YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles shut out the Yankees, 2-0, to open the four-game series... Gunnar Henderson hit his third leadoff home run of the year and fifth of his career, while Grayson Rodriguez tossed 5.2 scoreless innings to earn his fourth win...Danny Coulombe ned his first save of the season.

Marked the team's third shutout of the season, second in the last three games, and third in the last eight games; Baltimore is tied for second in the AL and tied for fourth in MLB with 30 shutouts since the start of 2022; the 0's had 28 shutouts from 2017-21. 0.

HOMER HAPPY: Baltimore has homered in 17 of the last 18 games with the club hitting at least three in eight of those...The Orioles lead MLB with 45 home runs, the most homers through the first 28 games in 0's history; the most home runs through Baltimore's first 29 games of a season is 47 by the 1996 team.

The Orioles are the only MLB team with eight players who've hit at least four home runs; the Padres, Phillies, Royals, and Yankees are tied for second with five players each.

EXTRA TOPPINGS: The 0's lead the AL and rank third in MLB with 98 extra-base hits, tied for the fifth-most through the first 28 names of a season in team biotografica 1954). The original team of the first 28 names of a season in team biotografica 1954. the fifth-most through the first 28 games of a season in team history (since 1954)...The Orioles have had 100+ extra-base hits through the first 29 games five times - 1996 (108), 2000 (105), 2005 (103), and 2020 and 2012 (102)...Last night, the Birds did not record at least two extra-base hits in a game for the first time since March 30, snapping a streak of 24 straight games with at least two...That marked the fourth-longest such streak in a single season in club history.

AL BEAST: Entering this week with the Yankees, Baltimore has not dropped a series against an AL East opponent in 15 straight sets since April 24-26, 2023, while going 11-0-4 in series during that time...That is the longest such streak in team history since divisions were introduced in 1969, per the Elias Sports Bureau...The Orioles are 34-16 against division opponents over that period...The O's went 32-20 (.615) against the AL East last year, the second-best winning percentage against the division by the team since 1981 behind the .618 (47-29) mark in 2014...
The Birds won the season series against the Blue Jays (10-3), Rays (8-5), Red Sox (7-6), and Yankees (7-6), the first time since 2014 that the Orioles won the season series against each of their division opponents their division opponents.

AGAINST THE YANKEES: The O's and Yankees are meeting at Oriole Park this week for the first four of 13 overall matchups this season...Baltimore will host New York again right before the All-Star Break from July 12-14 (3 G), and will face each other at Yankee Stadium from June 18-20 (3 G) and September 24-26 (3 G)...The Orioles won the season series (7-6) against the Yanks last year for the first time since doing so in three straight years from 2014-16.

RUN IT UP: The Orioles lead the AL and rank third in MLB with 153 runs scored...Their +36 run differential is fourth in the AL, while the 5.46 runs per game leads the AL and ranks second in MLB behind the Braves (5.56).

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson ripped his 10th home run of the season last night, tying him for the MLB lead with Los Angeles-AL's Mike Trout...Henderson ranks among AL leaders in slugging (1st., 632), total bases (1st., 72), extra-base hits (T-1st., 16), runs scored (T-1st., 25), triples (T-2nd., 3), OPS (3rd., 984), RBI (T-5th., 23), hits (8th., 33), and stolen bases (T-8th., 6).

Ob. Henderson became the youngest player in MLB history to reach double-digit home runs before May 1; at 22 years, 306 days today, he passes Trevor Story (23-167), who hit 10 home runs through April 30 with Colorado in 2016.

Ob. His nine home runs this month are tied for the third-most in April in O's history (since 1954); only Brady Anderson (11, 1996) amd Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer Frank Robinson (10, 1969), hit more before May 1.

Ob. Henderson's 95.6 mph average exit velocity is second-best in MLB this season, per Statcast (see chart at right).

BIG TIME RUTSCH: Adley Rutschman has hit a career-high 10 straight games since April 19 while slashing .378/.391/.600 (17-for-45) with one double, three homers, five runs scored, 10 RBI, and one walk...He's also hit in 15 of his last 16 games since April 11 while recording an ALhigh 24 hits during that period

(b) Last night, he became the ninth primary catcher in 0's history with at least 300 hits, joining Orioles Hall of Famers Rick Dempsey (854), Gus Triandos (794), Chris Hoiles (739), and Elrod Hendricks (395), as well as Matt Wieters (802), Andy Etchebarren (500), Javy López (367), and Ramón Hernández (351).

KIMBREL COUNT: Craig Kimbrel recorded the 424th save of his career on April 24 at Los Angeles-AL, tying John Franco for sixth in MLB history; only Boston's Kenley Jansen (425) has more among active players...Kimbrel has 1,209 strikeouts, the fourth-most all-time as a reliever behind Hoyt Wilhelm (1,363), Goose Gossage (1,340), and Lee Smith (1,225); the 1,209 punch outs by Kimbrel are the most by a player in MLB history who never started a game.

DOWN BUT NOT OUT: The Orioles are slashing .187/.239/.341 (95-for-507) in two-strike counts...They lead MLB in slugging and extra-base hits (41) with two strikes, and are second in home runs (17) and OPS (.580)...**Gunnar Henderson** leads MLB with a .629 slugging percentage and **Jordan Westburg** ranks second with a .609 slugging in two-strike counts, while Westburg leads MLB with a .969 OPS with two strikes.

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The Orioles are in the middle of a seven-game homestand against the As (1-2) and Yankees (1-0)...The O's are 10-6 at home to start the year...Last season, the Orioles went 49-32 (.605) at Oriole Park, the third-best record in ballpark history (since 1992), behind the 2014 and 2016 teams who went 50-31 (.617) at Camden Yards...Marked the third-best home record in the AL in 2023 behind Tampa Bay at 53-28 (.654) and Texas at 50-31 (.617), and tied for the fifth-best in MLB.

O THE PLACES YOU'LL 60: The Birds went 4-2 on their last road trip against the Royals (2-1) and Angels (2-1) from April 19-24...Their next trip will be a five-gamer in Cincinnati (3 G) and Washington (2 G) from May 3-8...The club has scheduled off days on May 6 and May 9...The O's are 8-4 on the road to begin year...Last season, the Orioles went 52-29 (.642) away from Camden Yards, tied with the Braves for the best road record in MLB and tied with the 1997 O's squad for the best road record in club history (since 1954); marked the third time an O's team reached 50 road wins, joining 1997 (52) and 1980 (50).

SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE: With tonight's game, the Orioles will have gone 101 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) without being swept...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, that is the fourth-longest regular-season streak in MLB history, trailing the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124), 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115), and 1903-05 New York Giants (105)...Baltimore's current streak is the longest in 0's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72...The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3)...The Orioles were swept by the Rangers in three games in the 2023 ALDS.

The 2023 Orioles (52 series) were the fourth MLB team since 2000 to go a full regular season without being swept in a series of at least two decisions, joining the Braves teams of 2022 (51 series), 2004 (52 series), and 2002 (52 series).

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the Baseball Writers' Association of America (BBWAA) AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 333 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his sixth start of the season...Made his fourth Opening Day roster...Went 13-5 with a 4.12 ERA (79 ER/172.2 IP), allowing 171 hits (27 HR) with 55 walks and 157 strikeouts across 32 starts in his 2023 campaign...The 0's went 24-8 in his starts and his career-high 13 wins were tied for sixth in the American League...Acquired by the Orioles along with INF Breyvic Valera, 0F Yusniel Diaz, RHP Zach Pop, and INF Rylan Bannon in exchange for INF Manny Machado on July 18, 2018... Originally selected by the Dodgers in the 14th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of UNLV.

LAST TIME OUT: Picked up his first win of the season on Wednesday at Los Angeles-AL, allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR) and one walk with 10 strikeouts across 5.1 innings; the 10 strikeouts tie a career high(2x, last: 7/5/23 at NYY)...Did not surrender his first hit until the fifth inning...One of his two runs scored after he exited the game...Threw 101 pitches, 66 strikes.

AGAINST THE YANKEES: Today will mark Kremer's 10^{th} career start against the Yankees, his most against any team...Owns a 2-3 record with a 5.04 ERA (25 ER/44.2 IP) in his nine prior starts against them.

AGAINST THE AL EAST: Making his 33rd career start against the AL East and first since he picked up the win and completed 5.1 shutout innings on September 28, 2023 vs. Boston, clinching the division...0wns a lifetime 8-11 record with a 4.75 ERA (86 FR/163.0 IP).

AT HOME: In Kremer's two starts at Camden Yards this season, he has surrendered 11 runs (9 ER) across 9.1 innings...Opponents are slashing .295/.326/.614 (13-for-44) against him in home starts this season, compared to .159/.206/.286 (10-for-63) on the road.

<u>NIGHT OWL:</u> Kremer has surrendered six runs across 11.0 innings pitched in two night starts this season...Completed 5.2 innings, allowing three runs on two hits (1 HR) and three walks with three strikeouts in his last evening start on April 19 at KC; two his three runs scored after he was removed from the game.

APRIL SHOWERS: In his 15 career starts in the month of April, Kremer has a 6.25 ERA (50 ER/72.0 IP), allowing 85 hits (17 HR) and 21 walks with 70 strikeouts...0pponents are slashing .290/.340/.512 (85-for-293), the highest OPS against (.852) in any month; his second-highest OPS against in a month is June at .776.

GAME OF ADJUSTMENTS: Kremer pitched to a 5-1 record with a 3.09 ERA (28 ER/81.2 IP) and seven quality starts in his final 15 outings last season...He went 8-4 with a 5.04 ERA (51 ER/91.0 IP) and seven quality starts in his first 17 starts to open the year, allowing 105 hits (19 HR) and 24 walks with 82 strikeouts.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Earned the win on September 28 vs. Boston, clinching the AL East...Collected his 300th career strikeout on September 17 vs. Tampa Bay, matching Chuck Estrada and Daniel Cabrera as the fifth-fastest Orioles by appearances (69) to reach the mark...Logged four straight quality starts from August 10-29, the longest such streak of his career...Pitched for Team Israel in the 2023 World Baseball Classic; made the start in Team Israel's 3-1 win over Team Nicaragua in Pool Play on March 12, 2023 at loanDepot park in Miami (4.0 IP, 3 H, BB, K).

<u>POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE:</u> Kremer made his Postseason debut last season, taking the loss in Game 3 of the ALDS against the Texas Rangers on October 10...Allowed six runs on seven hits and one walk in 1.2 innings...The six earned runs marked the most amount that Kremer had given up in a game since June 30 vs. Minnesota (7 ER...It was his shortest outing since June 24, 2021 at Toronto (0.1 IP).

Scheduled to make his seventh start of the season and his second career start against the Yankees...Did not factor into the decision in his last start on Friday vs. Oakland, allowing one run on three hits (1 HR) and three walks with six strikeouts across 6.0 innings...Completed 8.0 no-hit and shutout innings in his only prior start against the Yankees on September 10, 2023 in New York; one of four starts in which he tossed 8.0 shutout innings last season, most such starts in MLB in 2023...Became the first pitcher in 0's history (since 1954) to go 6.0+ innings and allow two hits or fewer in his first three appearances with the team, according to MLB.com's Sarah Langs (@SlangsOnSports)...Went 10-8 with a 3.39 ERA (73 ER/193.2 IP) in 32 starts for the Provers in 2023.
