Atlanta's 73 double plays this season are tied for fifth in MLB behind Kansas City (82), St. Louis (81), Washington (76) and San Francisco (76).

TODAY'S GAME: Atlanta and San Diego today continue their four-game midweek series to round out their season slate against one another...The Padres secured the season set with last night's win after sweeping the Braves in three games at Petco Park from June 22-24.

 Atlanta lost yesterday, 8-3, after mustering just four hits...The club was out-hit by nine, tied for its third-worst disparity of the season.

 Since the beginning of the 2025 season, the Braves are just 2-10 (.167) against the Padres...Both of their wins in that span have occurred here at Truist Park.

 Atlanta entered this series with just a single win over San Diego since the start of 2025...The Padres have beaten the Braves more than any other team since the beginning of last year (10-2).

 RH Michael King is slated to make his third career start and fourth career appearance against Atlanta today...All-time, he's 1-0 with a 2.02 ERA (3 ER/13.1 IP) against the Braves...Earlier this season on June 22, the 6-foot-3, 210-pounder spun 7.0 shutout innings against the club at Petco Park, allowing six hits and striking out five...The Rochester, NY, native has gone 2-1 with a 2.54 ERA (8 ER/28.1 IP) overall since his last start against Atlanta.

MARTÍN PÉREZ: Today is slated to make his 15th start and 19th appearance of the season, but his first since July 5 versus New York-NL...The southpaw missed 12 games while on the injured list due to a left forearm contusion.

 After earning a win in four straight starts from May 30-June 19, Pérez has been charged with a loss in each of his last three turns dating to June 24 against these San Diego Padres.

 On June 24, Pérez worked 4.0 innings against San Diego at Petco Park and allowed three earned runs...He struck out four, walked four and allowed a home run to Ty France...In four career games (three starts) against San Diego, the native of Guanare, VZ, is 0-2 with a 4.50 ERA (9 ER/18.0 IP).

 Pérez is just three victories shy of the 100-win milestone (97-99).

AUSTIN RILEY: Registered the hardest-hit ball in yesterday's game, 111.4 mph, but it was converted for an out...Riley has hit two balls with exit velocities over 100 mph in each of his last three games...He has eight total batted balls with 100+ mph exit velocities since returning from the All-Star break.

 Riley's eight 100+ mph batted balls since the break are tied for fourth in MLB behind Ty France (SD, 12), Fernando Tatis Jr. (9) and Junior Caminero (SD, 9)...His four hard-hit outs are the second most in baseball in that time.

 He owns a BABIP of just .143 on balls hit 95+ mph after the All-Star break...The MLB average BABIP on balls hit 95 mph-or-harder is .423 this season.

JIM JARVIS: Last night went 2-for-3 with a two-run triple and a run scored...He also drew a walk, reaching base three times to tie his career high...Jarvis is slashing .292/.333/.458 (14-for-48) as a major-leaguer this season.

 Fifteen games into his career, Jarvis has amassed nine singles, three doubles, one triple and one home run...The last Brave to collect one hit of each type in his first 15 career games was William Contreras, who did so spanning 2020-21...The last Braves shortstop to do so was Andrelton Simmons (2012).

 Defensively, Jarvis has tallied four defensive runs saved (*Sports Info Solutions*)...That total ranks eighth among MLB shortstops despite playing just 112.0 innings in the field...Every shortstop ahead of him has played at least 480 innings.

DRAKE BALDWIN: Last night went 0-for-2, but tied his career high with three walks...He also drew a trio of free passes on August 27, 2025 at Miami...The backstop has posted a .455 on-base percentage in July, the highest single-month average of his career.

 Baldwin's OBP is the fifth-highest mark in the National League and the ninth-highest in MLB this month...He has been on-base 35 times in July, ranking second in the majors behind Washington's James Wood (36).

 Since July 5, Baldwin has reached base safely in more than half of his plate appearances (30-of-59 PA)...Only two other players in baseball have joined him in that span: Nolan Schanuel (LAA, .581 OBP) and Steven Kwan (CLE, .512 OBP).

 Baldwin is the only Brave this season to post an OBP over .500 throughout a 13-game span (min. 50 PA), and the first since Ronald Acuña Jr. did so in September of last season.

DEFENSE: According to *Sports Info Solutions'* defensive runs saved metrics, Atlanta's defense (36 DRS) is third-best in the National League and fifth-best in Major League Baseball behind Chicago-NL (63 DRS), Tampa Bay (56 DRS), Los Angeles-NL (53 DRS) and Boston (44 DRS).

 Individually, utility player Mauricio Dubón has saved nine total runs in his efforts throughout the diamond, tied for 15th most in MLB...Dubón has made 56 appearances in left field, 37 at shortstop, 14 in center field, four at third base and one as the designated hitter.

 Michael Harris II (7 DRS) ranks fourth among all MLB center fielders in DRS, only trailing Andy Pages (LAD, 17), Cedanne Rafaela (BOS, 16) and Pete Crow-Armstrong (CHC, 12).

 Eli White has been worth seven DRS despite playing just 302 innings in the field...Regardless of position, that's the second-highest DRS total of any player with 302-or-fewer defensive innings.

 The club has converted 63.7% of the balls hit to the outfield into outs, tied for the best percentage in MLB.

Today's Game

- Makes his 15th start of the season and the 294th of his career in the third game of a four-game series against San Diego at Truist Park.
- Was reinstated from the 15-day injured list today and makes his first start since July 5, having been sidelined by a left forearm contusion.
- Will make his fourth career start against San Diego, owning an 0-2 record and a 4.50 ERA (9 ER/18.0 IP) in four previous appearances (three starts).
- The 6-foot, 210-pound left-hander enters with a 6-6 record and a 3.54 ERA (32 ER/81.1 IP) over 18 total appearances - 14 starts and four relief outings - with 62 strikeouts against 32 walks.
- His 3.54 ERA ranks ninth among National League left-handed pitchers who have made at least as many starts as Pérez this season...Teammate Chris Sale leads that group with a 2.06 ERA.
- Owns the third-highest ground-ball rate (47.7 percent) in that group...Opponents are batting .221 against him, tied with Sale for the third-lowest average among the 13.
- Has limited opponents to two earned runs-or-fewer in eight of his 14 starts this season.
- Right-handed batters are hitting .212 (43-for-203) with six homers off Pérez this season, while left-handers are batting .242 (22-for-91) with four homers.

2026

- Was placed on the 15-day injured list July 6 with a left forearm contusion and reinstated July 22 to make tonight's start.
- In his last start before the injury, July 5 against New York (NL), took the loss in a 10-9 defeat at Truist Park, allowing five runs - four earned - on six hits over 4.1 innings with two walks and one strikeout on 77 pitches...Surrendered six hits and five runs through the first two innings, his highest totals in both regards since July 3, 2023 with Texas, then did not allow a hit over his next 2.1 innings...It was his third consecutive loss.
- Allowed five hits or fewer in 20 consecutive starts from March 31, 2025 to June 13, 2026, the second-longest such streak by a left-handed starting pitcher since 1901, trailing only Tony Cingrani's 22-game run from 2013-14...The streak ended June 19, when he surrendered six hits to Milwaukee.
- Over his first 15 appearances of the season, from March 31 to June 19, Pérez posted a 2.78 ERA (21 ER/68.0 IP), the second-lowest ERA he has recorded over a season-opening 15-game span, trailing only the 2.22 ERA he posted to begin 2022 with Texas.
- Logged his first career 10-strikeout game in his 285th start on May 19 at Miami, the second-most starts before a first career 10-or-more strikeout game among pitchers to debut since 1893, trailing only Doyle Alexander (321st start, July 23, 1985).
- At 35 years, 45 days, Pérez is the 17th-oldest pitcher to record a first career 10-strikeout game dating to 1893, and the first to do so at age 35-or-older since Colin Rea (35 years, 79 days) on September 18, 2025 (per Elias).
- Earned his first win as a Brave on April 17 at Philadelphia, holding the Phillies to four hits over 6.0 scoreless innings with two walks and four strikeouts on 94 pitches in the 9-0 victory at Citizens Bank Park.
- Allowed four earned runs on five hits over 5.0 innings in his first career start as a member of the Braves on April 5 at Arizona, walking one with one strikeout on 75 pitches...Did not factor in the decision in Atlanta's 6-5 loss in 10 innings.
- Made his first appearance with the Braves on March 31 vs. the Athletics, tossing 4.1 scoreless innings of relief...Allowed just two hits with no walks and three strikeouts on 47 pitches (31 strikes) in the 5-2 loss.
- Had his contract selected by Atlanta from Triple-A Gwinnett on April 17...Originally had his contract selected on March 30 before being designated for assignment on April 12, outrighted to Gwinnett on April 14, and re-signed to a minor league deal on April 15.

- Awards:** AL All-Star (2022) and World Series Champion (2023, Texas).
- In his 15th major league season, Pérez has pitched for seven clubs: Texas (2012-18), Minnesota (2019), Boston (2020-21), Texas (2022-23), Pittsburgh (2024), San Diego (2024), Chicago (AL) (2025) and Atlanta (2026).
- Enters play ranking fourth in starts (293) among active left-handed pitchers, trailing Patrick Corbin (369), Jose Quintana (366) and teammate Chris Sale (330).
- Ranks fifth in starts among Venezuela-born pitchers (293), seven ahead of Carlos Carrasco (286).
- Originally signed by Texas as an international free agent on July 2, 2007...Represented Venezuela in the World Baseball Classic in 2017 and 2023.
