PITTSBURGH PIRATES (1-5) AT TAMPA BAY RAYS (4-1)

April 2, 2025 - George M. Steinbrenner Field - Tampa, FL - 1:10 EDT - Game #7/Road #7 RHP Paul Skenes (0-0, 3.38 ERA) vs. RHP Ryan Pepiot (0-0, 1.50 ERA)

THE PIRATES: fell for the fourth time in a row and fifth time in six games to open the season with their loss last night...Earned their first win of 2025 with a 4-3 victory Friday night...Opened the season on the road for the ninth straight year and the 10th time in 11 years...Finished 2024 with a 76-86 record (fifth place in the N.L. Central)...Won 15 games in their last at-bat last season (most since having 16 in 2021)...Played in 51 one-run games in 2024, their most since 2018 (also 51).

BETTER CALL PAUL: Paul Skenes will make the start today in the finale of this three-game series and season-opening, sevengame road trip...He was in line for the win, but came away with a no-decision on Opening Day at Miami...The 22-year-old Skenes has amassed a total of 177 punchouts since making his big-league debut on May 11, 2024, tied with Detroit's Tarik Skubal for third-most among all Major League pitchers in that time, trailing only Atlanta's Chris Sale (185) and Seattle's Logan Gilbert (184).

<u>SHIRTS ON YOUR BACK</u>: Major League Baseball announced on Monday that Paul Skenes was the 15th-most popular jersey purchased by fans since the culmination of last season's World Series...Skenes' first appearance on this list also marks the first time a Pirates player has ranked among the 20 most popular player jersey purchases since Andrew McCutchen in 2016.

SO LONG, SUNSHINE STATE: Today is the final day of 2025 that the Pirates will spend in the state of Florida...Their first workout for pitchers and catchers took place on February 12 in Bradenton...In addition to the 30 games the Pirates played during Grapefruit League action, they also opened the regular season with a four-game series against the Marlins in Miami.

412 DAY: The Pirates will be off tomorrow before returning to action Friday afternoon against the Yankees at PNC Park (first pitch is scheduled for 4:12 p.m.)...This will be the fourth consecutive season that first pitch for Pittsburgh's Home Opener will be at 4:12 p.m., as well as the third season in a row that the Pirates' Home Opener will be played against an American League opponent.

<u>IKF</u>: Isiah Kiner-Falefa is 6-for-16 (.375) while hitting safely in each of his last five games since going hitless on Opening Day (he has hit out of the ninth spot of the lineup in each of the first six games)...The five-game hitting streak is tied for his longest since joining the Pirates on July 30 of last year (also 8/30-9/3, 2024)...Since the beginning of last season, Kiner Falefa is batting .340 (16-for-47) with a .415 on-base percentage in 17 games out of the ninth spot...Pittsburgh's .333 average out of the ninth spot is tied for the third-best (along with Houston, Philadelphia and Tampa Bay) mark in MLB, trailing Chicago-NL (.400) and Cincinnati (.357).

FERGALICIOUS: Caleb Ferguson pitched a scoreless sixth inning Tuesday against the Rays, his fourth scoreless outing in a row to open the season...Ferguson, who was signed by Pittsburgh on January 10 after spending 2024 with New York (AL) and Houston, has a 1.35 earned run average (6.2ip/1er) with seven strikeouts over his last eight regular-season games (since September 16, 2024).

SPEED & DISCIPLINE: Oneil Cruz has reached base safely in five of six games to begin the season...He leads MLB with five steals and is pacing the Pirates with six walks through the first six games of 2025...<u>Cruz became one of four Major Leaguers since 1901 with five-plus steals and six-plus walks through his first five games of a season, the first since Rickey Henderson with Oakland in 1982.</u>

I'VE BEEN EVERYWHERE: When Andrew McCutchen pinch hit in the ninth inning of Tuesday's game at George M. Steinbrenner Field, it became the 37th stadium he's played at least one regular-season game in since making his Major League debut in 2009, per the Elias Sports Bureau...Out of the 30 active stadiums, the only ones McCutchen hasn't played at are Globe Life Field (Rangers) and Sutter Health Park (Athletics)...He's also played in games at eight stadiums not currently in use by a Major League team (Globe

Life Park, Hubert H. Humphrey Metrodome, Oákland Coliseum, Sahlen Field, Sun Life Stadium, TD Ballpark, Tropicana Field and Turner Field)...McCutchen also appeared in one game at Historic Bowman Field in Williamsport, PA, when Pittsburgh was a part of Major League Baseball's 2017 Little League Classic.

CUTCH: Andrew McCutchen collected the 800th extra-base hit of his Major League career with his home run leading off the second inning Sunday at Miami...His 611 extra-base hits with Pittsburgh rank fifth in Pirates history, while his 800 Major League extra-base hits are third-most among all active players...McCutchen is also just three RBI shy of 1100 for his Major League career, and he ranks fifth among active players on that list (LAD's Freddie Freeman leads with 1236, while NYY's Giancarlo Stanton is six RBI ahead of McCutchen with 1103)...McCutchen is also tied with Arky Vaughan for 10th on Pittsburgh's all-time runs list (936)...Tommy Leach ranks ninth with 1009 runs.

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected by the Pirates in the 1st round (No. 1) of the 2023 Draft.

STARTING OFF: The 22-year-old righty will make his second start of the season today here at George M. Steinbrenner Field...Took home BBWAA National League Rookie of the Year honors last season after making his Major League debut on May 11 vs. the Cubs...Was the No. 1 overall selection by the Pirates in the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of Louisiana State University.

LAST TIME: Skenes allowed two runs in 5.1 innings but had a no-decision on March 27 (Opening Day) at Miami...He was in line for the win before the Pirates were walked off in the ninth inning.

OPENING DAY HONORS: Skenes allowed two runs in 5.1 innings but had a no-decision on Opening Day... At 22 years and 302 days old, Skenes was the youngest Opening Day starter in club history dating back to 1893 (Frank Killen, 22 years and 148 days)...He was also the youngest Major League pitcher to make an Opening Day start since José Fernández, who did so in Miami for the Marlins on March 31, 2014, when he was 21 years and 243 days old....Skenes, who was the top pick in the 2023 First-Year Player Draft, also became the fastest No. 1 overall selection to make an Opening Day start...According to Major League Baseball, the previous quickest to do so were Mike Moore (top pick in 1981 and Opening Day starter in 1984) and Stephen Strasburg (top pick in 2009 and Opening Day starter in 2012).

ROOKIE OF THE YEAR HONORS: Last year, Skenes became the second player in Pirates history to take home BBWAA Rookie of the Year honors, along with Jason Bay in 2004...He became the first rookie pitcher to make at least 23 starts and post a sub-2.00 ERA in a single season since Scott Perry with the Philadelphia Athletics in 1918...He also became the 24th pitcher to win the N.L. Rookie of the Year Award and the first to do so since Devin Williams with Milwaukee in 2020.

IN A LEAGUE OF HIS OWN: Skenes recorded a 1.96 earned run average in 23 starts during his rookie season in 2024...His 1.96 ERA from the time of his big-league debut on May 11 through the end of the season was the lowest in all of MLB...His .198 batting average against was also the lowest by a Pirates starting pitcher in team history (minimum 16 starts)...His 1.96 ERA was the lowest by a Major League rookie pitcher (minimum 18 starts) in the Live Ball era (since 1920).

ALL-STAR HONORS: Skenes entered the 2024 All-Star break with a 6-0 record, 1.90 ERA, 0.92 WHIP, 89 strikeouts and 13 walks in 11 starts...The strikeout total was the fifth-most in Major League history (since 1901) through 11 starts...When he started for the National League on July 16 in Arlington, he became one of five rookie pitchers to start the All-Star Game, joining Hideo Nomo (1995), Fernando Valenzuela (1981), Mark Fidrych (1976) and Dave Stenhouse (1962).

AND THE WHIFF: Skenes struck out a club rookie-record 170 batters last season...He became the first pitcher in the Modern Era with 150 strikeouts and an ERA under 2.00 over his first 22 games...The previous club record since 1900 was 142, which was held by Cy Blanton in 1935.

IN GOOD COMPANY: Skenes became one of just four pitchers since 1893 with 10 strikeouts and zero hits allowed in multiple outings in a single season in 2024...The only other pitchers to accomplish that were Nolan Ryan in 1973, Max Scherzer in 2015 and Justin Verlander in 2022.

Skenes has made one start in his career against the Rays, coming on June 23, 2024 at PNC Park. In that start, where he did not earn a decision in Pittsburgh's 3-1 loss, Skenes struck out eight batters across 7.0 innings while throwing 98 pitches.


