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BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles continue a nine-game road trip tonight against the Cardinals (1-0, 2 to play), Athletics (3 to play), and Rockies (3 to play)...The Birds are coming off a 2-4 homestand, having been swept by the Yankees before taking two of three from the Rays...The O's are in fourth place in the AL East and 2.5 games behind the Guardians for the final Wild Card spot.

- 🦅 Last night, the Birds matched a season high with 13 runs (also 6/5 at TOR), while their 16 hits were the most on the road since tallying 16 knocks on September 28, 2024 at Minnesota...The 13 runs were also the most scored by a visiting team at Busch Stadium since the Nationals scored 14 on July 27, 2024.
- 🦅 The 12-run margin of victory was Baltimore's largest since a 12-0 win on August 17, 2025 at Houston...It marked the O's largest margin of victory in 25 all-time matchups with the Cardinals, surpassing a 12-2 (+10) victory on August 8, 2014 at Camden Yards.
- 🦅 The Birds scored eight runs in the fifth inning, their most in a frame since scoring nine in the seventh inning on July 26, 2025 vs. Colorado.
- 🦅 **Pete Alonso** (4-for-4, 2B, HR, 2 R, 4 RBI) surpassed the 800-career RBI mark, becoming one of 26 active MLB players with 800+ RBI...LAD's Freddie Freeman leads all active players with 1,383 RBI...He registered four hits for the first time since August 26, 2025 vs. PHI (also 4 H), while his four RBI matched a season high (3x, last: 8/9 at TEX)...He is one of six players in MLB with two four-RBI games in August, joining AZ's Nolan Arenado, STL's Alec Burleson, KC's Jac Caglianone, BOS' Caleb Durbin, and STL's Jordan Walker.
- 🦅 Oriole pitching did not permit a walk for the ninth time this season (last: 8/5 vs. LAA).
- 🦅 Baltimore went 7-for-16 with runners in scoring position after going 5-for-41 (.122) in its previous seven games...The seven hits were the O's most with runners in scoring position since August 17, 2025 at Houston (also 7).
- 🦅 **Christian Encarnacion-Strand** blasted a 450 ft. home run at 111.8 mph, snapping an 0-for-16 skid...It was the second-hardest hit ball of his career, trailing a 113.3 mph long ball on March 31, 2024 vs. Washington.

POLAR VORTEX: In 21 career games at Busch Stadium, **Pete Alonso** is slashing .368/.467/.776 (28-for-76) with seven doubles, eight home runs, 21 runs, 18 RBI, and 11 walks.

- 🦅 Alonso has hit safely in each of his last 10 road games, batting .579 (22-for-38) with three doubles, six home runs, 14 RBI, and six walks against five strikeouts...It is tied for the third-longest active road hitting streak in MLB, trailing ATH's Tyler Soderstrom (12 G) and CIN's Blake Dunn (11 G).
- 🦅 He enters play today with 89 RBI, second in the AL behind HOU's Yordan Alvarez (91)...Alonso looks to become the eighth player in franchise history (since 1954) to lead the AL in RBI, joining Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961)...He also ranks among the AL in total bases (3rd, 254), home runs (4th, 31), slugging percentage (5th, .512), OPS (5th, .876), and runs scored (T-6th, 81).
- 🦅 Through 22 games in August, Alonso is slashing .398/.451/.723 (33-for-83) with three doubles, eight home runs, 20 RBI, and a 1.173 OPS...The .398 batting average would signal his highest in any month of his career (min. 25 AB in month), surpassing April 2025 (.358, 34-for-95)...His career high for hits in a month came in August 2025 (36).

PLAYING THE LONG GAME: The Orioles have homered in 13 straight games, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Cardinals and Yankees (both 8 G)...It marks Baltimore's longest streak since going deep in 16 straight from August 4-21, 2024.

- 🦅 Baltimore has homered in seven straight road games, one shy of their season-best eight-game run from April 17-May 2.
- 🦅 The O's have hit multiple home runs in seven of their last nine road games (19 HR total).
- 🦅 Overall, the Birds have hit 27 homers since August 9, second most in MLB behind the Cubs (30).

ACTION JACKSON: **Jackson Holliday** has hit safely in each of his last five road games since August 14 and is batting .379 (25-for-66) with five doubles, one home run, and 12 runs over his last 16 road games since July 22 (G1).

- 🦅 Among all MLB hitters with at least 40 at-bats on the road since July 22, Holliday's .379 batting average is tied for fourth highest behind teammate **Pete Alonso** (.431), NYM's Carson Benge (.400), and LAD's Freddie Freeman (.382).

'PEN PALS: **Cam Sanders** has not permitted a hit in each of his last five appearances, tied for the second-longest active streak in the majors behind NYM's Nate Lavender (6 G).

- 🦅 Sanders has not allowed a hit to any of the last 21 batters he has faced...According to *STATS Perform*, it is the longest active streak in MLB.
- 🦅 **Yennier Cano** has gone 44 consecutive appearances (33.2 IP) without allowing a home run...It is tied for the third-longest active streak among all MLB relievers behind MIL's Trevor Megill (60 G) and CLE's Colin Holderman (51 G).

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 41-45 (.477) in games decided by three runs or fewer, the fifth-most such games in the league this season and 20th in winning percentage in those situations this year...The club is 33-32 (.508) in games decided by two runs or fewer and 13-19 (.406) in one-run games...The team's winning percentage in one-run games is tied for the third lowest in the majors ahead of the Giants (11-23, .324) and Tigers (12-22, .353).

PINCH ME: The Orioles lead MLB with 34 pinch-hit RBI this season, ahead of the Nationals (27)...The O's are one of six teams in the majors this year with at least six pinch-hit home runs, led by the Nationals (8).

- 🦅 **Tyler O'Neill** is one of five players in the majors with at least three pinch-hit homers this year, along with CHC's Michael Conforto (4) and CWS' Randal Grichuk, MIA's Heriberto Hernández, and PHI's Derek Hill (all 3)...His three pinch-hit home runs are tied for the single-season franchise record (since 1954), joining Sam Horn (1991), Jim Dwyer (1986), Pat Kelly (1979), Sam Bowens (1967), and Whitey Herzog (1962).
- 🦅 **Jeremiah Jackson** leads all Orioles batters with six pinch-hit RBI this season.
- 🦅 The team record for most pinch-hit RBI in a season is 45 in 1982...Miami led the majors with 33 pinch-hit RBI in 2025.

QUICK HITS: Bradish is scheduled to make his 26th start of the season and 93rd of his career tonight at St. Louis...Made six starts in his return from Tommy John surgery last season, going 1-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER/32.0 IP) on 23 hits (3 HR), 10 walks, and one hit batter with 47 strikeouts...Acquired from Los Angeles-AL along with RHP Kyle Brnovich, RHP Isaac Mattson, and RHP Zach Peek in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019.

☞ Agreed to terms on a five-year contract with the O's on July 18, extending him through 2031.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss on August 20 vs. New York-AL after allowing a season-high-tying five runs (3 ER) in 5.2 innings on eight hits (2 HR) and two walks with five strikeouts...Threw 100 pitches, 60 strikes.

☞ Marked his third time allowing multiple home runs this season (last: 6/11 vs. SEA, 3 HR), including his second multi-homer outing against the Yankees (5/2 at NYY, 2 HR).

☞ His nine unearned runs allowed this season are a career high behind 2022 (4 UER).

THE REDBIRDS: Bradish is 1-0 with a 2.25 ERA (3 ER/12.0 IP) over two career starts opposite St. Louis, both of which came at Busch Stadium...Last faced the Cardinals on May 21, 2024 and didn't factor into the decision (5.0 IP, 1 ER, 4 H, BB, HBP, 6 K).

☞ Earned his first career win on May 10, 2022 at St. Louis (7.0 IP, 4 H, 2 ER, 1 HR, 0 BB, 11 K)...Became the second pitcher in MLB history to have an outing with 11 or more strikeouts and no walks in one of his first three career starts, joining WSH's Stephen Strasburg (6/8/10 vs. PIT, 14 K).

☞ Over 24 career Interleague starts, he is 6-6 with a 3.07 ERA (45 ER/132.0 IP)...Has suffered the loss in each of his last three Interleague games since June 28, 2026.

FIRST-INNING FOCUS: Bradish has allowed only two runs in the opening frame this season, during which opponents are slashing .183/.264/.268 (15-for-82) with four doubles, one home run, eight walks, and 30 strikeouts.

☞ His two runs allowed in the first inning this season are tied with three others for the second fewest in MLB (min. 15 GS) behind SD's Casey Mize (1).

SLIDE AWAY: Bradish's .517 slugging percentage on his slider is the fourth-highest mark in MLB (min. 100 AB ending in pitch) ahead of ATH's Jeffrey Springs (.626), CWS' Luis Castillo (.570), and Miles Mikolas (.547)...In 2025, he held a .156 slugging percentage on the pitch over six starts.

☞ Overall, his breaking balls (slider, curveball) own a negative five run value, which ranks in the bottom 14 percent of MLB... Opponents are slashing .230/.303/.447 (50-for-217) with 10 doubles, two triples, and 11 home runs on his breaking pitches.

WALK DON'T RUN: His 10.2 percent walk rate is the seventh-highest mark in MLB and is the highest mark of his career (9.2%, 2024)... However, holds a 7.0 percent walk rate (13 BB/187 BF) over his last eight starts since July 5 with one walk or fewer in four of those games.

☞ His 13 games with three or more walks are tied for second most among MLB starters ahead of TOR's Dylan Cease (15).

FOUR-SEAM FOCUS: Opponents are slashing .667/.700/.889 (6-for-9) with one triple off his four seamer this month after hitting .235/.235/.353 (4-for-17) with one triple on the pitch over four July starts...Bradish opened the season holding opponents to a .308/.400/.400 (20-for-65) slash line on his four seamer with three doubles and one home run over 17 starts from March-June.

BEHIND THE EIGHT BALL: Bradish owns a 55.7 percent first-pitch strike rate, the lowest mark in MLB among qualified pitchers with the next closest hurler being CHC's Shota Imanaga (57.1%)...Threw 16 of 25 (64.0%) first pitches for strikes in his last start on August 20 vs. New York-AL.
