Sal Frelick has started 21 games this season and has reached base safely in 20 of those games, including each of his last 16 contests.....his .432 OBP leads the team and is fourth in the NL.

We Went to Jared

Jared Koenig is unscored upon in his last 10 outings (9.2ip 1h, 3bb, 13k) with opponents batting .033 (1-for-30).

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is game 1 of a season-long 10-game, 11-day road trip to San Francisco (4g), St. Louis (3g) and Chicago-AL (3g).....the Brewers are coming off a 4-2 homestand against Detroit (2-1) and the Athletics (2-1).....following this trip, the team returns to American Family Field for a 6-game homestand against Chicago-NL (3g) and Houston (3g).

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without Bob Uecker on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

IN THE STANDINGS [34 days]: The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each position in the NL Central standings: FIRST: 10*, SECOND: 11, THIRD: 7, FOURTH: 3, FIFTH: 3.....the Brewers are in second place, trailing the first-place Cubs by 1.0 game (* 9 days tied for first from 3/18-3/26 before playing their first game).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Brewers are 5-2-0 in series play. Game 1: 4-3, Game 2: 4-3, Game 3: 3-4, Game 4: 1-0 Sweep Wins [-]: None.....Sweep Losses [1]: at NYY (3g, 3/27-3/30)

AT HOME: The Brewers are 9-4 at home, going 4-0-0 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 3-6 on the road, going 1-2-0 in series play.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

COACHES: Returning from 2024 is associate manager Rickie Weeks (2nd season). Tield coordinator Néstor Corredor (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach Jim Henderson (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (2nd season), hitting coach **Connor Dawson** (4th season), assistant coach **Daniel de Mondesert** (2nd season), infield coach Matt Erickson (2nd season) and third base coach Jason Lane (10th season/5th in current role)....first base coach Julio Borbón, lead hitting coach Al LeBoeuf and hitting coach Eric Theisen are all in their first seasons on the staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made one replay challenge, going 1-0... the challenge game on 4/20 vs. the Athletics as an out call on a stolen base attempt by Caleb Durbin was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times over the last seven seasons (missed in 2022) and have won the NL Central in four of the last seven seasons, three of the last four, and two straight.....the Brewers are one of just five teams to qualify for the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons... joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include the shortened 2020 season.....the Brewers have 678 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League.....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight consecutive seasons, missing out by just a game in both 2017 and 2022.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #46 - RHP QUINN PRIESTER (2gs, 1-0, 0.90)

PRIESTER AT A GLANCE: Quinn Priester, 24, will make his third start of the season.....Priester last pitched last Tuesday vs. Detroit in a 5-0 win (5ip, 1h, 3bb, 4k, 84 pitches)..... he made his Brewers debut on 4/10 at Colorado and received no decision in the Brewers' 7-2 loss (5ip, 6h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 4k, 1hr, 72 pitches).....he was acquired from Boston on April 7 in exchange for OF Yophery Rodriguez, a Competitive Balance Round A selection and a player to be named.....Priester began the season at Triple-A Worcester, where he made his only appearance in a start on 4/3 at Jacksonville.

LAST SEASON: Priester went 3-6 with a 4.71 ERA in 11 games/7 starts between Pittsburgh (10g/6gs) and Boston (1g)....his teams went 1-6 in his starts.....had 2 quality starts..... opponents batted .277 (56-for-202, 7hr).....went 1-5 with a 4.42 ERA as a starter (36.2ip, 18er) and 2-1 with a 5.54 ERA as a reliever (13ip, 8er).....Priester was traded by Pittsburgh to Boston on 7/29/24 in exchange for INF/OF Nick Yorke.

CAREER: Is 7-9 with a 5.74 ERA in 23 games/17 starts (109.2ip, 70er) while pitching for Pittsburgh (2023-24), Boston (2024) and Milwaukee (2025).....has gone 4-8 with a 5.61 ERA as a starter (86.2ip, 54er) and 3-1 with a 6.26 ERA as a reliever (23ip, 16er).....was selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (18th overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Cary-Grove (IL) High School.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Priester has gone 26-17 with a 3.61 ERA in 87 games/84 starts while pitching in the Pittsburgh [2019-24] and Boston [2024-25] organizations [408.2ip, 361h, 188r, 164er, 149bb, 428k, 27hr].....has held opponents to a .235 batting average.....was a 2023 International League All-Star and Triple-A Indianapolis Pitcher of the Year....was named Pirates Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2022.....was selected to the All-Star Futures Game in 2021.....was a 2021 East League All-Star and High-A East League Pitcher of the Year.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 2-1 with a 3.86 ERA in 4 games/3 starts (21ip, 9er).....is 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA in 1 start this season (5ip, 0er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: IS 3-5 with a 5.18 ERA in 13 games/9 starts (66ip, 38er).....is 0-0 with a 1.80 ERA in 1 start this season (5ip, 1er).

TOMORROW'S STARTER: LHP JOSÉ QUINTANA (2gs, 2-0, 0.71)

LHP José Quintana will make his third start of the season.....Quintana last started last Wednesday vs. Detroit and picked up a 5-1 victory (5.2ip, 4h, 1r, 1er, 3bb, 4k, 1hr, 100 pitches).....he made his Brewers debut on 4/11 at Arizona and earned a 7-0 win (7ip, 4h, 0bb, 2k, 1bk, 80 pitches).....he signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on March 5.....Quintana is 1-4 with a 4.98 ERA in 7 games/6 starts (34.1ip, 31h, 20r, 19er, 12bb, 31k, 5hr) in his career against the Giants.....he took a 5-2 loss last season with the Mets on 4/22 at Oracle Park (5ip, 7h, 5r, 5er, 3bb, 4k, 1hr)....he is 1-3 with a 4.56 ERA in 4 career starts against the Giants at Oracle Park (23.2ip, 20h, 13r, 12er, 8bb, 17k, 2hr).
