Multiple Homers

Ronald Acuña Jr. and Austin Riley each hit home runs for Atlanta yesterday, the former in the third inning and the latter in the seventh.

The Braves fell to 43-10 (.811) when hitting multiple home runs in a game, still the best winning percentage in the NL and the third-best in baseball behind New York-AL (.885) and Tampa Bay (.878).

The club is 4-3 in its last seven games when hitting at least two homers after winning 10 consecutive games when doing so from July 19-August 6.

TODAY'S GAME: The Atlanta Braves and Philadelphia Phillies today continue a four-game wraparound series with the ninth of 13 scheduled meetings...Atlanta swept Philadelphia in three games here at Citizens Bank Park from April 17-19 and took two-of-three at Truist Park from April 24-26.

 These two teams played six games in a 10-day span from April 17-26, but hadn't seen each other since...The Braves and Phillies on Friday began a stretch wherein they will play seven games in a 10-day span to complete their season slate.

 This is Atlanta's second wraparound series of the season after dueling the New York Mets in the same fashion at Truist Park from July 3-6...The two teams split that series.

 The Braves went just 5-8 in 13 games against the Phillies last year, dropping the season set against Philadelphia for the first time since the 2019 season...Atlanta can secure the season series for the sixth time in seven seasons with a win today.

FACING NOLA: Right-hander Aaron Nola is set to start against the Braves for the 40th time in his career, easily the most among active pitchers...The second-place hurler in that regard was yesterday's Philadelphia starter, Zack Wheeler (34 starts).

 The last player to reach the 40-start milestone against the Braves was Fernando Valenzuela, who took exactly 40 turns across his 17-season major-league career from 1980-1997.

 In his 39 previous starts against the Braves, the 6-foot-2, 200-pounder has gone 17-12 with a 3.80 ERA (101 ER/239.0 IP)...He faced Atlanta on April 26 at Truist Park and surrendered six runs, all earned, across 4.2 innings...He conceded a pair of home runs in the contest.

TYLER MAHLE: Today will make his 25th start of the season, and his sixth since joining Atlanta via trade on August 2...Since his acquisition, the Newport Beach, CA, native has pitched to a 1.48 ERA (5 ER/30.1 IP) – the fifth-best mark in the majors (min. 5 starts).

 His ERA since the deadline is the best of any starter that was dealt (min. 5 starts)...The only starters with lower ERAs in that time are Blake Snell (LAD, 0.93), Cal Quantrill (TEX, 1.18), Jesús Luzardo (PHI, 1.32) and Reid Detmers (LAA, 1.46).

 Mahle's 1.48 ERA through five starts with Atlanta is the lowest by any Brave since Aaron Harang pitched to a 0.85 mark (3 ER/31.2 IP) through five turns in 2014.

 MLB-wide, the last player to record at least 30 strikeouts, five-or-fewer walks and a 1.50 ERA-or-lower through his first five starts with a team was Sonny Gray (STL, 2024)...Mahle is the only player to do so in the modern-era history of the franchise.

 Mahle has made five prior starts against the Phillies, going 1-2 with a 3.80 ERA (10 ER/23.2 IP)...He has already faced Philadelphia twice this season while with San Francisco (4.22 ERA).

RONALD ACUÑA JR.: Last night belted his 15th home run of the season in the third inning off Philadelphia starter Zack Wheeler...The longball marked the fifth time that Acuña Jr. has taken Wheeler deep, tied for the most of any MLB hitter...Cody Bellinger has also tagged him five times.

 The home run traveled 450 feet, his longest home run of the season and deepest since a 451-footer on September 28, 2025 versus Pittsburgh.

 Since Acuña Jr.'s debut during the 2018 season, his 27 home runs of at least 450 feet are the most in Major League Baseball...Dating to the beginning of the Statcast era (2015), those 27 home runs are the most in the National League and third most in MLB behind Giancarlo Stanton (37) and Aaron Judge (32).

 Since the beginning of play on August 28, Acuña Jr.'s batting average is the highest in Major League Baseball (min. 25 AB)...The stretch marks the first time he's batted .480-or-higher in an eight-game span since June 13-21, 2025.

500 RBI: Ronald Acuña Jr.'s home run last night signified his 500th career RBI...Since the 2017 season, Ozzie Albies (650), Austin Riley (548) and Matt Olson (515) have also accumulated 500 RBI with the team.

 Atlanta is the only major-league club with at least four 500-RBI players in that span... Only three other teams can claim multiple such players: Houston (3; Altuve, Alvarez, Bregman), Philadelphia (2; Harper, Schwarber) and New York-AL (2, Judge, Stanton).

BULLPEN: Left-handed relievers Ray Kerr and Brent Suter last night combined to post 4.1 innings of scoreless relief, allowing just one hit apiece...Left-hander Martín Pérez started for Atlanta as the team fielded southpaws exclusively.

 Braves relievers covered at least 4.1 scoreless innings for the 10th time this season, tied for the third most such efforts in the majors...Milwaukee (13) and Pittsburgh (11) are the only clubs with more.

 The team has garnered at least 3.0 scoreless innings from its 'pen on 44 occasions, the most in Major League Baseball.

WITHIN THE DIVISION: Atlanta enters today's game against Philadelphia with the best intradivision record in Major League Baseball (29-15, .659)...The Milwaukee Brewers rank second at 25-14 (.641).

 The Braves' .659 intradivisional winning percentage would finish as the team's fifth-best in the Divisional Era (since 1969)...The club finished with higher marks in 1993 (.705), 1999 (.686), 2023 (.673) and 2004 (.671).

 Including tonight's game, Atlanta has eight games remaining against NL East foes: five against Philadelphia and three against Miami...The Braves are 6-2 (.750) versus the Phillies and 8-2 (.800) versus the Marlins this season.
