ROSTER MOVE—The Rays have placed RH **Diego Castillo** (right groin tightness) on the 10-day IL, retroactive to May 4, and reinstated RH **Pete Fairbanks** (right rotator cuff strain) from the 10-day IL...Castillo has seven of the club's 10 saves and his 7 saves are tied for 2nd in the AL behind **TEX Ian Kennedy** (8)...prior to last night's game, the Rays placed RH **Michael Wacha** (right hamstring tightness) on the 10-day IL, retroactive to May 3, and reinstated RH **Collin McHugh** (low back strain) from the 10-day IL.

- + Last night 1B **Ji-Man Choi** (arthroscopic surgery, right knee) began a rehab assignment with Triple-A Durham, playing five innings at first base...he is scheduled to DH tonight's game in Memphis.

RAY MATTER—The Rays have won three consecutive games, their 2nd-longest winning streak of the season behind April 16-20 (5)...the Rays are over .500 for the first time since the end of play on April 28 (13-12) and tonight are attempting to improve to a season-high-tying 2 games over .500 for the first time since they were 10-8 through April 20...the Rays are 5-5 in their last 10 games and 6-7 in their last 13 games...this 3-game winning streak has brought them from last place in the AL East into a tie for 2nd...they are 2.5 GB of the first-place Red Sox (18-12) in the division.

- + The Rays are 9-5 on the road, 3rd in the AL, and 29-11 (.725) on the road since Aug 10, 2020, best in the majors over that stretch...the Rays have won seven of their last eight road games after going 2-4 on the season-opening trip...over this 7-1 span, the Rays have made just 2 errors while their opponents have combined for 15 errors.
- + The Rays have used 37 players, 22 pitchers and 10 starting pitchers...all rank 2nd in the majors—the Brewers have used 41 players, Cubs have used 24 pitchers and Blue Jays have used 11 starters.
- + The Rays have blown a lead in eight of their 15 losses...the eight blown leads (games lost after holding a lead) ties their 2020 total.
- + The Rays are 6-6 in this stretch of 17 consecutive days without an off day, and 14-11 in this stretch of 30 games in 31 days.

ABOUT THE OFFENSE—The Rays have totaled 15 runs on 19 hits, 12 BB and 4 errors this series, scoring 7 runs (or more) in back-to-back games for the second time this season (April 20-21 at KC)...the Rays have also struck out 28 times this series, the seventh time in ML history a team has reached 7+ runs and 13+ SO in back-to-back games...the most recent was the Giants (Sep 17-18, 2019); no team has done it in three straight games.

- + The Rays have scored 7 runs (or more) in four straight road games, matching the longest such streak in club history...the previous instances were Aug 10-13, 2020 at BOS and Aug 16-19, 2012 at LAA.
- + The Rays have hit multiple homers in consecutive games for the second time this season (April 10-11 vs. NYY)...the 4 HR in 2 games this series match their total from the previous 8 games combined.
- + In the last 12 games since April 23 vs. TOR, the Rays have scored 40 runs (3.33 R/G) on 82 hits and 39 BB, have struck out 130 times and are batting .208 (82-for-394) overall and .129 (12-for-93) with RISP.
- + The Rays have scored 4 runs (or fewer) in 19 of 31 games (61.3 pct.), tied for 3rd-fewest in the AL after the Tigers (22) and Orioles (20).
- + The Rays have struck out 319 times this season, 2nd in the majors behind the Rangers (323)...the Rays rank 10th in the AL in batting avg. (.226), 9th in on-base pct. (.309) and 10th in home runs (32).
- + Last night **Kevin Kiermaier's** second steal was the 100th of his career; **Austin Meadows' second** homer was the 50th of his career.
- + The Rays have used 31 different batting orders in 31 games.

CHICKEN ON THE BONE—The Rays have scored 15 runs this series despite batting .227 (5-for-22) with RISP...the 5 hits are only two shy of tying the team total from the 10-game homestand, when they hit .099 (7-for-71) with RISP...the Rays are 7-for-33 with RISP during the winning streak.

- + This season the Rays are batting .194 (53-for-273) with RISP, last in the majors—in 29th place is the Orioles at .205...with RISP and 2 out, their .155 avg. (20-for-129) is 29th in the majors (30th: Mets, .143)...strangely, they are batting .304 (7-for-23) with the bases loaded.
- + The Rays are batting .241 (34-for-141) with RISP on the road, compared to batting .144 (19-for-132) with RISP at Tropicana Field.
- + The Rays have had 62 PA this season with a runner on third and less than 2 outs, and that runner has scored 30 times (48.4 pct.), 16th in the majors...the ML avg. in those situations is 49.0 pct.

PITCHING PROPERLY—The Rays have pitched to a 3.09 ERA (99-IP, 34-ER) in their last 11 games, allowing 3 runs (or fewer) nine times over that stretch...this has lowered the staff's season ERA from 4.62 to 4.08...the team ERA has been over 4.00 every day since the end of play on April 3...

the Rays have allowed 3 runs (or fewer) in 15 of their last 24 games (62.5 pct.) since April 10, after doing it once in the first 7 games this season.

- + Rays pitching ranked as low as 28th in the majors with a 5.74 ERA through April 9...since April 10, the Rays have a 3.60 ERA (217.2-IP, 87-ER) in 24 games, which ranks 6th in the AL over that stretch.
- + The bullpen has a 2.63 ERA (51.1-IP, 15-ER) in the last 12 games, reducing its season ERA from 5.40 to 4.33...since April 10, the bullpen is 13th in the majors with a 3.58 ERA (108-IP, 43-ER) in 24 games.
- + The Rays have allowed 53 runs in the 7th inning or later, 5th in the majors and most in the AL (Twins, 52)...the Rays have yielded 3 HR in the 7th, 4 HR in the 8th, 2 HR in the 9th and 1 HR in extras.
- + The Rays are 8-8 in games decided by 2 runs (or fewer) this season after going a major-league-best 23-10 last season...similarly, they are 4-5 in 1-run games after going a majors-best 14-5 in 2020.

RAYS vs. ANGELS—Tonight is the third of seven meetings against the Angels this season, which includes a 3-game series from June 25-27 at Tropicana Field...the two clubs did not meet last season and the Rays went 4-3 against them in 2019, winning the season series for a fourth consecutive year while improving to 4-0-1 over the last five season series.

- + The Rays are 86-101 (.460) all-time against them (42-49 at home, 44-52 on the road), including 54-38 as the Rays after going 32-63 in the Devil Rays era (1998-2007).
- + Since the start of 2010, the Rays are 30-12 (.714) at Angel Stadium, including 10-1-1 in series play, compared to 16-19 (.457) at Tropicana Field...the Rays are 14-3 at Angel Stadium since June 2, 2015.
- + The Rays have seen former Manager **Joe Maddon** in two prior series, both with the Cubs: July 4-5, 2017 at Wrigley Field (1-1) and Sep 19-20, 2017 at home (1-1)...only two current Rays played for a Rays team managed by Joe: **Chris Archer** and **Kevin Kiermaier**.

PITCHING PLANS—Tonight's game will be started by **Andrew Kittredge**, his 13th career start and second this season...tonight is the fifth time this season the Rays are using an opener (2-2)...the Rays introduced the opener concept at Angel Stadium on May 19, 2018, when **Sergio Romo** pitched a perfect 1st inning and struck out **Zack Cozart**, **Mike Trout** and **Justin Upton**...Romo opened again the next day, pitching 1.1 scoreless innings.

- + Incl. postseason, since the debut of the opener on May 19, 2018, the Rays have used one 112 times and are 67-45 (.598) in those games.

DYNAMIC DUO—Last night **Shane McClanahan** (4 IP) and **Luis Patiño** (3 IP) combined to allow 1 run on 4 hits, 2 BB and 10 SO in 7 IP...Patiño recorded the second win of his career and first with the Rays...at 21 years, 190 days, he became the youngest Rays winning pitcher since **Scott Kazmir** (21.185) on July 28, 2005 vs. KC...McClanahan made his second career start, reaching 100 mph five times last night (four in the 1st inning)...his seven pitches of 100+ mph rank 4th among starters behind **NYM Jacob deGrom** (46), **LAA Shohei Ohtani** (9) and **TB Tyler Glasnow** (8).

MIDNIGHT MEADOWS—Last night **Austin Meadows** recorded a career-high 5 RBI with a RBI groundout and the second multi-HR game of his career, following April 12, 2019 at TOR...he became the first Ray with a multi-HR game since **Randy Arozarena** on Sep 23, 2020 at NYM and the first Ray to reach 2 HR and 5 RBI since **Eric Sogard** on Aug 3, 2019 vs. MIA...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, the Rays have won 12 consecutive games in which he homers, the longest active streak in the majors...it was the second time in club history a player hit multiple homers off the same reliever in a single game, joining **B.J. Upton** on Sep 9, 2012 vs. TEX.

MINOR MATTERS—Triple-A Durham and Low-A Charleston both won their season openers last night, while Double-A Montgomery and High-A Bowling Green were postponed...*Baseball America* has released its list of the most talented Opening Day minor league rosters and Durham ranks No. 1 among the Top 10 list...from *Baseball America*: "Other teams have more Top 100 Prospects, but Durham's combination of star power and depth pushes it to the top. The Bulls open with the No. 1 prospect in baseball and nine of the Top 30 prospects from baseball's best farm system."

THIS DAY IN RAYS HISTORY—On May 5, 2012, **Joe Maddon** managed his 1,000th game for the Rays, a 4-3, 12-inning home loss to Oakland.
