AROUND THE HORN

\$100 MILLION IN GIVING: The D-backs and Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation have earned a place among professional sports' most impactful philanthropic organizations in fewer than three decades, reaching a historic milestone of \$100 Million In Giving through their signature "D-backs Give Back" approach and investment in communities across Arizona...March 9 will forever be celebrated annually as "D-backs Give Back Day" as proclaimed by Arizona Governor Katie Hobbs ensuring the organization's longstanding statewide commitment will be recognized each year.

HERE'S THE STORY: Since March 30, the D-backs' 14 wins are tied for third in MLB (also: Cubs and Reds) to the Braves (15) and Padres (15).

- Since April 4, their 11-5 (.688) record is third in MLB to the Padres (14-3, .824) and Cubs (12-5, .706).
- The D-backs have won 5 of their last 7 games and 9 of their last 13.
- The D-backs seek their fifth straight series win, seventh straight series win/split and seventh straight series win vs. White Sox:
 - Last 5+ straight series wins: 9 from July 12-Aug. 14, 2024.
 - Last 7+ straight series wins/splits: 13 from June 28-Aug. 12, 2024.

• **Ildemaro Vargas'** career-best 20-game hitting streak since Sept. 26, 2025 is the Majors' longest active streak since 2025.

- His 20-gamer is tied for MLB's third-longest hit streak since 2025, with Jackson Chourio's 20-gamer (July 3-27), behind José Ramírez's 21-gamer (May 7-28) and Bobby Witt Jr.'s 22-gamer (April 8-May 1).
- Is the sixth D-back ever to have a 20+-game hit streak:

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 11-7 vs. White Sox with a season-high in runs and hits (16) to even the series.

- **Ildemaro Vargas** extended his MLB-best and career-long 20-game hit streak (since Sept. 26, 2025) while recording a career-high-tying 2 homers and career-best 5 RBI.
- **Nolan Arenado** reached base 5 times (4-for-4, HR, 3 RBI, BB) for the first time since Sept. 18, 2024 vs. Pirates (13th overall).
- **Corbin Carroll** and **Geraldo Perdomo** both reached base 4 times (3 H, BB, RBI)...**Perdomo** has reached base 3+ times in 3 straight games.
- **Eduardo Rodriguez** improved to 2-0 (W; 5.0 IP, 4 R, 6 H, 3 BB, 4 K).
- **Juan Morillo** (1.0 IP) and **Paul Sewald** (1.0 IP) combined for 2.0 scoreless innings (2 H, BB, 3 K).

GO VARGY GO: **Ildemaro Vargas'** 17-game hit streak is tied for MLB's second-longest streak of 17+ games to start a season (within the first 30 G) since 2023:

- Owns the second-longest single-season streak by a D-back since 2024 to Ketel Marte's 21-gamer from April 28-May 22, 2024.

HE CAN SLUG T00: **Vargas** is the first D-back (11th overall) to homer in 3+ straight plate appearances (April 21 in Bot 9, Weds in Bot 2 & 3) since Eugenio Suárez's 4-homer game on April 26, 2025 vs. Braves.

WITH RISP: Since April 13 over 8 games with runners in scoring position, the D-backs are hitting .284 (21-for-74)/.964 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 7 homers and 35 RBI.

- Since April 13, rank among MLB leaders with RISP in OPS (1st, .964), SLG (1st, .635), extra-base hits (T-1st, 11), homers (2nd, 7), runs (T-4th, 39) and total bases (4th, 47).

LEVEL UP: The D-backs' 21 high-leverage hits to tie a game or take a lead are most in the NL and tied for third in MLB (also: Guardians) to the Athletics (22) and Rays (22) [source: Stathead].

HOME HITS: **Ildemaro Vargas** owns a 9-game home hitting streak, batting .400 (12-for-30)/1.319 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 4 homers, 12 RBI and 1 walk.

- **Nolan Arenado**, in his last 7 home games, is hitting .435 (10-for-23)/1.239 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 3 walks.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely 10 times in his last 3 home games, hitting .636 (7-for-11)/1.896 OPS with 3 triples, 2 RBI and 3 walks.
- **Alek Thomas**, in his last 5 home games, is hitting .353 (6-for-17)/1.000 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer and 2 RBI.
- **Jose Fernandez** has hit safely in 6 of his last 7 home games at a .294 clip (10-for-34)/804 OPS with 2 homers, 5 RBI and 2 walks.

INTERLEAGUE ACTION: The D-backs are 8-3 vs. AL opponents (3-0 vs. Tigers, 2-1 @ Orioles, 2-1 vs. Blue Jays, 1-1 vs. White Sox).

- Since Aug. 12, 2025, the D-backs lead the NL with a .720 win pct. (18-7) against the AL and are tied for most wins with the Braves.
- **Ildemaro Vargas** (12 G), **Jose Fernandez** (7 G) and **Geraldo Perdomo** (6 G) have active Interleague hit streaks.

VS. WHITE SOX: The D-backs' 6 straight series wins (since 2014, 14-4) are tied for the longest streak by a NL team since 1998, along with the Brewers (since 2020, 15-4).

- The D-backs are 6-2 in their last 8 games @ Chase Field.
- The D-backs' .690 win pct. (20-9) is the NL's best since 1998, ahead of the Mets (.636, 14-8).

- **Geraldo Perdomo** has an 8-game hitting streak, batting .387 (12-for-31)/1.099 OPS with 1 double, 3 triples, 3 RBI and 6 walks.
- **Nolan Arenado**, in his last 11 games, is hitting .463 (19-for-41)/1.453 OPS with 3 doubles, 5 homers, 15 RBI and 8 walks.
- **Ildemaro Vargas**, in his last 9 games, is hitting .346 (9-for-26)/1.182 OPS with 1 double, 3 homers, 9 RBI and 4 walks.

ON DECK - PADRES MEXICO CITY: The D-backs face the Padres in 2 home games (April 25-26) in Mexico City at Estadio Alfredo Harp Helú...last season, the D-backs split the season series at home 3-3...the D-backs are 11-13 vs. Padres since May 5, 2024.

WIN WIN WIN WIN: Is the second D-back to record the win in his first 4 starts with the team, joining Chase Anderson from May 11-June 3, 2014 (club-record 5 straight wins).

• His 28 strikeouts through his first 4 starts are tied for second most to begin a D-backs tenure with Randy Johnson from April 24-May 9, 2007 and behind Johnson's 44 strikeouts from April 5-April 20, 1999.

INTERLEAGUE: In his last 2 starts (vs. DET, vs. TOR), is 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA (2 ER in 12.0 IP), opponent .205 AVG, 1 walk and 15 strikeouts.

10 STRIKEOUTS: With 10 strikeouts on March 30 vs. Tigers and April 10 @ Phillies, joined Randy Johnson (1999) as the only D-backs' starters with 10+ strikeouts in 2 of their first 3 starts with the team.

• Johnson, in 1999, had 4 straight starts with 10+ strikeouts in starts 2-5: 15 K on April 10 @ Braves...10 K on April 15 vs. Dodgers...10 K on April 20 vs. Phillies...11 K on April 25 @ Padres...in his first start, on April 5 @ Dodgers, had 9 strikeouts.

NL RANKINGS: Ranks among NL starters [min. 4 GS] in wins (T-1st, 4), K/9 (6th, 11.12) and earned runs allowed (T-7th, 7).

D-BACK DEBUT: His 10 strikeouts on March 30 vs. Tigers were the most in a D-backs debut (previously: 9, Randy Johnson on April 5, 1999 @ Dodgers)...had an immaculate inning in the fifth inning:
