$\Phi$ Sits eight strikeouts shy of 400 in his career....owns a 20.3 percent strikeout rate and 8.0 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings this season, both career lows.


SERIES FINALE VS. KC: Last pitched May 30 vs. Kansas City, opposite Daniel Lynch IV, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 7-6 win...allowed four runs on five hits (2 HR) in 5.2 innings with two walks and four strikeouts...allowed first-inning two-run home run to Vinnie Pasquantino, third-inning RBI double to Bobby Witt Jr. and fourth-inning solo shot to MJ Melendez...was pulled with a runner on first and two outs in the sixth; Caleb Thielbar entered and stranded the runner.
$\Phi$ Induced eight whiffs on 41 swings (19.5\%)...ranks in MLB's 34th percentile with a 23.1 percent whiff rate this season.
Ф Allowed nine hard-hit balls ( $95.0+\mathrm{mph}$ ); Kansas City went $4-$ for -9 on those swings, including the Pasquantino ( 106.1 mph ) and Melendez ( 109.0 mph ) home runs...ranks in MLB's 25 th percentile with a 42.2 percent hard-hit rate.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started May 25 vs. Texas, opposite Michael Lorenzen, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's $5-3$ winn...allowed two runs on four hits ( 1 HR ) in 5.0 innings with no walks and three strikeouts...first run came in the fourth on Adolis García's RBI double...Ezequiel Duran added a solo home run in the fifth...exited with a 2-1 deficit; Minnesota won 5-3 after Alex Kirilloff's eighth-inning, go-ahead three-run home run.
$\Phi$ Allowed seven hard-hit balls; Texas went 3-for-7 on those swings, including Duran's 106.6 mph home run and a 112.7 mph Corey Seager single.

REMATCH WITH RODÓN: Making third career start vs. New York-AL; has gone 0-2 with an 8.10 ERA ( 10.0 IP, 9 ER), three walks and 10 strikeouts in the two prior starts...faced Carlos Rodón and the Yankees on May 14 at Target Field, taking his most recent loss...allowed five runs on a career-hightying 12 hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings, with two walks and four strikeouts in Minnesota's 5-1 defeat.

PLATOON SPLITS: On May 30, Kansas City's left-handed hitters went 2-for-7 with two home runs off Paddack, while its righties went 3 -for-15 with a double, two walks and four strikeouts...through 11 games vs. Paddack, lefties have hit . 289 (37-for-128) with a . 748 OPS and 15.9 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .285 ( 35 -for-123) with an .800 OPS and 25.0 percent strikeout rate.
$\Phi$ Has induced a 19.4 percent whiff rate vs. lefties 2711
