### Ozzie Albies

2B Ozzie Albies went 3-for-5 last night at Boston, finishing a triple shy of the cycle while scoring two runs, logging two RBI and belting his ninth home run of the season.

He's on pace for 26 home runs and 52 extra-base hits after hitting 10 and 39 last year, respectively.

Last night's home run snapped his 20-game streak without an extra-base hit, the longest such drought of his career. His previous long was 15 games from April 26-May 11, 2022.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Braves and Reds today begin a three-game weekend series with the first of six games between the clubs this season...Atlanta will host Cincinnati in its final home series of the regular season, September 22-24, in a three-game homestand.

*A* The Braves went 5-2 against the Reds last season, playing games in three different cities: Atlanta, Cincinnati and Bristol, TN...Atlanta has taken the season series from the Reds in four of the last five seasons, playing to a 20-13 record since 2021.

*A* Since Great American Ball Park opened in 2003, Atlanta has hit the most home runs here (130) of any non-NL Central club...The team has averaged 1.7 home runs per game at this venue.

*A* RHP Chris Paddack is slated to face Atlanta for the second time this season, doing so for his second different club...He shouldered the loss against the Braves as a Marlin on April 15, allowing a pair of earned runs across 4.2 innings in a 6-3 defeat...The 6-foot-5, 217-pound Texan has a lifetime record of 2-1 against Atlanta, accompanied by a 2.45 ERA (7 ER/25.2 IP)...Paddack has pitched five times against the Braves and has never surrendered more than two runs.

*A* RHP Grant Holmes is scheduled to start his third career game against Cincinnati...In five total appearances against the club, the right-handed native of Conway, SC has posted an 0-1 record and a 5.14 ERA (8 ER/14.0 IP)...In 10 starts this season, Holmes is 3-2 with a 3.78 ERA (22 ER/52.1 IP).

**RONALD ACUÑA JR.:** Last night belted a lead-extending grand slam to the top of the Green Monster while also reaching base three times in the Braves win, 10-2...The homer was his first since April 24 versus Philadelphia (missed 12 games while on the IL in that span).

*A* The blast marked the fourth grand slam of his career and his first since his MVP-winning 2023 season, when he had one off Lance Lynn and the Los Angeles Dodgers...On that swing, he became the first player in Major League Baseball history to reach 30 home runs and 60 stolen bases in a single season.

*A* Also stole a pair of bases last night, becoming the first Brave in modern franchise history with a grand slam and multiple stolen bases...Combined with the two walks he drew, became just the fifth player in modern MLB history to post such a stat line and the first since Jazz Chisholm Jr. (MIA) did so against Atlanta on September 16, 2023.

*A* Acuña Jr. is one of just seven players in MLB history with at least 150 home runs and 200 stolen bases out of the leadoff spot in the batting order, alongside Bobby Bonds, Rickey Henderson, Craig Biggio, Brady Anderson, Johnny Damon and Jimmy Rollins.

**MICHAEL HARRIS II:** Went 2-for-5 with two runs and his 13th home run of the season...The centerfielder is slashing .350/.366/.750 (14-for-40) in his last nine games, including five home runs...He has a 1.116 OPS in that time.

*A* Harris II is pacing for 81 runs scored, 39 homers, 99 RBI and 309 total bases...Each would constitute a new career best by a significant margin...He needs just seven more home runs to match his career high.

*A* He's batting .362 and slugging .695 in road games this season, each the best mark among qualified batters in MLB.

*A* Harris II has posted the fifth-best fWAR (1.9) by a primary centerfielder, only trailing Andy Pages (LAD, 2.8), Byron Buxton (MIN, 2.1), Mike Trout (LAA, 2.1) and Pete Crow-Armstrong (CHC, 2.0).

**WILD ONES:** Last season, Atlanta and Cincinnati played a collection of back-and-forth contests...The season set included two walk-off wins and three extra-inning victories for the Braves...Five of the seven games were decided by a single run.

*A* On July 31, 2025, the Braves and Reds were tied, 3-3, entering the eighth inning...Both clubs scored eight runs in the eighth before the Braves eventually won, 12-11, in 10 innings...It marked the first game in baseball's modern era (since 1900) in which both teams scored at least eight runs in the same frame in the sixth inning or later.

*A* Additionally, Atlanta won despite blowing an eight-run lead in the eighth inning or later and failing to homer in the game, the first such win by a club since the Pirates on July 12, 1933...Pittsburgh beat the Boston Braves, 9-8, that afternoon...Research courtesy StatsPerform.

*A* The Braves hadn't played three extra-inning games against a team outside their division since 2011, when they went to additional frames three times against the Pittsburgh Pirates.

*A* Atlanta and Cincinnati played the inaugural MLB Speedway Classic on August 2, 2025 – a Braves win, 4-2.

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Braves today recalled RHP Anthony Molina to Atlanta and designated RHP Carlos Carrasco for assignment.

*A* Molina appeared in one game for Atlanta earlier this season at Coors Field, covering 2.0 scoreless innings of a Braves win over the Rockies, 8-6... In nine games (five starts) for Triple-A Gwinnett this year, he has gone 2-2 with a 4.50 ERA (15 ER/30.0 IP).

*A* Carrasco pitched 4.0 innings for Atlanta on Wednesday at Boston...He registered his 1,700th career strikeout, one of 14 active hurlers to reach the milestone.

#### Today's Game

- A Makes his 11th start of the season in the opener of a three-game series at Cincinnati.
  - A Owns an 0-1 record and a 5.14 ERA (8 ER/14.0 IP) in four career appearances against the Reds, two of them starts...Looks for his first career win versus Cincinnati...Most recently faced the Reds in 2025, allowing four runs on seven hits over 5.1 innings.
- A Took the loss in his last turn on May 23 against Washington, surrendering two runs on six hits over 5.0 innings with two walks and a season-high 10 strikeouts on 87 pitches in Atlanta's 2-0 defeat at Truist Park...Both runs scored on solo home runs.
- A Recorded the third 10-strikeout game of his career in that outing, his first of 2026... The other two came in 2025, a 15-strikeout effort June 15 versus Colorado and 10 on July 1 against Los Angeles (AL).
  - A Fanned the side in order in the first inning May 23, the third such inning of his career and the first by a Braves pitcher since Bryce Elder on May 4, 2025.
  - A Six of his 10 strikeouts May 23 came on the slider, giving him 32 strikeouts on the pitch this season, the sixth-most among Major League pitchers with at least 10 starts.
- A Enters play with a streak of 31 consecutive appearances issuing at least one walk dating to March 31, 2025.
- A Has posted four quality starts over 10 outings this season, going 3-2 with a 3.78 ERA (22 ER/52.1 IP) and 48 strikeouts...Is holding opposing hitters to a .222 average (44-for-198).
- A Has issued 24 walks and surrendered nine home runs through 10 starts, equating to a 4.13 BB/9 and a 1.55 HR/9.
- A Has held opponents 0-for-7 with the bases loaded in 2026.
- A His 38 career starts for the Braves are the most in Atlanta-franchise history by a South Carolina-born player.

#### 2026

- A Took the loss May 23 against Washington, allowing two runs on six hits over 5.0 innings with two walks and 10 strikeouts on 87 pitches in the 2-0 defeat at Truist Park...Both Washington runs came on solo home runs.
- A Earned the win May 17 against Boston, allowing no runs on five hits over 6.0 innings with one walk and four strikeouts on 87 pitches in Atlanta's 8-1 victory at Truist Park...A rain delay ended his afternoon.
- A Received a no-decision May 12 against Chicago (NL), allowing two earned runs on one hit over 4.0 innings with four walks and five strikeouts on 78 pitches in the 5-2 win at Truist Park...The lone hit was a solo home run by Alex Bregman in the fourth inning.
- A Was the seventh Braves pitcher since 2000 to allow two-plus earned runs while exiting a start having surrendered one hit or fewer, and the first since Spencer Strider on June 15, 2022 at Washington (5.2 IP, 1 H, 2 ER)...Was the first Atlanta pitcher to do so while issuing four-plus walks since Jorge Sosa on July 3, 2005.
- A Was charged with five earned runs over 5.0 innings in a no-decision May 1 at Colorado, scattering seven hits with three walks and four strikeouts on 87 pitches in the 8-6 win at Coors Field...The six total runs allowed tied his career high, last reached April 26, 2025 at Arizona.
- A Reached 200 career strikeouts April 3 at Chase Field in Arizona.
- A Went 1-0 with a 1.02 ERA in five spring appearances (four starts), fanning 20 over 17.2 innings with just one walk.

#### Career Recap

- A Awards: Midwest League Midseason All-Star (2015); Texas League Pitcher of the Week (July 30, 2017).
- A In his MLB debut season in 2024, went 2-1 with a 3.27 ERA (11 ER/30.1 IP) in 26 relief appearances and one start...Was recalled by Atlanta from Triple-A Gwinnett on August 8, 2024.
- A In 2022, pitched for three different minor league teams throughout the Oakland and Atlanta organizations...Separately, went 1-2 with Triple-A Las Vegas before joining the Braves system.
- A Pitched the entire 2021 season for Triple-A Las Vegas and saw more relief appearances (29) than starts (7) for first time in career.
- A Set career highs and led the team in games (50) and saves (13) in 2023 with Triple-A Gwinnett...Led all Strippers relievers in strikeouts (74).
- A Named Gatorade Player of the Year in South Carolina following his senior year in 2014.
- A Selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the first round (22nd overall) of the 2014 June draft (Conway High School, SC).
- A On August 1, 2016, traded by the Dodgers to the Oakland Athletics along with RHP Frankie Montas and RHP Jharel Cotton for OF Josh Reddick and RHP Rich Hill.
- A Pitched 10 seasons in the minors before making his MLB debut.
- A Signed by the Atlanta Braves as a minor league free agent on August 13, 2022.

- His 31.3% changeup rate is the second highest among Braves relievers in the Modern era (min. 100 games) and ranks first among such pitchers with 111 strikeouts on the pitch, 25 more than the next highest strikeout count.
