**TODAY'S GAME:** With a home series win secured, the Giants will try to get greedy in this afternoon's finale as they eye a sweep of the A's.

- ▶ SF's home series win is its first since taking two-of-three from the White Sox from May 22-24.
- ▶ The Giants are seeing a left-handed starter for a second straight day and have now won each of their last three games vs. a LHSP... they are 9-13 overall this year versus lefty starters.
- ▶ Technically speaking, SF swept its abbreviated two-game series with Atlanta last week for its first sweep of the year...the Giants are trying to sweep a series at home for the first time since ending last year with a three-game sweep of the Rockies at home.

**VS. THE A'S:** Last night's win brought the Giants to 10-2 over their last 12 games vs. the A's dating to August 18, 2024.

- ▶ The Giants are 11-3 (.786) vs. the A's here at Oracle Park since the start of the 2021 season...SF's .786 home winning percentage is its second best vs. any opponent over that time behind only its mark vs. Colorado (33-6, .846).
- ▶ With a win today, SF would sweep the A's at home in a three-game series for a second straight year...the last time the Giants swept consecutive home series versus the A's was from 2009-2011 when they swept three consecutive series against the A's (9-0 overall).
- ▶ A win today would make it five straight victories vs. the A's, which would be SF's longest winning streak vs. the A's since 2010-2011 (six straight wins).
- ▶ Today marks the 160th game all-time during Interleague play between the A's and Giants...the 160 games match the Angels-Dodgers matchup for most in Interleague history.

**LANDMAN: RHP Landen Roupp** closes this series for SF this afternoon looking to sustain momentum from his outing in Miami last Friday...Roupp logged his first quality start in a month against the Marlins (6.0ip, 7h, 2r, bb, 7k) but the Giants still lost the game, 4-3.

- ▶ The Giants have dropped each of Roupp's last nine starts dating to May 2 after winning five of his first six starts to begin the year...Roupp is 0-6 with a 5.40 ERA (27er, 45.0ip) in those nine starts.
- ▶ Today marks his second career start against the A's...his other start against them came last May here at Oracle...he blanked the A's over 6.0 innings, surrendered five hits and struck out five in SF's eventual 1-0 win in 10 innings.

**VICTOR(Y): OF Victor Bericoto** sent the Giants home victorious with his first career walk-off hit and RBI with his 9th-inning homer yesterday.

- ▶ It was the second walk-off homer by a Giant all-time in their head-to-head series with the A's that began in 1997...the only other walk-off homer was hit by **Ray Durham** exactly 20 years ago to the day on June 24, 2006 (*Sport Radar*).
- ▶ Bericoto's walk-off homer joined the walk-off grand slam by **IF Bryce Eldridge** on June 10 as the two walk-off homers by SF hitters this season...the last time two Giants rookies age 24 or younger both hit walk off homers in the same season was 1985 when **Rob Deer** and **David Green** both did so...it's the third time overall in the SF-era (1958-pres.) that SF has had two (or more) players 24-years-old or younger hit walk-off homers in the same season (also 1961 with **Orlando Cepeda** hit two, and **Matty Alou** and **Willie McCovey** each hit one) (*Stats, LLC*).

**JHL DELIVERS:** With two more hits last night, **OF Jung Hoo Lee** is now hitting .462 (42-for-91) with 12 extra-base hits, 10 RBI, 20 runs scored and five stolen bases in 23 game since coming off the Injured List on May 29...his .333 average entering play today is second-best in MLB behind MIA's Otto Lopez (.340).

- ▶ Lee's .462 average since May 29 leads the Majors (min. 95 PA) while his 1.128 OPS in this stretch is fourth-best in the Majors behind CHC's Pete Crow-Armstrong (1.328), LAD's Shohei Ohtani (1.156) and the A's Nick Kurtz (1.138).

**WE MEET AGAIN...:** SF welcomes in the Braves for a weekend series beginning tomorrow night...the Giants swept the rain-altered, two-game series in Atlanta last week.

- ▶ With the two wins last week, the Giants are 7-1 against the Braves dating back to the start of last season...SF swept its three-game series with Atlanta here at Oracle last June...that sweep marked the Giants first series win over the Braves in SF since 2022.

**ROUPPER:** Roupp is in his third season with San Francisco...the 27-year-old was the Giants' 12th round pick in 2021 out of UNC Wilmington.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Received a no-decision in his last start despite a solid outing in Miami last Friday...left in line for the win after he allowed two runs on seven hits (one homer) and a walk while striking out seven over 6.0 innings...he generated a season-high 16 swings and misses from Marlins hitters during the outing...his previous high this year was 15 on May 14 at the Dodgers.

**VS. THE A'S:** Will be making his second career start vs. the A's (also May 17, 2025)...threw 6.0 shutout innings in that start, striking out five while allowing five hits and two walks.

**MAY DAY:** Roupp has struggled since the start of May after finishing April as one of MLB's best pitchers (5-1 with a 2.55 ERA in six starts)...since May 2, Roupp is 0-6 with a 5.40 ERA (27er, 45.0ip), 52 strikeouts and a 1.60 WHIP over his last nine starts (two quality starts)...SF is winless in each of his last nine outings.

**SO WHAT CHANGED?:** The big difference for Roupp are the results vs. his sinker...since May 2, opponents are slashing .355/.437/.645 with 11 extra-base hits (three homers) and a 1.082 OPS in nine starts...prior to this stretch, opponents were slashing .114/.264/.159 with two extra-base hits (zero homers) and a .423 OPS...in his last start, which was more reminiscent of his dominant first month, his sinker was again on point, with Marlins batters going 1-for-6 vs. the pitch.

**WHERE'S THE K COUNTER LOCATED?:** Roupp has 89 strikeouts in 80.1 innings this season with his 26.3% strikeout rate currently standing as a career-best (21.7% rate in 2024 and a 21.4% rate in 2025)...the 26.3% strikeout rate is 10th best in the NL among qualified pitchers while his 89 strikeouts are tied for 10th-most in the NL.

**WHAT'S THE COUNT?:** Roupp's 17.9 pitches per inning is the highest mark in MLB among pitchers with at least 80.0 innings pitched this season...Roupp's 4.26 pitches per batter faced is also the highest in MLB (min. 80.0ip) ahead of his teammate **Robbie Ray** (4.17).

**NO EAR PLUGS NEEDED:** The righty's 29.9% hard hit rate this season is the lowest in the Majors by (min. 200 batted ball events)...Roupp's 51.4% ground ball rate in 2026 is sixth-highest in MLB (among qualified pitchers).

**CALLING CARD:** Since entering the Majors in 2024, Roupp's go-to out pitch has been his curveball...this season, Roupp's curveball has been his best pitch this season in terms of whiff rate (37.0%) and putaway rate (29.6%)...the pitch's +4 run value is tied with his sinker for his best pitch this season.

**CLUTCH UP:** With two outs and RISP are batting just .103 (3x29) with a .310 OPS when facing Roupp...the .103 opposing batting average with two outs and RISP is sixth best in MLB among qualified pitchers while the .310 OPS is fourth.

**WE LOVE TO SEE IT:** Roupp averages 13.6 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, which is third-fastest in MLB (min. 400 pitches thrown)...the league average in 2026 is 16.2 seconds with the bases empty.

**RUNS 4 ROUPP:** The righty has 34 total runs of support this season, tied for eighth-fewest in MLB among pitchers with at least 15 starts...his 3.81 run support average is 19th lowest among pitchers with at least 15 starts.

- ▶ Is 0-5 with a 6.75 ERA (20er, 26.2ip) in his last six starts dating to May 22...SF is 1-5 in those starts...the Giants were 3-0 in McDonald's first three starts this year.
