METSCELLANEOUS: The Mets downed the Twins, 5-1, last night in Minneapolis...The Mets have allowed one run over their last two games...The Mets have won back-to-back games...The team has not lost back-to-back games this year...The Mets are in a stretch of 13 straight games...They are 3-1 in that span...New York has won 10 of their last 13 games...The Mets are in the midst of their second road trip of the year, a six-game road trip (3-1) against the A's (2-1) and Twins (1-0)...Following this series, the Mets head home for their second homestand of the season, a seven-game stand against the Cardinals (four games) and Phillies (three games).

JACKIE ROBINSON DAY: The Mets, along with the rest of Major League Baseball, will celebrate the life and legacy of Jackie Robinson...Every major league manager, coach and player will wear #42 today to commemorate the Anniversary of Hall of Famer Jackie Robinson breaking baseball's color barrier in 1947...MLB retired Robinson's number throughout the Majors in 1997 in ceremony at Shea Stadium and every player and all on-field personnel has worn his Number 42 during games scheduled on Jackie Robinson Day since 2009.

A GOOD DAY TO CELEBRATE: The Mets own all-time record of 15-3 record on Jackie Robinson Day since its inception...That is the best record in the majors.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Francisco Lindor doubled in his first plate appearance yesterday...He is batting .429 (6-14) with two runs, three doubles, one home run, one RBI, one walk, a .467 OBP and an .857 SLG in the first inning this year...His .429 average in the first inning is the fourth-best mark in the majors (min. 10 PA)...After going 0-11 through his first three games, Lindor is batting .271 (13-48) with nine runs, four doubles, one home run, five RBI, five walks, two steals, a .327 OBP, a .417 SLG and a .744 OPS.

THE ROAD TO 250: Lindor is one home run away from 250 for his career...He is seeking to become the 19th active player with at least 250 home runs.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Mets are seeking their fifth straight series victory and their third on the road...After dropping their first series of the season, the Mets have won each of their last four series.

THEY'RE OUT OF OUR LEAGUE: This year marked the first time in franchise history that the Mets open their home and road schedule against an Interleague Opponent...The Mets are 7-3 in Interleague Play this season...The team went 24-22 in Interleague Play last year...Overall, New York owns a 285-279 record in Interleague play.

INTERGALACTIC: Pete Alonso has hit a franchise-record 58 home runs in Interleague Play...His 58 home runs is tied for the eighth-most all-time...It is fourth among active players...Only Aaron Judge (69), Kyle Shwarber (60) and Manny Machado (59) have more.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: New York hits the road for the second time this season...The Mets are 6-4 on the road this year...The Mets have posted a 2.45 ERA on the road this year, the best mark in the majors...There 88 road strikeouts are tied for the second-most in the majors.

HERE'S THE PITCH: The Mets lead the majors with a 2.22 ERA (35 ER/142.0 IP)...They have struck out 151 this season, which is the sixth-most in the majors and is the third-most in the NL.

STARTING OFF: The Mets starting staff has posted an MLB-best 2.50 ERA (23 ER/82.2 IP)...They have struck out 91, which is the fifth-most in the majors and is the second-most in the NL.

THE PEN IS MIGHTIER: Mets relievers have combined to post a 1.82 ERA (12 ER/59.1 IP) this season...That is the third-best mark in the majors...New York relievers have stranded 21 of 26 inherited runners (19.2 percent) the third-best mark in the majors and the best in the NL.

MAX POWER: Max Kranick owns a career-high scoreless inning streak of 15.0 IP (since: 5/7/22 at CIN with PIT), including 10.0 innings pitched this season...He has held opponents to a .063 on-base percentage (2-32, 0 BB) which is the best in the majors among relief pitchers (min. 20 BF)...He has not issued a walk to any of his 32 batters faced and is one of four pitchers in the majors this season to not issue a walk and face at least 30 batters.

WE FOUND NIMMO: Brandon Nimmo has collected 310 career extra-base hits...That puts him tied with Daniel Murphy for 10th-most on the Mets all-time list...He has drawn 479 career free passes...That is the sixth-most in Mets history...Wayne Garrett is fifth with 482 walks as a Met.

ALMOST ALWAYS JUAN: Juan Soto hit his second home run as a member of the Mets yesterday...Overall, he has reached base safely in 15 of his 16 games as a Met...He is batting .250 (14-56) with 13 runs, four doubles, two home runs, six RBI, 14 walks with an .829 OPS and a 142 OPS+.

WE REMEMBER: The New York Mets announced that the team will wear a tribute uniform patch all season long to honor Mets Hall of Famer Ed Kranepool...Kranepool passed away on September 8, 2024, at age 79...Kranepool played for the Mets from 1962-1979, spending his entire 18-year career with the Mets...He was a member of the 1969 Miracle Mets, a 1965 All-Star and the club's all-time leader in games played...Kranepool remains in the Mets all-time top 10 in many statistical categories including plate appearances, hits, at-bats, total bases, doubles, RBI, walks and runs scored...He was inducted into the Mets Hall of Fame in 1990.

LAST TIME OUT: Megill made his third start of the season in the last of the Mets' six-game opening homestand on April 9...He recorded the loss despite not allowing an earned run through 4.0+ innings pitched (6 H, 2 R, 3 BB, 7 K)...He threw 90 pitches, his most in a game this season...Marked the first time the Mets lost a game he started since July 31, 2024 vs. Minnesota and was his first loss recorded since July 27, 2024 vs. Atlanta.

SO FAR SO GOOD: In three combined starts this season, he has gone 2-1 with a 0.63 ERA (1 ER/14.1 IP), seven walks and 17 strikeouts...Has held opponents to a .204/.291/.241 slash line...Has not allowed a home run to 62 batters faced this season...He has retired the first batter faced of an inning in 14-of-17 opportunities this season, striking out seven...Among pitchers who have faced at least 60 batters this season, he is second in ERA (second in NL) and ninth in opponents' SLG (sixth in NL)...Is one of 15 pitchers to not allow a home run with at least 60 batters faced.

TYLOR MADE: The Mets recorded have recorded the win in eight of Megill's last nine starts, dating back to August 30, 2024...Tylor has gone 4-1 with a 1.79 ERA (9 ER/45.1 IP), 17 walks and 53 strikeouts during that stretch...He also has held opposing batters to a .213/.284/.284 slash line in those games...In that span, he ranks second in ERA (second in NL), fourth in opponents' SLG (second in NL), tenth in opponents' OPS (third in NL) among major league pitchers (min. 40.0 IP).

STARTING OFF STRONG: Megill has made 14 career starts in the months of March and April, going 9-3 with a 2.40 ERA (19 ER/71.1 IP), 28 walks and 67 strikeouts in those games...Since making his first Opening Day roster in 2022, Megill's nine wins in March/April are tied for the third most in the majors (tied for first in NL)...His 2.40 ERA in March/April is the fifth-lowest (first in NL) among pitchers since 2022.

VS. MINNESOTA: Has made two career appearances (one start) against the Twins, allowing one earned run over 7.0 innings pitched...In his only appearance at Target Field on September 10, 2023, he did not record a decision despite allowing just two hits over five scoreless innings (4 BB, 2 K).

ACROSS LEAGUE LINES: In 19 career outings (17 starts) in Interleague games, Megill has went 7-2 with a 3.22 ERA (32 ER/89.1 IP), 34 walks and 92 strikeouts...Has made two starts against Interleague opponents this season, going 2-0 with a 0.87 ERA (1 ER/10.1 IP), four walks and 10 strikeouts...Since the start of last season, the right-hander has allowed just one home run to a total of 156 baters faced, posting a 0.24 HR/9.0IP ratio in Interleague games...He also recorded a 10.18 K/9.0IP ratio (43 K/38.0 IP) in those games...Among National League pitchers who faced at least 100 American League batters in 2024, his K/9.0 and HR/9.0IP both ranked eighth.

HOPE SPRINGS ETERNAL: In four Spring Training starts, Megill went 0-2 with a 4.24 ERA (8 ER/17.0 IP)...He allowed just one home run to 66 total batters faced...The right-hander last pitched on March 22 against Washington, tossing a spring-high 88 pitches over 5.1 innings.

2024 RECAP: Over 16 games (15 starts) in 2024, Megill went 4-5 with a 4.04 ERA (35 ER/78.0 IP), adding 32 walks against 91 strikeouts...The right-hander allowed three runs or less in 11 of his 15 starts, including each of his last six starts of the season (August 30 - September 30)...He recorded at least six strikeouts in nine starts, tied for his most such starts in a single season (also: 2021)...Among National League pitchers, his 10.50 K/9.0IP ratio was tied for the ninth-best (min. 75.0 IP)...Megill pitched in the Postseason for the first time in his career, making appearances in Game 2 of the NLDS vs. Philadelphia (1 ER/1.1 IP) and in Game 3 of the NLCS vs. Los Angeles-NL (4 ER/3.0 IP)...Was on the 15-day Injured List from April 1 - May 20 with a right shoulder strain...In seven starts with Triple-A Syracuse in July and August, Megill went 2-0 with a 4.67 ERA (18 ER/34.2 IP) with 41 strikeouts...Also made four combined rehab appearances (April 27 - May 12) with Brooklyn (A+), Binghamton (AA) and Syracuse (AAA), posting a 0.64 ERA (1 ER/14.0 IP) with one walk and 23 strikeouts.

FAMILY MATTERS: His brother, Trevor, plays for the Milwaukee Brewers...Tylor and Trevor both debuted in the majors in 2021...*Elias* notes that there have been three other pairs of brothers to make their major league debut in the same season since 2000: Scott and Tyler Heineman (2019), Joe and A.J. Jimenez (2017) and Donovan and Jhonatan Solano (2012)...The Megill brothers join teammates Luisangel Acuña (Ronald Acuña Jr.) and Edwin Díaz (Alexis Díaz) as three of 13 pairs of siblings to begin the season on 40-man rosters...Courtesy of *Elias*.

CAREER NOTES: Made his third career Opening Day roster (also: 2022, '24)...Over parts of four Major League seasons with the Mets, Megill has combined to go 23-22 with a 4.40 ERA (174 ER/355.2 IP), 137 walks and 363 strikeouts over 77 games (70 starts)...In 2024, he established career bests in ERA (4.04), K/9.0IP (10.50), HR/9.0IP (0.92) and FIP (3.62)...Was originally drafted by the Mets in the eighth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Arizona.
