AT A GLANCE: The Yankees continue their six-game road trip tonight with the first game of a three-game set at Baltimore (through Thurs.)...are 1-2 on the road trip after dropping two-of-three games at Toronto this past weekend...following this series, will return home for a 10-game homestand, featuring a three-game set vs. Toronto (Fri.-Sun.), a three-game series vs. Houston (8/25-27) and a four-game set vs. Boston (8/28-30).

- **Their 69-55 (.556) record is the second-best in the American League and the sixth-best in the Majors**, trailing only Milwaukee (77-48, .616), Tampa Bay (75-49, .605), Los Angeles-NL (75-51, .595), Atlanta (74-51, .592), and Chicago-NL (73-53, .579).
- Snapped their three-game losing streak (8/12-15) on Sunday at Toronto...was their longest losing streak since a seven-game streak from 6/25-7/1...are 15-11 in their last 26 games (since 7/19) and 19-13 in their last 32 games (since 7/9).
- **Have won three of their last five series (since 7/31) and have won or split eight of their last 11 series since 7/6 (are 6-3-2 in those series).**
- Have had 22 of their last 31 games decided by 2R-or-fewer (since 7/10), going 14-8 in those games...are 34-28 (.548) in games decided by 2R-or-fewer this season.

WHERE WE LEFT OFF: The Yankees defeated the Blue Jays, 4-3, in 10 innings on Sunday at Rogers Centre...**LHP Ryan Weathers** (7.1IP, 6H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 4K, 0HR) started and did not record a decision despite allowing only 1R/ER over 7.1IP...**DH Luis García Jr.** (1-for-3, 1RBI, 1BB, 1SF) reached base twice and drove in the club's first run with a go-ahead sac fly in the third inning...**2B/3B José Caballero** (1-for-2, 1R, 1RBI, 1BB, 1SB) reached base twice, scored the Yankees' first run in the third inning and hit a go-ahead RBI single in the seventh inning...**1B Ben Rice** (1-for-5, 1R, 1HR, 2RBI) hit his 33rd home run of the season with a go-ahead two-run HR in the 10th inning...**LF Heliot Ramos** (1-for-4, 1 double, 1BB, 1SB) and **SS George Lombard Jr.** (1-for-3, 1R, 1 double, 1BB, 1SB) each reached base twice...**RHP David Bednar** (1.2IP, 1R/0ER, 1BB, 1K, 1WP) earned his sixth win of the year...**LHP Tim Hill** (1.0IP, 1H, 1R/0ER) earned his sixth career save and second of the year.

WEATHERS REPORT: LHP Ryan Weathers allowed only 1R/ER over 7.1IP in a no-decision on Sunday at Toronto (6H, 1BB, 4K, 0HR)...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in nine of his last 11 starts (since 6/18), posting a 2.56 ERA (59.2IP, 17ER) with 59K during that span.
► Has gone undefeated in each of his last seven starts (since 7/10), going 2-0 with a 1.94 ERA (41.2IP, 9ER) over that span...has allowed 1R-or-fewer in six of his last seven starts...the Yankees are 6-1 in those starts.
► **Has tossed at least 5.0IP and has allowed 1R-or-fewer in each of his last five starts (since 7/25), matching the fifth-longest streak by a Yankees pitcher in franchise history...has gone 2-0 with a 0.85 ERA (31.2IP, 3ER) during that stretch.**

HIP HIP JOSÉ: INF/OF José Caballero reached base twice on Sunday at Toronto, scoring the club's first run in the third inning and hitting a go-ahead RBI single in the seventh inning...also stole his 30th base of the year in the third inning, marking his third straight season with at least 30SB (also 44SB in 2024 and 49SB in 2025)...is one of three Major League players to record at least 30SB in each of the last three seasons, joining teammate Jazz Chisholm Jr. and Kansas City's Bobby Witt Jr.
► Is hitting .320/.433/.600 (8-for-25) with 3R, 1 double, 2HR, 5RBI, 5BB and 7SB over his last 12 games (since 7/29).

FAST AND FURIOUS: Yankees baserunners stole four bases on Sunday at Toronto...have recorded 12SB in their last eight games (since 8/8)...their 120SB this season are the third-most in the AL and the seventh-most in the Majors...marks only the sixth time in the last 110 years (since 1917) the Yankees have recorded as many stolen bases through their first 124G of a season (also 121SB in 2011, 131SB in 2001, 128SB in 1998, 121SB in 1989 and 136SB in 1976).
► **INF Jazz Chisholm Jr. (32SB) and INF/OF José Caballero (30SB) are the first set of Yankees teammates in the last 24 years (since 2003) and the eighth in the last 112 years (since 1915) to each record at least 30SB in a single season.**

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK: INF Luis García Jr. reached base twice and drove in the club's first run on Sunday at Toronto with a go-ahead sac fly in the third inning...has hit .278/.310/.541 (111-for-399) with 51R, 23 doubles, 5 triples, 24HR, 79RBI, 19BB, 2SF and 45B in 115 games this season...ranks fifth in the Majors in slugging percentage, is tied for fourth in multi-HR games (four) and tied for ninth in RBI.
► Over his last 81 games (since 5/9), has batted .296/.329/.619 (86-for-291) with 37R, 17 doubles, 4 triples, 23HR, 63RBI, 15BB, 1SF and 25B...during that stretch, leads the Majors in RBI and SLG, ranks fourth in XBH (44), is tied for fifth in home runs and sixth in OPS (.948).
► Has batted .293/.321/.577 (99-for-338) with 23 doubles, 5 triples, 21HR and 15BB vs. right-handed pitchers this season.
► Has hit .314/.333/.529 (32-for-102) with 7 doubles, 5HR, 50RBI, 4BB and 2SF with runners in scoring position this year.

FOR STARTERS: Yankees starting pitchers have allowed 2R-or-fewer in 15 of their last 18 starts (since 7/28), including 1R-or-fewer in 13 of those starts, posting a 1.97 ERA (105.0IP, 23ER) during that span...have allowed 2R-or-fewer in 18 of their last 23 starts and 1R-or-fewer in 16 of those starts (since 7/22-G2), posting a 2.30 ERA (129.0IP, 33ER) with 144K during that span.

- **Have allowed 1ER-or-fewer in each of their last four starts (since 8/13) and six of their last seven starts (since 8/9).**
- **Have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 97 starts this season, their most such starts through their first 124 games of a season in franchise history** (previous: 96GS in 2021 and 2022)...have allowed 2R-or-fewer in 73 games this season, their second-most starts through their first 124 games of a season in franchise history, trailing only their 77 starts in 2022.
- Have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 29 of their last 33 starts (since 7/8), including 2R-or-fewer in 24 of those starts, posting a 2.72 ERA (179.0IP, 54ER) during that span.
- **Yankees starters own the best ERA in the Majors (3.38)**, rank third in strikeouts (694, first in AL), strikeout rate (25.2%, first in AL), K/9.0IP (9.35, first in AL), opponents' BA (.227, first in AL) and opponents' SLG (.372, second in AL), fourth in opponents' OPS (.663, second in AL) and HR/9.0IP (1.04, second in AL), fifth in opponents' OBP (.291, third in AL), sixth in K/BB (3.30, third in AL) and WHIP (1.16, fourth in AL), and seventh in BB/9.0IP (2.83, fourth in AL).

PITCH PERFECT: Yankees pitchers have posted a Major League-best 3.26 ERA (1,107.2IP, 401ER) this season (next: Milwaukee-3.46)...have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 15 of their last 23 games (since 7/22-G2), including 2R-or-fewer in 12 of those games, posting a 2.57 ERA (210.0IP, 60ER) during that stretch.

- Have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 20 of their last 31 games (since 7/10), posting a 2.77 ERA (283.0IP, 87ER) with 303K during that span.
- Their 466R allowed this season are their second-fewest through their first 124 games of season in the last 46 162-game seasons (since 1979), trailing only their 433R allowed in 2022 (excludes the 60-game season in 2020 and the strike-shortened 1981 season).

RICE RICE BABY: C/INF Ben Rice hit his 33rd home run of the season with a go-ahead two-run shot in the 10th inning on Sunday at Toronto...marked his second career extra-inning home run (also a go-ahead grand slam to break a 1-1 tie in the 10th inning on 9/21/25 at Baltimore)...was the first extra-inning HR by a Yankee this season and first since Jazz Chisholm Jr.'s solo HR on 9/21/25 at Baltimore...was the first go-ahead HR by a Yankee in extra innings since his own go-ahead HR on 9/21/25 at Baltimore.

- **15 of his 33HR this year have either tied the game (one) or given the Yankees the lead (14)**, including 12 of his last 22HR and 13 of his last 24HR.
- Has hit a career-high 33HR in 119 games this year after hitting 26HR in 138 games in 2025.
- 56 of his 111H this year have been extra-base hits (20 doubles, 3 triples, 33HR).
- Since 5/22, has hit .304/.400/.714 (17-for-56) with 1 double, 2 triples, 6HR, 30RBI and 9BB/2IBB with RISP during that span.
- **Has hit .377/.441/.951 (23-for-61) with 16R, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 10HR, 20RBI, 6BB, 1HP and 1SB in his last 16 games vs. Baltimore (since 7/14/24)...his 10 career home runs against the Orioles are his most HR against a single opponent in his career.**

RODOMINANT: LHP Carlos Rodón will make his 10th start of the season tonight at Baltimore and his first since 6/28 at Boston...in nine starts this year, is 4-2 with a 3.30 ERA (46.1IP, 17ER) and 52K...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in each of those starts and 2ER-or-fewer in five starts.
► Has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in four of his last seven starts (since 5/21), posting a 2.82 ERA (38.1IP, 12ER) over that stretch.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Yankees are 38-28 (.576) on the road this year, the second-best record in the AL and the fourth-best in the Majors...are 24-15 in their last 39 games on the road (since 5/25).

NEW YORK 'PEN STATION: Yankees relievers have posted a Major League-best 2.56 ERA (239.1IP, 68ER) over their last 64 games (since 6/3), holding opponents to a .201 (174-for-864) BA during that stretch.

GEORGE OF THE CONCRETE JUNGLE: INF George Lombard Jr. reached base twice for his second straight game on Sunday at Toronto...has hit safely in eight of his first 11 career games, batting .270/.357/.459 (10-for-37) with 7R, 1 double, 2HR, 3RBI, 5BB and 1SB

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: LHP CARLOS RODÓN (4-2, 3.30 ERA)

LHP Carlos Rodón will make his 10th start of the season in tonight's series opener at Baltimore...the 33-year-old will make the start on regular four days' rest...was returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day injured list prior to tonight's game...was placed on the 15-day injured list with left elbow inflammation on 7/3 (retroactive to 6/30)...missed 40 team games...made his most recent start on Thursday vs. New Hampshire with Double-A Somerset, tossing 4.1 scoreless innings (2H, 1BB, 7K, 1WP)...is 4-2 with a 3.30 ERA (46.1IP, 32H, 20R/17ER, 26BB, 52K, 3HR) over nine starts this season...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in each of his starts and 1ER-or-fewer in four of those starts...missed the first 40 team games of the season...was returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day injured list on 5/10...made three rehab starts with High-A Hudson Valley, Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, posting a 3.38 ERA (16.0IP, 13H, 7R/6ER, 3BB, 16K, 3HR)...was placed on the 15-day injured list on 3/25 (retroactive to 3/22) recovering from left elbow surgery...underwent a left elbow arthroscopy procedure on 10/15/25...the procedure was performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache at the Kerlan-Jobe Surgery Center in Los Angeles, Calif...went 18-9 with a 3.09 ERA (195.1IP, 132H, 74R/67ER, 73BB, 203K, 22HR) in 33 starts last season...set career highs in wins, starts and innings pitched...was named to his third All-Star team and first as a Yankee (also 2021 with Chicago-AL and 2022 with San Francisco)...opponents batted .188/.272/.321 (132-for-701, 22HR); LH .177/.257/.285 (28-for-158, 5HR); RH .192/.277/.331 (104-for-543, 17HR)...recorded 203K, his second-most in a single season in his career (237K in 2022 with San Francisco)...since 2021, ranks third in the Majors with an 10.64 K/9.0IP ratio...is also tied for seventh in double-digit strikeout games (21) over that span, trailing only Dylan Cease (33), Gerrit Cole (26), Blake Snell (26), Zack Wheeler (26), Kevin Gausman (25), and Corbin Burnes (22)...has recorded at least 10K and 0BB in nine games, tied for the fifth-most such games in the Majors during that stretch, trailing only Wheeler (14), Gausman (12), Cole (11) and Jacob deGrom (11)...has pitched over parts of 12 Major League seasons with the Chicago White Sox (2015-21), San Francisco Giants (2022) and Yankees (2023-26)...has finished in the top-six of Cy Young voting three times (fifth in 2021 and sixth in 2022 and '25)...is a three-time All-Star (2021-22, '25)...has made six Opening Day rosters (2016, '19-22, '24-25)...began the 2017, 2018, 2023 and 2026 seasons on the injured list...was originally selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 16th round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign and went on to play three seasons at North Carolina State University (2012-14)...was selected by the Chicago White Sox in the first round (third overall) of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft...signed a six-year Major League contract with the Yankees extending through the 2028 season on 12/21/22.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his most recent start on Thursday vs. New Hampshire with Double-A Somerset, tossing 4.1 scoreless innings (2H, 1BB, 7K, 1WP).
✦ Made his last Major League start on 6/28 at Boston, allowing 2R/0ER in 5.0IP (1H, 4BB, 6K) without recording a decision...surrendered his only hit on an RBI single to Caleb Durbin in the fourth inning.

ROAD RULES: Will make his seventh road start of the season...in six road starts this season, is 3-1 with a 3.56 ERA (30.1IP, 12ER) and 31K...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in each of those starts.
✦ As a Yankee (since 2023), has gone 20-17 with a 4.30 ERA (259.2IP, 124ER) and 284K in 49 road starts.
✦ Made 18 starts on the road in 2025, going 8-5 with a 3.18 ERA (104.2IP, 84H, 44R/37ER, 41BB, 110K, 9HR)...tossed at least 6.0IP in 12 of those starts...allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 13 of those starts...went 4-1 with a 2.25 ERA (36.0IP, 30H, 10R/9ER, 12BB, 28K, 2HR) over his last six road starts (8/6-9/20)...allowed 2ER-or-fewer in all six starts.

VS. BALTIMORE: In nine career games (eight starts) vs. the Orioles, has gone 2-3 with a 4.53 ERA (43.2IP, 40H, 27R/22ER, 14BB, 56K, 7HR).
✦ Made two starts vs. the Orioles in 2025, going 2-0 with a 2.08 ERA (13.0IP, 3ER) and 15K.
✦ Has made six career appearances (five starts) at Camden Yards, going 2-2 with a 4.66 ERA (29.0IP, 26H, 18R/15ER, 6BB, 36K, 6HR)...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in four of those starts.

ALL THAT'S LEFT: In his career, left-handed batters have hit just .213/.290/.332 (220-for-1,031)...has also surrendered just 26HR.
✦ **Is just the fourth left-handed Yankees pitcher in the last 48 seasons (since 1979) to allow 3R-or-fewer in each of his first nine starts of a season, joining Jordan Montgomery (first 13GS in 2022), Nestor Cortes (first 10GS in 2022) and CC Sabathia (first 11GS in 2016).**
✦ His 9.90 K/9.0IP ratio since his Major League debut in 2015 ranks fourth among left-handed pitchers in that span (min. 1,000.0IP), trailing only Chris Sale (11.71), Blake Snell (11.20) and Robbie Ray (10.66).
✦ Since 2015, his 1,461K are the fourth-most among active left-handed pitchers...his 28 double-digit strikeout games over that stretch among lefties are the fifth-most in the Majors, trailing only Sale (76), Ray (40), Clayton Kershaw (39) and Snell (39).

2026: In nine starts this year, is 4-2 with a 3.30 ERA (46.1IP, 32H, 20R/17ER, 26BB, 52K, 3HR)...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in each of those starts and 2ER-or-fewer in five starts.
✦ Was returned from his rehab assignment reinstated from the 15-day injured list prior to tonight's game...was placed on the 15-day injured list with left elbow inflammation on 7/3 (retroactive to 6/30)...missed 40 team games.
✦ **Has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in four of his last seven starts (since 5/21), going 4-1 with a 2.82 ERA (38.1IP, 12ER) over that stretch.**
✦ The Yankees have won five of his last six starts (since 5/29).
✦ Has tossed at least 6.0IP in three of his last six starts and allowed 1ER-or-fewer in three of those starts.
✦ Has held opponents to a .195/.306/.305 (32-for-164) slash line this season...has allowed just 3HR to his 194 batters faced, posting a 0.58 HR/9.0IP ratio.
✦ Is holding right-handed batters to a .182/.296/.256 (22-for-121) slash line this year.
✦ Has allowed 4H-or-fewer in seven of his nine starts, allowing just 12XBH (9 doubles, 3HR).
