**THE TWINS:** Return home tonight after a short three-game roadtrip to Toronto, where Minnesota took two of three from the Blue Jays...tonight, they will begin a three-game homestand with the first of three against the Yankees...after this series they will travel to Cleveland to begin a six-game roadtrip with three against the Guardians (May 17-19) and three against the Nationals (May 20-22).

☞ Twins have won 17 of their last 20 games...since April 22, the Twins lead baseball in wins (17-3), ahead of the Dodgers (15-3) and Phillies (15-5).

**OBER SETS THE TONE, SLAMTANA SENDS 'EM HOME:** The Twins beat the Blue Jays on Sunday afternoon at the Rogers Centre by a score of 5-1, winning their sixth consecutive series (first time since 2010)...Bailey Ober (4-1) was the starter and winner, pitching 6.1 shutout innings, with one hit allowed (Guerrero Jr. single), no walks and a career-high-tying 10 strikeouts...the offense scored all five of their runs after the sixth inning, highlighted by a Carlos Santana three-run home run...Santana's home run broke a 0-0 tie, was his seventh of the season and third in as many days...Max Kepler went 1-for-4 and extended his career-long 14-game hitting streak with a double in his final at-bat.

**ROCCO-FELLA RECORDS:** Rocco Baldelli enters today with 399 career managerial wins...since becoming the Twins manager in 2019, only two AL managers have won more than Rocco: Kevin Cash (442-308) and Aaron Boone (436-314)...14 active managers have reached the 400 wins mark (Bruce Bochy, Bob Melvin, Bud Black, A.J. Hinch, Dave Roberts, Kevin Cash, Craig Counsell, Ron Washington, Brian Snitker, Scott Servais, Aaron Boone, Torey Lovullo, Alex Cora and Dave Martinez...below are the Twins' all-time managerial wins leaders (left) and Baldelli's milestone victories (right):

**NEW YORK STATE OF MIND:** The Twins went 4-3 against the Yankees last season, going 2-2 in New York from April 13-16 and 2-1 at Target Field from April 24-26...it was the first winning season for Minnesota against New York since going 4-2 in 2001...Twins outscored the Yankees 34-28 last season (+6)...it marked the first time they were in the + vs. New York since 2014 at +3 (32-29).

☞ Minnesota will travel to the Bronx for three games from June 4-6.

☞ Jose Miranda is hitting .300 (15-for-50) with three doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI, three walks and an .892 OPS in 14 career games vs. the Yankees.

**SANTANA PERK:** In his last 17 games (roughly since Carlos Santana and Glen Perkins shook hands in the Anaheim visiting clubhouse), Carlos Santana is hitting .295 (18-for-61) with three doubles, seven home runs, 18 RBI, a .689 slugging percentage, a 1.037 OPS and a 12.1% strikeout rate...in his previous 20 games, he posted a .407 OPS with two doubles, no home runs, three RBI and a 22.5% strikeout rate.

**KEP ON KEPPING ON:** Max Kepler enters today with a career-high 14-game hitting streak (previous best was 10 G)...since coming off the Injured List on April 22 (right knee contusion), Kepler has hit .413 (26-for-63) with nine doubles, three home runs, seven walks, 17 RBI, a .465 on-base percentage and a 1.163 OPS in 19 games.

☞ Kepler's streak is the longest by a Twin this season and longest by a Twin since Ryan Jeffers hit in 14 straight from July 15-August 9, 2023...the last Twin to hit in at least 15 straight was Brian Dozier, who hit in 24 from September 22, 2017-April 23, 2018.

☞ The 14-game hitting streak is tied with Ketel Marte for the longest active streak in baseball...a hit tonight and Kepler will join Alec Bohm (18), Marcell Ozuna (17) and Ozzie Albies (15) as the only players in baseball this season to reach the 15-game mark.

☞ Since June 30, 2023, Kepler is hitting .307 (107-for-349) with 26 doubles, two triples, 17 home runs, 60 RBI and a .912 OPS in 99 games...since that date, Kepler's OPS ranks sixth-best in the AL and 14th-best in baseball (minimum of 350 plate appearances).

**TOP JEFF:** Ryan Jeffers is hitting .333 (21-for-63) with eight doubles, six home runs, 18 RBI, five walks, a .405 on-base percentage, a .746 slugging percentage and a 1.151 OPS in his last 18 games, since April 22.

☞ Among all MLB qualifiers on the season, Jeffers ranks fifth in OPS (.988), trailing Shohei Ohtani (1.081), Marcell Ozuna (1.048), Kyle Tucker (.993) and Mookie Betts (.993)...additionally, he ranks third in baseball in slugging percentage (.617), fourth in RC/27 (.928) and fifth in OPS+ (181.4).

**RISP, REWARD:** In their last 16 games since April 26, Twins are hitting .335 (56-for-167) with runners in scoring position...since that date, their RISP average ranks second in baseball, trailing only the Royals (.346).

☞ In their first 24 games, prior to April 26, the Twins hit .160 (32-for-200) with RISP, the lowest in baseball.

**SOUTHPAW STORIES:** Twins hitters are slashing .279/.329/.439 with a .767 OPS vs. left-handed pitching compared to .228/.308/.402 with a .711 OPS vs. right-handed pitching.

☞ In their last 13 games vs. lefties, the Twins are slashing .339/.374/.524 (.898 OPS).

☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .333 (6-for-18) with a .900 OPS in his last 10 games vs. lefties.

☞ Willi Castro is hitting .464 (13-for-28) with a 1.214 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...in his last 10 games, he is 13-for-18 (.722) with a 1.833 OPS vs. lefties.

**FASHIONABLY LATE:** The Twins scored six more runs after the sixth inning during the three-game series in Toronto, including all five of their runs on Sunday in innings seven and eight...Minnesota has scored 85 of their 195 runs from the seventh inning-or-later, accounting for 44% of their runs scored...the 85 runs scored lead all of baseball...Minnesota has scored 35 runs in the seventh inning, 17 runs in the eighth inning, 25 runs in the ninth inning and eight in extra innings.

**TALL ORDER:** Double-A Wichita outfielder Carson McCusker has been named Texas League Player of the Week...in five games for the Wind Surge, the 25-year-old hit .526 (10-for-19) with three doubles, three home runs, nine RBI and a 1.749 OPS...the 6-foot-8, 250-pound outfielder's week included a 5-for-5 game on May 7 vs. Arkansas, in which he hit one double, three home runs, six RBI and five runs scored.

- ☞ Making eighth start of season and 73rd of career...last pitched May 8 vs. Seattle; earned fourth-straight win, allowing one run on eight hits (1 HR) in 5.1 innings with one walk and a season-high-tying 10 strikeouts.
- ☞ Only career start vs. New York-AL came May 29, 2019 at Yankee Stadium...allowed four runs on six hits (3 HR) in 5.0 innings and took the loss.
- ☞ Has gone 3-0 with a 1.17 ERA (23.0 IP, 3 ER) in four starts at Target Field this season, compared to 1-1 with a 9.42 ERA (14.1 IP, 15 ER) in three road starts.

**SHUT DOWN SEATTLE:** Last pitched May 8 vs. Seattle, opposite George Kirby, earning his career-best fourth-straight win in Minnesota's 6-3 victory...allowed one run on eight hits (1 HR) in 5.1 innings, with one walk and a season-high-tying 10 strikeouts...threw a season-high 99 pitches, his most in a start since July 27, 2021 vs. Oakland (102)...only run came on Mitch Garver's fourth-inning solo home run...was pulled with a runner on first in the sixth; Caleb Thielbar entered and stranded the runner.

- ☞ Induced a season-high 19 whiffs on 55 swings (34.5%)...improved 2024 whiff rate to 24.8 percent, which ranks in MLB's 47th percentile.
- ☞ Allowed seven hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph)...Seattle went 4-for-7 on those swings, including Garver's 98.3 mph home run...Paddack's 41.3 percent hard-hit rate ranks in MLB's 34th percentile.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Started May 3 vs. Boston, opposite Tanner Houck, earning his third-straight win and second quality start of the season in Minnesota's 5-2 victory...threw 6.0 scoreless innings, allowing two hits and one walk with six strikeouts...escaped no-out, second-and-third jam in the first...only hit allowed after the first was a third-inning leadoff single by Ceddanne Rafaela; Rafaela was then caught stealing...retired 12 of his last 13 hitters, including three strikeouts in the sixth.

- ☞ Induced 12 whiffs on 39 swings (30.8%).
- ☞ Allowed six hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph)...Boston's only hit on those swings was Rafael Devers' 111.9 mph double.

**PADDACK VS. THE YANKEES:** Only career start vs. New York-AL came May 29, 2019 at Yankee Stadium...took the loss in a 5.0-inning effort, allowing four runs on six hits (3 HR) with one walk and six strikeouts...six active Yankees hitters have faced Paddack, combining to go 7-for-21 with two home runs (both by Juan Soto) and four strikeouts.

- ☞ New York-AL has posted a .775 OPS vs. right-handed pitching, the second highest in baseball behind Los Angeles-NL (.784).

**HAPPY HOME:** Making fifth start at Target Field this season...has gone 3-0 at home with a 1.17 ERA (23.0 IP, 3 ER), four walks and 31 strikeouts, compared to 1-1 on the road with a 9.42 ERA (14.1 IP, 15 ER), four walks and six strikeouts...has allowed 0.78 home-runs-per-9.0-innings at home, compared to 2.51 on the road...both of his quality starts have come at Target Field...here are some more home/road splits for Paddack this season:

**PLATOON SPLITS:** On May 8, Seattle's left-handed hitters went 4-for-11 with five strikeouts, while its righties went 4-for-13 with a home run, a walk and five strikeouts...through seven games vs. Paddack, left-handed hitters have hit .346 (27-for-78) with an .824 OPS and 17.7 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .266 (21-for-79) with a .748 OPS and 26.8 percent strikeout rate.

- ☞ Has induced a 21.6 percent whiff rate vs. lefties, 27.9 percent vs. righties.
- ☞ Among pitchers with 500-or-more total pitches in 2024, Paddack has allowed the fifth-highest batting average to left-handed hitters.

**THE ARSENAL:** Has thrown a four-pitch mix through seven starts, per Baseball Savant...here are his pitch usage and results thus far in 2024:

- ☞ May 8 vs. Seattle, tallied eight strikeouts with the 4-seamer...pitch generated 11 whiffs on 23 swings and has a 28.3 percent whiff rate this season, a career high (excl. 2023).
- ☞ Garver home run was the first off a Paddack 4-seamer since September 5, 2021 (Carlos Correa and Yuli Gurriel).
- ☞ 4-seamer has allowed a .315 batting average but a .247 expected batting average.
- ☞ Slider has allowed a .333 batting average but a .258 expected batting average.

**WIN STREAK:** Paddack is currently riding a career-long four-game winning streak...last Minnesota pitcher to win four-straight starts was Pablo López from August 1-18, 2023...Paddack's win on April 22 was the first start of a 12-game winning streak the Twins carried until May 4; his three wins during the streak led all Twins pitchers...during Paddack's personal winning streak, he has posted a 1.93 ERA (23.1 IP, 5 ER), the fifth lowest in the AL since April 22 (min. 20.0 IP).

**IN CONTROL:** Ranks in baseball's 86th percentile this season with a 4.8 percent walk rate...has issued four total walks in his last five starts...has issued two-or-fewer walks in 36-straight appearances (33 starts); last three-walk outing came April 4, 2021 vs. Arizona...has issued 1.84 walks-per-9.0-innings in his career (2019-present), the ninth lowest in baseball during that span (min. 350.0 IP).

**2023 NOTES:**

- ☞ Signed three-year contract extension on January 18.
- ☞ On 60-day Injured List from February 23 to September 24, rehabbing from Tommy John surgery in May 2022.
- ☞ Allowed four earned runs in 9.2 innings with 15 strikeouts in three-game rehab assignment.
- ☞ Returned September 24 vs. Los Angeles-AL...exited the bullpen and as he was approaching the infield dirt, umpires called for the tarp...didn't return after 50-minute rain delay.
- ☞ Made official return to major league mound on September 25 vs. Oakland...first major league appearance in 507 days...threw fastest pitch of career, a 99 mph four-seam fastball to Zack Gelof in the top of the sixth inning.
- ☞ Included on American League Wild Card Series roster but didn't appear in two-game sweep of Toronto.
- ☞ Made relief appearances in Games 1 and 4 of American League Division Series vs. Houston, allowing one baserunner and striking out six in 3.2 total innings...both no-decisions in Twins losses.
