THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
APRIL 30

1982 - At Three Rivers Stadium in Pittsburgh, Phil Garner hits a 3-run HR on his 33rd birthday to help defeat the Pirates, 4-3...Garner, who was voted into the Astros Hall of Fame earlier this month, had played for the Pirates (1977-81) prior to being traded to HOU on Aug. 31, 1981.

1979 - At Busch Stadium in St. Louis, Terry Puhl's 2-run HR in the top of the 9th lifted the Astros to a 6-5, comeback win over the Cardinals. The Astros had entered the 9th, trailing, 4-2. Puhl's HR capped a dramatic, 4-run 9th-inning rally.

TODAY'S DOUBLEHEADER: As a result of last night's rainout, the Astros and Orioles will play a traditional doubleheader today...**Game One: RHP Peter Lambert** (1-1) will make his 3rd start of the season as he takes on Orioles RHP Chris Bassitt (1-2)...today will be Lambert's 1st career appearance vs. BAL...**Game Two: RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (1-2) will make his 6th start of the season of the season as he takes on Orioles RHP Brandon Young (2-0).

DOUBLEHEADER INFO: Today will be the first doubleheader for the Astros since July 21, 2022 at home vs. NYY, which resulted in an Astros sweep of the Bronx Bombers...that DH was scheduled as a result of the delay to the start of the 2022 season due to the work stoppage...doubleheaders are a rarity at Daikin Park since the Astros have a roof...the Astros last doubleheader played vs. BAL was Sept. 29, 2018 at Camden Yards, which also resulted in an Astros sweep...in Game 2 of that DH, today's Game 2 starter, **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.**, hurled 0.2 scoreless in relief, earning a hold in the Astros 5-2 win.

TODAY'S GM 1 STARTER: RHP Peter Lambert will make his 3rd start/app. of the season today...he was stellar in his last start on 4/22 at CLE, allowing just 3 hits in 6.0 scoreless innings with 8 strikeouts (16 whiffs) in the Astros 2-0 win...Lambert joined the Astros via free agency this offseason after pitching last year for the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the NPB, posting a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts in 23 appearances in Japan...he began this season at Triple A Sugar Land (1.84 ERA in 3 app. (2 GS) before being called up for a start on April 17 vs. STL.

A SWING AND A MISS: In his 2 starts this season, **RHP Peter Lambert** has induced a combined 39 swing-and-misses...the 23 whiffs he induced in his April 17 start vs. STL are the 3rd-highest total by an AL pitcher in 2026 and T-5th highest in the Majors:

TODAY'S GM 2 STARTER: RHP Lance McCullers Jr. will make his 7th career start and 9th overall app. vs. BAL in Game 2...he is 3-0 in his career vs. the O's with a 3.34 ERA (13ER/35IP) and 41 strikeouts...**Déjà Vu:** McCullers pitched in relief in Game 2 of the last doubleheader between HOU and BAL, which was on Sept. 29, 2018 at Camden Yards (0.2 IP, 0 R, 1 SO)...Last Start: Prior to today, McCullers last start was on Friday vs. NYY (5 IP, 5 ER)...**Innings Milestone:** McCullers needs just 0.2 IP to reach 800.0 for his career...**Fun Fact:** He and his father, Lance McCullers Sr., were both the 41st overall pick in their respective MLB Drafts (1982 and 2012)...Lance Sr. pitched 7 seasons in the Major Leagues.

VS. THE O'S: Today's doubleheader will wrap up this 3-game series vs. the Orioles...the Astros were 4-3 vs. BAL in 2025 with a 3-1 mark here at Camden Yards, Aug. 21-24...the two clubs will next meet for a 3-game set at Daikin Park, July 17-19.

PLAYER OF THE MONTH?: Yordan Alvarez is a strong candidate for the AL Player of the Month Award as he has had a torrid start to his season, hitting .355 with 11 HR and 26 RBI...Alvarez leads the AL in OPS (1.199), RBI (26), SLG (.736), OBP (.463) and Total Bases (81) while ranking 2nd in batting avg. (.355) and WAR (1.9)...additionally, Alvarez' current 13-game hitting streak is tied for the longest active streak in the AL (McGonigle-DET) and matches his career-best, done May 2-16, 2023.

HISTORIC HOMERS: Yordan Alvarez is off to one of the most prolific starts in franchise history. His 11 HR through the club's first 30 games of the season are the 2nd-most in franchise history...below is a breakdown:

ROAD WARRIOR: In 9 road games (6 starts) this season, **Brice Matthews** is 7x21 (.333) with a HR, 6 RBI and 6 BB, slashing (.333/462/.619) for a 1.081 OPS...in his young career, Matthews is hitting .289 in 16 road games (12 starts) with 5 HR and 15 RBI with a .396 OBP and a .689 SLG (1.085 OPS).

The O's:** Additionally, Altuve's has a .315 career avg. (94x298) vs. the Orioles overall...he has posted a .300+ career batting avg. vs. 15 opposing teams.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS: With 238 career HR, Jose Altuve needs one more to tie Lou Whitaker for 7th place all-time among 2nd basemen...Altuve also needs 3 RBI to become the 5th player in franchise history to reach 900.

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: Christian Walker is hitting .429 (12x28) in his last 7 games (since 4/20) with 3 HR and 7 RBI...**Among The Leaders:** For the season, Walker enters today ranked T-3rd in the AL in RBI (23), 4th in SLG (.579), T-6th in TB (62), 5th in OPS (.956) and T-6th in doubles (9).

LAST START - 4/22 at CLE: Had a stellar 2nd start of his season in Cleveland on April 22...allowed only 3 hits in 6.0 shutout innings with 3 walks and 8 strikeouts...has struck out 8 batters in back-to-back starts...threw 96 pitches (61 strikes), the most amount of pitches he's thrown in an MLB game since August, 24, 2023 at TB...earned his 1st win of the season and his 1st career win since April 6, 2024 vs. AZ as a member of the Colorado Rockies.

SAVANT SAYS: His 41.5 whiff % ranks in the 99th percentile of all Major League players...it ranks 3rd in the AL and 4th in MLB, behind **SD Mason Miller, NYY Fernando Cruz, BAL Ryan Helsley**, and is 1st among MLB starters...is not far behind in K% with a 33.3% ranked in the 93rd percentile.

MILESTONE WATCH: is 3 strikeouts away from 200 for his MLB career.

WITH THE SPACE COWBOYS: Made 3 appearances, including 2 starts for Triple A Sugar Land to begin the 2026 season...in those 3 appearances, he recorded a 1.84 ERA (3ER/14.2IP) with 12 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .208 opponent batting average.

2025 SEASON: Spent the 2025 season with the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the Nippon Professional Baseball League...made 23 appearances for the Swallows, recording a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts, 54 walks and a 1.44 WHIP.

AGAINST THE O'S: Will be making his 1st career start and appearance against the Orioles...has faced **BAL Pete Alonso (2x4, 3B, BB), Blaze Alexander (0x2), Taylor Ward (0x2)** and **Leody Taveras (0x1)** prior to this season...only Alonso has managed to collect at least a hit off of Lambert.

ABOUT LAMBERT: Right-handed pitcher joined the Astros on a minor league deal this offseason...has appeared at the Major League level in four seasons with the Colorado Rockies (2019, 2021, 2023-24)...in 76 career Major League appearances, including 37 starts, he's recorded a 6.15 ERA (174ER/254.2IP) with 197 strikeouts...was selected by the Rockies in the 2nd round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of San Dimas High School, was committed to play baseball at UCLA before signing with the Rockies...was signed by Rockies scout Jon Lukens...as a senior at San Dimas HS in 2015, he went 13-0 with a 0.34 ERA...was also named the Los Angeles Times Baseball Player of the Year.

FAMILY TIES: Has an older brother, **Jimmy Lambert**, who pitched in parts of four seasons (2020-23) in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox...in 83 career appearances, he recorded a 4.33 ERA (48ER/99.2IP) with 98 strikeouts.

LAST START, 4/24 vs. NYY: In his 5th start of the year, allowed 7 runs (5 earned) on 6 hits with 4 walks and 3 strikeouts (92 pitches-51 strikes)...suffered the loss in a 12-4 Astros defeat.

VS. THE O'S: holds a 3.34 ERA (13ER/35IP) in 8G/6GS vs. the Orioles in his career...will be facing the Orioles for the first time since last season on Aug. 22 at BAL, where he gave up 3 runs in 4.0 innings of work with 5 walks and 4 strikeouts...in his very first start against Baltimore on June 3, 2015 at Daikin Park, he threw a complete game, allowing just 1 run on 4 hits with no walks and 11 strikeouts...it was his 4th career start in the Majors...has held **BAL** **Adley Rutschman**, **Dylan Beavers**, **Colton Cowser** and **Colby Mayo** hitless when facing them in the past...**BAL** **Taylor Ward** (3x9, HR, 2 BB), **Leody Taveras** (1x7, 2B), **Gunnar Henderson** (1x3), and **Jeremiah Jackson** (2x3, 2B) have all collected hits off him.

CUT ABOVE: Has thrown his cutter at a 28.9-percent rate, the highest of any of his pitches this season...per Baseball Savant, he only began to throw a cutter last season and threw it at a 4.5-percent rate.

APPROACHING 800: enters tonight start with 799.1 innings pitched...with 2 more outs, he's looking to become the 25th player in Astros history to reach 800 career innings with the club, and the 1st to do so since **LHP** **Framber Valdez**.

SEASON DEBUT: had a spectacular debut to his 2026 season, striking out 9 over 7.0 innings while allowing just 1 run on 4 hits with 1 walk (96 pitches-63 strikes) on March 30 vs. LAA...was his longest start since also tossing 7.0 innings on Sept. 21, 2022 at TB...was his longest start while allowing 1-or-fewer runs since allowing 1 run through 7.0 innings on July 16, 2021 at CWS...was his longest start in a season debut in his 9-year MLB career and were his most strikeouts in a season debut since striking out 10 batters on March 31, 2018 at TEX...is also the longest start by an Astro and tied for the 7th-longest start by an AL pitcher this season.

2025 RECAP: made his return to the mound after missing the entire 2023-24 seasons due to a right flexor tendon injury that required surgery...worked around four IL stints to go 2-5 with a 6.51 ERA (40ER/55.1IP) and 9.92 SO/9IP through 16 games (13 starts)...made his season debut on May 4 at CWS, marking his first appearance on a Major League mound since Game 3 of the 2022 World Series in Philadelphia, a span of 915 days...logged his 50th career win on June 3 at PIT...became the 23rd pitcher in franchise history to reach the mark.

GROUNDING: is one of the game's elite groundball pitchers...his 55.1 ground-ball percentage ranks 3rd in the Majors among active pitchers since 2015 (min. 700 IP)...trails only **LHP** **Framber Valdez** (62.2%) and **RHP** **Logan Webb** (58.0%).
