THE PIRATES:...have lost back-to-back games for the second time this season (also 4/9-11)...Are 2-4 heading into the finale of their seven-game road trip against the Phillies (2-2) and Mets ( $0-2$ )...Have lost back-to-back games on the road for the first time this season...Began the season 5-0 for the first time since 1983...Swept a season-opening four-game series on the road for the first time since doing so in 1903 in Cincinnati...Have the seventh-best record (11-7) in MLB and third-best in the National League behind the Braves (11-5) and Brewers (10-6)...Have the seventh-best run differential (+19) in all of MLB.

ABOUT TODAY'S STARTER: Bailey Falter gets the start this afternoon in the finale of this three-game series and seven-game road trip...The 26 -year-old Falter earned his first win of the season Friday night at Philadelphia after limiting the Phillies to one run in 5.0 innings....The Pirates are $3-0$ in Falter's first three starts this year... He allowed five first-inning runs in his first start on March 31 at Miami...Since then he has allowed just one run over his last 14.0 innings.

AND THE WHIFF: Jared Jones struck out seven batters in 5.0 scoreless innings in his fourth big league start last night...The 22 -year-old Jones is the fourth Major Leaguer since 1893 to record seven or more strikeouts in each of his first four career games and the first to do it since Masahiro Tanaka did so in five straight games to open his career from April 4-27, 2014...The other pitchers to accomplish it were Washington's Stephen Strasburg from June 8-28, 2010 (five starts) and Pittsburgh's Jose DeLeon from July 23, 1983 to August 10, 1983 (five starts).

KEEPING UP WITH CUTCH'S HITS: Andrew McCutchen enters today's action with 999 career
 singles with the Pirates...Among his 1572 hits with the Bucs, 313 have been doubles, 44 have been triples and 216 have been home runs... Arky Vaughan is 10th on the club's all-time list with 1,218 singles.

BACK TO THE BURGH: The Pirates will return to Pittsburgh following today's game and begin their second homestand of the season Friday night against the Red Sox....The homestand will conclude with a four-game series against the Brewers that gets underway Monday night...The Pirates have played the most road games (13) in MLB coming into today, going 8-5 while outscoring their opponents 71-52 (+19 run differential).

AGAINST THE EAST: The Pirates will have just one road series remaining against the National League East after today, which will take place from June 28-30 in Atlanta...The Pirates have gone 2-1-1 in their first four series on the

OUR FAVORITE FRIEND: Joey Bart has two home runs in three games with the Pirates, making him the ninth Pirate since at least 1900 to record two-plus homers in his first three games with the team...Prior to Bart, the last Pirate to accomplish that was Derrek Lee, who went deep twice in his first three games in 2011...Bart has also recorded five RBI in his first three games with Pittsburgh...That has already matched his total from 30 games last season with the Giants.

START ME UP: Pittsburgh's starting pitching staff has allowed 20 earned runs in 73.2 innings
in the last 11 games ( 2.44 ERA)...Pittsburgh's 3.39 starting rotation ERA (103.2ip/39er) is the fifth-lowest among all teams in MLB... The only four starting rotations to record a lower ERA are the Red Sox (2.03), Royals (2.29), Phillies (2.69) and Rangers (3.33).

DOWN ON THE FARM: Triple-A Indianapolis' Nick Gonzales is hitting . 397 ( 25 -for-63) with nine doubles, a triple, home run, nine RBI and 1.060 OPS during his 15 -game on-base streak (tied for the longest active on-base streak in the International League)... Gonzales ranks first in the International League in batting (.397), hits (25) and doubles (nine), tied for second in extra base hits (11), fourth in total bases (39), ninth in OPS (1.060) and third in runs (16)...The 24-year-old Gonzales is currently rated as Pittsburgh's ninth-best prospect according to Baseball America.
