THE TWINS: After finishing their six-game, eight-day roadtrip with a record of 2-4 (1-2 at Baltimore and 1-2 at Kansas City), the Twins opened their first homestand of the season with a 1-2 series loss to Tampa Bay, their only win being the Home Opener on Friday...tonight, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the first of four games against the Detroit Tigers through Thursday afternoon...after this series, Minnesota will travel to Toronto for a three-game weekend series at Rogers Centre.
 ☞ Today marks day six of a stretch of 15-straight days with a game for Minnesota...their next off-day will be on April 16.

EASTER BUNNY UNKIND: The Twins lost to the Rays yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 4-1 in 10 innings...Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on five hits in 6.2 innings pitched, with two walks and four strikeouts...SWR's only blemish on the day was a solo home run by Junior Camerino in the fourth inning...Justin Topa was issued the loss, allowing a Richie Palacios two-run homer in the top of the 10th inning...Minnesota's offense recorded just three hits, their only run coming on a Matt Wallner solo home run in the second inning, his team-leading third of the season.

GLOW JOE UP: Since the start of last season, 2025 AL All-Star Joe Ryan has gone 13-11, 3.49 ERA (180.1 IP, 70 ER) with 41 walks, 204 strikeouts, a .222 opponent batting average and a 10.2 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio...below are his ranks in a few categories among AL pitchers since the start of last season (minimum 180.0 IP):

THIS SEASON ON TIGER KING: The Twins went 5-8 against Detroit in 2025, going 2-5 at Target Field and 3-3 at Comerica Park...these two last met for four games at Target Field from August 14-17 as the Tigers took three of four.

- ☞ The Twins have gone 40-24 at home against the Tigers since the start of the 2018 season, second-most home wins against any opponent in that span (Kansas City - 45-17).
- ☞ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 150, 35 ahead of Cleveland (115).
- ☞ Byron Buxton has a .961 OPS and a .632 slugging percentage in his last 17 games against the Tigers, hitting six doubles and six home runs in 73 plate appearances...Buck homered five times against the Tigers last season: April 11 off Beau Brieske, April 13 off Casey Mize, June 27 off Sawyer Gipson-Long, June 28 off Casey Mize and August 17 off Chris Paddack.
- ☞ Royce Lewis has posted an .850 OPS in 20 career games vs. the Tigers...he has reached base safely in all 20 career games vs. the Tigers (.390 OBP, 17 H, 13 BB).
- ☞ Brooks Lee is hitting .291 (16-for-55) with four doubles, two home runs and 15 RBI in 16 career games vs. the Tigers...15 RBI are his most vs. any opponent.
- ☞ Luke Keaschall has hit safely in all six career games vs. Detroit, hitting .391 (9-for-23) with two doubles, one home run, seven RBI, three walks and a 1.070 OPS.
- ☞ Career home runs off Casey Mize: Byron Buxton - 2, Ryan Jeffers - 1, Trevor Larnach - 1 and Matt Wallner - 1...Mize has allowed 11 total home runs in his career vs. the Twins, his most vs. any team (next is Kansas City with 6).

BULLSEYE BUCK: Byron Buxton enters today with 84 career home runs at Target Field, tied with Max Kepler for the most in the ballpark's history (top 10 - lower right margin).
 ☞ Buck's .878 OPS at Target Field last season was the 10th-highest in the AL among players with at least 275 plate appearances in their home ballpark...his .541 slugging percentage ranked sixth in that same group.
 ☞ Buxton's other rankings in Target Field history (since 2010): first in stolen bases (67), fourth in runs (264) and RBI (215), fifth in hits (382) and sixth in doubles (80)...below are Target Field rankings in a few offensive categories:

KEEP THEIR HEADS RINGING: Josh Bell has gone 6-for-21 (.286) with three doubles, two home runs, five walks, six RBI, nine runs scored, a .444 on-base percentage, a .714 slugging percentage and a 1.159 OPS in his last seven games.

- ☞ Among all AL players this season with a minimum of 30 plate appearances, he ranks tied for 12th in slugging percentage (.556) and 13th in OPS (.927).
- ☞ Bell has 195 career home runs, needing five to become the 39th active player in baseball to reach the 200 home run mark...Xander Bogaerts is the closest to 200 among actives with 197.

TOUGH LUCK LUKE: Luke Keaschall has made nine outs on balls hit 100+ mph, the most in baseball...he added to his total yesterday with two ground ball outs, one at 104.7 mph and one at 100.9 mph...he finished the three-game series vs. Tampa Bay with four 100.0+ mph hit balls that resulted in outs.
 ☞ Keaschall's hart hit percentage is up 3.2 percentage points from last season, going from 31.2% in his rookie season to now 34.4%.

REMEMBERING TOM NIETO: Former Twins catcher Tom Nieto sadly passed away recently at the age of 65...Nieto played in parts of seven major league seasons with St. Louis (1984-85), Montreal (1986), Minnesota (1986-88) and Philadelphia (1989-90)...he played in 65 games for the Twins from '87-88 and was one of the catchers on the 1987 World Champion Twins.

HAPPY BERT DAY! Hall-of-Famer Bert Blyleven turns 75 today...Bert appeared in five games on his birthday, combining to go 2-1, 2.51 ERA (32.1 IP, 9 ER) with 13 walks and 22 strikeouts...he pitched a complete game on his birthday in 1973 against Oakland.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1982, the largest crowd ever to see a baseball game in Minnesota, 52,279, showed up for the inaugural game at the brand-new Hubert H. Humphrey Metrodome...Twins rookie Gary Gaetti had four hits, including a pair of home runs, but the visiting Seattle Mariners won, 11-7.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan picked up his first loss of 2026 on April 1 at Kansas City; surrendered five runs on nine hits - matching a single-game high for hits allowed - with no walks and three strikeouts...marked the earliest loss in a season of his career (was previously April 3, 2025 vs. Houston).

- ☞ Plunked his first batter of the year, hitting Isaac Collins with a splitter in the bottom of the fourth inning.
- ☞ Marked his 26th career outing with three or more strikeouts and zero walks, the 14th most such games among all pitchers since the start of the 2022 season.

2025 RECAP: Made a career-high 30 starts (31 appearances), finishing 13-10 with a 3.42 ERA (171.0 IP, 65 ER), 39 walks, 194 strikeouts (4.97 K/BB), a 1.04 WHIP and a .218 (138-for-633) BAA...matched his single-season high in wins (2022)...finished top 10 in the American League in strikeouts (6th), WHIP (6th), wins (T-6th), BAA (9th) and ERA (10th)...was named to the American League All-Star team for the first time in his career...received the Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year, as voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the Baseball Writers Association of America.

RY OF THE TIGER: Ryan is making his 10th career start against the Tigers (4-2); enters the game with a 3.42 ERA (52.2 IP, 20 ER), eight walks, 71 strikeouts and a .211 (42-for-199) BAA...last faced the Tigers on July 27, 2024, making a quality start, allowing three runs (two earned) in 6.0 innings pitched on three hits, one walk and eight strikeouts in a 7-2 loss at Comerica Park.

- ☞ His 66 strikeouts against Detroit since the start of the 2022 season are the second most in MLB, trailing only his teammate and Wednesday's expected starter, Bailey Ober (67).
- ☞ Seeking his first win against Detroit since September 30, 2022; 0-2, 4.44 ERA (24.1 IP, 12 ER) with three walks and 33 strikeouts (11.0 K/BB) in four starts since his last victory vs. the Tigers.
- ☞ Did not face Detroit in 2025 despite the two teams meeting 13 times.

AL CENTRAL: Ryan is 18-9 in 38 career starts (39 games) against the AL Central, posting a 3.02 ERA (223.2 IP, 75 ER) with 44 walks, 235 strikeouts, a 0.94 WHIP and a .204 (167-for-818) BAA.

- ☞ In 2025, Ryan appeared in six games against division opponents (five starts); 2-2, 4.50 ERA (30.0 IP, 15 ER) with nine walks, 24 strikeouts, a 1.10 WHIP and a .218 (24-for-110) BAA.
- ☞ Is 10-4 with a 3.68 ERA (117.1 IP, 48 ER), 21 walks and 136 strikeouts in 20 games (19 starts) at Target Field against division foes.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In 58 career road starts, Ryan is 20-20 with a 3.95 ERA (318.2 IP, 140 ER), 71 walks and 339 strikeouts, compared to 26-17 with a 3.66 ERA (332.0 IP, 135 ER), 79 walks and 390 strikeouts in 59 home appearances (58 starts).

- ☞ Posted a 7-5 record and a 3.48 ERA (85.1 IP, 33 ER) with 21 walks and 103 strikeouts through 15 starts (16 games) at Target Field in 2025.
- ☞ His 103 strikeouts at home ranked fifth in the American League; 390 strikeouts at Target Field are third most all-time, trailing Kyle Gibson (436) and José Berríos (432).
