TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners today play the series finale in a rubber match against the Kansas City Royals (1-1)...Seattle will also travel to Sacramento (3 G, 5/25-5/27) to take on the Athletics on the trip...today's tilt will be televised live on **Mariners TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Angie Mentink** on the call and **Brad Adam** serving as field reporter...the game will be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Gary Hill Jr.** and **Ryan Rowland-Smith** on the call.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners dropped yesterday's middle game by a 5-0 score, after blanking the Royals in the series opener by a 2-0 advantage...Seattle goes for consecutive series wins, after taking 2 of 3 from the White Sox from May 18-20 at T-Mobile Park.

- **Rubber Soul** - The Mariners are 4-3 in series rubber games heading into today's deciding game against the Royals.
- **Daylight Come And** - Seattle is 12-8 (.600) in day games this season, and 13-20 (.394) in night games.
- **Ouch!** - Mariners batters rank 3rd in the Majors with 36 HBP this season, trailing only the St. Louis Cardinals (38 HBP) and Los Angeles Angels (37).
- **Yard Card** - Seattle is 22-13 (.629) in games when homering this season, and 3-15 (.167) when they do not homer as a team.
- **Happy Birthday!** - Mariners President of Baseball Operations **Jerry Dipoto** celebrates his 58th birthday today...Dipoto was named *Baseball America's* Executive of the Year following last season.

A MODEL OF CONSISTENCY...in each of his last 4 starts (5/1-c), **Bryan Woo** has gone exactly 6.0 innings...in each of his last 3 starts (5/6-c), Woo has gone exactly 6.0 innings, recorded the win, allowed no home runs, walked exactly 2 batters, allowed 2-or-fewer runs, and recording 8+ strikeouts.

WOO WERE SAYING?...across those 3 most recent starts (5/6-c), **Bryan Woo** is 3-0 with a 1.00 ERA (2 ER, 18.0 IP) with 26 strikeouts and 6 walks, allowing no homers and just a pair of extra-base hits (both doubles) among the 67 batters he's faced...since May 6, Woo's .131 opponent batting average ranks 2nd in the Majors (min. 15 IP) to only teammate **Logan Gilbert** (.127 opponent batting average).

REALLY GOOD ARMS...the Mariners pitching staff has posted a combined 3.57 ERA (187 ER, 471.1 IP) with an MLB-fewest 136 walks, along with 457 strikeouts...among Major League pitching staffs they rank 2nd in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.36), 1st in fewest walks-per-9 innings (2.60), 6th in ERA, T-6th in WHIP (1.22) and 9th in strikeouts...Mariners starting pitching leads MLB with 303.2 innings pitched and ranks 5th in strikeouts (286)...the Seattle bullpen ranks T-3rd in the Majors in ERA (3.01).

JOSH SPICE...over his last 30 contests (4/17-c), **Josh Naylor** is batting .330 (38x115) with 11 runs, 5 doubles, 3 home runs, 15 RBI, 12 walks and 12 stolen bases, getting on base at a .391 clip, slugging .452 with an .843 OPS in 128 plate appearances...during that span, Naylor's .330 average ranks T-7th in the big leagues (min. 100 AB)...Naylor's 12 stolen bases are tied for most in the Majors since April 17 with José Ramírez-CLE.

THE J-ROD SHOW DOESN'T BOW TO ROYALTY...in 28 career games against the Royals, **Julio Rodríguez** owns a .371 (43x116) batting average with 18 runs, 9 doubles, 5 home runs, 26 RBI, 7 stolen bases and 10 walks...his average is the highest against any individual opponent Rodríguez has faced in his career...in 12 career games at Kauffman Stadium, he is batting .404 (21x52) with 6 doubles, 1 home run, 14 RBI, 3 stolen bases and 5 walks.

RALEY GOOD IN THE BOX...**Luke Raley** went 3-for-3 with a double yesterday...in 47 games this season, he is batting .276 (35x127) with 19 runs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 10 homers and 27 RBI, getting on base at a .338 clip, slugging .567 with a .905 OPS.

RANDY! RANDY! RANDY!...**Randy Arozarena** is batting .294 (55x187) with 36 runs, 13 doubles, 1 triple, 5 home runs, 21 RBI, 14 stolen bases, a .389 OBP and slugging .455 for an .844 OPS in 53 games this season...Randy has been scorching hot as of late, batting .373 (19x51) with a 1.045 OPS across his last 15 games (5/8-c).

J.P. PRESENTS STEELHEADS UNIFORM TO NLBM...yesterday prior to the game **J.P. Crawford** presented his game-worn, autographed Seattle Steelheads uniform to **Bob Kendrick**, President of the Negro Leagues Baseball Museum located in Kansas City...manager **Dan Wilson** also presented Kendrick with a check for \$25,000 from the Mariners Care Foundation as a donation to the museum in support of its Buck O'Neil Education and Research Center.

ON THE UPCOMING HOMESTAND...following the current road trip, the Mariners return to T-Mobile Park for a 6-game homestand against the Diamondbacks (3 G, May 29-31) and Mets (3 G, June 1-3)...featured on the homestand is '90s weekend (May 29-31) with '90s Fireworks Night on Friday, **Julio Rodríguez** '90s Jersey Night on Saturday and '90s Pin Day on Sunday, as well as Pride Night on June 1.

AS YOU MAY KNOW...**Bryan Woo** is set to toe the rubber for the Mariners in today's series finale...Woo has been effective at limiting baserunners throughout his career and particularly over the past couple seasons, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...since the start of last season (2025-c), Woo's 0.94 WHIP (walks and hits allowed per inning pitched) ranks 3rd among qualified pitchers across the Majors?...among pitchers with at least 200 innings since 2025, Woo trails only the two defending Cy Young Award winners in each league: Paul Skenes-PIT (0.89) and Tarik Skubal-DET (0.90), while ranking ahead of Jacob deGrom-TEX (0.95) and Yoshinobu Yamamoto-LAD (0.98).

ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - MAY 24

- **1995 - Mike Blowers** etches his name in the Mariners record book alongside **Alvin Davis** as the only players in Seattle history to have 8 RBI in a game. Mike had a club-record four extra base hits, including his first HR of the season. He entered the game batting .118.
- **1996 - Ken Griffey Jr.** hits three home runs and drove in five runs in a 10-4 win vs. New York.
- **1998 - Randy Johnson** strikes out 15 in a 3-1 victory vs. Tampa Bay.
- **1999 - Ken Griffey Jr.** sets career-high with 13-game hitting streak.
- **2002 - Mark McLemore** homered in the 5th inning vs. Baltimore to give him a 12-game hitting streak, tying his career high (done two other times).
- **2007** - With his 3-for-6 performance, which includes a home run, **Ichiro Suzuki** collects 1,414 hits in his first 1,000 games in the major leagues. The Mariners outfielder total during this span is second only to Hall of Famer Al Simmons who collected 1,443 hits playing for the Philadelphia A's.

ABOUT BRYAN WOO...

- The 26-year-old right-handed pitcher is set to make his 11th start of the season and his 81st career start...is also making his 2nd start against the Royals this season and the 3rd of his career...it marks his first career start at Kauffman Stadium.

LAST TIME OUT...W#4 on May 18 vs. the White Sox, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings and allowing 3 hits and 2 walks with 8 strikeouts...he threw 90 pitches (60 strikes) in his 10th start of the season while retiring the last 11 consecutive batters faced...marked his 4th consecutive start of 6.0+ IP and his 3rd straight start with 8+ strikeouts.

SHUTTING IT DOWN...has thrown 6.0+ innings without an earned run allowed in 3 starts this season (last: 5/18 vs. CWS) and 8 times since 2025, tied for 7th-most such starts across that span.

THE LAST THREE...owns a 1.00 ERA (2 ER, 18.0 IP) with 26 strikeouts to 6 walks and no home runs allowed across his last three starts (5/6-c)...has also factored into the win in each of his last 3 starts, matching a career-high mark (also: 9/8/25-9/19/25)...his 3 straight starts of 8+ strikeouts also matches his career-high mark (done 2x prior, last: 8/5/25-8/16/25).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN...is making his 6th road start of the season...has tossed 6.0+ IP in 17 of his 21 road starts since 2025, tied for most such starts in MLB across that span (also: Garrett Crochet-BOS)...among qualified pitchers since 2025, his 126.0 IP on the road are tied for 5th-most while his 13 QS on the road are T-4th most across that span.

PLENTY OF PUNCHIES...has thrown 6.0 innings with 9 strikeouts in 3 total starts this season (last: 5/12 at HOU)...his 9 starts of 6.0+ IP and 9+ strikeouts since 2025 are tied for the 3rd-most in MLB across that span, alongside Zack Wheeler-PHI.

GOING THE DISTANCE...has tossed 6.0+ innings in 8 starts this season and in 52 career starts...his 35 starts of 6.0+ IP since 2025 are most in MLB while his 245.2 IP since 2025 are 6th-most in MLB.

EFFECTIVE AND EFFICIENT...currently averages 14.6 pitches per inning this season, 6th-fewest among qualified starting pitchers...is currently averaging 14.8 pitches per inning across his career, tied for the fewest P/IP among starters since 2023 (min. 400 IP), alongside Tarik Skubal-DET and Cristopher Sanchez-PHI.

FIRST PITCH STRIKE...his 71.2% first pitch strike percentage currently leads the league this season, ranking ahead of teammates Logan Gilbert (2nd, 70.2%) and Emerson Hancock (6th, 66.5%) also rank within the top ten this season...Woo's 68.4% first pitch strike percentage across his career ranks 3rd-best in MLB since 2023 (min. 400 IP), trailing Miles Mikolas-STL (69.4%) and Tarik Skubal-DET (68.6%).

FEW FREE PASSES...has issued 12 walks across 59.0 innings and 10 starts this season...his 1.70 walks-per-nine innings this season ranks 7th-best in MLB while his 4.7 walk percentage ranks T-8th best...among qualifying pitchers since 2025, he also ranks 2nd in walks-per-nine (1.76), 3rd in walk percentage (5.0%) and 4th in strikeouts-to-walk ratio (5.27)...in addition, he has tossed 6.0+ IP with 2-or-fewer walks in 8 of his 10 starts this season and in 35 total starts since 2025 which leads MLB across that span.

WATCH ME WHIP...his 0.98 WHIP this season ranks 8th in MLB among qualified starters while his 0.98 career WHIP ranks 3rd-best in MLB among qualified pitchers since 2023, trailing Tarik Skubal-DET (0.91) and Paul Skenes-PIT (0.93)...his 0.983 career WHIP is also the lowest in franchise history (min. 400 IP).

QUALITY STUFF...has tossed a quality start in each of his last 3 starts (5/6-c) and in 7 total starts this season, T-3rd most in MLB (7 others)...threw a quality start in 21 of his 30 starts last season, tied for 4th-most in the Majors that season...his 28 quality starts since 2025 are 2nd-most in MLB, trailing only Cristopher Sánchez-PHI.

WOO HOLDS THE TRIDENT...his 3.25 career ERA (164 ER, 454.2 IP) is a franchise best mark among Mariners starters (min. 75 GS), ranking ahead of Randy Johnson, Félix Hernández, Hisashi Iwakuma, and James Paxton who each hold a 3.42 career ERA.

LEONARDO DA WOOSKI...has thrown 6.0+ IP with 1-or-fewer hits in 2 starts this season (4/3 at LAA and 5/6 vs. ATL)...is 1-of-4 pitchers with multiple games of 6.0+ IP and 1-or-fewer hits allowed this season, joining Michael McGreevy-STL, Chris Sale-ATL, and Paul Skenes-PIT...his 5 such games since last year are most in MLB across that span, ahead of Yoshinobu Yamamoto-LAD (4 G).

WOOOOO...has tossed 7.0+ innings in 3 starts this season (last: 4/19 vs. TEX)...threw 7.0 shutout innings, allowing just 1 hit on April 3 at LAA, his 3rd career start tossing 7.0+ IP with 1-or-fewer hits...his 3 such starts are tied for the most such games in MLB since the start of last season (also: Yoshinobu Yamamoto-LAD).

MAY FLOWERS...May is historically a high performing month as he is 7-1 with a 2.30 ERA (23 ER, 90.0 IP), 7.90 strikeout-to-walk ratio (79 SO, 10 BB) and a 0.811 WHIP while limiting batters to a .193 average (63x326) across 15 career starts in the month of May...among pitchers with 10+ GS in May since 2024, he ranks 2nd in BB/9 (1.0), T-2nd in SO/BB ratio (7.9), and 3rd in WHIP (0.811)...has tossed 6.0+ IP in 13 of those 15 starts in May, including 11 quality starts.

FIRST HALF WARRIOR...is 15-8 with a 3.00 ERA (84 ER, 252.1 IP), 236 strikeouts and 47 walks allowed across 44 career starts pre All-Star Break...among pitchers with 200+ IP in the first half since 2023, he ranks 2nd in WHIP (0.955), 4th in BB/9 (1.68) and 8th in SO/BB (5.02).

LAST SEASON...threw 6.0+ innings in all 18 starts before last year's All-Star break, while posting a 2.75 ERA (35 ER, 114.2 IP) with 109 strikeouts and 21 walks...his 2.75 ERA last year was the 6th-best by a starting pitcher in the first half (min. 15 GS) in franchise history.
