NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees clinched a series win over the Diamondbacks with a come-from-behind 6-4 victory over Arizona today.
 - Have posted a Major League-best 17-9 (.654) record since 8/28 (San Diego is 16-9 over that stretch and plays tonight).
 - Are 9-5 in their last 14 games (since 9/10) and 19-12 in their last 31 games (since 8/23).
 - Nine of the Yankees' last 13 wins have been comeback wins (since 9/2).
- RHP Clarke Schmidt** (4.0IP, 3H, 2ER, 3BB, 3K, 0HR, 1WP, 1HP) started and did not record a decision.
 - Has allowed 3R-or-fewer in 19 of his last 22 starts (since 5/19), 21 of his last 25 starts (since 5/3) and 22 of his last 27 starts (since 4/23).
 - Threw just 4.0IP after tossing at least 5.0 innings in 18 of his previous 21 starts (5/19-9/19) and 21 of his previous 26 starts (4/23-9/19).
- C Austin Wells** (2-for-4, 2R, 1HR, 2RBI) hit his second career HR on a game-tying two-run shot in the fourth inning...six of his 10 Major League hits have gone for extra bases (4 doubles, 2HR).
 - Recorded multiple hits for the second time in his last four games (since 9/20).
 - Is hitting .280/.308/.640 (7-for-25) with 4R, 3 doubles, 2HR, 4RBI and 1BB in his last seven games (since 9/16).
- 3B Oswald Peraza** (1-for-3, 1R, 1HR, 2RBI, 1BB) hit a game-tying solo HR in the seventh inning and drew a bases-loaded game-tying walk in the eighth inning.
 - According to Statcast, his HR had an estimated distance of 443 ft.
 - Is hitting .290 (20-for-69) with 6R, 6 doubles, 2HR, 8RBI and 3BB in his last 18 games (since 9/2).
- CF Estevan Florial** (0-for-2, 1RBI, 1BB, 1SF) hit a go-ahead sac fly in the eighth inning...has 6RBI in his last eight games (since 9/15).
 - Has reached base in 10 of his last 11 games (since 9/12-Game 2).
- 2B Gleyber Torres** (2-for-3, 2R, 1 double, 1BB) reached base three times... has reached base multiple times in seven of his last 12 games (since 9/12-G2).
 - Is batting .309/.399/.536 (56-for-181) with 30R, 14 doubles, 9HR, 22RBI, 25BB, 2HP and 5SB in 48 games since 8/1...has hit safely in 34 of those games and has reached base safely in 40 of those contests.
- LF Everson Pereira** (2-for-4, 1 double, 1RBI) doubled in the fifth inning and hit an RBI single in the eighth inning...marked his first game played since 9/14-Game 1 at Boston.
- 1B DJ LeMahieu** (2-for-5) has hit safely in nine of his last 10 games (since 9/12-G1), batting .325/.413/.400 (13-for-40) with 6R, 3 doubles, 5RBI, 6BB and 1SB in that span.
 - Since the All-Star break (since 7/14), is hitting .279/.383/.443 (56-for-201) in 55 games in that span...prior to the break, had batted .220/.285/.357 (61-for-277) in 76 games.
 - Has reached base multiple times in 21 of his last 39 games (since 8/4) and 27 of his last 49 games (since 7/21).
 - Has reached base in 19 of his last 21 games (since 8/30), 37 of his last 41 games (since 8/1), 54 of his last 60 games (since 7/4) and 61 of his last 69 games (since 6/23).
- RHP Greg Weissert** (2.0IP, 1H, 3K) tossed 2.0 scoreless innings of relief...matched the longest scoreless appearance of his career (also 2.0IP on 8/28/22 at Oakland and 8/30/22 at Los Angeles-AL).
- RHP Ian Hamilton** (1.2IP, 2H, 1ER, 1BB, 2K, 1HP) earned his third win of the season.
- RHP Clay Holmes** (1.0IP, 2K) tossed a perfect ninth inning to record his career-high 22nd save.

ARIZONA DIAMONDBACKS NOTES

- The Diamondbacks fell to the Yankees in the series finale of their three-game set...are 1-2 on their current six-game road trip.
 - Have still won six of their last eight games (since 9/15), seven of their last 12 games (since 9/11) and 11 of their last 17 games (since 9/6).
 - Fell to 19-21 in Interleague games this season.
 - Are 10-15 vs. the Yankees all-time and 3-5 at the current Yankee Stadium, going 0-4-1 all -time in series play in the Bronx.

- **RHP Merrill Kelly** (5.0IP, 4H, 2ER, 2BB, 5K, 1HR) made his 29th start of the season and took a no decision after allowing 2ER over 5.0IP.
 - Struck out Gleyber Torres in the first inning for his 178th of the season, setting a new career high.
 - Has tossed 5.0IP-or-more with 2ER-or-fewer allowed in five of his last seven starts (since 8/24).
 - In 15 road starts this season, is 7-3 with a 4.07 ERA (84.0IP, 38ER) and 81K.
 - In six Interleague starts this season, has gone 3-1 with a 3.03 ERA (35.2IP, 12ER) and 44K...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in each of those starts.
 - Has surrendered a home run in each of his last three starts after not doing so in his previous four starts.
- **LF/RF Corbin Carroll** (3-for-5, 1R, 1RBI, 1SB) recorded his team-leading 46th multi-hit game of the season, including a go-ahead RBI single in the eighth inning...marked his seventh hit this season that gave his team the lead in the eighth inning-or-later...his seven such hits are tied for the most in the Majors (also Cincinnati's Elly De La Cruz).
 - Has hit safely in eight of his last nine games (since 9/14), batting .400/.429/.525 (16-for-40) with 9R, 2 doubles, 1HR, 5RBI, 1BB, 1HP and 4SB in that span.
 - In his last 32 games (since 8/19), is batting .358/.413/.545 (44-for-123) with 27R, 5 doubles, 4HR, 15RBI, 8BB, 5HP, 2SF and 14SB...has recorded 17 multi-hit games in that span.
 - Is batting .313 (42-for-134) with 25R, 10 doubles, 2 triples, 7HR, 21RBI, 11BB, 2HP, 2SF and 10SB in 37 Interleague games this season.
- **CF Alek Thomas** (1-for-5, 1 double, 2RBI) drove in the first two runs of the game with a go-ahead two-run double in the first inning.
 - Has hit safely in six of his last seven starts (since 9/15).
 - Is hitting .444 (4-for-9) with 1R, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 1HR and 5RBI in the first inning this season.
 - Four of his last six hits have gone for extra bases (2 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run).
- **1B Christian Walker** (1-for-3, 1R, 1BB, 1SB) reached base twice.
 - Has reached base in eight of his last 17 plate appearances over his last four games, posting a .471 OBP in that span (6H/1BB/1HP).
 - Stole his 11th base of the season in the fifth inning...is just the second Diamondbacks first baseman (min. 50% of games at 1B) to hit 30-or-more home runs with 10-or-more stolen bases in a single season in franchise history (also Paul Goldschmidt: 2013, '15, '17).
- **C Gabriel Moreno** (1-for-4, 1R, 1RBI, 1BB) recorded a go-ahead RBI single in the seventh inning...marked his third career hit that gave his team the lead in the seventh inning-or-later (also a "walk-off" single in the 13th inning on 9/16 vs. Chicago-NL and an RBI single in the seventh on 4/15 at Maimi).
 - Has reached base safely in each of his last eight games (since 9/15), batting .448/.514/.517 (13-for-29) with 4R, 2 doubles, 5RBI, 3BB, 2HP, 1SF and 1SB in that span.
- **DH Tommy Pham** (0-for-5) appeared in his 1,000th career game today.
- **LHP Andrew Saalfrank** (1.0IP, 1BB) tossed a scoreless sixth inning in relief.
 - Has not allowed an earned run in his first 8.2 career innings pitched.
