**BIRDLAND BITES:** Tonight, Baltimore continues a stretch of 13 games in 13 days, including a road trip through Boston (2-1) and Toronto (3 G) before returning home with sets against Seattle (4 G) and San Diego (3 G)...The Birds have won four of five and nine of their last 13 games since May 22...They enter play today 0.5 games out of a Wild Card spot and 8.0 games back of the Rays in the AL East.

⚾ The O's scored six runs in the first inning of yesterday's 8-2 victory over the Red Sox...It marked the Orioles most runs in an opening frame since plating seven on July 30, 2023 vs. New York-AL...Baltimore had not accomplished the feat on the road since scoring seven on August 12, 2017 at Oakland.

⚾ **Taylor Ward** became the first Oriole with two hits in the first inning since **Adley Rutschman** on July 30, 2023 vs. New York-AL and the first with multiple hits in the opening frame on the road since Jerry Hairston Jr. on September 24, 2003 at Boston.

⚾ Ward has three hits in back-to-back games for the third time in career (last: 5/21-22/25)...He joins Gunnar Henderson (5/20-22) as the only O's to accomplish the feat this season...The last Oriole to have 3+ hits in three straight games was Welington Castillo (4 G) from April 30-May 19, 2017.

**YOUNG MONEY:** Baltimore is 7-1 (.875) in games started by **Brandon Young** this season, the second-highest winning percentage in the majors (min. 5 GS) behind HOU's Spencer Arrighetti (8-1, .889).

⚾ In four starts since May 11, Young has posted a 2.42 ERA (6 ER/22.1 IP), with the O's going 4-0 in those games.

⚾ He has limited the opposition to a .125 (8-for-64) clip on his four-seam fastball this season...The .125 average off the offering is second-lowest in MLB (min. 60 AB ending in pitch) behind PHI's Zack Wheeler (.100, 6-for-60).

**HIT PARADE:** The Birds have tallied 7+ hits in 10 straight games since May 25, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Angels (7 G)...Baltimore is the only MLB team to have multiple streaks of 10+ straight games with seven or more hits this season, having also done so in 10 straight from April 5-15...The O's look for their first 11-game streak with 7+ hits since a 14-game run from August 28-September 12, 2023.

**ON-BASE ADLEY:** **Adley Rutschman** has reached base safely in a season-high 15 straight games since May 18, his longest streak since a career-best 16-game run from June 12-29, 2024.

⚾ Despite recording a .232 (13-for-56) batting average during this period, he owns a .371 on-base percentage and .746 OPS, recording three doubles, one triple, one home run, seven runs, seven RBI, and 13 walks against seven strikeouts...Prior to his current 15-game streak, Rutschman had two walks and 12 strikeouts over his previous 15 games from April 30-May 16.

⚾ In 54 career games against Toronto, he is slashing .305/.384/.559 (65-for-213) with 15 doubles, 13 home runs, 39 runs, 42 RBI, and 28 walks against 33 strikeouts...His .942 career OPS opposite the Blue Jays is the second-highest mark by an Oriole in team history (min. 150 PA) behind Harold Baines (1.071).

⚾ Rutschman has reached base safely in 14 straight games at Rogers Centre since August 1, 2023, slashing .339/.403/.589 (19-for-56) with two doubles, four home runs, 13 runs, 11 RBI, and five walks against six strikeouts.

**WISE BEYOND HIS YEARS:** **Samuel Basallo** is slashing .345/.397/.602 (39-for-113) with nine doubles, one triple, six homers, 19 runs scored, 22 RBI, and 11 walks in 35 games since April 20.

⚾ Among players with at least 120 plate appearances during that time, he ranks among MLB leaders in batting average (3<sup>rd</sup>), OPS (3<sup>rd</sup>, .999), and slugging percentage (4<sup>th</sup>).

⚾ Basallo ranks among all qualified MLB rookies in slugging percentage (2<sup>nd</sup>, .500), OPS (2<sup>nd</sup>, .842), home runs (T-4<sup>th</sup>, 9), extra-base hits (T-4<sup>th</sup>, 19), triples (T-5<sup>th</sup>, 1), batting average (6<sup>th</sup>, .276), RBI (8<sup>th</sup>, 26), total bases (8<sup>th</sup>, 85), on-base percentage (9<sup>th</sup>, .342), walks (9<sup>th</sup>, 18), and hits (10<sup>th</sup>, 47).

**POLAR BEAR ROARING:** **Pete Alonso** has hit safely in each of his last eight games since May 27, and is slashing .324/.375/.521 (23-for-71) with two doubles, four home runs, and 15 RBI over his last 18 games since May 16...He is one game shy of matching his season-long nine-game hitting streak from April 30-May 8.

⚾ Seven of Alonso's 12 home runs this season have gone to the opposite field, the second-most such long balls in the majors behind WSH's James Wood (9).

**CAN'T WARD HIM OFF:** **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (3<sup>rd</sup>, 55), times on base (T-4<sup>th</sup>, 115), and on-base percentage (6<sup>th</sup>, .404)

⚾ His four games with at least three walks are tied for the MLB lead with ATH's Nick Kurtz and LAA's Mike Trout...He is the first Oriole to have four such games in a season since Mark Reynolds (also 4 G) in 2012...The last to have five was Nick Markakis (6, 2008).

⚾ Ward has seen 1,229 total pitches this season, second most in the majors behind WSH's James Wood (1,241)...He has seen 426 of those pitches in a 3-2 count, second in MLB behind LAA's Mike Trout (466).

**TRENDING UP:** In 14 games since May 13, **Coby Mayo** is batting .292 (14-for-48) with three doubles, three home runs, nine runs, and eight RBI...During that period, he is 8-for-15 (.533) with two doubles, two home runs, and three RBI off left-handed pitching.

⚾ **Colton Cowser** is batting .333 (13-for-39) with one double, four home runs, 10 runs, 12 RBI, and five walks across 17 games since May 17...During this stretch, he is hitting .348 (8-for-23) with one double, two home runs, and a 29.2 percent strikeout rate on breaking and off-speed pitches...Prior to that period, he was 4-for-48 (.083) with zero extra-base hits and a 47.1 percent strikeout rate on such offerings.

**'PEN PALS:** **Rico Garcia** ranks among all qualified MLB relievers in opponent average (1<sup>st</sup>, .083), opponent on-base percentage (1<sup>st</sup>, .172), opponent OPS (1<sup>st</sup>, .327), hits per nine innings (1<sup>st</sup>, 2.39), base runners per nine innings (1<sup>st</sup>, 5.47), WHIP (1<sup>st</sup>, 0.61), and ERA (3<sup>rd</sup>, 0.68).

⚾ Garcia's 40.2 percent whiff rate is fourth highest among all MLB pitchers (min. 25.0 IP) behind SD's Mason Miller (52.2%), TOR's Jeff Hoffman (42.3%), and NYY's Fernando Cruz (41.6%).

⚾ Orioles relievers own a 21.0 percent inherited runner scored rate (17 IRS/81 IR), second lowest in the majors behind the Mariners (16.1%, 10 IRS/62 IR).

**QUICK HITS:** Young is set to make his ninth start of the season and the 21<sup>st</sup> of his career tonight in the series opener at Toronto...Was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk for the second time this year on April 23 and made his second start of the season on April 24 vs. Boston...Was optioned to minor league camp on March 7 after making two Grapefruit League appearances...Signed with the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent on June 14, 2020.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision on May 30 vs. Toronto after allowing two runs in a season-high-tying 6.2 innings (also 5/24 [G1] vs. DET), scattering seven hits, one walk, and one hit batter with a career-high seven strikeouts...Has allowed two runs or fewer in a career-best four consecutive starts since May 11, posting a 2.42 ERA (6 ER/22.1 IP) during that period...Threw 86 pitches, 59 strikes.

👉 Generated a career-high-tying 12 whiffs (3x, last: 7/29 [G2]/25 vs. TOR), including five on his four-seam fastball and three on his slider.

👉 Has tossed at least 6.2 innings in consecutive starts for the first time in his career.

**THE NORTH:** Young has made two career starts opposite the Blue Jays, going 0-0 with a 2.84 ERA (4 ER/12.2 IP)...Tonight will mark his first career start at Rogers Centre...Has earned quality starts in each of his two outings vs. Toronto, during which the O's are 2-0.

👉 Is 1-0 with a 3.42 ERA (9 ER/23.2 IP) over four career starts against the AL East, all of which have come at Camden Yards...Has allowed three runs or fewer in each of those outings.

**VELO UPTICK:** Young's average fastball has climbed to 93.9 mph in 2026, up 1.4 miles per hour from 2025 (92.5 mph)...The 1.4 mph increase is tied for the fourth-highest year-over-year increase by any pitcher in MLB this season, trailing SD's Adrian Morejon (+1.9 mph), LAA's Ryan Zeferjahn (+1.8 mph), and ATH's Hogan Harris (+1.7 mph).

👉 His .125 (8-for-64) opponent average on his four-seamer is the second-lowest mark in MLB (min. 60 AB ending in the pitch) behind PHI's Zack Wheeler (.100).

**FIRST-INNING FOCUS:** Of the 24 runs Young has permitted this season, eight have come in the opening frame, with opponents hitting .306 (11-for-36) with four walks... However, those eight runs came over consecutive starts on April 30 (G2) vs. Houston (5 ER in 1<sup>st</sup>) and May 6 at Miami (3 ER in 1<sup>st</sup>).

👉 From the second inning on, the opposition is 31-for-132 (.235) with 13 walks.

**THEM CHANGES:** Young is averaging 83.0 mph and 1,324 revolutions per minute (RPM) on his split finger over his last two starts, during which opponents are hitting .222 (2-for-9) with no extra-base hits on the pitch...Over his first six starts of the season his splitter averaged 87.7 mph and 1,501 RPM, with opponents hitting .476 (10-for-21) off it with three doubles.

👉 Last season opponents hit .281 (18-for-64) off his split finger with six doubles and five home runs...Threw the pitch 17.8 percent of the time in 2025 compared to 20.2 percent this season, marking a 2.4 percent increase in usage.

**ROAD TRIPPIN':** Young is on a career-long, three-decision winning streak on the road dating back to August 15, 2025 at Houston, during which he owns a 1.99 ERA (5 ER/22.2 IP) over four starts...Prior to the winning streak, Young began his career with an 0-3 record and 4.58 ERA (9 ER/17.2 IP) over four starts on the road from April 26-August 3, 2025...The O's are 4-4 in Young's eight career road starts, winning each of his last four outings after losing his first four starts.

**CLEAN SHEET:** On July 8, 2025 vs. New York-NL, Young threw an immaculate inning in the fifth frame, becoming the fifth pitcher in Orioles history (since 1954) to accomplish the feat, joining Kevin Gausman (4/23/18 vs. CLE, 7<sup>th</sup> inn.), B.J. Ryan (9/5/99 vs. CLE, 6<sup>th</sup> inn.), Mike Mussina (5/9/98 vs. TB, 9<sup>th</sup> inn.), and Jimmy Key (4/14/98 vs. CWS, 2<sup>nd</sup> inn.).

**HOMECOMING:** On August 15, 2025 at Houston, the Lumberton, Texas native earned his first career win, tossing a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings, allowing one hit with zero walks and six strikeouts...He was perfect through 7.2 frames before Ramón Urías tallied an infield single, marking the longest perfect-game bid by an Oriole since Mike Mussina threw 7.2 perfect innings on August 4, 1998 vs. Detroit.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP KYLE BRADISH (3-6, 3.44)**

**LAST TIME OUT:** Bradish earned his third victory of the year on May 31 vs. Toronto after allowing one unearned run on four hits and three walks with four strikeouts across 7.0 innings pitched...Has allowed three earned runs or fewer in each of his last five starts since May 8, owning a 1.72 ERA (6 ER/31.1 IP) in that span...Threw 94 pitches, 56 strikes.

**vs. TORONTO:** Bradish is 2-3 with a 4.40 ERA (23 ER/47.0 IP) over nine career starts against Toronto, including a 1-2 record and 6.10 ERA (14 ER/20.2 IP) over four career starts at Rogers Centre...Hasn't pitched in Toronto since August 1, 2023, when he earned the win and a quality start with 7.0 innings of three-run ball on four hits (2 HR) and one walk.
