RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their seven-day, six-game road trip with the second game of a three-game series with the division-rival Milwaukee Brewers tonight at American Family Field, their last road series of the season ... The Cardinals began their road trip by dropping two-of-three to the Padres at Petco Park over the weekend.

FLIGHT PATTERN: With five games remaining, the Cardinals enter today in 5th place in the NL Central, 5.0 games behind 4th-place Pittsburgh ... St. Louis has spent 141 of 175 days in last place on the MLB schedule (April 26-May 19, May 29-July 7 & July 28-present) ... The Cardinals 69-88 record is their lowest at the 157-game mark since 1978 when they were 67-90 (.427).

DIVISION MATH: The Cardinals enter tonight's game with an 19-28 mark (.404) in divisional play ... It's their 2nd-lowest mark in divisional play behind 1995 (20-32, .385), and it will be the first time since 2017 (34-42, .447) that they will finish below .500 within the division ... St. Louis has finished .500 or better within the National League Central in 22 of 30 seasons since MLB's six-division alignment began in 1994.

MAKE YOURSELF AT HOME: Paul Goldschmidt has gone yard 18 times at American Family Field, 5th among all visiting players and 2nd among active opponents to **Joey Votto** (24) ... Goldy enjoyed a three-homer game here on March 29, 2019 in his second career game as a Cardinal. **ALL IN THE FAMILY:** The Cardinals have hit the most home runs (234) of all opposing teams at American Family Field since it opened in 2001.

NORTHERN EXPOSURE: Since St. Louis and Milwaukee began regular season play in 1997, the Cardinals own the most wins against the Brewers (239-187, .561) and have the best road winning percentage (123-88, .583) of any team to visit Milwaukee since 1997 ... Their .587 win pct. (111-78) since American Family Field opened in 2001 is tops among all teams who annually play in Milwaukee.

HEIR JORDAN: 21-year-old rookie **Jordan Walker** has hit safely in 19 of his 22 games played in September, and extended his hitting streak to 11 games last night ... With his active 11-game hitting streak (.325/.400/.450, 13-40), Walker is:

- 1 of 8 Major Leaguers (and the only rookie) this season with 3+ different double-digit game hitting streaks (17, 12, 11) ... Walker owns 3 of the 11 longest rookie hit streaks, with **Josh Jung** being the only other rookie with two (14 and 10).
- 1 of just 5 Cardinals rookies since 1900 with three or more different double-digit hitting streaks in the same season, joining **Albert Pujols** (3 in 2021); **Bake McBride** (4 in 1974); **Johnny Mize** (3 in 1936); and **Pug Bennett** (3 in 1906) ... Pujols and Walker are the only two to do so at age 21 or younger. - Elias
- The 1st Cardinal overall with three different double-digit hit streaks in same season since **Yadier Molina** (11, 16, 11 in 2016).
- The 8th Cardinals rookie since 2000 to collect 25 or more hits in September/October.

WHAT'S BREWING: **Tommy Edman** is hitting .389/.436/.583 (14-36) with a 1.019 OPS in 10 games vs. Milwaukee this season, with 14 hits that tie **Matt McLain** and **Dansby Swanson** for most in MLB ... **Jordan Walker** (10-26, .385) has hit safely in all eight games vs. the Brewers ... **Ryan Helsley** has hurled 4.2 scoreless innings with three saves and eight strikeouts vs. Milwaukee this year.

SOUTHPAW STARTERS: **Zack Thompson** tonight makes the 65th start by a Cardinals left-handed pitcher this season, most since 70 by southpaws by the 1995 Cardinals ... The single-season franchise record is held by the 1949 Cardinals with 101 starts by lefties.

SINGLE-SEASON MILESTONE WATCH: With five games remaining, the Cardinals can establish a new record for fewest errors committed (63), three fewer than 66 committed in 2019 and 2022 ... St. Louis is also in danger of becoming the final team in MLB history without a pitcher throwing a complete game.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (September 27, 1998): On the final day of the regular season, **Mark McGwire** hits his 69th and 70th home runs against **Mike Thurman** and **Carl Pavano** of the Montreal Expos in a 6-3 victory at Busch Stadium II.

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Ryan Helsley made his MLB debut on April 16, 2019 at Milwaukee...his first strikeout victim was Ryan Braun (swinging) that night.

Willson Contreras' younger brother, **William**, is also a catcher for the Brewers.

Jacob Barnes was selected by the Brewers in the 14th round of the 2011 MLB Draft...pitched parts of four seasons (2016-19) in Milwaukee before bring claimed off waivers by Kansas City.

Devin Williams was born in nearby Florissant, Mo...was 1st Team Rawlings/Perfect Game Pre-season High School All-American at Hazelwood West High School in 2013...committed to the Univ. of Missouri before drafted by Milwaukee in the 2nd round in 2013.

Steve Dillard, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Dylan Carlson and **Rowdy Tellez** are both graduates of Elk Grove High School, where Dylan's father Jeff Carlson was the head baseball coach.

Turner Ward played parts of three seasons (1994-96) with the Brewers.

Dakota Hudson (freshman) and **Brandon Woodruff** (junior) were teammates at Mississippi State University in 2014.

Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** played five seasons with Milwaukee (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against St. Louis in the 1982 World Series...traded to Milwaukee with **Rollie Fingers** and **Pete Vuckovich** by the Cardinals for **David Green**, **Sixto Lezcano**, **Dave LaPoint** and **Lary Sorensen**.

Ricky Horton made five starts for the Denver Zephyrs (AAA) in the Brewers organization in 1990.

Trevor Megill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & broadcaster **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...traded by the Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for **Jimmie Coker** and **Gary Kolb** (Apr. 9, 1964).

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

KMOX studio host **Matt Pauley** hosted Brewers pre- and postgame shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-Green Bay women's basketball team.

Cardinals AGM/Player Development **Gary LaRocque** was selected by Milwaukee in the 14th round of the 1975 MLB Draft.

Cardinals Special Asst. to the GM, Player Procurement **Matt Slater** is a Marquette Univ. graduate...started in pro baseball as the Brewers' Scouting and Player Development Assistant (1991).

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Second year player and former Cardinals 1st round draft pick (2019, 19th player overall) out of the University of Kentucky, is making his 9th start of the 2023 season and the 10th of his young career.
- Making his 2nd career start against the Brewers, both in the last seven days.
- Previously made one relief appearance against Milwaukee on 4/8 at MIL as part of Cardinals 6-0 combined shutout win.
- Worked a career single-game high 7.0 IP with 92 pitches vs. PIT (9/3) and threw a career-high 98 pitches in 4-3 win at CIN (9/9).
- Leads STL pitchers with 4.05 ERA & 46 strikeouts since August 1 (min. 40 IP).
- Ranks 8th among National League LHP starting pitchers in ERA (4.40) since August 1 & ranks 6th in strikeouts (46).
- Has received 21 runs of support in his last six starts after receiving zero runs of support in his first two starts this season.
- His 8 strikeouts vs. COL (8/6) were the most in franchise history by a Cardinals left-hander making his 2nd career start.
- Is 3-4, 5.20 ERA in his 9 career starts (45.0 IP/26 ER) with 43 strikeouts.
- In the month of August, posted a team-best 3.13 ERA among STL starters (4 starts).
- Recalled on 8/1 from Memphis (AAA) - his 3rd stint with the Cardinals this season.
- Appeared in just four games between St. Louis & Memphis (AAA) in the month of July.
- Appeared in 11 games (9 starts) at Memphis & made 18 relief appearances (6 starts) for St. Louis this season, totaling 85.1 IP overall in 2023 between the two teams.
- Earned his 1st win since 4/14 vs. PIT on 7/19 vs. MIA, tossing 2.0 scoreless innings of relief on 29 pitches.
- Induced 2 GIDP in 2.0 IP or fewer on 7/19 vs. MIA; 1st Cards pitcher to do so since Luke Weaver on 8/17/17 at PIT.
- Was 1-4, 8.66 ERA at Memphis, striking out 41 batters in 34.1 IP while issuing 39 walks.

LAST TIME OUT

- Served up a three-run home run in the 1st inning for the 2nd consecutive start putting the Cardinals behind 3-0 early. Held his opposition to one run the rest of the game over his next 4.1 innings in an 8-2 loss as Milwaukee scored four runs in the 9th inning.
- Held his opposition to five hits for the 3rd straight start.

- Is making his 6th appearance and 2nd consecutive start vs. MIL, last facing the Brewers at Busch Stadium last Wednesday in an 8-2 loss.
- Earned his first Major League win vs. Milwaukee on June 21, 2022 at American Family Field, coming in relief of Jack Flaherty who exited after 3.0 innings pitched.
- Has not allowed a run in his three career appearances at American Family Field over 3.2 innings pitched.

CAREER

- On June 3, 2022 in his MLB debut at Wrigley Field, he became the first Cardinal to wear uniform No. 57 in nearly 20 years since the death of pitcher **Darryl Kile**, 6/22/02.
- Became the 8th pitcher in MLB history to qualify for a 4.0-inning save in his Major League debut and first since **Bob Stanley** (4.0 IP) for Boston at Cleveland Municipal Stadium on April 16, 1977. The last Cardinals pitcher was **Billy Muffett** (4.0 IP) vs. Philadelphia on August 3, 1957.
- Threw 74 pitches in relief in his Major League debut, becoming the 55th pitcher in MLB history to throw over 70 pitches in a relief appearance in his first MLB game. It marked the 2nd-most pitches by relief pitcher in his MLB debut in 2022 behind the Cubs' **Anderson Espinoza** (5/30/22 [2] vs. MIL) with 84, and most by a Cardinals relief pitcher in his MLB debut since pitch counts became tracked in 1988.
- Joined current Cardinals broadcaster **Brad Thompson** (5/8/2005 vs. SD) as one of four pitchers with what would qualify as a save of 3.0 innings or more in Cardinals history (**Billy Muffett** 1957 & **Paul Derringer** 1931).

- Is making his 7th career start (10th app.) vs. Milwaukee and his 5th career start at American Family Field.
- Has yet to win at Milwaukee (0-3) and the Cardinals are 0-4 overall in his four previous starts.
- His one career win vs. MIL came at Busch Stadium on Aug. 19, 2019 in which he carried a no-hitter 6.2 innings into the game before he was removed for pitch count at 111, a then career-high, which he would break two starts later vs. CIN (112).
