Roster Move

The Braves today selected RHP Elieser Hernández to the major league roster after optioning RHP Owen Murphy to Triple-A Gwinnett following yesterday's game.

Hernández, 31, has 99 games of major-league experience with Miami (90), Los Angeles-NL (5) and Milwaukee (4).

In those outings, including 49 starts, he's 10-22 with a 5.10 ERA (172 ER/303.1 IP). The right-hander from Ocumare del Tuy, VZ, is 1-5 with a 4.83 ERA (41 ER/76.1 IP) for Triple-A Gwinnett this year.

TODAY'S GAME: In a matchup of two first-place teams, the Atlanta Braves and Texas Rangers duel for three games to commence baseball's second half...This is the only scheduled meeting between these two clubs this season.

 The Braves committed two errors in a loss to the Rangers last night, 7-6...Atlanta used a season-high eight pitchers and mustered just one hit with runners in scoring position.

 The Rangers swept the Braves across three games in Arlington last July...Atlanta won its previous home series against Texas in 2024, and needs a win today to secure another set.

 Prior to this series, Atlanta and Texas had met for just 11 series and 33 total games...The Braves swept the first two series in 2002 and '03, before the Rangers won six straight sets from 2005-22...The Braves have played to a 16-19 record (.457) against Texas all-time.

 RH Nathan Eovaldi has made 18 career starts against Atlanta, the fifth most among active pitchers behind Aaron Nola (39), Zack Wheeler (33), Jacob deGrom (28) and Patrick Corbin (22)...The right-hander from Houston, TX, has posted a 4-4 record and a 2.86 ERA (35 ER/110.0 IP) against the club...Among the 15 active pitchers with at least 10 starts against the Braves, Eovaldi's ERA is third-best behind deGrom (2.17) and Logan Webb (2.32).

 RH Grant Holmes has faced the Rangers once in his career, starting against them at Globe Life Field on July 26 last season...He allowed four earned runs across 4.0 innings in an extra-inning Braves loss, 6-5...The right-hander from Conway, SC, has pitched to a 0.96 ERA (2 ER/18.2 IP) in his last four outings, the fourth-best mark in MLB since June 22 (min. 18.2 IP).

LOSS: The Braves plated five runs last night, but fell to 40-10 (.800) when doing so...The team has scored at least five runs in eight straight home games dating to July 1, its longest run in a single season since a 10-game streak from June 1-17, 2019.

 This season, the Kansas City Royals are the only other team to score five-plus runs in at least eight straight home games...They did so in nine straight from April 12-May 5.

 The Braves used eight pitchers in the game last night, their highest total since matching that mark on May 10, 2023 versus Boston...Danny Young and Raisel Iglesias also appeared in that game.

 The Braves played their 40th game when opposed by a left-handed starter, the most in the major leagues this season...The team has lost seven of its last eight such games and 13 of its last 20 since May 24 after starting the season 16-4 against southpaw starters.

THE SERIES: The Braves today will attempt to secure their 21st series victory of the season...The club won 21 series throughout the entirety of the 2025 season, and looks to match that mark with a victory today.

 At present, only three teams in MLB have accumulated at least 20 series wins: Milwaukee Brewers (21), Atlanta Braves (20) and Los Angeles Dodgers (20).

 Atlanta hasn't won the first series out of the All-Star break since 2022, when it took two-of-three from the Los Angeles Angels here at Truist Park.

 After playing to a 7-1 record in their first eight rubber matches, the Braves have won just two of their last six...They won their last try on July 9 at Pittsburgh, 10-5.

 The Braves have scored 83 runs in rubber matches this season, the second most in MLB behind Pittsburgh (86)...The club's 3.00 ERA with the series on the line also ranks second, trailing Milwaukee (2.58).

DRAKE BALDWIN: Posted his second consecutive multi-hit game via a 2-for-5 performance out of the leadoff position...In the month of June, he's slashing .308/.429/.423 (16-for-52) with nine runs and 13 RBI.

 The 2026 All-Star has amassed 14 hits in his last 10 games, dating to July 5 versus New York-NL...Only four major-leaguers have more hits in that span: Gabriel Moreno (ARI, 16), Lane Thomas (KC, 15), Curtis Mead (WSH, 15) and Garrett Mitchell (MIL, 15).

 Prior to this 10-game stretch by Baldwin, he collected 14 total hits in his previous 24 games combined...That stretch spanned May 12-July 4 and included a stint on the injured list.

MAURICIO DUBÓN: Recorded a pair of hits last night, including an RBI-double with two outs in the seventh...His 27 two-out RBI pace the National League and are tied for fifth in MLB behind Dillon Dingler (DET, 34), Cody Bellinger (NYY, 30), Pete Alonso (BAL, 30) and Christian Walker (HOU, 28).

 Dubón has hit safely in 30-of-36 games since June 3, slashing .301/.346/.503 (43-for-143) with eight doubles, seven homers and 24 RBI in that span...Only one player in MLB has hit safely in more games in that time: Bryan Reynolds (PIT, 31 games).

 In that span, Dubón leads Atlanta's club in batting average, on-base percentage and slugging percentage (min. 50 PA), as well as hits (43) and RBI (24).

 The 32-year-old ranks fourth on Atlanta's club with 2.2 fWAR, trailing Chris Sale (3.1 fWAR), Matt Olson (2.9 fWAR) and Michael Harris II (2.7 fWAR).

Will make his second career appearance against the Rangers...His lone prior look came in a start at Texas last season, when he allowed four runs on six hits over 4.0 innings.

Turned in 5.0 scoreless innings in a no-decision July 8 at Pittsburgh, allowing three hits and one walk with five strikeouts on 90 pitches...Atlanta scored all three of its runs after he exited in a 3-0 win.

Has allowed one earned run or fewer in three of his last four starts...Owns a 0.64 ERA (1 ER/14.0 IP) over his last three outings, two starts and one relief appearance.

Has issued 39 walks and surrendered 15 home runs, equating to a 4.02 BB/9 and a 1.55 HR/9.

Has generated 52 of his 76 strikeouts this season with his slider, the third-most in the National League entering play...Opponents are batting .225 (31-for-138) with a 2.68 ERA (11 ER/37.0 IP) in at-bats ending on the pitch.

Has thrown 534 sliders this season, the sixth-most in the majors...Opponents are missing 39.8 percent of their swings against the pitch and chasing it out of the zone 40.4 percent of the time, both the fourth-highest rates among pitchers with at least 500 thrown.

Opponents are batting .194 (26-for-134) with a 2.43 ERA (10 ER/37.0 IP) against him the first time through the order this season...The second time through, opposing hitters are batting .302 (39-for-129) with a 6.39 ERA (22 ER/31.0 IP).

Has held opponents 0-for-8 with the bases loaded in 2026.

His 45 career starts, all with Atlanta, are the most in Atlanta-franchise history by a South Carolina-born player.

Tossed 5.0 scoreless innings in a no-decision July 8 at Pittsburgh, allowing three hits with five strikeouts in a 3-0 win...It was his first career start against the Pirates.

Earned the win July 3 against New York (NL), allowing two runs - one earned - on five hits over 5.0 innings with two strikeouts in a 5-3 victory.

Tossed 4.0 scoreless innings of relief June 27 at San Francisco, allowing one hit with four strikeouts and no walks on 47 pitches in a 5-0 loss...It was his first walk-free appearance since March 31, 2025.

Has not allowed more than three earned runs in 17 consecutive home starts, dating to May 25, 2025 - the second-longest such streak by a starter in modern franchise history, trailing only Warren Spahn's 18 (1961-62.

Recorded his 250th career strikeout June 3 against Toronto, earning the win after allowing two runs on five hits over 6.0 innings in a 7-3 victory for his fifth quality start of the season.

Recorded the third 10-strikeout game of his career and his first of 2026 on May 23 against Washington, fanning the side in order in the first inning - the first such frame by a Braves pitcher since Bryce Elder on May 4, 2025.

Reached 200 career strikeouts April 3 at Chase Field in Arizona.

Went 1-0 with a 1.02 ERA in five spring appearances (four starts), fanning 20 over 17.2 innings with just one walk.
