LOCK IN 2027 TICKETS NOW: D-backs 2027 Advantage Memberships feature Postseason ticket priority, along with discounted ticket plans, preferred seat priority and more, and are available now by placing a deposit at dbacks.com/membership...the 2027 schedule is packed with fan favorites and holiday staples including Mother's Day in May, Father's Day in June and the 4th of July, monthly NL West matchups and exciting Interleague action.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are 5-2 in their last 7 games and 15-7 in their last 22 games.

- The D-backs' 15 wins since July 9 are tied for second most in the Majors (also: Braves), behind the Red Sox (19).
- The D-backs are 5-2 in their last 7 home games, lead the Majors in OPS (.863) and own the third-best OBP (.368) and SLG (.496).
- The D-backs, who have 10 straight NL West games, are 14-11 overall vs. Padres (4-4), Dodgers (5-5) and Rockies (5-2) this season.
- **James McCann's** 8 consecutive games with 1+ RBI tied the D-backs' all-time record (also: Luis Gonzalez from June 3-11, 2022 and Paul Goldschmidt from June 1-8, 2013).
 - No catcher has recorded 1+ RBI in 9 straight games since Mike Piazza's 15-gamer from June 14-July 2, 2000.
- **Ryan Waldschmidt** has hit safely in 11 of his last 13 games at a .390 clip (16-for-41)/.956 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer, 4 RBI.
- **Brandyn Garcia** is scoreless in 20 of his last 21 games, going 0-0 with a career-best 3 saves, 1.04 ERA (3 R-2 ER in 17.1 IP), opponent .119 AVG (7-for-59)/.344 OPS, 0.63 WHIP, 4 walks and 25 strikeouts.

- LAST GAME:** The D-backs lost 9-4 vs. Padres last night.
- **Nolan Arenado** hit a 2-run homer (16) in the seventh inning to make it an 8-2 game.
 - **James McCann** extended his hitting streak to 10 games with a 2-run homer in the seventh inning to make it an 8-4 score.
 - **Lars Nootbaar** drew 2 walks in his D-back debut as DH...became the first D-back since 2008 (ninth D-back ever) to record 2 walks in his club debut (last: Adam Dunn on Aug. 12, 2008 @ Rockies).
 - **Geraldo Perdomo** singled twice to extend to a 5-game hitting streak, with 2+ hits in 4 of those.
 - **Paul Sewald** (1.0 IP) and **Gerardo Carrillo** (1.0 IP) combined to post 2.0 hitless innings (0 BB, 2 K).

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled LHP **Philip Abner** from Triple-A Reno, reinstated C **Gabriel Moreno** from the Paternity List, placed RHP **Ryan Thompson** on the 15-day Injured List (strained lower back) and optioned C **Adrian Del Castillo** to Reno.

- FARMHANDS AWARDS:** The D-backs named High-A Hillsboro C **Carlos Virahonda** and Single-A Visalia RHP **Dean Livingston** the organization's Minor League Player and Pitcher of the Month for July.
- In 18 games with the Hops, Virahonda hit .304 (17-for-56)/1.058 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers, 11 RBI and 7 walks.
 - In 4 starts with the Rawhide, Livingston went 1-1 with a 1.83 ERA (4 ER in 19.2 IP), opponent .211 AVG (15-for-71), 0.97 WHIP, 4 walks and 16 strikeouts.
 - DSL D-backs Red RHP **Jeyver Manaure** was named the Dominican Summer League (Rookie) Pitcher of the Month by Minor League Baseball.
 - In 4 starts went 3-0 with a 0.45 ERA (6 R-1 ER in 20.0 IP), opponent .123 (9-for-73), 0.55 WHIP, 2 walks and 17 strikeouts.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are third in the NL Wild Card race, 5.0 games behind the Cubs, 1.0 game behind the Phillies and 1.0 game ahead of the Padres.

HOME SWEET HOME: The D-backs' .582 home win pct. (32-22) is fifth in the NL, behind the Braves (.649, 37-20), Brewers (.638, 37-21), Marlins (.596, 34-23) and Dodgers (.589, 33-23).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The D-backs have won or split 6 of their last 7 series (2-2 @ Padres, 3-0 @ Dodgers, 2-1 vs. Cardinals, 2-1 vs. Athletics, 1-2 @ Nationals, 2-1 @ Pirates, 2-1 @ Guardians).
*Does not include the 1-game makeup win on July 23 @ Cardinals.

RUNS ON THE BOARD: Since the All-Star Break, the D-backs' 101 runs are tied for second in the NL (also: Cubs), behind the Padres.

STARTING PITCHERS: D-backs starting pitchers, in their last 8 bids, have a 2.49 ERA (17 R-13 ER in 47.0 IP), 13 walks and 32 strikeouts.

'PEN SPOTLIGHT: Brandyn Garcia is scoreless in 19 homes game, going 0-0 with an opponent .115 AVG (6-for-52)/.298 OPS, 3 walks and 14 strikeouts.

- Since being acquired in July of 2025, has not allowed an earned run in 24 home games (1 R-0 ER in 21.1 IP), going 0-1 with an opponent .143 AVG (10-for-70)/.335 OPS, 3 walks and 20 strikeouts.

WINNING VS. NL WEST: The D-backs' .647 division win pct. (22-12) is second in MLB, behind the Braves (.657, 23-12), ahead of the Brewers (.645, 20-11).

- The D-backs are 12-6 (.667) at home vs. NL West, tied for the NL's best division home win pct. along with the Braves and tied for fourth-best in the Majors (also: Braves and Yankees).

MCCANN STREAKING: James McCann's 10-game hitting streak, which is tied for the second-longest of his career, features a .528 average (19-for-36)/1.469 OPS with 2 doubles, 4 homers, 15 RBI and 1 walk.

- Is 4 shy of his career-best 14-gamer from July 16-Aug. 4, 2017.

VS. PADRES: The D-backs split their first 2 series vs. Padres (3-3): 1-1 in Mexico City Series from April 25-26 and 2-2 from July 6-9 @ Padres.
