AT A GLANCE: The Yankees continue their nine-game road trip tonight with the first game of the Subway Series at Citi Field (3G through Sun.)...are 1-5 on the road trip after being swept by Milwaukee and dropping two-of-three games at Baltimore...following this series, will return home for a seven-game homestand, featuring a four-game series vs. Toronto (Mon.-Thurs.) and a three-game set vs. Tampa Bay (5/22-24).

- ▶ **Their 27-17 (.614) record is the second-best in the American League and the fourth-best record in the Majors**, trailing only Atlanta (30-14, .682), Tampa Bay (28-14, .667) and Chicago-NL (28-16, .636).
- ▶ Have lost five of their last six games (since 5/8) and six of their last eight games (since 5/6) after winning 15 of their previous 17 games from 4/17-5/5...**are 17-8 in their last 25 games (since 4/17), 18-9 in their last 27 games (since 4/15) and 19-10 in their last 29 games (since 4/13).**
- ▶ Have lost each of their last two series (since 5/8) after winning or splitting their previous seven series (6-0-1)... have won or split 10 of their 14 series this season (9-4-1).
- ▶ The Yankees' +69 run differential this season is the best in the AL and the second-best in the Majors, trailing only Atlanta (+91).

WHERE WE LEFT OFF: The Yankees fell to the Orioles, 7-0, on Wednesday at Camden Yards...**Yankees batters** were shut out for the fourth time this season...**LHP Max Fried** (3.0IP, 5H, 3R/ER, 1BB, 2K, 0HR) suffered his third loss of the season and exited the game with left elbow posterior soreness...**2B Jazz Chisholm Jr.** (1-for-3, 1 double) recorded the Yankees' only hit...**CF Trent Grisham** (0-for-2, 2BB) and **RF Spencer Jones** (2-for-1, 2BB) each reached base twice...**RHP Paul Blackburn** (2.0IP, 2H, 3R/ER, 2BB, 1K, 1HR) allowed 3R/ER in 2.0IP...**LHP Ryan Yarbrough** (3.0IP, 3H, 1R/ER, 4K) allowed 1R/ER in 3.0IP.

RICE RICE BABY: C/INF Ben Rice has hit .303/.413/.667 (40-for-132) with 31R, 9 doubles, 13HR, 29RBI, 25BB/21BB, 1HP, 2SF and 2SB in 39 games this season...22 of his 40H this season have gone for extra bases (9 doubles, 13HR)...has reached base safely in 29-of-35 starts.

- ▶ **Has hit 9HR in his last 22 games (since 4/16).**

FOR STARTERS: Yankees starters have posted a **3.14 ERA (240.2IP, 84ER) and 240K in 44 starts this season...marks the third-best ERA in the Majors**, trailing only Atlanta (2.96) and Tampa Bay (3.00)...have allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 22 of their last 25 starts (since 4/17), including 2ER-or-fewer in 18 of those starts and 1ER-or-fewer in 12 starts...have posted a 2.95 ERA (137.1IP, 45ER) over that span.

- ▶ **Have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 37 of their 44 starts this season, tied with Milwaukee for the most starts in the Majors...also marks their second-most in franchise history through their first 44 games of a season**, trailing only their 40 starts in 2022.
- ▶ **Have allowed 2R-or-fewer in 26 of their 44 starts, matching their fourth-most through their first 44 games of a season in franchise history**, trailing only their 32 starts in 2022 and 27 starts in 1966 and 2019.
- ▶ **Lead the Majors in opponents' SLG (.318), opponents' OPS (.599) and HR/9.0IP (0.75)**, rank third in ERA (3.14, second in AL), opponents' BA (.210, second in AL), opponents' OBP (.281, second in AL) and WHIP (1.09, second in AL), fourth in strikeout rate (24.6%, second in AL), fifth in innings pitched (240.2, third in AL), sixth in strikeouts (240, fourth in AL), seventh in K/BB (3.04, third in AL) and BB/9.0IP (2.95, third in AL), eighth in K/9.0IP (8.98, fourth in AL) and ninth in walk rate (8.1%, fifth in AL).

SAVED BY THE BELL: INF/OF Cody Bellinger has hit **.484/.568/.935 (15-for-31) with 7R, 5 doubles, 3HR, 10RBI and 6BB in his last nine games vs. the Mets (since 6/21/24)**...in 45 career games vs. New York-NL, has batted .293/.356/.665 (48-for-164) with 30R, 11 doubles, 1 triple, 16HR, 41RBI, 16BB/31BB and 2SB.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Yankees batters have scored 35R in the first inning this season, the most in the AL and the second-most in the Majors, trailing only Washington (39R)...their 12HR in the first inning are the most in the AL and the second-most in the Majors, trailing only Philadelphia (13HR)...the Yankees have gone 15-6 (.714) when scoring in the first inning this year.

▶ The Yankees are 22-6 this season when scoring first.

WALK IT OUT: Yankees batters have walked 200 times this season, their most walks through their first 44 games of a season in the last 28 seasons (since 1999).

ALL RISE: OF Aaron Judge has reached base multiple times in eight of his last 13 games (since 5/1) and 15 of his last 22 games (since 4/21), hitting .307/.475/.640 (23-for-75) with 18R, 4 doubles, 7HR, 14RBI, 23BB/51BB, 1HP and 15B over that 22-game span.

- ▶ Has reached base in 35 of his last 38 games (since 4/3), batting .293/.440/.662 (39-for-133) with 34R, 7 doubles, 14HR, 27RBI, 33BB/51BB, 2HP and 5SB over that span.
- ▶ **Has hit 4HR in his last 11G (since 5/3), 7HR in his last 17G (since 4/26) and 13HR in his last 30G (since 4/12).**
- ▶ 23 of his 42H this season have been XBH (7 doubles, 16HR).
- ▶ **Has hit .346/.553/.808 (9-for-26) with 4HR, 15RBI, 11BB/51BB and 1HP with RISP this season.**
- ▶ Has hit .300/.392/.727 (33-for-110) with 22R, 5 doubles, 14HR, 26RBI, 15BB/21BB, 3HP, 2SF and 15B in 31 career games vs. the Mets...**has 9HR in his last 16 games against New York-NL (since 9/11/21)...has hit 9HR in 17 career games at Citi Field against the Mets, including 7HR in his last nine games at the venue (since 9/11/21).**

SCHLITZ'S CREEK: RHP Cam Schlitler will make his 10th start of the season tonight...has gone 5-1 with a 1.35 ERA (53.1IP, 8ER) and 59K in nine starts this season, holding opponents to a .177/.214/.234 (34-for-192) slash line...**according to OptaSTATS, is the first Major League pitcher to record a sub-1.50 ERA, at least 50K, less than 10BB and one-or-zero HR over his first nine starts of a season since Walter Johnson in 1913.**

- ▶ **His 2.4 WAR (FanGraphs) is the highest among Major League pitchers**...also ranks first in the Majors in opponents' SLG (.234), second in ERA (1.35, first in AL), opponents' OBP (.214, first in AL), opponents' OPS (.448, first in AL), WHIP (0.81, first in AL) and HR/9.0IP (0.17, second in AL), tied for second in starts (nine, tied for second in AL), third in K/BB (6.56, second in AL) and BB/9.0IP (1.52, second in AL), fourth in opponents' BA (.177, first in AL) and walk rate (4.5%, third in AL), tied for fifth in wins (five, tied for second in AL) and tied for ninth in strikeouts (59, tied for fourth in AL)...also ranks sixth in the AL in innings pitched (53.1) and strikeout rate (29.2%), and ninth in K/9.0IP (9.96).
- ▶ **His 1.35 ERA is the seventh-lowest by a Yankees pitcher through his first nine starts of a season since 1913** (when ER became an official stat), trailing only Max Fried (1.11 ERA in first 9GS in 2025), Lefty Gomez (2x: 1.27 ERA in first 9GS in 1937 and 1.29 ERA in first 9GS in 1934), Phil Niekro (1.32 ERA in first 9GS in 1984), Rob Gardner (1.34 ERA in first 9GS in 1972) and Allie Reynolds (a lower 1.35 ERA in first 9GS in 1952).
- ▶ **The Yankees have gone 7-2 in his starts this season**, his seven team wins are tied for the most in the Majors this season.
- ▶ **Is only the third Yankees pitcher to post a sub-1.50 ERA and record at least 50K through their first nine starts of a season since 1913** (when ER became an official stat), joining Max Fried (1.11 ERA and 52K in first 9GS in 2025) and Allie Reynolds (a lower 1.35 ERA and 51K in first 9GS in 1952).
- ▶ **Has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in each of his last five starts (since 4/17), going 3-0 with a 0.57 ERA (31.2IP, 2ER) and 29K.**
- ▶ His seven starts of 1ER-or-fewer this year are tied for the most in the Majors.
- ▶ **Over his last 17 Major League starts (since 8/20/25), has gone 8-2 with a 1.77 ERA (96.2IP, 19ER) and 113K**...the Yankees are 14-3 in those starts...has tossed at least 6.0 innings in 10 of those starts.
- ▶ **Has allowed only 1HR to 202BF this season**...is only the fourth Yankees starting pitcher to allow one-or-zero home runs over his first nine starts of a season in the last 42 years (since 1985), joining Max Fried (1HR this season in first 10GS), Chien-Ming Wang (1HR in first 9GS in 2008) and Scott Kamieniecki (1HR in first 9GS in 1992).
- ▶ Has gone 4-1 with a 0.98 ERA (36.2IP, 4ER) and 42K in six road starts this season...has allowed one-or-zero ER in five starts (including four scoreless starts)...**his 0.98 ERA is the third-lowest by a Yankees pitcher through his first six road starts of a season since 1913** (when ER became an official stat), trailing only Ray Fisher (0.77 ERA in first 6GS in 1917) and Whitey Ford (a lower 0.98 ERA in first 6GS in 1964).

RISPY BUSINESS: Yankees batters have hit .328/.411/.567 (59-for-180) with 10 doubles, 3 triples, 9HR, 86RBI, 31BB and 85F with RISP over their last 24 games (since 4/18).

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: RHP CAM SCHLITTLER (5-1, 1.35 ERA)

RHP Cam Schlittler will make his 10th start of the season in tonight's series opener at New York-NL...the 25-year-old will pitch on extended five days' rest due to Thursday's team off day...made his ninth start of the season on Saturday at Milwaukee, allowing just 2H over 6.0 scoreless innings without recording a decision (0BB, 6K)...has gone 5-1 with a 1.35 ERA (53.1IP, 34H, 10R/8ER, 9BB, 59K, 1HR) in nine starts this season...has also allowed 1ER-or-fewer in seven of his starts, including each of his last five starts (since 4/17)...has allowed only 1HR to 202BF this season...made his first career Opening Day roster...**over his last 17 Major League starts (since 8/20/25), has gone 8-2 with a 1.77 ERA (96.2IP, 61H, 21R/19ER, 26BB, 113K, 3HR)**...saw his first Major League action in 2025 with the Yankees, going 4-3 with a 2.96 ERA (73.0IP, 58H, 24R/ER, 31BB, 84K, 8HR) in 14 starts...in 23 career Major League starts, has gone 9-4 with a 2.28 ERA (126.1IP, 92H, 34R/32ER, 40BB, 143K, 9HR)...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in 21-of-23 career starts, 2R-or-fewer in 17 starts and 1R-or-fewer in 13 starts...**according to Elias, his 21 starts of 3R-or-fewer through his first 23 career starts are the most in franchise history...his seven scoreless starts are tied with Russ Ford for the most by a Yankees pitcher through their first 23 starts in franchise history** (min. 5.0IP each start)...**his 143K through his first 23 career games are the third-most in franchise history**, trailing only Masahiro Tanaka (159K) and Orlando Hernández (146K)...**his 34R allowed are the fewest by a Yankees pitcher through their first 23 career starts** (not including openers)...**has posted a .200 opponents' BA over his first 23 career starts...according to Elias, marks the sixth-lowest opponents' BA by a Yankees pitcher through their first 23 career starts** (ignoring relief appearances), trailing only Luis Gil (.178), Al Downing (.181), Tommy Byrne (.185), Russ Ford (.187) and Spec Shea (.195)...the Weymouth, Mass., native was selected by the Yankees in the seventh round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of Northeastern University (Mass.).

LAST TIME OUT: Made his ninth start of the season on Saturday at Milwaukee, allowing just 2H over 6.0 scoreless innings without recording a decision (0BB, 6K)...retired 17 of his final 18BF (1H).

2026: In nine starts this season, has gone 5-1 with a 1.35 ERA (53.1IP, 34H, 10R/8ER, 9BB, 59K, 1HR)...has held opponents to a .177/.214/.234 (34-for-192) slash line...**his 2.4 WAR (FanGraphs) is the highest among Major League pitchers**...also ranks first in the Majors in opponents' SLG (.234), second in ERA (1.35, first in AL), opponents' OBP (.214, first in AL), opponents' OPS (.448, first in AL), WHIP (0.81, first in AL) and HR/9.0IP (0.17, second in AL), tied for second in starts (nine, tied for second in AL), third in K/BB (6.56, second in AL) and BB/9.0IP (1.52, second in AL), fourth in opponents' BA (.177, first in AL) and walk rate (4.5%, third in AL), tied for fifth in wins (five, tied for second in AL) and tied for ninth in strikeouts (59, tied for fourth in AL)...also ranks sixth in the AL in innings pitched (53.1) and strikeout rate (29.2%), and ninth in K/9.0IP (9.96).

- ★ **His 1.35 ERA is the seventh-lowest by a Yankees pitcher through his first nine starts of a season since 1913** (when ER became an official stat), trailing only Max Fried (1.11 ERA in first 9GS in 2025), Lefty Gomez (2x: 1.27 ERA in first 9GS in 1937 and 1.29 ERA in first 9GS in 1934), Phil Niekro (1.32 ERA in first 9GS in 1984), Rob Gardner (1.34 ERA in first 9GS in 1972) and Allie Reynolds (a lower 1.35 ERA in first 9GS in 1952).
- ★ **Is only the third Yankees pitcher to post a sub-1.50 ERA and record at least 50K through their first nine starts of a season since 1913** (when ER became an official stat), joining Max Fried (1.11 ERA and 52K in first 9GS in 2025) and Allie Reynolds (a lower 1.35 ERA and 51K in first 9GS in 1952).
- ★ **According to OptaSTATS, is the first Major League pitcher to record a sub-1.50 ERA, at least 50K, less than 10BB and one-or-zero HR over his first nine starts of a season since Walter Johnson in 1913.**
- ★ **Has allowed 3R-or-fewer in all nine starts this season, including 1R-or-fewer in six starts (including four scoreless starts)**...his nine starts of 3R-or-fewer are tied for the most in the Majors (first in AL)...along with his nine-start streak to begin the 2025 season, is only the second pitcher in franchise history to allow 3R-or-fewer in at least nine starts to begin a season multiple times, joining Jim Bouton (2x: first 12GS in 1966 and first 10GS in '63).
- ★ **Has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in seven of his starts this season, including each of his last five starts (since 4/17)**...his seven starts of 1ER-or-fewer are tied for the most in the Majors (tied for first in AL)...is the first Yankees starter to allow 1ER-or-fewer in at least five straight starts since Max Fried (5GS from 4/20-5/13/25).
- ★ **Has allowed only 1HR to 202BF this season**...is only the fourth Yankees starting pitcher to allow one-or-zero home runs over his first nine starts of a season in the last 42 years (since 1985), joining Max Fried (1HR this season in first 10GS), Chien-Ming Wang (1HR in first 9GS in 2008) and Scott Kamieniecki (1HR in first 9GS in 1992).
- ★ Has recorded at least 7K in five of his starts, including 8K in three starts.
- ★ Has allowed 4H-or-fewer in six of his starts, tied for the third-most in the Majors.
- ★ The Yankees are 7-2 in his starts...his seven team wins are tied for the most in the Majors this season (tied for first in AL).
- ★ Has tossed at least 6.0IP in five of his last eight starts (since 4/1), including four of his last five starts (since 4/17).
- ★ Has posted two of the Yankees' top-three longest scoreless streaks: 14.0 inning streak from 4/23-5/4 (second longest) and a season-opening 13.2 inning streak from 3/27-4/7/... trails only Max Fried's 16.0 scoreless streak from 4/22-5/3...is one of four pitchers in the Majors this year to record at least two scoreless streaks of at least 13.0IP, joining Fried (16.0IP and 13.1IP), Paul Skenes (two streaks of 16.0IP) and Ranger Suarez (19.0 and 14.0IP)...opened the season with a 13.2 scoreless inning streak from 3/27-4/7... was the second-longest scoreless streak by a Yankees starter to begin the season in the last 15 years (since 2012), trailing only Luis Gil's 18.2 scoreless inning streak in 2021.
- ★ Did not allow a run in 11.2 innings over his first two starts of the season from 3/27-4/1 (3H, 0BB, 15K)...**was the first pitcher in franchise history to not allow a run or a walk and record at least 15K over a two-game span.**
