HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs are 5-3 in their last 8 overall games vs. NL West.

- The D-backs are 6-2 in their last 8 road games @ NL West.
- The D-backs are 5-0-2 in their last 7 series vs. NL West: 2-1 @ Rockies, 3-0 vs. Giants, 3-1 vs. Rockies, 3-0 @ Giants, 2-2 vs. Dodgers, 2-1 vs. Giants, 2-2 @ Padres.
- First-time All-Star **Eduardo Rodriguez**, in his last 3 starts vs. Dodgers, has a 0.53 ERA (2 R-1 ER in 17.0 IP) and an opponent .213 AVG (13-for-61) with 7 walks and 12 strikeouts.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached safely in 29 straight starts.
- **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 7 of his last 8 games vs. NL West, batting .333 (10-for-30)/.988 OPS with 3 homers and 3 RBI.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 3-1 @ Padres for their second straight 4-game series split vs. Padres.

- **Merrill Kelly** got the victory with a quality start (7.0 IP, 1 R, 3 H, 3 BB, 6 K).
- **Geraldo Perdomo** had a go-ahead, RBI single in the fifth inning, and **Nolan Arenado** hit a solo homer in the sixth inning.
- **Corbin Carroll** and **Tommy Troy** each had 1 single and 1 walk.

IT STARTS WITH STARTING PITCHING: D-backs starting pitchers, in their last 6 starts, have a 3.51 ERA (13 ER in 33.1 IP), an opponent .238 AVG (30-for-126)/.680 OPS, 10 walks and 28 strikeouts.

- Among NL teams since July 4, rank tied for third with 33.1 innings, sixth with a 3.51 ERA and an opponent .238 AVG, and seventh with a .680 OPS.

FIRST-INNING TALLIES: The D-backs have scored in the first inning in 5 of their last 6 games, including a season-high 5 consecutive games from July 4-8.

VS. NL WEST: The D-backs' 18 wins vs. NL West are second among NL teams, behind the Dodgers (22) and ahead of the Phillies (16), Cubs (15) and Padres (15).

EL PIKE VS. NL WEST: **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 20 of his last 21 games vs. NL West, hitting .391 (34-for-87)/1.209 OPS with 8 doubles, 1 triple, 8 home runs, 26 RBI and 7 walks.

- Reached base in 20 straight games vs. NL West from May 16-July 8, the third-longest streak of his career behind a 23-gamer (April 2-Aug. 1, 2023) and 21-gamer (June 10-Aug. 17, 2018).

ARENADO CLOSING IN ON 2,000 HITS: **Nolan Arenado's** 1,994 hits are 6 hits shy of 2,000 career.

- Will become the sixth active player with 2,000+ hits: Manny Machado/BAL-LAD-SD (July 7, 2025), Paul Goldschmidt/AZ-STL-NYY (July 26, 2024), Jose Altuve/HOU (Aug. 20, 2023), Freddie Freeman/ATL-LAD (June 25, 2023) and Andrew McCutchen/PIT-SF-NYY-PHI-MIL-TEX (June 11, 2023).
- Will become the third player to record their 2,000th career hit while with the D-backs, joining Steve Finley (Sept. 13, 2002 vs. Brewers) and Luis Gonzalez (May 22, 2004 @ Marlins) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

MORENO'S ON-BASE STREAK: **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 29 straight starts (C: 24, DH: 5), since June 2, hitting .337 (35-for-104)/.911 OPS with 5 doubles, 3 homers, 11 RBI and 18 walks (11 K).

- Majors' longest active streak and fourth-longest streak this season, behind 30 by Ian Happ/CHI (April 5-May 9), 33 by Bryan Reynolds/PIT (May 23-June 29) and 48 by Nick Kurtz/ATH (April 3-May 25).
- Tied for the 10th-longest streak in club history with Ketel Marte (2019 and '23), Luis Gonzalez (2003) and Steve Finley (2000).
 - Next on the franchise list is 31 straight starts by Paul Goldschmidt (2013), Eric Byrnes (2007) and Matt Williams (1999).

GABI ON THE ROAD: Since May 13, **Gabriel Moreno's** .390 road AVG leads the Majors and his 1.025 road OPS is seventh.

- Has reached base in 21 of his last 23 road games, including 2+ times in 16 of those, hitting .390 (32-for-82)/1.025 OPS with 5 doubles, 3 homers, 12 RBI and 12 walks (12 K).

GERRY MAKING HIS WAY ON BASE ON THE ROAD: **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 7 of his last 8 road games, batting .344 (11-for-32)/.963 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 3 RBI and 2 walks (2 K).

ALL-STAR FACTS: **Eduardo Rodriguez** (first career appearance in 11th MLB season) is 1 of 8 MLB players since 2022 to be named a first-time All-Star in their 10th season or later, joining Raisel Iglesias/ATL ('26, 12th), Matthew Boyd/CHC ('25, 11th), Jurickson Profar/SD ('24, 11th), Alex Cobb/SF ('23, 12th), Jorge Soler/MIA ('23, 10th), Martín Pérez/TEX ('22, 10th) and Travis d'Arnaud/ATL ('22, 10th) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

- **Corbin Carroll** (second straight appearance, third career) is 1 of 7 players who have debuted since 2017 with 3+ All-Star selections at age 25 or younger, along with Ronald Acuna Jr./ATL (4 in 2019, 2021-23), Vladimir Guerrero Jr./TOR (4 in 2021-24), Juan Soto/WSH-SD-NYY (4 in 2021-24), Riley Greene/DET (3 in 2024-26), Julio Rodriguez/SEA (3 in 2022-23, 2025) and Paul Skenes/PIT (3 in 2024-26).

VS. DODGERS: The D-backs series split vs. Dodgers from June 1-4 at Chase Field was their second straight 4-game split at home (also: May 8-11, 2025).
