THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
APRIL 16
2002 - **Lance Berkman** continues to torment the Reds pitching staff as he ties the club record by homering three times in the Astros 8-3 win in Cincinnati... he homers in his first three at-bats and has two more chances to become the only player in club history with a four-homer game, but falls just short...Berkman would finish his career with 52 homers against the Reds, his most by far against any single opponent.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros, who enter tonight's game on a seven-game home winning streak, look to secure a series sweep tonight in the finale of their three-game series vs. the Rockies...Astros starter **RHP Ryan Weiss** will transition from the bullpen to the rotation to make his first Major League start tonight as he opposes the Rockies and their opener **RHP Juan Mejia**.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: **RHP Ryan Weiss**, who's made five relief appearances this season, is back pitching in the United States in 2026 after spending the last two seasons in the KBO...he made 46 career starts in Korea for the Hanwha Eagles and posted a 3.16 ERA, a 1.07 WHIP and 305 strikeouts in 270.1 innings over those two seasons...the Astros signed him to a Major League deal in December.

HOME-COOKIN': Tonight is the third game of a six-game homestand for the Astros, in which they'll host a pair of NL opponents in the Rockies and Cardinals...the Astros enter tonight's game 7-2 overall at Daikin Park in 2026 and own an active seven-game home winning streak, their longest at home since a nine-game run from June 11-27, 2025.

SWEEPSTAKES: The Astros are going for their second sweep of the season, last sweeping the Red Sox in Houston from March 30-April 1...the Astros have several two-game sweeps over the Rockies recently, but have not swept them in a three-game series since June 1-3, 2009.

VS. THE ROCKIES: The Astros were swept by the Rockies last week in a three-game series at Coors Field (April 6-9), which was the Astros first sweep at the hands of the Rockies since a four-game series from May 28-31, 2012...after the 2012 season, the Astros have not lost a season series against the Rockies, winning seven times and splitting twice.

TONIGHT'S SPECIAL GUESTS: Astros closer **LHP Josh Hader** will host a group of kids from BEAR at Thursday's game as a part of his Hader's Heart program...the group will also get to experience BP and talk with Hader on the field prior to the game.

FLEET WEEK HOUSTON: In honor of Fleet Week Houston, a ceremonial first pitch will be thrown out by U.S. Navy Machinist's Mate 3rd Class **Tarren Foreman** from Lufkin, Texas...a special Play Ball Call will be made by Admiral **Karl Thomas**, Commander, U.S. Fleet Forces Command.

LAST NIGHT'S WIN: For the first time this season, the Astros won by scoring fewer than four runs in a 3-1 win over the Rockies...**RHP Spencer Arrighetti** (1ER/6IP) was the story, as he shut down the Rockies thru 6.0 innings with 10 strikeouts in his first Major League start of the season...**DH Yordan Alvarez** (2x3, HR, RBI) smashed a homer in the win, giving him seven longballs on the season, which ranks tied for first in the AL.

DOUBLE DIGIT K'S: With 10 strikeouts last night, **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** picked up his fifth career double-digit strikeout game and his first since the 2024 season...the 10 strikeouts were also a single-game high for an Astros pitcher in 2026.

TAXI SQUAD ADDITION: The Astros have added **RHP Peter Lambert** to the Major League Taxi Squad...a former Rockie, Lambert has spent his 2026 season at Triple A Sugar Land, posting a 1.84 ERA (3ER/14.2IP) in three games (two starts).

THE ORDER: The Astros have used 19 different batting orders in their 19 games so far this season... only **LF Yordan Alvarez** has started every game in the same spot in the batting order (batting second).

HOT START: **LF Yordan Alvarez** ranks first in the AL in extra-base hits (13), total bases (48), OPS (1.250), SLG (.762) and OBP (.488), ranks tied for first in walks (17), tied for second in RBI (17), tied for third in doubles (6), and tied for fourth in batting average (.333) and runs scored (15).

MR. 2000: **2B Jose Altuve** has appeared in 1,994 career games and is looking to become the third player in franchise history to reach 2,000 career games, which would join him with **Craig Biggio** (2,850) and **Jeff Bagwell** (2,150)...only four active players have reached 2,000 career games: **Andrew McCutchen** (2,274), **Carlos Santana** (2,212), **Fredie Freeman** (2,197) and **Paul Goldschmidt** (2,081).

ROCKING THE ROCKIES: **1B Christian Walker** has enjoyed facing the Rockies throughout his career, posting a .332 avg. (123x370) vs. them with 29 HR and 78 RBI with a 1.018 OPS...his career avg., RBI and OPS vs. COL are his best vs. any club (min. 10g) while his 29 HR match his most against any single opponent (also the Dodgers)...his 29 home runs are also tied with **1B Paul Goldschmidt** for the most homers against the Rockies among active players.

AGENT SMITH: **RF Cam Smith** is coming off a strong road trip, in which he hit .324 (12x37) with three doubles, two homers, seven RBI and a .927 OPS in 10 games (nine starts)...Smith has continued that hot streak this homestand, going 2x6 with a double, 2 RBI and a run scored in two games.

HARD TO HIT: **RHP Kai-Wei Teng**, just the second Taiwanese-born player to appear with the Astros in their history, has held opponents to 5x34 on the season for a .147 opponent average...overall, Teng has gone 1-0 with a 2.79 ERA (3ER/9.2IP), a 0.93 WHIP and 11 strikeouts in 9.2 innings in relief.

ON THE MEND: **LHP Bennett Sousa** (left oblique strain) is currently on a rehab assignment with Double A Corpus Christi and is next scheduled to pitch tomorrow for the Hooks...Sousa was an integral member of the Astros bullpen in 2025, posting a 5-1 record with four saves and 2.84 ERA (16ER/50.2IP) in 44 appearances.

WEISS IS RIGHT: Is set to make his 1st career MLB start in what will be his 6th career MLB appearance, all made this season with the Astros...last appeared on Friday at SEA, tossing a season-high 64 pitches (35 strikes) while allowing 2 runs on 4 hits with 2 walks and 4 strikeouts.

LETS GET STARTED: Has a wealth of experience as a starter at the pro level, including 30 starts in his breakout 2025 season with the Hanwha Eagles of the KBO, going 16-5 with a 2.87 ERA (57ER/178.2IP), a 1.02 WHIP and 10.4 SO/9IP...across 5 seasons in the affiliated minor leagues (2018-23), spent in the Diamondbacks and Royals systems, he made 47 starts among his 132 total appearances...while with the High Point Rockers of the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball in 2024, he averaged 14.4 SO/9IP (73SO/45.2IP) through his 9 appearances, all starts.

2026 AT A GLANCE: Was a member of the Astros Opening Day roster and made his MLB debut with his 1st appearance of the season on March 27 vs. LAA (1.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 2 SO)...picked up his 1st career strikeout vs. **OF Jorge Soler**...has been a go-to multi-inning reliever out of the Astros bullpen this season, logging 2.0+ innings in all but 1 of his appearances thus far...his 11.0 relief innings this season are T-3rd in the AL...he also ranks T-2nd among AL relievers in strikeouts (15)...in the AL, is 1 of 4 relievers with at least 4 appearances of 2.0+ innings, and only **LAA LHP Brent Suter** has more appearances of 2.0+ innings (5).

THE HEATER: Has averaged 95.7 mph with his fastball, which ranks 5th among Astros pitchers this season, behind **RHP Hunter Brown** (96.2), **RHP Christian Roa** (96.1), **RHP AJ Blubaugh** (95.8) and **RHP Jayden Murray** (95.8).

2025 BREAKOUT: In the KBO in 2025, he ranked 3rd in innings (178.2IP), 3rd in wins (16) and 4th in strikeouts (207)...those totals also constituted single-season career highs for his pro career.

ABOUT WEISS: Returned to the United States after 2 seasons in the KBO, signing a MLB deal with the Astros on Dec. 9, 2025...has been well-traveled in his professional career, spending his first five seasons (2018-23) at the affiliated minor league level in the Diamondbacks and Royals systems, followed by stints with the Fubon Guardians of the Chinese Professional Baseball League (2023), the High Point Rockers of the Atlantic League of Professional Baseball (2023-24) and the Hanwha Eagles of the KBO (2024-25)...was originally selected by the Diamondbacks in the 4th round of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft from Wright State University.

ALL-TIME RANKINGS: Among relievers in club history, ranks 4th in K's (460), 7th in apps. (325) and 11th in IP (336.0)...surpassed **RHP Ryan Pressly** for 11th in innings last week...is 1.0 inning from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** (337) for 10th on that list.

MULTI-INNING MAN: A starter throughout his minor league career, has 4 multi-inning outings among his 7 appearances this season...among AL relievers, ranks T-5thin innings (10.2).

OPENING DAY FIRE: Made his 1st career Opening Day roster this season and pitched that day vs. LAA, tossing 2.1 innings of 1-run ball...tossed a 98.8 mph 4-seam fastball on a strikeout of **IF Yoán Moncada**, the hardest pitch thrown in his career.
