### TODAY’S STARTERS: RHP SETH LUGO (6-7, 4.61) vs. LHP PARKER MESSICK (10-8, 2.50)

**PINCH ME:** The Royals rallied from a 2-0 deficit to score an 8-3 victory in Cleveland yesterday, their 13th win in the last 15 games, a stretch in which they’ve now won 5 straight series.

- + **Isaac Collins** tied the game with a 2-run double in the 5th inning, and the Royals sent 10 to the plate in their 4-run 6th, a frame that was capped by **Josh Rojas’** pinch-hit, 2-run single on a 1st-pitch check swing.
- + Rojas added a 2-run home run in the 8th to match a career high with 4 RBI, becoming the first Royal with a 4-RBI game off the bench since **Brandon Berger** entered in the 2nd inning on June 7, 2002 and had 2 HR and 4 RBI.
- + **Daniel Lynch IV** was charged with 2 runs in 3.1 innings but five relievers combined to retire 17 of 19 batters—including 14 straight at one point—over 5.2 innings of 1-run ball.

**SWEEPSTAKES:** After winning the 1st 2 games of this series, the Royals are hoping to win again today to clinch their 6th series sweep of the season...a sweep today would mark their 3rd in the last 4 series and 4th since the All-Star break, which would tie for the most in the Majors in the 2nd half.

- + The Royals are 5-5 with a chance to sweep this season.
- + The Royals are attempting to sweep the Guardians for the first time since Sept. 18-20, 2023 in Kansas City (3 games).
- + Only three times in franchise history have the Royals had a sweep of at least 3 games in Cleveland, and the last was more than 23 years ago, from June 24-26, 2003.

**SERIES STREAKING:** The Royals have won each of their last 5 series since the final leg of their last trip in Anaheim from Aug. 14-16...it’s tied with the Brewers for the longest active streak in the Majors, and only the Red Sox (9), Rays (8) and Yankees (6) have had longer streaks among American League teams this season...it’s the Royals longest series win streak since April 22-May 8 of last season (5 straight series).

**15 GAMES OF FAME:** The Royals have won 13 of their last 15 games since the start of their series in Anaheim on Aug. 14, a stretch in which they have the best record in the Majors and the 2nd-best run differential (+41), trailing the Brewers (+49).

- + The Royals lead American League teams since Aug. 14 in runs per game (5.7), batting average (.286), on-base pct. (.360), slugging pct. (.461) and OPS (.821), and rank 3rd in starting pitcher’s ERA (2.82).
- + The Royals have 13 wins in a span of 15 games for just the sixth time in the Wild Card Era (since 1995) and for only the second time in the last 10 years, following a run in April and May of last season, when they won 16 of 18 games.

**WHERE WE STAND:** After being swept at Dodger Stadium, the Royals emerged from an off day in Anaheim on Aug. 13 with a 49-73 record, a season-high-tying 24 games under .500 and 11.5 games out of a playoff spot...but they have won 13 of 15 games since, improving to 62-75 and are now only 6.5 games out of the final Wild Card spot with 25 games left.

- + The Guardians currently hold the last Wild Card position at 68-68 and are on pace for 81 wins...for the Royals to get 81 wins, they would have to go 19-6 in the final 25 games.
- + Last season, the Guardians entered this date—Aug. 30—10.5 games behind the Detroit Tigers before finishing 21-8 to steal the American League Central Division title.

**SECOND THOUGHTS:** The Royals are 24-16 (.600) since the All-Star break, which is the 3rd-best record in the American League, trailing only the Red Sox (28-14) and Rays (25-16).

- + Their 2nd-half play marks a significant improvement for the Royals, who were 21 games under (38-59) before the break, which tied for the worst record in the Majors.
- + The Royals win pct. has improved from .392 before the break to .600 since, for a difference of +.208, best in MLB.
- + The Royals are 8-4-1 in 13 series since the All-Star break after going 9-19-3 in 31 sets in the 1st half...their 8 series wins since the All-Star break are tied for 2nd most in the American League, trailing only the Red Sox (9).
- + Only three American League teams have a better run diff. than the Royals (+15) in the 2nd half: the Red Sox (+72), Tigers (+46) and Rays (+21).

**PITCHING PROPS:** The Royals have allowed 3 runs or fewer in 11 of their last 14 games, including each of the 1st 5 games on this trip, during which they’ve allowed a total of 11 runs.

- + During the Royals active 5-series win streak, which began on Aug. 14, the starting rotation ranks 3rd in the American League with a 2.82 ERA (26 ER in 83.0 IP) and the bullpen has a 3.24 ERA (18 ER in 50.0 IP), 6th best in the AL.

**MONTHLY MATTERS:** The Royals lost 8 of their 1st 11 games in August but have won 13 of the last 15 to improve to 16-10, marking their most wins in a month this season, besting their 13-14 record in June...it’s their most wins in any calendar month since last August (16-12), and a win today to end the month would mark their most in August since 2016 (20-9).

- + The Royals in August rank 2nd in the AL in slugging pct. (.426) and OPS (.755) and are tied for 2nd in runs per game (4.96), trailing only Boston in all three categories.
- + On Tuesday, baseball writers and broadcasters will vote for Player and Pitcher of the Month for August in each league, and there’s a good chance the Royals will be well represented on the American League ballot.
- + **Jac Caglianone** leads the AL this month in batting average (.418), slugging pct. (.692), OPS (1.128) and RBI (26).
- + **Noah Cameron** is 4-0 in 5 August starts and ranks among the AL leaders (min. 5 GS) in wins (2nd), innings (33.2, 2nd), opponents’ avg. (.155, 2nd) and ERA (1.87, 4th).

**SOUTHPAW STORY:** The Royals are 13-28 (.317) in 41 games vs. left-handed starting pitchers, which is the 3rd-worst mark in the Majors, but they have won their last 4 games vs. southpaw starters dating back to Aug. 18 vs. the Athletics.

- + Lefty starters own a 3.12 ERA (76 ER in 219.0 IP) vs. KC and have allowed 3 earned runs or fewer in 37 of 41 starts.
- + Royals left-handed batters have hit 17 homers vs. left-handed pitchers, 3rd most in the American League, trailing the Yankees (26) and A’s (19)...**Jac Caglianone** is responsible for 7 of those left-on-left home runs, 5th most in the American League.

**DAILY DOUBLE:** **Salvador Perez** had 2 doubles yesterday to run his season total to 21, becoming the seventh Royals player with 20 doubles this year, most in the Majors...the Cubs, Twins and Rockies have six players with 20 doubles.

- + The Royals lead the Majors with 247 doubles, 2 more than the Rockies and Red Sox (245).
- + The Royals are attempting to lead the Majors in doubles for just the sixth time in franchise history, following 1977 (299), 1978 (305), 1982 (295), 1990 (316) and 1992 (284).

**ROAD WORK:** The Royals wrap their penultimate road trip of the season today, a 6-game stretch at the Blue Jays (2-1) and Guardians (2-0)...they have already clinched a winning trip (4-1) for just the second time this season and their first since going 4-2 in Sacramento and Seattle from April 28-May 3.

- + The Royals have won 6 of their last 8 road games on the heels of a 7-game road skid, and they have won 3 straight road series after being winless (0-7-2) in their previous 9.
- + The Royals have won 3 consecutive road series for the first time in four years, since June 17-July 3, 2022...a win today would mark a 4-game road win streak, which would be their longest since a 5-game run from June 8-20, 2025.

**ON DECK:** The Royals today will close the book on August, and will fly to Kansas City tonight to enjoy tomorrow’s off day...Tuesday night marks the start of a 9-game homestand, followed by a 9-game road trip and a season-ending 6-game stay, which represents the final 24 games of the season.

**FINAL THOUGHTS:** The Royals are 17-26 (.395) this season in 43 series finales but have won each of their last 4 finales, during which they’ve outscored opponents 33-11 (+22).

**CENTRAL STATION:** The Royals are 23-22 against American League Central teams this season but they’ve won 10 of the last 13 intra-division games, including each of their last 5.

- + After today, the Royals will have only 6 games left vs. the American League Central, and they’ll all come on the final homestand vs. the White Sox and these Guardians.

**EN GUARD!:** The Royals have outscored the Guardians 11-3 (+8) in the 1st 2 games this weekend, and have already clinched a series victory for just the fifth time in their last 28 visits to Cleveland dating back to 2016...a win today would mark only the Royals 3rd series sweep in Cleveland (min. 3 games) and the first in 23 years, since June 24-26, 2003.

- + The Royals have won the season series vs. Cleveland just once in the last 10 years (since 2016), and that came in 2024 (8-5)...they are 5-4 vs. the Guardians this year, and can clinch the season series with 2 wins in their remaining 4 games, including today, plus the final series of the regular season at Kauffman Stadium from Sept. 25-27.
- + They have a 3.74 ERA (33 ER in 70.1 IP) vs. Cleveland this season and have allowed 3 runs or fewer in 7 of 9 games.

**SETH LUGO** is making his 151st career start (388th outing) today vs. the Guardians in Cleveland...he’s in his 11th Major League season and third with Kansas City, after spending seven seasons with the Mets (2016-22) and one with the Padres (2023).

- + Originally signed a two-year contract with the Royals in December 2023, but in July 2025, he signed a two-year extension through 2027, with a vesting option for 2028.
- + Missed one turn in the rotation while on the Concussion Injured List from June 12-19.

**WINNER WINNER:** Seth earned his 2nd win in his last 4 starts and his 6th of the season in this road trip opener on Tuesday in Toronto, where he spun 5.0 innings of 1-run ball in the Royals 5-3 victory which extended their win streak to a season-high 9 straight games...the only run he allowed came in the 1st inning, when with 1 out and the bases loaded, he yielded a sacrifice fly to **Jesús Sánchez** before striking out **Ernie Clement** to end the threat...he faced only 3 batters over the minimum from the 2nd through 5th innings, scattering just 4 hits and inducing an inning-ending double play in the 4th...he exited with the Royals ahead 4-1 and Kansas City later tacked on an insurance run in the top of the 9th, after which Toronto rallied for 2 runs in the bottom half, but the game ended when **Isaac Collins** assisted in throwing out **Nathan Lukes** at second base, as he tried to extend his 2-run single into a double.

- + Snapped a stretch of 4 starts to begin August in which he allowed 18 runs in 21.2 IP.

**A STRANGE AUGUST:** Over 5 starts this month, Lugo has pitched to a 6.41 ERA (19 ER in 26.2 IP), more than 2 runs higher than his 4.32 ERA (16 ER in 33.1 IP) in 6 July starts...he’s yielded 5 runs in 3 of his 5 starts this month, despite showing improvements in his walks and home runs allowed since the start of the season.

- + Seth has allowed just 1 home run in his last 8 starts since July 17 (45.2 IP), after yielding 15 homers over his 1st 19 starts of the season (104.2 IP).
- + He’s walked just 2 batters in his last 4 starts, after walking 45 in his 1st 23 starts.
- + The Royals, have scored 27 runs in his last 4 starts since Aug. 8 vs. the Cubs, and have won each of those games, despite Lugo’s unsightly 5.82 ERA in that stretch.

**CONSISTENCY IS KEY:** Lugo’s 14 quality starts are tied for the 5th most in the American League this season, 4 behind leader **Michael Wacha**...since joining the Royals in 2024, he’s recorded a quality start in 48 of his 86 outings (55.8%)...over that span, 54 different pitchers have started at least 70 games, and his 55.8% rate of quality starts ranks T-13th among that group, trailing Philadelphia’s **Zack Wheeler** (69.2%).

- + His 48 overall quality starts since 2024 rank 6th in the Majors and 3rd in the AL.
- + Lugo’s 30 wins as a Royal are the 8th most in the American League since the start of 2024, trailing leaders **Carlos Rodón** and **Tarik Skubal** (38 each).
- + His 502.1 innings pitched since 2024 are the 4th most in the AL (9th in MLB).

**THE BEST OFFENSE IS A GOOD DEFENSE:** Seth has benefited from the Royals impressive defense this season, which ranks T-6th in the Majors with 18 Outs Above Average (per *Baseball Savant*), including 30 OAA from the infield alone, which leads all American League infield defenses...it’s for this reason that he’s successfully induced 18 double plays in 27 starts this year, 2 behind **Braxton Ashcraft** for the MLB lead...since joining the Royals in 2024, his 45 double plays induced rank 6th in the Majors.

- + On July 28 in Minnesota, he became the first Royal to induce at least 4 groundball double plays in a game since **Jason Vargas** (4) on June 2, 2017 vs. Cleveland...it was the 22nd such instance in club history, and he was the 17th different player to do so.
- + He’s recorded 6 pickoffs since the start of last season, after not having any pickoffs over the first nine years of his career...his 6 pickoffs in this span are tied for the 3rd most in the AL, behind only **Max Fried** (9) and **Gavin Williams** (7).
- + Lugo was named a *Rawlings* Gold Glove Award winner in 2024, becoming the first Royals pitcher to win the award since **Bret Saberhagen** in 1989.

**IN FOR A TREAT:** Lugo has started some of the craziest and most memorable games of the season, including 5 games that have been decided in extras...his 5 starts in extra-inning games are tied for the 3rd most in the Majors and trail **Freddy Peralta**, who has started 7 extra-inning games for the Mets and Rays...Royals Hall of Famer **Mark Gubicza** started a club-record 7 extra-inning games in 1989.

- + The Royals are 14-13 in his 27 starts this year, but have held a lead in 19 of his games.

**ROAD WOES:** Seth has made 13 road starts this season, pitching to a 5.35 ERA (41 ER in 69.0 IP)...he’s been hit hard in 6 of his last 10 starts on the road, allowing at least 5 runs in those outings—including 2 of his last 3 road games—after starting the season with a 1.42 ERA (3 ER in 19.0 IP) in his 1st 3 starts away from Kauffman Stadium.

- + He’s recorded at least 5.0 innings in 10 of his 13 road starts this season and in 33 of his 41 road starts since 2024, which are tied for 10th most in the AL in that span.
- + Since last season, 11 of his 25 road outings have been quality starts and he’s recorded at least 6.0 innings in 13 of 25 starts...the Royals are 12-13 in those games.

**KEEP YOUR GUARD UP:** Today will mark Lugo’s 7th career appearance (6th start) vs. the Guardians, who he’s gone 2-1 against with a 3.90 ERA (13 ER in 30.0 IP) and 28 strikeouts...he last faced them in Kansas City almost four months ago, on May 7, when he allowed 4 runs on 7 hits and 4 walks in 4.0 innings of an 8-5 Royals loss.

- + Is seeking his 1st win vs. an AL Central team since Sept. 4, 2024 vs. Cleveland...in 16 starts vs. the division since his last win, he’s 0-8 with a 5.84 ERA (53 ER in 81.2 IP).

**KANSAS CITY ROYALTY:** Since joining the Royals prior to the start of the 2024 season, Lugo has gone 30-23 (.566) with a 3.82 ERA (213 ER in 502.1 IP), which is the 11th-lowest ERA in the American League over this stretch (min. 400.0 IP).

- + In the 58-season history of the Royals, 36 different pitchers have made at least 75 starts with the club, and among that group, Lugo’s 3.82 ERA ranks 13th lowest.
