OUR STARTING ALL-STAR: Ketel Marte was voted as the 2025 NL All-Star starting second baseman hosted at Truist Park, home of the Atlanta Braves...it is his second consecutive All-Star starting selection at second base and third in career (also: 2024, 2019).

- · First NL second baseman to win consecutive fan-elected starting assignments since Chase Utley with 5 straight from 2006-10.
- Led all NL players in Phase 2 voting.
- First-ever D-back with 3 All-Star fan elections.
- Second D-back to make 3 All-Star starts, joining Paul Goldschmidt (3).
- Third D-back to earn consecutive All-Star starts, joining Goldschmidt (2014-15) and Randy Johnson (2000-01).
- Sixth D-back to earn 3+ All-Star appearances, joining Goldschmidt (6), Luis Gonzalez (5), Johnson (5), Zack Greinke (3) and Brandon Webb (3).
- Ninth D-back fan-elected start for a position player and 32nd position player selection overall.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 9-3 vs. Royals in the opener.

- Eugenio Suárez hit his NL second-best 28th homer (4th in MLB) in the fifth inning...his 28 homers pre-All-Star break rank second in franchise history, behind Luis Gonzalez's 35 in 2001...he is the sixth D-back alltime with 70+ RBI pre-All-Star break and first since Paul Goldschmidt's 77 in 2015.
- Geraldo Perdomo reached base 4 times (2 H, 2 BB)... his 8 games reaching 4+ times are the most in the NL (2nd in MLB behind Aaron Judge/NYY-14)...his 3 games with 2+ hits and 2+ walks rank tied for second (also: 9 others), behind Manny Machado/SD (4).
- Ketel Marte hit safely in his third straight game with a single in the first inning.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The D-backs reinstated OF **Corbin Carroll** from the 10-day injured list (fractured left wrist) and optioned INF/OF Tim Tawa to Triple-A Reno following last night's game.

J.D. DIX & JUNIOR SANCHEZ EARN D-BACKS JUNE MONTHLY HONORS: The D-backs named Single-A Visalia INF JD Dix and RHP Junior Sanchez the organization's Minor League Player and Pitcher of the Month for June.

- Dix (No. 12 prospect) was named Minor League Baseball's ACL Player of the Month for June after hitting .397 (31-for-78) with 8 doubles, 3 triples, 10 RBI, 9 walks and 4 stolen bases in 19 games with the ACL D-backs.
- **Sanchez**, in 4 starts (2 quality) with the Rawhide, went 3-0 with a 0.40 ERA (1 ER in 22.2 IP), opponent .177 AVG, 0.97 WHIP and 13 strikeouts.

VS. ROYALS: The D-backs have won 7 of their last 11 matchups vs. Royals (since 2022), including 4 of their last 6 @ home...own a 21-17 (.553) record all-time.

PATRIOTIC TEE GIVEAWAY: Today, the D-backs featuring their Patriotic | COOKIN' VS. KC: Geraldo Perdomo has hit safely in 8 straight starts, hitting .357 (10-for-28)/.486 OBP/.986 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 RBI and 7 walks.

- Ketel Marte has homered in 3 of his last 4 starts Rovals with a combined 7 RBI...over his last 10 sta is batting .302 (13-for-43)/.927 OPS with 1 double homers, 10 RBI, 6 walks and 1 hit-by-pitch.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr. has hit safely in his last 5 sta with 1 double and 2 stolen bases.

POWER + ON BASE COMBO: The D-backs are currently only team to have multiple players (2 - Corbin Carr and Eugenio Suárez) with 20+ homers, 20+ walks a 40+ RBI...Ketel Marte is 1 homer shy of joining the cl to bring the total to 3 players.
