THE TWINS: Began their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip by going 2-2 in their first four games, taking two of three in Houston, followed by a loss last night in the Bronx...tonight, Minnesota will continue the trip with the second of three at Yankee Stadium...after the series finale tomorrow night, the Twins will travel to Pittsburgh to play the Pirates for three games over the weekend.

☞ Since April 22, the Twins have gone 26-14, the third-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing Philadelphia (29-11) and New York-AL (28-12).

☞ The Twins are 12-7 in their last 19 road games.

BRONX BUMMER: The Twins lost to the Yankees last night by a score of 5-1 at Yankee Stadium, dropping their fifth straight to the Yankees (since 2023)...Bailey Ober (5-4) started and was dealt the loss, allowing three runs on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded just two hits, a Christian Vázquez third-inning double and a Royce Lewis seventh-inning solo home run...Lewis also walked twice and has now reached safely in all five of his plate appearances this season.

A THOUSAND SON: Royce Lewis has reached base in each of his first five plate appearances to start his season, going 2-for-2 (1B, HR) on March 28 at Kansas City and 1-for-1 (HR) with two walks last night...according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, he is the first player in Twins history (since 1961) to reach safely in his first five plate appearances to start a season...the previous high was four, done four times: Joe Mauer (2013 — 3 hits, 1 walk), Gary Gaetti (1982 — 4 hits), Larry Hisle (1973 — 4 hits) and Brant Aleya (1970 — 4 hits).

ROUND TRIP ROYCE: A home run tonight and Royce Lewis will become the first player in club history to homer in each of his first three games to start his season...below are the Twins to homer in their first two games:

NOTE: The last player in baseball to homer in the first three games to start their season was Lourdes Gurriel Jr. earlier this season from March 28-30 vs. Colorado...the last player to homer in their first four was Christian Yelich from March 28-31, 2019 vs. St. Louis.

ROYCE RULES THE ROAD: In 31 career road games, Royce Lewis is hitting .391 (45-for-115) with 11 home runs, 33 RBI, a .704 slugging percentage and a 1.162 OPS...he enters tonight with a 12-game hitting streak on the road...in fact, in his last 15 road games, dating back to August 23, 2023, he has posted a .500 on-base percentage (21 hits, 11 walks in 64 PA), has recorded 22 RBI and has homered in every road series he has appeared in (7 series).

BRONX BITS: The Twins and Yankees are playing the fifth of six games in 2024...Minnesota is 0-4 vs. the Yankees this season...they have lost five straight against the Yankees, seeking their first win over New York since a 6-2 victory on April 25, 2023 at Target Field...the only two runs the Twins have scored against the Yankees this season were a leadoff home run by Ryan Jeffers on May 14 and Royce Lewis' homer last night.

☞ Minnesota has gone 3-3 in their last six at Yankee Stadium after going 1-16 in their previous 17 from September 18, 2017-September 7, 2022 here.

☞ Jose Miranda has driven in 11 runs in 17 career games against the Yankees.

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .284 (52-for-183) with 10 doubles, 13 home runs, 34 RBI, a .563 slugging percentage and a .909 OPS in 48 career regular season games vs. New York...Correa's .563 slugging percentage against NY is the second-best among actives (minimum of 175 plate appearances), trailing only José Ramirez (.591)...his .909 OPS ranks fourth, trailing Ramirez (.992), Mike Trout (.979) and Francisco Lindor (.945)...in his last nine games at Yankee Stadium he has four home runs with a .928 OPS.

☞ Carlos Santana is hitting .356 (21-for-59) with four doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI, a .426 on-base percentage, a .627 slugging percentage and a 1.054 OPS in his last 15 games at Yankee Stadium.

LEFT IS RIGHT: Twins hitters are slashing .257/.306/.416 with a .721 OPS vs. left-handed pitching compared to .219/.301/.384 with a .685 OPS vs. right-handed pitching...the .257 average vs. lefties ranks fourth among AL teams and eighth in all of baseball.

☞ Willi Castro is hitting .365 (19-for-52) with a .919 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...in his last 20 games vs. lefties, he is 19-for-42 (.452) with a 1.108 OPS.

☞ Ryan Jeffers is 3-for-7 with a double and two home runs in his last three games vs. lefties...he was hitting just .212 (11-for-52) in 29 games vs. lefties prior to this current stretch.

☞ Manny Margot is hitting .364 (8-for-22) with an .826 OPS in his last 10 games vs. left-handed pitching...Margot typically gets the leadoff spot vs. left-handed starters, starting there in four of the club's last 13 games.

☞ In 39 career games vs. lefties, Royce Lewis is hitting .344 (21-for-61) with a .911 OPS.

KINGS OF THE RODÓN: Notable individuals vs. Carlos Rodón lifetime: Carlos Santana is 14-for-37 (.378) with two doubles, one home run and five walks...14 hits by Santana are the most off Rodón in his career...Byron Buxton is 4-for-12 (.333) with two doubles and two walks...Manny Margot is 2-for-5 (.400) with a double.

BIRTHDAY BOYS: Joe Ryan is celebrating his 28th birthday today and Royce Lewis is celebrating his 25th birthday...the last game Lewis played on his birthday was with High-A Fort Myers in 2019, going 0-for-5...he hit a grand slam on his birthday in 2018 with Low-A Beloit, because of course he treaking did.

COOL MONTH LUKE: High-A Cedar Rapids Kernels second baseman Luke Keaschall has been named Midwest League Player of the Month for May...Keaschall batted .375/.472/.625 and led the league in hits (33), on-base (.472) and OPS (1.097) and was second in average (.375), runs (22) and slugging percentage (.625)...he finished third in total bases (55) and was fourth in doubles (7)...he recorded 10 multi-hit games before a May 27 promotion to Double-A Wichita...Keaschall, 21, was selected in the second round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Arizona State University.

SERIES FINALE VS. KC: Last pitched May 30 vs. Kansas City, opposite Daniel Lynch IV, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 7-6 win...allowed four runs on five hits (2 HR) in 5.2 innings with two walks and four strikeouts...allowed first-inning two-run home run to Vinnie Pasquantino, third-inning RBI double to Bobby Witt Jr. and fourth-inning solo shot to MJ Melendez...was pulled with a runner on first and two outs in the sixth; Caleb Thielbar entered and stranded the runner.

- ⚡ Induced eight whiffs on 41 swings (19.5%)...ranks in MLB's 34th percentile with a 23.1 percent whiff rate this season.
- ⚡ Allowed nine hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph); Kansas City went 4-for-9 on those swings, including the Pasquantino (106.1 mph) and Melendez (109.0 mph) home runs...ranks in MLB's 25th percentile with a 42.2 percent hard-hit rate.
- ⚡ Minnesota has gone 8-3 in Paddack's starts this season (4-2 in May).

TWO STARTS AGO: Started May 25 vs. Texas, opposite Michael Lorenzen, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-3 win...allowed two runs on four hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings with no walks and three strikeouts...first run came in the fourth on Adolis Garcia's RBI double...Ezequiel Duran added a solo home run in the fifth...exited with a 2-1 deficit; Minnesota won 5-3 after Alex Kirilloff's eighth-inning, go-ahead three-run home run.

- ⚡ Induced two whiffs on 33 swings (6.1%).
- ⚡ Allowed seven hard-hit balls; Texas went 3-for-7 on those swings, including Duran's 106.6 mph home run and a 112.7 mph Corey Seager single.

REMATCH WITH RODÓN: Making third career start vs. New York-AL; has gone 0-2 with an 8.10 ERA (10.0 IP, 9 ER), three walks and 10 strikeouts in the two prior starts...faced Carlos Rodón and the Yankees on May 14 at Target Field, taking his most recent loss...allowed five runs on a career-high-tying 12 hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings, with two walks and four strikeouts in Minnesota's 5-1 defeat.

- ⚡ Only career start at Yankee Stadium came May 29, 2019; allowed four runs on six hits (3 HR) in 5.0-inning loss.
- ⚡ Has made seven career starts vs. American League East opponents, going 3-4 with a 6.82 ERA (34.1 IP, 26 ER), seven home runs allowed, nine walks and 26 strikeouts.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Making fifth road start of the season...has gone 1-1 with a 6.85 ERA (22.1 IP, 17 ER), 2.01 home-runs-per-9.0 innings and 4.84 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings on the road, compared to 3-1 at home with a 3.26 ERA (38.2 IP, 14 ER), 1.40 HR/9 and 9.78 K/9.

- ⚡ Most recent road start came May 19 at Cleveland; allowed two runs in a career-high 8.0 innings and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-2 loss.

PLATOON SPLITS: On May 30, Kansas City's left-handed hitters went 2-for-7 with two home runs off Paddack, while its righties went 3-for-15 with a double, two walks and four strikeouts...through 11 games vs. Paddack, lefties have hit .289 (37-for-128) with a .748 OPS and 15.9 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .285 (35-for-123) with an .800 OPS and 25.0 percent strikeout rate.

- ⚡ Has induced a 19.4 percent whiff rate vs. lefties, 27.1 percent vs. righties.
- ⚡ New York-AL ranks first in baseball with a .798 OPS vs. right-handed pitching this season.

THE ARSENAL: Has thrown a four-pitch mix in his 11 starts, per Baseball Savant...here's his pitch repertoire and results this season:

- ⚡ On May 3, his 4-seamer averaged season-low 91.5 mph...Royals hitters went 1-for-9 with a home run and two strikeouts vs. the pitch.
- ⚡ Threw 18 changeups vs. Royals, tied for second fewest in a start this season; Royals hitters went 1-for-7 with a strikeout and 75.1 mph average exit velocity vs. the pitch.
- ⚡ Against Paddack's 4-seamer, righties have hit .217 (13-for-60) with a 29.4 percent whiff rate, lefties have hit .370 (17-for-46) with a 22.6 percent whiff rate.
- ⚡ Opponents have hit .600 (6-for-10) with two home runs vs. Paddack's first-pitch fastballs and .375 (3-for-8) with two home runs vs. first-pitch sliders.

HOT STRETCH: In his last eight starts since April 22, has gone 4-1 with a 3.45 ERA (47.0 IP, 18 ER), seven walks and 45 strikeouts...opponents have slashed .255/.281/.404 vs. Paddack during that span...posted an 8.36 ERA (14.0 IP, 13 ER) with five walks, nine strikeouts and a .381/.429/.603 opponent slash line in his first three starts of the season.

DISPARITY BEHIND THE DISH: Has posted a 2.57 ERA (35.0 IP, 10 ER), .221 opponent batting average and 7.25 strikeout-to-walk-ratio in six games with Ryan Jeffers behind the plate, compared to 7.27 ERA (26.0 IP, 21 ER), .358 BAA and 3.13 K/BB in five games throwing to Christian Vázquez.

- ⚡ As a pitching staff, Minnesota has a 4.22 ERA (243.1 IP, 114 ER) and 4.17 K/BB with Jeffers, compared to a 4.02 ERA (286.2 IP, 128 ER) and 3.27 K/BB with Vázquez.

IN CONTROL: Ranks in baseball's 91st percentile this season with a 4.5 percent walk rate; compares to 2024 MLB average of 8.4 percent...has issued two-or-fewer walks in 40-straight appearances (37 starts); last three-walk outing came April 4, 2021 vs. Arizona...has issued 1.8 walks-per-9.0-innings in his career (2019-present), the ninth lowest in baseball during that span (min. 350.0 IP).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP PABLO LÓPEZ (5-5, 4.84 ERA // CAREER: 44-44, 3.95 ERA)

Right-hander Pablo López is scheduled to start tomorrow's series finale at New York-AL...last pitched May 31 at Houston, allowing one run on six hits (1 HR) in a season-high-tying 7.0 innings, with one walk and six strikeouts; earned the win in Minnesota's 6-1 victory...faced New York-AL on May 15 at Target Field, allowing three runs on 10 hits (1 HR) in 6.1-inning loss...in three career starts vs. New York-AL, has gone 0-2 with a 2.95 ERA (18.1 IP, 6 ER), two walks and 14 strikeouts.
