NATIONALS HISTORY
APRIL 28 (6-7)
 2012 - Bryce Harper made a memorable MLB debut at Dodger Stadium. In an intense contest, Harper went 1-for-3 with a seventh-inning double off Chad Billingsley and one RBI, which came via a go-ahead sac fly in the ninth inning. However, the Dodgers tied the game with two runs in the bottom of the ninth and win it in the 10th on Matt Kemp's solo blast, his team-record 11th April homer.

NATIONALS NEWS

WINNING WAYS
The Washington Nationals continue their six-game, seven-day road trip with the first of three games against the New York Mets tonight at Citi Field.

- The Nationals took game three by a score of 2-1 in extra innings, securing their third series win of the season on Sunday...**Foster Griffin** threw a career-high 7.0 scoreless innings and struck out a career-high eight batters...**Paxton Schultz** earned his first career save...**José Tena's** 10th inning pinch-hit homer extended the lead, 2-0, for the Nationals.
- Prior to yesterday's off day, the Nationals went 9-8 in a 17-game stretch from April 10-26 without a day off.
- Washington is 10-6 (.625) on the road in 2026, tied for second most road wins in Major League Baseball...The .625 road winning percentage ranks fifth in Major League Baseball.

START ME UP

Washington's starters have posted a 0.93 ERA (2 ER/19.1 IP) with 28 strikeouts and just two walks across the last four games.

- Including a career-high 10 strikeouts on Thursday vs. Atlanta, **Cade Cavalli** has struck out 15 batters without issuing a walk over his last two starts.
- Jake Irvin** has 13 strikeouts against zero walks in his last two starts.
- Foster Griffin** set career-highs in both innings pitched (7.0) and strikeouts (8) in his last scoreless start against the White Sox on April 26...He's pitched to a 2.67 ERA with 30 strikeouts in six starts this season.

PRETTY OFFENSIVE

The Nationals rank tied for third in Major League Baseball with 156 runs, the second most by a Nationals club in team history (2005-pres.) through its first 29 games behind the 2017 National League East champion Nationals (183).

- Washington has scored 30 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals have scored 58 runs in the seventh inning or later, tied for most in MLB with San Diego.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 19 times this season, the most in Major League Baseball.

HITTERISH

Some notes on a few Nationals hitters as of late:

- Luis García Jr.** is 8-for-19 (.421) with two doubles, four RBI, one stolen base and four runs scored over his last six games...He's hit safely in four of the six.
- Brady House** has hit safely in seven of his last eight games, going 7-for-27 with a homer, three RBI, three walks, one stolen base and five runs scored.
- Jorbit Vivas** has hit safely in 14 of his 17 starts this season and has reached base safely in 10 consecutive starts.

GOOD WOOD

James Wood has placed himself among the league leaders...See chart to the right.

- Wood leads Major League Baseball in on-base percentage (.485), OPS (T1st, 1.192), home runs (9) and walks (T1st, 23) since April 5...This comes after starting the season 4-for-26 (.111) in eight games from March 26 to April 4.
- He is one of three players Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Yordan Alvarez** (3) and **O'Neil Cruz** (3).
- Wood's 39 batted balls over 100 MPH are tied for most in Major League Baseball with **Fernando Tatis Jr.**

DON'T WALK SIGN

Washington's pitching staff ranks fourth in Major League Baseball in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.03) and fifth in walks per 9.0 innings (2.73) since April 15...The staff has fanned 103 batters against 34 walks in 112.0 innings.

- Irvin ranks ninth in the National League with 10.31 strikeouts per 9.0 innings and Cavalli ranks 10th (10.22).

FRAME JOB

Bobby Wilson's catchers rank tied for third in Major League Baseball with three Catcher Framing Runs (**Drew Millas** - 2, **Keibert Ruiz** - 1) along with the New York Yankees, according to Baseball Savant...*"Catcher Framing Runs converts strikes to runs saved on a .125 run/strike basis, and includes park and pitcher adjustments. To qualify, a catcher must receive 6 called pitches per team game."*

- For comparison, Washington's catchers ranked 30th in MLB with -18 Catcher Framing Runs in 2025.

DAYLEN'S DAYS

Daylen Lile has hit safely in 12 of his last 16 games and has reached safely in 14 of the 16...Lile is hitting .286 (18-for-63) and is slugging .492 (4 2B, 3 HR) during this 16-game stretch...He has struck out just three times in 30 plate appearances over his last seven games.

- Lile is tied for third in the NL with 10 multi-hit games and is ninth in the NL with 32 hits.

FARM REPORT

PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Rochester right-handed pitcher **Andry Lara** was named International League Pitcher of the Week on Monday after having a strong start that matched career-highs with 7.0 innings and nine strikeouts on Friday at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre...He did not allow a run or walk and surrendered just two hits...He's pitched to a 2.12 ERA (4 ER/17.0 IP), 20 strikeouts, two walks and a .194 opponents' average (12-for-62) in his last three starts.

CAREER

Veteran starter is one of 21 pitchers in Major League Baseball to make 60 starts and maintain an ERA under 4.00 since the beginning of 2024.

- Littell (lih-TELL) began his career as a reliever before moving to the rotation in 2023 after being claimed by Tampa Bay...Is 21-26 with a 3.94 ERA in 79 starts since June 29, 2023.
- In 2024, was named the recipient of the Paul C. Smith Champion Award by the Tampa Bay chapter of the BBWAA, presented to the player who best exemplifies the spirit of true professionalism on and off the field.
- His 4.2% walk rate since the start of 2023 is the third-best mark in MLB.

LAST START

Littell allowed eight runs, six earned on seven hits (4 HR) with a strikeout and two walks in 6.0 innings of work on April 22 against the Atlanta Braves.

vs. NEW YORK

Littell is set to make his second career start against the Mets...He has made seven appearances against New York since 2019.

- He has gone 0-1, holding a 1.38 ERA on 10 hits and two earned runs through 13.00 innings.

2025

He led Major League Baseball with .042 walks per batter faced and was second with 1.54 walks per 9.0 innings...His 32 starts were tied for ninth in Major League Baseball...Did not issue a walk in 13 starts, tied with Tarik Skubal for the most-such outings in MLB...Was acquired by the Reds at the Trade Deadline.

- Set career highs in wins (10), starts (32) and innings pitched (186.2), while pitching to a 3.81 ERA for Tampa Bay and Cincinnati in 2025.
- He tossed his first career complete game on May 31 at Houston (9.0 IP, 10 H, 3 ER, BB, 6 SO).
- Made his Reds Postseason debut as the club's starting pitcher in Game 2 of the National League Wild Card Series at Los Angeles (NL)...Was his first career Postseason start after five Postseason relief appearances with Minnesota (2019), San Francisco (2021) and Tampa Bay (2023).
- Made his Reds debut on Aug. 5 at Chicago (NL)...Became the fifth pitcher in Reds history with at least 7.0 innings, one run or fewer allowed and at least eight strikeouts in his team debut (also: Brady Singer, 3/31/25 vs TEX; Johnny Cueto, 4/3/08 vs AZ; Mo Sanford, 8/9/91 at SD; Tom Seaver, 6/18/77 at MON).
- 2025 Pitch Mix:** Slider (27.5%) Split Finger (27.3%) Four Seamer (23.8%) Sinker (16.0%) Sweeper (5.4%)

2024

In his first full season as a starter, went 8-10 with a 3.63 ERA in his seventh Major League season.

- Led the Rays in wins (11st, 8), innings (156.1), starts (29) and quality starts (11st, 10)...All were career highs.
- From April 17-May 4, recorded at least six strikeouts without issuing a walk in a club-record four straight starts...On May 11 vs. New York (AL), he walked Anthony Rizzo in the second inning to end a streak of 123 BF without walk, the fourth longest in franchise history.
- Went 5-3 with a 1.82 ERA (10 ER/49.1 ER) over his final nine starts from July 27 on and ranked second in the AL (4th in MLB) in ERA.
- Received two or fewer runs of support in 22 of 29 starts, including 17 of his final 20...His 3.22 run support average was the lowest in MLB and lowest in Rays history (prev. Tony Saunders, 3.51 in 1998).
- 2024 Pitch Mix:** Slider (34.8%) Split Finger (23.2%) Four Seamer (22.3%) Sinker (14.6%) Sweeper (5.1%)

2023

Appeared in 28 games (4 starts) between the Red Sox and the Rays...Converted to the starting rotation with the Rays on July 19.

- Ranked among MLB leaders after the All-Star break in walks per 9.0 IP (2nd, 0.89), walk rate (2nd, 2.4%) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (5th, 7.86).
- In 14 starts, went 3-5 with a 3.41 ERA (27 ER/71.1 IP) and 1.05 WHIP.
- Pitched in Game 2 of the AL Wild Card vs. Texas...Tossed 2.0 hitless innings and struck out three while hitting one batter
