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THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 1-5 (0-3 at San Diego and 1-2 at the Athletics), the Twins began their six-game homestand with consecutive losses to the White Sox on Friday and Saturday...this afternoon, Minnesota will complete the homestand with the three-game series finale against Chicago...starting tomorrow night, the Twins will host the Tigers for three games from Monday-Wednesday.

SATURDAYS ARE FOR THE SOX: The Twins lost to the White Sox yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 3-2...Bailey Ober was the starter, allowing two runs (1 earned) on two hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and five strikeouts...Andrew Morris was dealt the loss, allowing one run in the sixth inning to break a 2-2 tie...the offense recorded five hits, compared to Chicago's three...Luke Keaschall and Walker Jenkins each doubled...for Keaschall it was his 22nd of the season and for Jenkins it was the first extra-base hit of his career.

CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE: The Twins have 26 games remaining, 13 against AL Central opponents — four vs. the White Sox, six vs. the Tigers and three vs. the Guardians...they also play the Angels (.382 win%), Giants (.409 win%) and Rangers (.485 win%)...the remaining opponents have a combined winning percentage of .475, the fifth-lowest strength of schedule in baseball.

CHICAGO STYLE: The Twins and White Sox are playing the 10th of 13 games this season...Twins are 3-5 vs. the Sox in 2026, going 2-3 at Target Field and 1-3 at Rate Field.

- Twins need to win each of the final four games against Chicago this season to win the season-series for 2026.
- These two will play one final series to start Minnesota's next roadtrip, September 4-6 at Rate Field for three games.
- Minnesota has gone 27-16 in its last 43 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023...that includes a home record of 14-8.
- Luke Keaschall is hitting .361 (22-for-61) with five doubles, eight walks, five stolen bases, a .444 on-base percentage and an .887 OPS in 17 career games against the Sox...he has reached base safely in all 17 games.
- In his last 14 games vs. the White Sox, Trevor Larnach is hitting .313 (15-for-48) with five doubles, three RBI, five walks, six runs scored and a .794 OPS.
- In 15 career games vs. Chicago-AL, Royce Lewis is hitting .351 (20-for-57) with seven home runs, 21 RBI, a .737 slugging percentage and a 1.185 OPS.

UP JENKINS: Through two major league games, Walker Jenkins has gone 2-for-6 with one double, one walk, one RBI and one stolen base...he is one of just six players in Twins history (since 1961) to record a hit in each of his first two career games, joining Joe Mauer (2004), Luis Rivas (2000), Lenny Faedo (1980), Butch Wynegar (1976), and Rick Dempsey (1969)...also just one of seven players in Twins history to record his first hit, RBI and stolen base within his first two career games, joining Luke Keaschall (2025), Jake Cave (2018), Matt Macri (2008), Cleatus Davidson (1999), Jerry Terrrell (1973) and César Iovar (1965) as the only Twins to do so.

Jenkins (21-years-old, born on February 19, 2005) is currently the third-youngest active player on a major league roster, trailing Atlanta's Didier Fuentes (June 17, 2025) and New York-AL's George Lombard Jr. (June 2, 2005).

E-LUKE-TRIC CITY: Luke Keaschall is hitting .326 (31-for-95) with a .941 OPS in his last 25 games...since being inserted into the leadoff spot on August 17, he has led off in all 11 Twins games and has hit .313 (15-for-48) with an .811 OPS, reaching base safely in 10 of the 11...below are Keaschall's offensive comparisons through June and since July 1:

JOSHIN' AROUND: Yesterday afternoon, Josh Bell recorded his team-leading 81st RBI of the season, the fourth-most of his career (116 in 2019, 90 in 2017 and 88 in 2021).

81 RBI rank sixth-best in the AL and tied for 13th-most in baseball.

Bell is on pace for 96 RBI, which would be the most for a Twin since Jorge Polanco drove in 98 in 2021.

BREAKING BROOMS: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the seventh time in 2026, the others being April 17-19 vs. Cincinnati (3 games), April 24-26 at Tampa Bay (3 games), May 29-31 at Pittsburgh (3 games), June 22-24 vs. Los Angeles-NL (3 games), August 13-16 vs. Philadelphia (3 games) and August 21-23 at San Diego (3 games).

- Last time the Twins were swept by the White Sox was in four games at Target Field from September 1-4, 2025.
- Twins have entered a finale nine times this season attempting to avoid the sweep and have gone 3-6 in such instances...their three times avoiding the sweep were April 2 at Kansas City, May 17 vs. Milwaukee and August 6 at Kansas City.

TWINS MILB WEEKLYS: The Twins have named High-A Cedar Rapids catcher Vahn Lackey and Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher Adrian Bohorquez as their minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

- Lackey, 21, played in five games between Low-A Fort Myers and Cedar Rapids, going 5-for-15 (.333) with two home runs, five RBI, 11 walks, a .615 on-base percentage and a 1.348 OPS...the Atlanta, GA native was the third overall selection in the June draft.
- Bohorquez, 21, made the start on Wednesday vs. Arkansas, allowing zero earned runs on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts...the La Victoria, VZ native was signed by the Twins as an international free agent in January of 2023.

YOU DOWN WITH DSP, YEAH YOU KNOW ME: In a special pregame ceremony today, Twins longtime executive Dave St. Peter will be recognized as the 2025 Terry Ryan Award winner...a driving force in growing baseball and softball throughout the Upper Midwest, key accomplishments in St. Peter's tenure include:

- The Fields for Kids grant program, which has built and renovated more than 900 baseball and softball fields across Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota, Iowa and western Wisconsin — providing access to safe, quality playing surfaces.
- Expanding the Twins' free Youth Baseball and Softball Clinics to more than 60 annually throughout the region, teaching fundamentals while fostering mentorship between aspiring athletes and the community.
- Supporting leagues in need with Equipment and Uniform Assistance, ensuring that financial challenges don't keep kids off the field.

TWINS IN A BIG GREASY BUCKET: The Twins are currently at the 2026 Minnesota State Fair, with interactive games and special appearances all part of the team's daily lineup...The Minnesota Twins Experience is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar, and is open from 9:00 am to 9:00 pm daily, rain or shine, throughout the State Fair's duration (now through Monday, September 7)...National Baseball Hall of Famer Tony Oliva will be at the Experience tomorrow from 10:30 to 11:15 am.

ON THIS DAY: In 1987, Kirby Puckett set a club record with six hits at Milwaukee, recording two home runs, two doubles and two singles...Puckett tied his own record May 23, 1991 in 11 innings vs. Texas...in 2007, the Twins held a ceremony to break ground on Target Field...Target Field's first official game was on April 12, 2010 vs. Boston (5-4 win).
