RAYS REPORT—The Rays conclude their final homestand of 2025 tonight at Steinbrenner Field, a seven-game stretch against the Blue Jays (2-2) and Red Sox (0-2, one to play)...are 2-5 in their last seven games and 4-11 in their last 15 on the heels of a season-high seven-game winning streak (Aug. 29–Sept. 4)...are 11-11 during a stretch of 23 games in 24 days from Aug. 29–Sept. 21...including the current set, have gone 7-16-1 over their last 24 series since a 16-8-2 start...are fourth in the AL East for the 72nd consecutive day dating back to July 11, 14.0 GB the first-place Blue Jays...have a 2.0-game lead over the fifth-place Orioles with seven games to play...including off days and the All-Star break, they have spent two days in first, 37 in second, 32 in third, 102 in fourth and four in fifth.

- ✦ The Rays rallied from a 3-1 deficit in the 7th frame, but yielded three runs in the 9th inning of last night's 6-3 loss...the defeat ensured a series loss, extending their streak of winless sets to a season-high-tying five (0-4-1), matching June 27–July 12 (0-5-0).
- ✦ Tampa Bay has committed three errors (or more) in back-to-back games for the first time since Sept. 17-18, 2012 vs. TOR...the Rays have totaled 14 errors in their last 15 games since Sept. 5, tied for the most in MLB (LAA, WSH)—those miscues have led to a major league-leading 13 unearned runs in that span...they have yielded six unearned runs this series, their most in a single set since Sept. 29–Oct. 1 at TOR (6).
- ✦ The Rays 3.10 ERA (240.2IP, 83ER) in their last 27 games since Aug. 22 ranks third in the majors behind the Guardians (2.91) and Pirates (3.05)...the staff paces the AL with a 25.6 pct. strikeout rate since the All-Star break.
- ✦ With a major league-leading 187 SB, the Rays are 7 SB shy of matching the 2009 team's franchise-record 194 SB.
- ✦ Last night marked the Rays fifth straight loss when opposed by a left-handed starting pitcher...they are 6-16 in their last 22 games vs. southpaws.
- ✦ The Rays need to win tonight to avoid being swept for the eighth time this season, first since Aug. 19-20 vs. NYY...they would also be swept in consecutive series by the Red Sox for the first time since May 2–June 5, 2008.

WHERE THE RUBBER MEETS THE HOME—With a 40-40 record at Steinbrenner Field, the Rays need to win tonight to record their ninth consecutive winning season at home (2017–pres.)...entering the year, only the Yankees (33), Dodgers (19) and Brewers (9) had longer active streaks than the Rays current eight-season run...the Rays have finished with a winning record at home in 16 of their previous 27 seasons of existence, including 14 of their last 17 campaigns since 2008 compared to two of 10 from 1998–2007.

THE GREAT YANDINO—Yandy Diaz has reached base safely in 20 of 27 PA (.741 OBP) over his last six games, going 12-for-19 (.632) with 2 2B, 1 HR, 4 RBI, 8 BB, 1 SO and 3 R...the 20 times on base (H, BB or HBP) are tied for the most over any six-game span within a single season in Rays history, matching **Carl Crawford** (Aug. 4-9, 2007) and **Julio Lugo** (June 23-28, 2006)...the team record over a seven-game span is 23 times on base, held by Lugo (June 23-30, 2006)...Diaz tallied his MLB-leading 53rd multi-hit game last night, matching his career high from 2023...the last Ray with more multi-hit efforts was Crawford (54G) in 2009...Diaz has tallied a hit in 18 of his last 23 games since Aug. 25, batting .435/.520/.659 (37-for-85) with 7 2B, 4 HR, 10 RBI, 15 BB, 10 SO, 16 R and a 1.179 OPS...over that timeframe, he leads MLB in average, hits (11st) and on-base pct. and ranks second in OPS to NYY **Aaron Judge** (1.233).

- ✦ He is one double away from joining **Ben Zobrist** (2011-14) as the only players in Rays history with four straight 30-double seasons...his next double will also tie **Aubrey Huff** (172 2B) for the fifth-most two-baggers in Rays history.
- ✦ Diaz has career highs in home runs (25), RBI (83) and games (145, tied with 2024)...he is one hit and two extra-base hits shy of matching his 2023 career bests (173H/57H).
- ✦ He has reached base safely in 10 straight games and has drawn a walk in a career-high-tying seven consecutive games (also: July 24-31, 2020)—the last Ray with a longer streak was Zobrist (9G) from May 10-18, 2011.

ROOKIES RISING—Jake Mangum tallied his eighth three-hit game of the season last night, tying teammate **Chandler Simpson**, **Evan Longoria** (2008) and **Bobby Smith** (1998) for fourth most by a rookie in franchise history, according to Stats Perform...they trail **Randy Arozarena** (16G, 2021), **Delmon Young** (13G, 2007) and **Rocco Baldelli** (10G, 2003)...Mangum (.298, 382AB) and Simpson (.297, 391AB) are attempting to become the second and third rookies in franchise history to hit .300 or better with at least 400 AB, joining **Joey Wendle** (.300, 487AB) in 2018...only five pairs of rookie teammates in MLB history have accomplished the feat, most recently PIT **Kevin Newman** (.308) / **Bryan Reynolds** (.314) in 2019...other instances involved BOS **Fred Lynn** / **Jim Rice** in 1975, DET **Dale Alexander** / **Roy Johnson** in 1929, STL **George Barclay** / **Homer Smoot** in 1902 and PIT **Ginger Beaumont** / **Jimmy Williams** in 1899.

- ✦ Mangum is 6-for-10 with 1 2B, 1 RBI and 1 SB during a three-game hitting streak.
- ✦ Simpson is batting .429 (15-for-35) with 3 2B, 3 RBI, 6 R and 3 SB over his last nine games since Sept. 11, the third-best average in MLB over that stretch behind teammate **Yandy Diaz** (.484) and NYY **Aaron Judge** (.484).
- ✦ Simpson is second in MLB with 42 SB, tied for 10th most in team history and 3 SB shy of joining **Carl Crawford** (6x, last: 47SB in 2010) as the only Rays to reach 45 SB.
- ✦ He has a chance to become the ninth rookie since 1901 to hit .300 or better with 40 SB or more and the first since LAA **Mike Trout** (.326/.495B) in 2012...the only Ray in club history to meet those marks, regardless of rookie status, is **Carl Crawford** (5x, last: 2010 - .307/47SB).

THE CAMINER-SHOW—With seven games to play, **Junior Caminero** (44HR) is 2 HR shy of tying **Carlos Peña**'s franchise-record 48-HR campaign in 2007...has 17 HR in 43 games since Aug. 1, tying NYM **Juan Soto** for the MLB lead in that span...22 of his 44 HR have come at Steinbrenner Field, matching **Brad Miller** (2016) for the second-most long balls at home in franchise history behind Peña (23HR) in 2007...his 108 RBI are the most by a Ray since **Evan Longoria** (113RBI) in 2009 and are fourth most in Rays history (see table to the right)...his 72 XBH match **Ben Zobrist** (2011) for seventh most in a season in team history, one shy of Longoria in 2010 (73XBH) for sixth and two shy of Longoria in 2013 (74XBH) for fifth.

- ✦ Caminero is two doubles shy of becoming the first player in franchise history with a 30-double, 40-homer season.

BASH BROTHERS—With 29 HR, **Brandon Lowe** is one long ball shy of becoming the second Ray to reach 30 HR along with **Junior Caminero** (44HR)...they would become the sixth set of Rays teammates to both hit 30 HR in a season, first since Lowe (39HR) and **Mike Zunino** (33HR) in 2021...Lowe would also become the fourth active second baseman with multiple 30-HR seasons, joining ATL **Ozzie Albies** (2), HOU **Jose Altuve** (2) and AZ **Ketel Marte** (2), and would join **Evan Longoria** (4) and **Carlos Peña** (3) as the only players in franchise history with multiple 30-HR campaigns.

SOX AT THE STEIN—The Rays have lost 10 of their last 11 games against the Red Sox, including an active eight-game losing streak, their third longest vs. Boston behind streaks of 11 (April 6–June 26, 2001) and 10 games (Oct. 3, 2001–July 23 [G1], 2002)...four of eight losses during the current streak have come by one run...the Rays, who suffered their first season series loss to the Sox since 2018 to end a six-season unbeaten run, are 9-16 against Boston since the start of 2024 (3-8 at home)...including the current set, they have lost four straight series to the Sox since their last series win from Sept. 27-29, 2024 at Fenway Park, their longest skid since dropping five in a row from Aug. 8, 2017–April 8, 2018.



- ✦ Tonight marks the seventh of 13 straight games vs. AL East clubs to conclude the season...the Rays are 2-9 in their last 11 intra-division games and 5-15 in their last 20.
- ✦ **Yandy Diaz** has reached base safely in 12 straight starts against Boston, batting .380 (19-for-50) with 1 2B, 3 HR, 8 RBI, 8 BB, 10 R and a .466 on-base pct. in those games.
- ✦ Min. 250 PA, **Brandon Lowe**'s .987 OPS vs. the Sox in his career leads active players.
- ✦ **Jake Mangum** is 20-for-41 (.488) in 12 games against the Red Sox this season...min. 40 AB, it would surpass **Greg Norton** (.415) in 2006 for the highest single-season batting average against Boston in franchise history.

DOWN ON THE FARM—Double A Montgomery opens its best-of-three Southern League Championship Series against Birmingham (CWS) on the road tonight at 5:00 p.m. ET...the Biscuits, who swept Biloxi (MIL) in the division round, are making their second consecutive SL Championship Series appearance and third in the last five seasons (2024-25, 2021)...the club is seeking its first league title since 2007.

TONIGHT'S START—Joe Boyle will make his eighth start as a Ray and his 12th appearance of the campaign...marks the third time in his career he has faced the Red Sox...is in his third stint with the Rays, joining April 13-14 and July 6–Aug. 22...acquired from the Athletics along with **INF Will Simpson**, **RHP Jacob Watters** and a Competitive Balance Round A selection for **LHP Jeffrey Springs** and **LHP Jacob Lopez**, Dec. 14, 2024.

LAST TIME OUT—Boyle pitched a season-high 6.0 scoreless innings but received just one run of support in a 2-1 loss to the Blue Jays on Sept. 15 at Steinbrenner Field (ND, 6.0IP, 3H, 5SO)...allowed two of his three hits in the first two innings...gave up a single but faced the minimum in the 1st before surrendering just a single in the 2nd...then retired six of his next seven batters faced (fielding error on **Tristan Gray**) before allowing his last baserunner on a single in the 4th...put away his final eight faced to get through the 6th inning.

- ✦ Marked his second career outing of 6.0 scoreless innings, joining Aug. 19, 2024 vs. TB (W, 6.0IP) as a member of the Oakland Athletics.
- ✦ Marked the fifth time in 20 career starts he has gone 6.0 IP or more...has tallied 5 SO or more in four of his last six games.

FROM BEANTOWN TO THE BAY—Boyle is set for his third career appearance opposite the Red Sox and his second this season...his outing in 2025 came on July 11 at Fenway Park, when he tossed 4.0 innings of relief and allowed 2 ER on 3 H and 2 BB with 1 SO in a 5-4 loss...his other outing came on April 1, 2024 with the Athletics, when he started and went 2.2 IP, allowing 8 R (7ER) on 8 H and 4 BB with 4 SO in a 9-0 loss in Oakland...has made four appearances (2GS) against AL East teams this season, going 0-1 with a 3.52 ERA (15.1IP, 6ER) and a .179 (10-for-56) opp. average...in seven games (5GS) against the division in his career, he is 1-3 with a 5.00 ERA (27.0IP, 15ER) and a .219 (23-for-105) opp. average.

THE COMFORTS OF HOME—In six games (4GS) at Steinbrenner Field this season, he is 1-1 with a 2.16 ERA (25.0IP, 6ER), a 0.96 WHIP and a .178 (16-for-90) opp. average...he has worked 5.0 scoreless innings or more in three of his four home starts in 2025 and has allowed a combined six hits in those three contests.

- ✦ In his 15 career games (12GS) at home, he is 4-5 with a 3.50 ERA (61.2IP, 24ER) and a .589 opp. OPS...this, compared to a 2-4 record, 7.05 ERA (44.2IP, 35ER) and a .789 opp. OPS on the road.

THE ARSENAL—In addition to limiting opponents to a .214 (15-for-70) clip on his fastball, opposing hitters are 18-for-91 (.198) in at-bats ending with Boyle's slider (16-for-64) and split-finger (2-for-27)...he has generated a combined 31.0 pct. whiff rate on his secondary offerings and recorded 34 of his 44 strikeouts on those pitches...100 of his 115 career strikeouts have come on his four-seamer or his slider, with the others coming on a splitter (9), sweeper (5) and a sinker (1).

- ✦ With two strikes, opponents are 5-for-43 (.116) with 25 SO and a 36.0 pct. whiff rate against his slider.

ALRIGHT, ALRIGHT, ALRIGHT—Boyle has held righties to a .183 batting average (35-for-191) in his career...he has allowed just 10 extra-base hits, walked 25 batters and struck out 59 right-handed batters...meanwhile, lefties have hit at a .236 clip (48-for-203) against him with 19 extra-base hits, 41 walks and 56 strikeouts.

MINOR MATTERS—In his 18 games (17GS) with Triple-A Durham this season, Boyle has gone 8-4 and pitched to a 1.88 ERA (86.0IP, 18ER), posted a 1.01 WHIP and limited opponents to a .154 (46-for-299) batting average...in his most recent stint with the Bulls, he went 2-0 with a 2.08 ERA (13.0IP, 3ER) and 18 SO across three starts.

- ✦ Min. 250 AB, his .154 opp. average is the lowest among Triple-A pitchers this season...min. 85.0 IP, his 1.88 ERA is second-lowest.
- ✦ He was named International League Pitcher of the Week three times and named IL Pitcher of the Month for June...he went 3-0 with a 1.80 ERA (30.0IP, 6ER), a 0.97 WHIP and a .167 (18-for-108) opp. average in six outings (5GS) during the month...was also named Rays Minor League Pitcher of the Month by the club's baseball operations department.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS—Boyle's first start for the Rays came in a spot start on April 13 vs. ATL...he earned his first and only win of 2025 after tossing 5.0 hitless innings (2R, 0ER) with 2 BB, 1 HBP and 7 SO...the right-hander retired 13 straight batters to open the game before allowing his first baserunner to reach via walk in the 5th inning...put out the next two batters before yielding a hit-by-pitch and a walk to end his outing.

- ✦ He became one of 22 players since 1901 to toss five hitless innings (or more) in his debut with a team and the second Ray to turn the trick (**Nathan Eovaldi** - 6.0IP on May 30, 2018 at OAK).
