## NATIONALS HISTORY

**MAY 2 (8-8)**  
2019 - With a strikeout of **Dakota Hudson** in the fifth inning, **Stephen Strasburg** hit the 1,500-strikeout mark for his career. According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, he became the fastest pitcher to 1,500 career strikeouts - in terms of innings pitched - in Major League history. Strasburg earned the win at home in the Nationals 2-1 victory over St. Louis.

## NATIONALS NEWS

**MOVING ON**  
The Washington Nationals take on the Milwaukee Brewers today in the second game of this three-game series... Milwaukee defeated Washington last night, 6-1.

- **Daylen Life** doubled in the seventh inning and finished 1-for-3 with a walk...**Brady House** drove in the Nationals only run and drew a walk.
- **Cionel Pérez** worked 2.0 scoreless innings...He has not allowed an earned run in eight of his last 10 outings dating back to April 10...During that span he has a 3.18 ERA (4 ER/11.1 IP) with three holds.
- The Nationals will enjoy a home off day on Monday before taking on the Minnesota Twins from Tuesday to Thursday.

**HOME SWEET HOMERS**  
The Nationals are averaging 1.50 home runs per game at home, good for third in Major League Baseball and second in the National League...Washington is tied for eighth in MLB in home runs at home with 21 despite playing only 14 games at Nationals Park.

- **James Wood's** eight home runs at home are tied for the most in Major League Baseball with **Kyle Schwarber's** eight at Citizens Bank Park.

**ROAD WARRIORS**  
Washington is 12-7 on the road this season and have taken at least a share of five of their first six series away from home, including four straight...The Nationals 12 wins on the road are tied for the most in Major League Baseball with the Yankees.

**START ME UP**  
Washington's starters have posted a 3.32 ERA (14 ER/38.0 IP) with 47 strikeouts and 12 walks across the last eight games since April 23.

- **Cade Cavalli** struck out at least 10 batters for the second consecutive start...He has struck out 25 batters with just two walks over his last three starts.
- **Jake Irvin** has 18 strikeouts against four walks in his last three starts.
- **Foster Griffin** set career-highs in both innings pitched (7.0) and strikeouts (8) in his last scoreless start against the White Sox on April 26...He's pitched to a 2.67 ERA with 30 strikeouts in six starts this season.

**PRETTY OFFENSIVE**  
The Nationals rank second in Major League Baseball with 176 runs, the second most by a Nationals club in team history (2005-pres.) through its first 33 games behind the 2017 National League East champion Nationals (202).

- Washington has scored 32 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals have scored 65 runs in the seventh inning or later, the most in MLB.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 21 times this season, the most in Major League Baseball.

**WHAT A RELIEF**  
Washington's bullpen leads Major League Baseball with a 1.14 ERA since April 25...In all they are 3-0 with a 1.14 ERA (3 ER/23.2 IP) and 17 strikeouts in the last six games...They are also one of just four bullpens to not allow a home run since April 25.

- **Brad Lord** has allowed just one earned run with four strikeouts and no walks in his last four games (9.0 innings)...He has held batters to a .161 average (5-for-31) in that span.
- **PJ Poulin** is 2-0, allowing three earned runs on nine hits with four strikeouts in his last 10 games (three starts)...Eight of the 10 games have been scoreless.
- **Paxton Schultz** recorded his first career save on April 26 at Chicago (AL).
- Over his last nine games, **Gus Varland** has pitched to a 1.04 ERA (1 ER/8.2 IP) with nine strikeouts...He has recorded his first three career saves during this span.

**GOOD WOOD**  
**James Wood** has placed himself among the league leaders...See chart to the right.

- Wood leads Major League Baseball in home runs (11st, 9) and runs (26) since April 5...This comes after starting the season 4-for-26 (.111) in eight games from March 26 to April 4.
- He is one of three players Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Yordan Alvarez** (3) and **O'Neil Cruz** (3).
- Wood's 43 batted balls over 100 MPH are the most in Major League Baseball.

**FRAME JOB**  
**Bobby Wilson's** catchers rank tied for fifth in Major League Baseball with three Catcher Framing Runs (**Drew Millas** - 2, **Keibert Ruiz** - 1) along with the New York Yankees, according to Baseball Savant...*"Catcher Framing Runs converts strikes to runs saved on a .125 run/strike basis, and includes park and pitcher adjustments. To qualify, a catcher must receive 6 called pitches per team game."*

- For comparison, Washington's catchers ranked 30th in MLB with -18 Catcher Framing Runs in 2025.

## FARM REPORT

**ELI WILL HIT**  
Fredericksburg shortstop **Eli Willits** hit his third home run of the season last night and has now hit safely in 14 of his last 15 games...Since April 14, he's hitting .322 (19-for-59) with four doubles, a triple, three home runs, 13 RBI, 18 walks, 11 stolen bases and 20 runs scored.
