with an 8-5 record here at Comerica Park.

ABOUT KAI-WEI: Today will be RHP Kai-Wei Teng's 10th start and 23rd app. overall this season...he was solid in his last start on Sunday vs. CLE, allowing just 1 run on 4 hits in 6.0 IP to earn the win in the Astros 2-1 victory...today will be Teng's 2nd start vs. the Tigers (other was June 15 at Daikin Park, 9-3 loss)...he took the loss in that start, but did tally 9 strikeouts in just 3.1 innings of work (9 of the 10 outs recorded were via the punchout)... Daytime Warrior: Teng is 2-1 in 8 daytime app. (3 GS) with a 1.96 ERA (5ER/23IP) and a .188 opp. avg...Teng was acquired by the Astros from the Giants this offseason in exchange for minor league C Jancel Villarroel...Teng is the 2nd Taiwanese-born player ever to appear with HOU, joining RHP Chia Jen-Lo, who made 19 relief app. with the Astros in 2013.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP: The Astros were defeated by the Tigers last night, 8-0...RHP Spencer Arrighetti (7-4) took the loss (3.0 IP, 8 ER)...the Astros bullpen had a good night, allowing just 1 hit over 5.0 shutout innings pitched...RHP Nate Pearson hurled 3.0 innings (1H, 0R), which are a career-high for him as a reliever...offensively, the Astros were held to just 5 hits...Jose Altuve was 2x3.

PITCHING DEBUT: OF Jake Meyers hurled a scoreless 8th inning last night in what was his 1st ML appearance on the mound...while at the Univ. of Nebraska (2015-17), Meyers was 17-4 in 39 appearances (23 starts)...prior to last night, he had 1 pitching appearance as a professional, which was in 2018 while at Buies Creek (1.1 IP, 0 R).

RECENT STROS: The Astros have won 4 of 6, 7 of 10 and 9 of their last 14 games.

WINNING THE CLOSE CALLS: The Astros are 9-4 in 1-run games and 16-10 in 2-run games (4-4 in extra innings).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Astros have won 4 cons. series for the 1st time in 2026, posting an 8-4 record in those series...the last time that the Astros won that many series in a row was when they won 5 straight, from June 20-July 6 of last season (went 12-3 in that stretch).

THE SLOW TURNAROUND: After a slow start to the season, the Astros are 20-13 since May 21, which is the best record in the AL in that span.

MVP-CALIBER: Yordan Alvarez has had a torrid 1st half to his season, currently leading all of baseball with a 1.045 OPS...additionally, he leads the AL in SLG (.619), OBP (.427) and TB (185), is T-1st in HR (25), 2nd in batting avg. (.314) and runs scored (57) and T-3rd in RBI (56)...Alvarez, who was the AL Player of the Month for May, is hitting .349 (29x83) in June with 5 HR and 17 RBI with a 1.033 OPS (.455 OBP/.578 SLG).

ALL-STAR UPDATE: Per MLB's update on Thursday, Yordan Alvarez' 2,911,655 fan votes were tops among all DH's and the 2nd-most overall in the AL...the second phase of fan voting begins Monday, June 29th and features the top two vote-getters at each position...Phase 2 voting concludes at 12:00 p.m. (ET) on Thursday, July 2nd...Alvarez has been an All-Star 3 times thus far in his career...since 2017, the Astros' 37 All-Star selections are tops in the AL in that span.

OH MY FOR IMAI: With his 10 K's Thurs. night, RHP Tatsuya Imai now has tallied 21 strikeouts in his last 2 starts combined...he had a career-high 11 strikeouts in his previous start on June 19 vs. CLE...his 21 K's in his last 2 starts have come in just 12.0 innings pitched, and make him the 1st Astros pitcher to reach 10 punchouts in back-back starts since LHP Framer Valdez, June 5 and 12 of 2025 (11 K at PIT, 12 K vs. CWS, respectively)...Solid Stretch: Since May 25, Imai is 4-1 in his 6 starts with a 3.64 ERA (12ER/29.2IP) with 37 K's in 29.2 IP.

PEN PALS: The Astros bullpen combined for 5.0 scoreless innings last night, continuing a trend of solid pitching over the past 6 weeks...since May 15, the Astros bullpen has been one of the best in the AL, posting a 2.66 clip (42ER/142P) in that span...the Astros are 23-16 since May 15.

OKERT'S O's: LHP Steven Okert has not allowed a run in his last 17.0 innings, which is the longest scoreless streak by an Astros hurler this season and the 3rd-longest by a reliever in the Majors this season...in his current streak, which spans 14 appearances, and began on May 23 at CHC, Okert has allowed just 8 hits in those 17.0 innings pitched.

HADERADE: In his 10 appearances since coming of the IL on June 3, opponents are just 2x32 off LHP Josh Hader...for the season, Hader has posted a 0.90 ERA (1ER/10IP) and is 6-for-6 in save opportunities (.063 opp. avg., .040 WHIP).

TAPPING FOR SUCCESS: Astros batters have won an MLB-best 58 ABS challenges and lead the Majors in challenge success rate (60%)...Isaac Paredes (9-for-9) has the most successful challenges in the Majors without losing one...Jose Altuve has been successful on 14-of-20 challenges (70%), ranking 2nd in the Majors in successful challenges.

PRONUNCIATION: Full name is pronounced "kiy-way dhung"

LAST START, JUNE 21 vs. CLE: Earned the win last Sunday in Houston after tying his career-high with 6.0 innings pitched while allowing 1 run on 4 hits and 1 walk...struck out 4 and tossed 83 pitches (55 strikes)...the Astros won that game 2-1 over the Guardians...Teng's win snapped a personal 3-game losing streak...in the start, Teng surpassed the 100-inning mark in his MLB career.

KAI-WEI PATROL: The 27-year-old righty has split his season between the bullpen (13g) and rotation (9g)...is making his 9th consecutive turn in the Astros rotation, dating back to his start on May 10 at CIN...as a starter this season, he's recorded a 5.13 ERA (23ER/40.1IP) with 42 strikeouts, 20 walks and a .263 opponent batting average.

SWINGMAN: An offseason acquisition, Teng made his 1st career Opening Day roster and began the season working out of the Astros' bullpen...made his first 11 apps. of the season out of the bullpen, posting a 2.16 ERA (4ER/16.2IP) over that span, before making his 1st start of the season on April 28 at BAL...returned to the bullpen for 2 appearances on May 2 at BOS and May 4 vs. LAD before his current stretch of 8 consecutive starts.

STRONG RUN: In a 4-start stretch from May 10-29, he recorded a 2.84 ERA (6ER/19IP) with 21 strikeouts, a .188 opponent batting average (12x64) and a 1.26 WHIP...that 4-start stretch included his first career 6.0-inning start in a scoreless outing on May 23 at CHC.

CAREER MARKS: Has already set a single game career-high in starts with 9, surpassing 7 starts last season with the Giants...has also set his single-season career highs in appearances (22) and strikeouts (62), surpassing totals of 8 appearances and 39 strikeouts last season with the Giants.

FOR STARTERS: Has made 34 total MLB appearances (2024-26), with 16 of them as a starter...has posted huge strikeout numbers as a starter in his MLB career, recording 77 strikeouts through 65.0 innings in those outings.

HARD TO HIT: Has limited opponents to a .227 opponent average (51x225) this season, including a .184 (19x103) average to right-handed hitters...also owns a 0.94 WHIP vs. right-handed hitters this season.

VS. DET: Has faced the Tigers once in his career which came in the Astros last homestand on June 15 in Houston...allowed 5 runs in 3.1 innings and was handed the loss in the Astros 9-3 defeat...allowed a career-high 3 home runs and struck out a career-high 9 hitters in the outing.

THE TAIWANESE TENG: The Taiwanese righty was acquired from San Francisco on Jan. 29, 2026, in exchange for catching prospect **Jancel Villarroel**...has appeared in parts of 3 seasons with the Giants (2024-25) and Astros (2026), making 34 career Major League appearances (16 starts)...he became the 2nd Taiwanese-born player to appear with the Astros in franchise history, joining **RHP Chia-Jen Lo**, who made 19 relief appearances with the Astros in 2013.

LAST APPEARANCE (6/26 at DET): Struck out 1 in 1.0 scoreless inning last night at DET.

ACTIVATED: Was activated from the Restricted List on Thursday...missed the entire 3-game series against the Blue Jays.

TURNING THE PAGE: Has gone 2-1 with 4 saves and a 2.65 ERA (5ER/17IP) in his last 19 appearances, dating back to May 3...within these appearances, he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is the 2nd-longest by an Astro this season, behind **LHP Steven Okert** (active 14-game streak).

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: Has made 347 career appearances, recently passing **RHP Ryan Pressly** (342g) for 6th in franchise history in relief appearances...now directly trails **LHP Joe Sambito** (348g) for 5th on that all-time list...also ranks 4th all-time among Astros relievers in strikeouts (482) and 10th in innings pitched (356.0).

CAREER: In 347 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.91 ERA (115ER/356IP) with 482 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.19 K/9 and a 0.78 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
