Trade Acquisitions

LHP Brent Suter earned his first win for Atlanta yesterday after pitching 2.1 scoreless innings of relief. The Braves acquired him from the Angels at the deadline earlier this month.

Atlanta's three trade acquisitions to join the major league club – Suter, RH Tyler Mahle and OF Lane Thomas – have combined to produce 1.7 bWAR over 29 total games for the club.

Mahle and Suter, in particular, have combined to pitch to a 3-1 record and a 1.42 ERA (6 ER/38.0 IP) in 10 appearances.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Rockies today conclude a three-game weekend series with the sixth and final scheduled meeting between the clubs this season...The two played three games at Coors Field, May 1 to May 3.

 Atlanta rallied with a pair of runs in yesterday's eighth inning to claim a come-from-behind win, 2-1, and improve to a perfect 5-0 against Colorado this season...The Braves last swept a season set against a fellow NL club in 2023, when they also went a perfect 7-0 versus the Rockies.

 Atlanta went 4-2 in six games against Colorado last season, and is 25-6 (.807) against the Rockies dating to the start of the 2022 season...The Braves' .807 winning percentage over the Rockies in that span is the best by any fellow National League club.

 The Braves have now won five straight series against the Rockies here at Truist Park dating to 2022...Atlanta was just 2-10 versus Colorado over the first 12 games between the clubs here after the stadium opened in 2017, but has gone 12-3 in the 15 games here since.

 RH Mason Adams is set today to make just the second start of his major league career after debuting last Tuesday at Washington...The 6-foot-1, 190-pound Florida native went 4.0 innings in his debut start, allowing three hits and one run in a no-decision...He fanned five...The right-hander was originally selected by the Chicago White Sox in the 13th round of 2022 First-Year Player Draft, and Colorado acquired him at the trade deadline earlier this month in exchange for Brenton Doyle.

TYLER MAHLE: Makes his fifth start for the Braves after Atlanta acquired him at the trade deadline, and has combined to allow just four runs over 23.2 total innings (1.52 ERA) over his first four turns...The Braves acquired him from the Giants on August 2 in exchange for RHP Anthony Molina.

 Mahle is one of just three pitchers in franchise history to pitch to an ERA of 1.52 or better and fan at least 23 batters over his first four starts for the club, joining Reynaldo Lopez (0.72 ERA, 24 SO) and Ben Sheets (1.46 ERA, 23 SO)...Mahle's five walks in that span is the lowest of that trio.

 His 1.52 ERA with Atlanta ranks seventh in the majors among pitchers with as many starts since the deadline...It leads the Braves' starting staff since that date, while his 23 strikeouts trail just Chris Sale's 34.

 The 6-foot-3, 212-pound Californian has made 11 starts between the Giants and Braves since returning from the injured list (strained left hamstring) on June 24, and he has pitched to a 4-3 record with a 2.92 ERA (20 ER/61.2 IP) in that span.

 Mahle has made eight prior starts against the Rockies in his career, and enters play 3-1 with a 4.60 ERA (23 ER/45.0 IP) all time against them.

HIGH-WATER MARK: Atlanta's win yesterday afternoon pushed the club to a season-best 26 games over .500 at 81-55 (.596)...The Braves currently have the third-best record in all of baseball.

 Atlanta has also won six straight games, the longest active winning streak in baseball...The Braves have had just one longer winning streak this season, taking eight straight victories from July 29 through August 6.

 Yesterday's win tied the Braves with the Los Angeles Dodgers for the second-best record in the National League...Atlanta went 5-1 versus the Dodgers this season.

MICHAEL HARRIS II: Plated Atlanta's only two runs of the game yesterday afternoon, lining an eighth-inning double that scored the tying and go-ahead runs...In four games, three starts, against Colorado this season, he has hit .500/.500/1.167 with two doubles, two homers, four runs and seven RBI.

 He has delivered the game-winning RBI in three of Atlanta's five victories over Colorado this season, including twice in the club's final half inning at the plate...Prior to last night's eighth-inning heroics, he doubled in the first run of Friday's game that Atlanta never trailed, and hit a pinch-hit, go-ahead, two-run homer in the top of the ninth on May 1 at Coors Field.

 In 27 career games versus the Rockies, Harris II is now batting .373/.377/.618 with 10 doubles, five homers, 24 RBI and a .995 OPS.

MICHAEL HARRIS III: His eighth-inning double yesterday afternoon was his 16th two-base hit since the All-Star break, two more than any other player in baseball across that stretch...His 23 total extra-base hits since the break rank third, behind just Pete Crow-Armstrong (30) and Wilyer Abreu (24).

 On the year, he's totaled 32 doubles, knotted with four others, including teammate Matt Olson, for the second most in MLB, only behind Alec Burleson (STL, 33).

 Harris II has already set a career high with 22 home runs on the year, and he sits just one double shy of the career-best 33 two-base hits he tallied in 2023.

HOME WORK: Atlanta's win yesterday moved the Braves to 47-23 (.671) here at Truist Park this season, the best home winning percentage in baseball...Atlanta's 47 total wins at home are tied with Milwaukee (47-24, .662) for the most.

 The Braves are 20-5 (.800) here at home since the All-Star break, and have lost just one series at Truist Park in that span.

 Atlanta is on pace for 54 wins at home this season, and is looking for the fourth 50-win home campaign in Truist Park history.

- Has hit safely in 12 consecutive games against Colorado dating to June 17, 2023... In that span, he is slashing .500/.593/.705 (22-for-44)...Also has an active 17 game on-base streak against Colorado dating to June 5, 2022.
- In Friday night’s game, scored three runs for the second time this season (also: May 19 at Miami) and the 36th time in his career...Also recorded his first three-hit game since September 26, 2025 versus Pittsburgh.
- With his stolen bases on August 23–25, swiped a bag in consecutive games for the first time since June 3–4...Has swiped four bags in his last 12 games dating to August 16 after failing to steal a bag in the 20 previous games (June 7–August 15).
- Slugged his 13th homer of the season and the 199th home run of his career on August 15.
- Extended his franchise record with his 40th career leadoff home run and third of the season August 15...Since debuting in 2018, has the fourth-most leadoff jacks in MLB.
- Hit two homers August 6, his second multi-homer game of the season and 16th of his career.
- Activated from the 10–day IL on July 27 (strained left hamstring)...Slashing .212/.279/.390 (25-for-118) with a .669 OPS, six home runs and 13 runs scored in 30 game since.
- Homered in four straight games from May 28–31, the first time since May 14–17, 2023...The only player in the modern era with five homers, four stolen bags and seven walks in a four-game span.
