**THE TWINS:** After completing their six-game, seven-day homestand with a record of 3-3 (2-1 vs. Los Angeles-AL and 1-2 vs. Cincinnati), the Twins began their seven-game roadtrip with a split of the first two games against the Guardians over the last two nights...tonight, Minnesota will play the third of four against the Guardians through tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's game, the Twins will travel to Boston for three at Fenway Park over the weekend...after this trip, the Twins will finish the season with an off-day on Monday, followed by a six-game homestand with three against the Marlins and three against the Orioles.

☞ At 80-71, the Twins need two wins in their final 11 games to secure a winning record for the second-straight season (87-75 in 2023) and fourth time in six seasons under Rocco Baldelli.

**TWINS ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF A CLOSE ONE...FINALLY:** The Twins beat the Guardians last night at Progressive Field by a score of 4-1, evening the series at 1-1...Zebby Matthews was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on five hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...Zebby's one run allowed came on a Lane Thomas fourth-inning home run...Minnesota used five relievers to combine for 4.1 scoreless innings...the offense recorded eight hits and were led by Matt Wallner and Willi Castro...Wallner drove in both of the first two runs with RBI singles and Willi Castro provided insurance with a two-run homer in the eighth inning, his 12th home run of the season.

**BAILEY DOSE:** Since his complete game on June 22 at Oakland, Bailey Ober has gone 6-3, 3.15 ERA (88.2 IP, 31 ER) with 21 walks and 95 strikeouts, holding opponents to a .166 batting average and a .545 OPS...below are his AL rankings in a few categories since June 22:

**ON GUARD:** The Twins are playing the Guardians tonight for the 12th of 13 times in 2024...the Twins have gone 3-8 against Cleveland this season, going 2-4 at Target Field and 1-4 at Progressive Field.

☞ Last night's win snapped a five-game losing streak at Progressive Field and was Minnesota's first win in this ballpark since September 5, 2023.

☞ Of the 11 games played between these two teams this season, 10 have been decided by three runs-or-fewer...Cleveland has seven wins in those instances and Minnesota has three.

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .303 (36-for-119) with seven home runs, 14 RBI, a .390 on-base percentage, a .504 slugging percentage and an .894 OPS in 32 games against the Guardians since the start of 2022...in six games this season, he's hitting .368 (7-for-19) with six walks and a .520 on-base percentage against Cleveland pitching.

**CORREA ON A RUN:** Carlos Correa has hit safely in 15 consecutive games with an at-bat, dating back to June 26, the longest hitting streak by a Twin this season and longest active streak in baseball...during the streak, he is hitting .357 (20-for-56) with a 1.151 OPS...it is one shy of his career high of 16 games, from April 19-May 6, 2019.

**CENTRAL OF ATTENTION:** Twins enter today 6.5 games back of Cleveland in the AL Central and 1.5 games back of the Royals...additionally, they are 1.5 games ahead of the Tigers for the final wild card spot...below are miscellaneous Twins, Guardians, Royals and Tigers records:

**NOTE:** The Royals host the Tigers tonight with first pitch at 6:40 (CT)...Tarik Skubal and Alec Marsh are the probable starters.

**I AM THE ONE WHO 'NACHS:** Trevor Larnach has posted an .830 OPS in 14 games this month, including a .413 on-base percentage and a .417 slugging percentage...additionally, his nine walks this month are tied for fifth-most in the AL.

☞ He has already set single-season career-highs in games (105), hits (83), runs (56), doubles (17), home runs (15), RBI (48) and walks (38).

**BUCK AROUND AND FIND OUT:** Since coming off the 10-day IL on Thursday, Byron Buxton has reached base in all four games played, posting a slashline of .308/.400/.615 (1.015 OPS) with four hits, four RBI and two walks...over his last 47 games dating back to June 11, Buxton is hitting .329 (53-for-161) with 16 doubles, 14 home runs, 37 RBI, a .394 on-base percentage, a .702 slugging percentage and a 1.096 OPS...since that date, he leads baseball (min. 175 PA) in slugging, ranks second in OPS, fifth in batting average, and eighth in on-base percentage.

☞ Buxton's 94 games played are the second-most of his career, ahead of his 2016 and 2022 totals of 92...career-high is 140, set in 2017.

☞ He ranks in the 92nd percentile in baseball in xSLG (.512) and 91st percentile in barrel percentage (14.0%).

**TO THE WINDOW, TO THE WALLNER:** After starting the season 2-for-his-first-25 (.080), Matt Wallner was optioned to Triple-A St. Paul and returned on July 7...since that date, he is hitting .274 (48-for-175) with 15 doubles, 12 home runs, 32 RBI, 19 walks, a .377 on-base percentage, a .577 slugging percentage and a .955 OPS in 56 games.

☞ In his last 12 road games, he is hitting .294 (10-for-34) with two doubles, two home runs, nine RBI and a .914 OPS.

**TYPING THIS INTO EXISTENCE:** Royce Lewis has not homered in 14 games and has just one in his last 31 games, the homer being a three-run, eighth-inning, go-ahead shot on September 1 vs. Toronto, off Chad Green...Royce's 15.42 at-bats-per-home run ratio ranks fourth in Twins history (minimum of 500 PA), trailing Nelson Cruz (12.30), Jim Thome (13.03) and Harmon Killebrew (13.88).

**'PENMANSHIP:** Over their last three games, the Twins bullpen has combined to post a 1.59 ERA (11.1 IP, 2 ER) with three walks, 14 strikeouts and a .225 opponent batting average...the only blemish being the Kyle Manzardo two-run homer off Griffin Jax on Monday night.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Last started on September 13 vs. Cincinnati...took the loss, allowing five runs on six hits (1 HR) in 6.2 innings, two walks and six strikeouts...allowed second-inning solo home run to TJ Friedl, then five runs on three hits in the seventh...was pulled with two on and two outs in the seventh; Jorge Alcala entered, allowing a walk and a grand slam.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Made the start on September 7 at Kansas City...did not earn a decision but recorded his 17th quality start; threw 7.0 scoreless innings with one hit, no walks and seven strikeouts...faced just two batters over the minimum and did not allow a runner to advance past first base...stranded a two-out hit-by-pitch in the first inning and allowed a leadoff single in the third inning, after which he retired his last 15 batters and exited with a 2-0 Minnesota lead.

- ☞ He's the first Minnesota pitcher to record at least 7.0 scoreless innings with one hit and no walks since Joe Ryan on Sept. 8, 2021 at Cleveland.
- ☞ Sixth start of 7.0-or-more innings this season; earned a win in the first five.

**VS. CLEVELAND:** Making eighth career start vs. Cleveland.

- ☞ Making his third start of the year against Cleveland and first since August 9 at Target Field; has gone 1-1, 4.50 ERA (10.0 IP, 5 ER), three walks, 13 strikeouts, 1.30 WHIP and a .256 (10-for-39) opponent batting average.
- ☞ Making his fifth career start at Progressive Field; in his previous four, he is 1-1, 3.15 ERA (20.0 IP, 7 ER), three walks, 19 strikeouts, a 1.05 WHIP and a .247 (18-for-73) opponent batting average.
- ☞ His last start at Progressive Field came May 18, when he allowed five runs on eight hits (1 HR), one walk and five strikeouts in 4.0 innings taking the loss in an 11-4 Minnesota defeat.

**ON THE ROAD:** Making his 16th road start of the season today...in the previous 15, he's gone 5-4 with a 3.76 ERA (88.2 IP, 37 ER), 20 walks, 87 strikeouts, a 0.94 WHIP and a .198 (63-for-318) opponent batting average...in 13 home starts, he is 7-3, 4.07 ERA (73.0 IP, 33 ER), 21 walks, 81 strikeouts, a 1.05 WHIP and a .207 (56-for-270) opponent batting average.

- ☞ Has gone 11-12 with a 3.71 ERA (233.0 IP, 96 ER) in 43 career road starts, compared to 14-7 with a 3.74 ERA (221.0 IP, 92 ER) in 42 home starts.
- ☞ The Twins are 5-4 in Ober's 15 road starts this season.
- ☞ Since making his debut in 2021, Ober is third on the Twins in road wins with 11, trailing Joe Ryan (14) and Pablo López (14).

**REVERSE SPLITS:** Through 28 games vs. Ober this season, lefties have hit .178 (48-for-270) with a .572 OPS and 25.9 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .223 (71-for-318) with a .703 OPS and 26.6 percent strikeout rate.

- ☞ On September 13, Reds left-handed hitters went 2-for-9 with one home run and three strikeouts against Ober...right-handed hitters went 4-for-15 with two doubles, one triple and three strikeouts.
