TONIGHT'S STARTER: #62 - LHP JOSÉ QUINTANA (2gs, 2-0, 0.71)

QUINTANA AT A GLANCE: José Quintana, 36, will be making his third start of the season tonight.....Quintana last started last Wednesday vs. Detroit and picked up a 5-1 victory (5.2ip, 4h, 1r, 1er, 3bb, 4k, 1hr, 100 pitches).....he made his Brewers debut on 4/11 at Arizona and earned a 7-0 win (7ip, 4h, 0bb, 2k, 1bk, 80 pitches).....he signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on March 5....he is signed through the 2025 season with a mutual option for 2026....name is pronounced "keen-TAH-nuh."

LAST SEASON: Quintana went 10-10 with a 3.75 ERA in 31 starts with New York-NL....the team went 16-15 in his starts.....he made 12 quality starts.....opponents batted .237 (150-for-634, 22hr)....he was the Mets' Opening Day starter (against the Brewers).

MR. COLOMBIA: Quintana, born in Arjona, Colombia, is his country's all-time leader in nearly every statistical category in the Major Leagues, including games (361), starts (335), wins (104), innings pitched (1982.1) and strikeouts (1,733).....he pitched for Colombia in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

BEEN THERE, DONE THAT: Quintana has made 335 starts since 2012 - his first season - which ranks fourth in the Major Leagues behind Max Scherzer (357), Zack Greinke (344) and Lance Lynn (338).....this includes nine seasons of 30+ starts.

CAREER: Is 104-103 with a 3.72 ERA in 361 games/335 starts (1982.1ip, 820er)....is in his 14th Major League season while pitching for Chicago-AL (2012-17), Chicago-NL (2017-20), Los Angeles-AL (2021), San Francisco (2021), Pittsburgh (2022), St. Louis (2022), New York-NL (2023-24) and Milwaukee (2025).....was an All-Star in 2016 as he finished 10th in American League Cy Young Award voting.....Quintana was originally signed by the Mets as a non-drafted free agent on 4/26/06.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: IS 6-4 with a 3.71 ERA in 13 starts (72.2ip, 30er).....is 1-0 with a 1.59 ERA in 1 start this season (5.2ip, 1er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: IS 51-55 with a 3.77 ERA in 182 games/170 starts (995.1ip, 417er).....is 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA in 1 start this season (7ip, 0er).

CAREER vs. GIANTS: Is 1-4 with a 4.98 ERA in 7 games/6 starts (34.1ip, 31h, 20r, 19er, 12bb, 31k, 5hr).....he took a 5-2 loss last season with the Mets on 4/22 at Oracle Park [Sip, 7h, 5r, 5er, 3bb, 4k, 1hr].....is 1-3 with a 4.56 ERA in 4 career starts against the Giants at Oracle Park (23.2ip, 20h, 13r, 12er, 8bb, 17k, 2hr).
