BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles began their 73rd season on Thursday with a 2-1 win over the Minnesota Twins...March 26 was the earliest the O's have ever played a game in their history.

👉 The Birds improved to 48-25 on Opening Day since the franchise moved to Baltimore prior to the 1954 campaign...That .658 winning percentage since moving to Charm City is the best in the majors during that time.

👉 The Orioles are now 49-24 (.671) in Home Openers, including 34-13 (.723) when the Home Opener is also Opening Day...The O's have won five consecutive Home Openers.

👉 **Tyler O'Neill** had his major league record of homering in six consecutive Opening Days dating back to 2020 snapped on Thursday...He did score a run, becoming the 12th player since 1900 to score in at least seven straight Opening Days, joining Alex Rodriguez (9, 2003-12), Ben Zobrist (8, 2011-19), Rickie Weeks (8, 2006-13), Dean Palmer (8, 1992-2000), Will Clark (8, 1986-93), Babe Ruth (8, 1928-35), Austin Jackson (7, 2010-16), Vladimir Guerrero (7, 1999-2006), Gary Sheffield (7, 1995-2002), Barry Larkin (7, 1995-2002), and Ty Cobb (7, 1910-17).

THE WIZARD OF BAZ: The Orioles and **Shane Baz** agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension yesterday that covers the 2026-30 seasons...Baz, who is scheduled to make his Orioles debut in a start tomorrow, was acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in December in exchange for four minor leaguers and a draft pick...He made a career-high 31 starts for the Rays a year ago and has been the starting pitcher in all 124 career professional appearances.

ROGERS THAT: **Trevor Rogers** made his first career Opening Day start and tossed 7.0 scoreless innings, scattering three hits and three walks with five strikeouts...He became the eighth Oriole (ninth occurrence) to throw at least 7.0 scoreless innings on Opening Day, including the first since John Means on April 2, 2021 at Boston (W, 7.0 IP, 1 H, 0 BB, 5 K)...The last Oriole to accomplish the feat at Camden Yards before Rogers on Thursday was Dylan Bundy on March 29, 2018 vs. Minnesota (ND, 7.0 IP, 5 H, 1 BB, 7 K).

👉 Rogers earned Most Valuable Oriole last year after going 9-3 with a 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) in 18 starts...His ERA was the lowest mark by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history and marked the third-lowest ERA by an Oriole through his first 18 starts of a season, behind Milt Pappas (1.77 ERA, 1965) and Jim Palmer (1.78 ERA, 1975).

OPENING DAY RUTSCH: **Adley Rutschman** is now 12-for-16 with one double, three home runs, seven runs scored, nine RBI, and two walks in his first four career Opening Days...He is one of four players since 1900 to reach base 14+ times through his first four career Opening Days, joining Corey Patterson (15 TOB, 2002-05), Barry Bonds (14 TOB, 1987-90), and Dee Fondy (14 TOB, 1951-54)...His 12 hits are the most through a player's first four Opening Day games since 1900, ahead of Don Baylor (11, 1973-76), Fondy (11, 1951-54), and Frank Isbell (11, 1901-06).

HELs BELLS: **Ryan Helsley** recorded the fastest pitch of the MLB season on Thursday, a 101.9 mph ball to Matt Wallner in the ninth inning...He's the fifth Oriole in the *Statcast* era (since 2015) to hit at least 101.0 mph, joining Félix Bautista (2022 & 2023), Grayson Rodriguez (2023), Shintaro Fujinami (2023), and Kevin Gausman (2015)...In his career, Helsley has hit 102.0 mph 100 times, including a career-high 104.2 mph on September 27, 2022.

WELCOME TO BIRDLAND: Eight players on the Opening Day roster will be making their O's debut or did so on Thursday: **Blaze Alexander**, **Pete Alonso**, **Chris Bassitt**, **Shane Baz**, **Ryan Helsley**, **Anthony Nunez**, **Leody Taveras**, and **Taylor Ward**...Nunez will be making his major league debut with his first appearance.

👉 Alonso, Bassitt, Helsley, and Taveras signed as free agents, Alexander (AZ), Baz (TB), and Ward (LAA) were acquired via trade during the offseason, while Nunez (NYM) was acquired via trade at last year's trade deadline.

FOR THE BOYS: **Craig Albarnaz** became the eighth Orioles manager, full-time or interim, to win his debut with the team...He was hired to be the 22nd manager in Orioles history and 19th full-time manager on October 27, 2025... "Alby" joins Baltimore from the Cleveland Guardians where he served as bench coach (2024) and associate manager (2025) under Stephen Vogt, who won American League Manager of the Year both seasons...Albarnaz also worked under Gabe Kapler with the San Francisco Giants as bullpen coach from 2020-23 after spending his first five seasons as a minor league coach in various roles in the Tampa Bay Rays organization.

👉 New to the coaching staff is **Jason Bourgeois** (First Base Coach), **Miguel Cairo** (Infield Coach), **Hank Conger** (Bullpen Coach), **Donnie Ecker** (Bench Coach), **Dustin Lind** (Hitting Coach), **Brady North** (Assistant Hitting Coach), and **Joe Singley** (Field Coordinator/Catching Coach).

👉 **Buck Britton** (Third Base Coach), **Drew French** (Pitching Coach), **Ryan Klimek** (Pitching Strategy Coach), and **Mitch Plassmeyer** (Assistant Pitching Coach) all return to the staff.

SEEING DOUBLE: The Orioles and Twins are meeting for the first three of six games against each other this season this weekend at Oriole Park...The clubs match up at Target Field from August 10-12...Last year, Baltimore was swept in the season series (0-6) by Minnesota for the fourth time since the Twins moved to the Twin Cities in 1961, joining 2019 (0-6), 2015 (0-7), and 2007 (0-7)...The O's went 13-6 (.684) against Minnesota from 2022-24.

👉 **Ryan Mountcastle** has hit in 17 straight games against the Twins, the longest hitting streak against Minnesota in team history...Mountcastle's stretch began May 4, 2022, and he's slashing .400/.406/.677 (26-for-65) with nine doubles and three homers during that period.

👉 Twins Hall of Fame General Manager **Andy MacPhail**, who led Minnesota to two World Championships, served as Baltimore's President of Baseball Operations from 2007 to 2011.

👉 On April 15, 2000, **Cal Ripken, Jr.** singled at the Metrodome off Hector Carrasco for his 3,000th career hit.

👉 Former All-Star **Justin Morneau** is the only Twin to hit a home run onto Eutaw Street, which he did on July 25, 2004, off Daniel Cabrera.

QUICK HITS: Bradish is set to make his first start of the 2026 campaign...Made four Grapefruit League appearances, going 2-0 with a 2.35 ERA (4 ER/15.1 IP) and 12 strikeouts...In his final outing on March 22 vs. Washington at Camden Yards, Bradish earned the win after tossing 5.1 scoreless innings, scattering four hits and three walks with three strikeouts...He made six starts in his return from Tommy John surgery last season, going 1-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER/32.0 IP) on 23 hits (3 HR), 10 walks, and one hit batter with 47 strikeouts...Made his season debut on August 16 vs. Boston (L, 6.0 IP, 4 H, 2 ER, 2 HR, 0 BB, 10 K) and became the fifth Oriole (since 1954) to strike out at least 10 batters in his season debut.

PURPLE RAIN: Bradish is 0-1 with a 4.50 ERA (5 ER/10.0 IP) and 10 strikeouts in two career starts against Minnesota...He last faced the Twins on July 1, 2023, at Camden Yards and suffered the loss despite recording a quality start (6.0 IP, 7 H, 1 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 7 K).

👤 He is 3-1 with a 2.41 ERA (9 ER/33.2 IP) over six career starts (3 QS) against the AL Central and has gone 5.0+ innings, while allowing one run or fewer in each of his last three starts vs. the division.

ACE UP THE SLEEVE: Bradish has a 2.78 ERA (74 ER/240.0 IP) in 44 starts since the beginning of 2023...Among starting pitchers during that period, he has the sixth-lowest ERA in the majors (min. 200.0 IP) behind PIT's Paul Skenes (2.10), DET's Tarik Skubal (2.36), LAD's Blake Snell (2.53), LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto (2.67 ERA), and TB's Drew Rasmussen (2.74).

RIGHT SIDE, STRONG SIDE: Last season, Bradish limited right-handed hitters to a .157 (8-for-51) clip, permitting only one extra-base hit, a home run hit by BOS' Trevor Story on 8/26 in Bradish's season debut.

👤 Left-handed hitters went 15-for-64 (.234) with two doubles and two home runs off Bradish in 2025.

FRIENDLY CONFINES: In his last four starts at Camden Yards dating to June 14, 2024 vs. Philadelphia, Bradish has posted a 2.25 ERA (6 ER/24.0 IP) with 29 strikeouts while limiting the opposition to a .155 (13-for-84) average.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: In 2023, finished fourth in the AL Cy Young voting, the first Oriole to receive a Cy Young vote since Zack Britton in 2016...Went 12-7 with a 2.83 ERA (53 ER/168.2 IP), 168 strikeouts, and a 1.04 WHIP in 30 starts (18 QS)...Became the first qualified O's pitcher with a sub-3.00 ERA since Mike Mussina posted a 2.54 ERA (68 ER/241.0IP) in 1992.

👤 In 2022, made his MLB debut on April 29 vs. Boston (6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 2 ER, BB, 2 K).

👤 Earned his first career win on May 10 at St. Louis after pitching 7.0 innings, allowing two runs on four hits (1 HR) with a career-high 11 strikeouts...Became the first Oriole to pitch 7.0 innings with zero walks and 11 strikeouts since John Means threw a no-hitter on May 5, 2021 at Seattle...Was only the second pitcher in MLB history to have an outing with 11+ strikeouts and no walks in one of his first three career starts, joining WSH's Stephen Strasburg on June 8, 2010 vs. Pittsburgh (14 K).
