**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants and Twins play the second game of this three-game set this afternoon with SF looking to claim a series victory with a win.

- ▶ The two teams have been historically evenly matched since first facing each other in the regular season in 2003, with SF going 12-10 in the 22 overall games.
- ▶ The Giants are trying to win their third Interleague series of the year, having lost six of their eight Interleague series thus far in 2024...the only series vs. American League teams SF has won were at Texas (June 7-9) and vs. Houston (June 10-12).
- ▶ SF has won eight of its last 12 games here at Oracle Park dating to June 16 while averaging 6.0 runs/game...they have won 10 of their last 17 games overall since June 24.

**ROSTER MOVES:** RHP Austin Warren was returned from his rehab assignment, reinstated from the 60-day Injured List and optioned to Triple-A Sacramento.

**ENGAGE YOUR CORE:** The Giants are inducting the Core Four bullpen quartet of LHP Jeremy Affeldt, RHP Santiago Casilla, LHP Javier López and RHP Sergio Romo into the Giants Wall of Fame in a pregame ceremony today.

- ▶ The fearsome foursome were a vital cog in the Giants run to three World Series titles in five seasons from 2010-2014... they combined for a 1.14 ERA in 98 Postseason games from 2010-2014.
- ▶ Fans are encouraged to be in their seats by 3:15 p.m. for the ceremony.

**PURPLE RAIN:** SF has done well against the Twins in recent years, particularly here at home...the Giants have won seven of their last nine games against Minnesota at Oracle Park dating to June 22, 2011, outscoring them by 23 runs (45-22) in that stretch.

- ▶ Giants pitchers have a 2.33 ERA (21er, 81.0ip) in those outings, holding Twins batters to a .197 average and .564 OPS.

**FOUR SCORE AND NEARLY A MONTH AGO?:** Last night, LHP Kyle Harrison worked 5.1 innings in SF's win.

- ▶ He became the first Giants starter *other than* RHP Logan Webb to record an out in the 6th inning or later in almost a month...the last starter other than Webb to do it was RHP Keaton Winn on June 15 vs. the Angels (6.0ip).
- ▶ Overall, Webb himself has pitched 5.1 or more innings 16 times this season...the rest of the Giants starters *combined* have done so a total of 16 times (Harrison - 7, RHP Jordan Hicks - 4, Winn - 5).

**IT'S A START...:** SF's offense plated seven runs yesterday en route to the victory, their first time reaching the seven-run threshold since scoring 10 back on June 30 against the Dodgers.

- ▶ The Giants went 4-for-10 w/RISP last night...during their previous five games (of which they lost four), they had a combined six hits w/RISP (6-for-35).
- ▶ SF's .219 batting average so far in July (10 games) is tied for second-lowest in MLB with the Angels...only the Yankees (.211) have a lower average in July...SF has yet to record double-digit hits as a team this month.

**BIRDS OF A FEATHER...:** Rookie RHP Hayden Birdsong makes his fourth career MLB start with his outing this afternoon against the Twins.

- ▶ Birdsong, SF's #4 prospect and #98 on *MLB.com's* Top-100, pitched last Sunday in Cleveland and once again came just shy of finishing 5.0 innings...he ended up one out shy, working 4.2 innings and allowing two runs on five hits on 85 pitches.
- ▶ Through three starts his slider has been a go-to pitch with him throwing 73% of the sliders he's thrown for strikes with 10 swings and misses...opposing hitters are 1-for-10 off it thus far with three strikeouts (S/S).

**GOIN' STREAKING:** OF Heliot Ramos extended his on-base streak to 12 games with his 2-for-4 day yesterday...he's slashing .388/.426/.694 with three doubles, four homers, 10 runs scored and 10 RBI during the streak.

- ▶ Ramos leads the team in homers (14) and RBI (45)...his 2.5 fWAR is tied with IF Matt Chapman for second-most among position players on the team...C Patrick Bailey (2.6 fWAR) is first...RHP Logan Webb leads all Giants with 3.0 fWAR.

**STARGAZING:** Ramos, who was born in Humacao, PR but raised in Maunabo, PR, is the first Giants homegrown outfielder to be selected to an All-Star Game since OF Chili Davis in 1986.

- ▶ Since being called up on May 8, the 24-year-old leads the National League in RBI (45) and ranks among the top in home runs (14, 4th), batting average (.304, 4th), SLG% (.537, 6th), and OPS (.910, 6th)
- ▶ He has started 57 of SF's 58 games since being recalled and has 56 consecutive starts entering today.

**BRYCE AS NICE:** Giants prospect IF Bryce Eldridge will participate in today's Futures Game down in Texas to kick off the All-Star festivities.

- ▶ Eldridge, the Giants first-round pick a season ago (16th overall), began this year with Single-A San Jose and hit .263/.323/.478 for an .801 OPS with 14 doubles, 10 homers and 45 RBI in 51 games...he's since been promoted to High-A Eugene where he's slashed .325/.453/.475 (.928 OPS) with three doubles and a homer in 12 games.
- ▶ The 19-year-old Eldridge currently checks in as the Giants second-best prospect according to *MLB.com* and #70 overall in their Top-100 list.

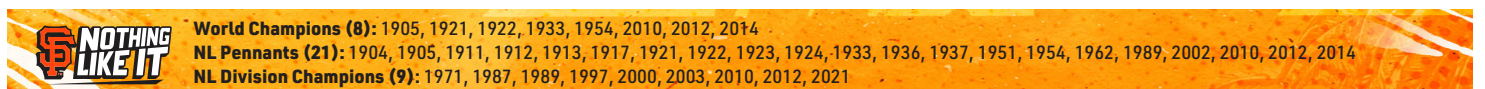
**This Date in Giants History**

## THE CORE FOUR

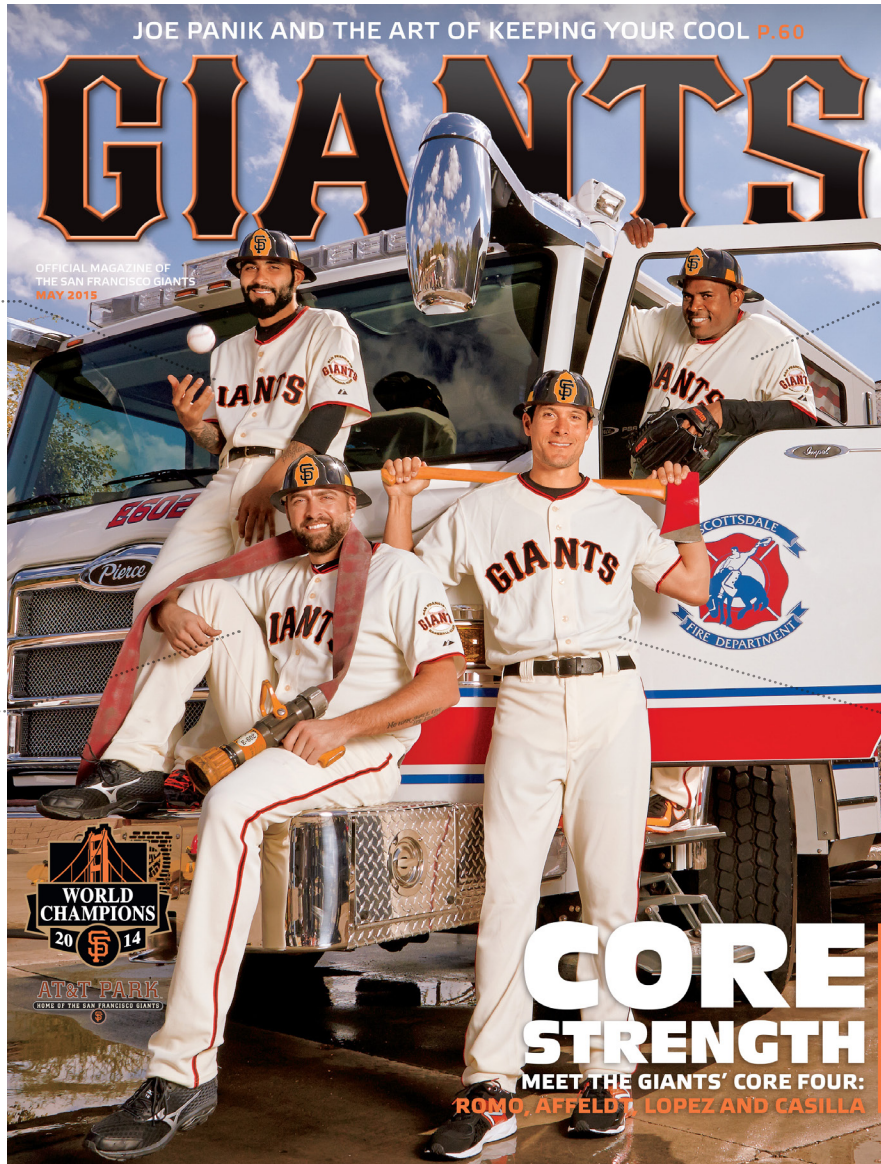
The Giants are inducting the Core Four into the Giants Wall of Fame prior to today's game for their contributions to the club's three World Series titles in five years from 2010-2014. The quartet of **LHP Jeremy Affeldt**, **RHP Santiago Casilla**, **LHP Javier López** and **RHP Sergio Romo** made up the four members of Bruce Bochy's bullpen that locked down games as soon as his starters exited the game. *During the title runs, the Core Four combined to make 98 appearances and boasted a combined 1.14 ERA while giving up two homers in 78.2 Postseason innings. They recorded eight saves and were a combined 7-1.*

### SERGIO ROMO

Had a 2.11 ERA with four saves in 25 Postseason games during the 2010, '12 & '14 run.

### JEREMY AFFELDT

In 26 career Postseason games with the Giants in '10, '12, & '14, Affeldt had a minuscule 0.69 ERA (2er, 26.0ip).



### SANTIAGO CASILLA

Had a 0.95 ERA over 24 Postseason games between '10, '12 and '14 with 20 strikeouts in 19.0 innings.

### JAVIER LÓPEZ

Boasted an 0.73 ERA with 14 strikeouts in 12.1 Postseason innings over 23 games between '10, '12 and '14.



### JEREMY AFFELDT

**YEARS W/SF: 2009-2015**

- ▶ Played the final seven seasons of his 14-year MLB career with the Giants after signing as a free agent w/SF in November of 2008.
- ▶ Logged a 3.06 ERA in 414 career regular-season appearances with the Giants.
- ▶ Struck out two in 2.0 hitless innings of relief on Oct. 23, 2010 (Game 6 of NLCS v Philadelphia).
- ▶ Struck out 4 (including MVP Miguel Cabrera) in 1.2 shutout/hitless innings of relief in the decisive Game 4 of the 2012 World Series.
- ▶ Earned the win when Travis Ishikawa hit the walk-off home run to clinch the NL Pennant in 2014.
- ▶ Earned the win in Game 7 of the 2014 World Series vs. KC.



### SANTIAGO CASILLA

**YEARS W/SF: 2010-2016**

- ▶ Spent seven years as a Giant after joining the organization in January of 2010 when he signed as a free agent.
- ▶ Posted a 2.42 ERA in 414 career regular season appearances for the Giants... his 123 saves with SF are sixth-most in franchise history
- ▶ Tossed an immaculate inning while earning the save vs. Cincinnati on May 17, 2015.
- ▶ Earned the win in the decisive Game 4 of the 2010 World Series vs. Detroit
- ▶ Earned the save on October 15, 2014 in the NLCS vs. St. Louis with two strikeouts in the 9th.
- ▶ Earned his 100th career save on April 25, 2016 vs. San Diego.



### JAVIER LÓPEZ

**YEARS W/SF: 2010-2016**

- ▶ Joined the Giants on July 31, 2010 in a trade from Pittsburgh that sent John Bowker and Joe Martinez to Pittsburgh...López went on to play seven seasons in a Giants uniform.
- ▶ Owned a 2.47 ERA in 446 career games with the Giants...his 446 games with the Giants are sixth-most in SF era (since 1958).
- ▶ Allowed just one run (0.73 ERA) through 23 postseason games with SF from 2010-2014.
- ▶ Recorded the win in Game 6 of the NLCS in 2010 against the Phillies.
- ▶ Was named the Willie Mac Award winner in 2016 along with teammate IF Brandon Crawford.



### SERGIO ROMO

**YEARS W/SF: 2008-2016**

- ▶ Drafted by SF in the 28th round of the 2005 draft out of Colorado Mesa University.
- ▶ Had a 2.58 ERA with 84 saves in 515 career games as a Giant... his 515 games with the Giants are third-most in SF era (1958-present).
- ▶ Recorded the final out in the 2012 WS in Detroit after getting Triple Crown winner Miguel Cabrera to look at strike three for the final out.
- ▶ Got Matt Holliday to pop out for the final out of SF's 9-0 clinching win in Game 7 of the 2012 NLCS at AT&T Park.
- ▶ Has three saves in the World Series, most in franchise history.

# HAYDEN BIRDSONG RHP #60

**WELCOME TO THE SHOW:** Will make his fourth Major League start today after having his contract selected from Triple-A Sacramento on June 26...Birdsong has spent parts of three seasons in the Giants system after being selected in the sixth round of the 2022 draft out of Eastern Illinois University (Charleston, IL).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Threw 4.2 innings on Sunday at Cleveland in SF's 5-4 loss to the Guardians...worked 3.0 innings of no-hit baseball with one walk and two strikeouts before giving up four straight hits to start the 4th inning...surrendered two runs in the inning and returned for the 5th, striking out two more batters before leaving the game.

**BREAKING!:** Cleveland batters were 0-for-4 with three strikeouts off his curveball in his last outing...opposing hitters overall are 0-for-8 with four strikeouts in at-bats ending with his curveball over his first three career starts.

**WITH THE SQUIRRELS:** Birdsong entered the season ranked as the Giants #6 prospect according to *Baseball America*...he began the year at Double-A Richmond and posted a 4-2 record with a 2.05 ERA (11er, 48.1ip) with 61 strikeouts in 11 starts for Double-A Richmond before being promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on June 11.

**WITH THE RIVER CATS:** Made two starts for Sacramento after the promotion and posted a 5.00 ERA (5er, 9.0) with 14 strikeouts...his last Triple-A start came on June 21 vs. Round Rock when he threw 5.0 innings and allowed two runs on three hits with seven strikeouts.

**THE FUTURE IS NOW:** With the prospect graduation of LHP Kyle Harrison, Birdsong is currently the Giants' second-ranked pitching prospect, No. 4 overall, according to *MLB.com*...he also enters today's start as #98 on *MLB.com*'s Top-100 prospects...Birdsong was the last of six consecutive pitchers the Giants selected during the 2022 draft, which is a group that included LHPs Reggie Crawford and Carson Whisenhunt.

**EARLY ARRIVAL:** Birdsong became the second Giant from the 2022 draft to reach the Majors, joining OF Wade Meckler (eighth round), who did so last year...there are just three players from the first round of that 2022 draft that have reached the Majors overall (IF Jackson Holliday with Baltimore, IF Zach Neto with the Angels and OF Jordan Beck with Colorado)...at the time of his debut, there were just 12 players selected ahead of Birdsong (6th round, 30th pick) in that 2022 draft that had made their debuts.
