BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles continue a seven-game homestand today against the Red Sox (0-3, 1 to play) before hosting the Guardians (3 to play) beginning Monday...Baltimore wrapped up a 6-3 road trip at the Cardinals (2-1), Athletics (3-0), and Rockies (1-2) on Wednesday, but dropped the final two games in Colorado...The O's are in the midst of 16 games in as many days since August 25, which will end with an off day following this homestand on September 10...The O's are in fifth place in the AL East and 3.0 games behind Cleveland and Toronto for the final Wild Card spot with Texas (2.0 GB) and Minnesota (3.5 GB) also in the mix.

- ☞ The Orioles have lost five games in a row since Tuesday, matching a season high from April 30 (G2)-May 4...Baltimore has not lost six in a row since an eight-game losing streak from May 14 (G1)-20, 2025...Prior to this current stretch, the O's won eight of 10 from August 21-31.
- ☞ The Birds have not scored in 18 consecutive innings, matching their longest streak of the season (7/27-29)...The last time the O's went 19+ consecutive innings without a run was from July 9-12, 2024 (25 innings).
- ☞ Last night, the O's were shut out for the sixth time this season with five of those instances coming since July 28...They have been blanked in consecutive games for the second time this season (also 8/1-2)...Baltimore has been shut out in three straight games twice in team history (since 1954): September 25-27, 2015 and July 29-31, 1957.
- ☞ **Coby Mayo** drew a walk as a pinch hitter in the eighth inning...His hitting streak remains at a career-high nine games, the third-longest active streak in the majors behind ATH's Lawrence Butler (14 G) and COL's TJ Rumfield (10 G)...ATH's Tyler Soderstrom has also hit in 11 consecutive games, but he has been on the 10-day Injured List since August 16.

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles recalled outfielder **Rece Hinds** from Triple-A Norfolk and designated right-handed pitcher **Albert Suárez** for assignment.

- ☞ Hinds will be making his O's debut after being acquired from the Miami Marlins in exchange for cash considerations on August 4.

HISTORIC DATE IN ORIOLES HISTORY: Today, the Orioles celebrate the 30th anniversary of Eddie Murray's 500th career home run...On September 6, 1996 vs. Detroit, Murray hit a game-tying solo homer in the seventh inning off Felipe Lira just minutes before midnight after rain delayed the start of the game, though Baltimore would lose 5-4 in 12 innings...Murray became the third player in MLB history and now one of seven with 3,000+ hits and 500+ homers, along with Willie Mays and Hank Aaron before being joined in the club later by Rafael Palmeiro, Alex Rodriguez, Albert Pujols, and Miguel Cabrera.

- ☞ On September 6, 1995, Cal Ripken, Jr. becomes baseball's "Iron Man" playing in his 2,131st consecutive game to break Lou Gehrig's record...Ripken goes 2-for-4 and homers for the second night in a row as the Orioles beat the Angels, 4-2...Amid the celebration when the game becomes official in the middle of the fifth inning, teammates Bobby Bonilla and Palmeiro push Ripken out of the dugout to take his now-famous lap around the ballpark, starting precisely at 9:31 p.m., or 21:31 in military time.
- ☞ Celebrating the 30th anniversary of Ripken's streak last year, the Orioles are being no-hit by LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto for 8.2 innings before **Jackson Holliday** hits a solo homer to cut the deficit to 3-1...Against the Dodgers bullpen the O's get a double, a hit batter, and two walks before Emmanuel Rivera's two-run single caps an improbable comeback for a 4-3 walkoff win in front of 42,612 fans.

POLAR BEAR SIGHTING: **Pete Alonso** ranks among AL leaders in RBI (T-1st, 94), home runs (4th, 33), total bases (4th, 265), slugging percentage (5th, .495), OPS (5th, .852), extra-base hits (6th, 57), runs (8th, 86), and hits (9th, 142).

- ☞ Alonso has started all 143 O's games this year, tied for the most in the majors this year with SF's Rafael Devers...The only other player in the AL to start each of his team's games this year is TB's Junior Caminero (142 GS)...The last Oriole to start every team game in a season was Jonathan Schoop in 2016.
- ☞ Alonso is tied with HOU's Yordan Alvarez for the AL lead in RBI...He looks to become the eighth player in franchise history (since 1954) to lead the AL in RBI, joining Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).
- ☞ Alonso to *STATS Perform*, since RBI became official in 1920, the only players to lead the AL in RBI in their first year playing in the Junior Circuit (including ties) are TEX's Josh Hamilton (130 RBI, 2008), CWS' Dick Allen (113 RBI, 1972), BAL's Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), BOS' Dick Stuart (118 RBI, 1963), and BOS' Ted Williams (145 RBI, 1939).

PLAYING THE LONG GAME: The Birds have hit 38 homers since August 9, second most in MLB behind the Cubs (54) and ahead of the Athletics and White Sox (both 35) in the AL during that time...Baltimore has not homered in back-to-back games, one shy of the season high from May 3-5...The Orioles had homered in 10 straight games at Camden Yards until Friday.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE: The O's lead the AL and rank fourth in the majors with 531 walks this season behind the Cubs (604 BB), Brewers (588 BB), and Dodgers (536 BB)...The Yankees are second in the AL with 511 free passes.

- ☞ The team's 30 games with 6+ walks are the most by a Baltimore club since 1999 (35).
- ☞ The Birds are averaging 3.97 pitches per plate appearance, tied for second in MLB with the Yankees behind the Brewers (4.00).

'PEN PALS: The Orioles bullpen has allowed 11 runs (9 ER) in the last five games, but the team's 2.25 ERA (13 ER/52.0 IP) in 16 games since August 20 ranks third in the majors during that period behind the Braves (1.74 ERA) and Padres (2.08 ERA).

- ☞ **Alex Hoppe** has yet to allow an earned run in 13 appearances (10.1 IP) since making his Orioles debut on August 5...His streak of 13 consecutive appearances without allowing an earned run is tied for the third-longest active streak in the AL with teammate **Josh Walker**, behind HOU's Josh Hader (21 G) and TOR's Mason Fluharty (19 G).
- ☞ **Yennier Cano** surrendered a home run on Thursday, snapping a streak of 48 consecutive appearances without allowing one.
- ☞ Ten Baltimore pitchers have recorded at least one save this season, tying the 1987 Orioles for the most in franchise history (since 1954)...The Birds are one of 11 teams in MLB to have at least 10 players tally at least one save this year, led by the Cubs (13).

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 46-50 in games decided by three runs or fewer, tied for the most such games in the majors this year with the Guardians (50-46)...The .479 winning percentage in those games ranks 19th in the majors.

- ☞ Baltimore is 16-22 in one-run games this year...The .421 winning percentage is the sixth lowest in the majors this year.

QUICK HITS: Bradish is scheduled to make his 28th start of the season and 95th of his career today...Made six starts in his return from Tommy John surgery last season, going 1-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER/32.0 IP) on 23 hits (3 HR), 10 walks, and one hit batter with 47 strikeouts... Acquired from Los Angeles-AL along with RHP Kyle Brnovich, RHP Isaac Mattson, and RHP Zach Peek in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019.

☞ Agreed to terms on a five-year contract with the O's on July 18, extending him through 2031.

LAST TIME OUT: Didn't factor into the decision of a 4-2 loss at Colorado on September 1 after allowing two runs in 5.0 innings on six hits (1 HR) and two walks with four strikeouts...Threw 95 pitches, 62 strikes.

☞ Has recorded five or fewer strikeouts in a career-high 11 consecutive starts since June 28...His previous career high was four straight starts (3x, last: 5/25-6/11/26).

☞ Has walked multiple batters in five of his last six starts since August 2.

BEANTOWN: Bradish has made 11 career starts opposite Boston, going 2-6 with a 6.12 ERA (34 ER/50.0 IP).

☞ However, earned the win in his last start against them at Fenway Park on July 22 (G2) after tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball on four hits, one walk, and one hit batter with four strikeouts.

☞ Is 2-2 with a 2.12 ERA (7 ER/29.2 IP) in five home starts vs. the AL East this season.

FIRST-INNING FOCUS: Bradish has allowed only two runs in the opening frame this season, during which opponents are slashing .198/.277/.286 (18-for-91) with five doubles, one home run, nine walks, and 33 strikeouts.

☞ His two runs allowed in the first inning are tied with two others for the second fewest in MLB (min. 15 GS) behind SD's Casey Mize (1).

SLIDE AWAY: Bradish's .540 slugging percentage on his slider is the fourth-highest mark in MLB (min. 100 AB ending in pitch) ahead of ATH's Jeffrey Springs (.667), CWS' Luis Castillo (.584), and Miles Mikolas (.547)...In 2025, he held a .156 slugging percentage on the pitch over six starts.

☞ Overall, his breaking balls (slider, curveball) own a negative 10 run value, which ranks in the bottom two percent of MLB... Opponents are slashing .251/.317/.481 (59-for-235) with 12 doubles, three triples, and 12 home runs on his breaking pitches.

WALK DON'T RUN: His 10.1 percent walk rate is tied for the sixth-highest mark in MLB and is the highest mark of his career (9.2%, 2024).

☞ His 13 games with three or more walks are tied for the sixth most among MLB starters ahead of leaders TOR's Dylan Cease and SD's Robbie Ray (both 15 G).

FOUR SEAM FOCUS: Opponents are slashing .583/.688/.833 (7-for-12) with one double and one triple off his four seamer in his last six starts since August 2 after hitting .235/.235/.353 (4-for-17) with one triple on the pitch over four games in July...Bradish opened the season holding opponents to a .308/.400/.400 (20-for-65) slash line on his four seamer with three doubles and one home run over 17 starts from March-June.

BEHIND THE EIGHT BALL: Bradish owns a 56.2 percent first-pitch strike rate, the lowest mark in MLB among qualified pitchers behind SF's Landen Roupp (56.7%)...Threw 13 of 23 (56.5%) first pitches for strikes in his last start on September 1 at Colorado.

BREAKING BRAD: Over two starts from June 17-22, Bradish allowed one run over 15.2 innings with 21 strikeouts to become the third pitcher in franchise history (since 1954) to have 20+ strikeouts and no more than one run allowed over a two-start span in a single season, joining Mike Mussina (2000) and Erik Bedard (2007).
