**METSCELLANEOUS:** The Mets dropped the final game of their three-game series with the Astros, 6-3...Finish their six-game homestand 2-4... They have now lost three consecutive series for the first time since they lost series to the Cubs, Phillies and Blue Jays from June 23 - July 1...They are still 14-10 (.583) over their last 24 games...The Mets Have lost six of their last eight against the Astros at Citi Field dating back to 2022 season.

**ROSTER MOVES:** Prior to tonight's game, the Mets announce the following roster moves...OF Luis Robert Jr. was claimed off waivers by the Baltimore Orioles...INF Mark Vientos was activated from the 10-Day IL.

**BACK-TO-BACK:** Francisco Lindor and Juan Soto went back-to-back to begin yesterday's game...That was the fifth time in team history that the first two batters of the game have homered in team history (last: 10/4/22 vs. WSH (G2)).

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** Six Syracuse pitchers combined to throw the franchise's first nine-inning no-hitter since 1971 as the Mets shut out the Lehigh Valley IronPigs, 8-0, on Sunday afternoon at Coca-Cola Park...The no-hitter was the 18th in Syracuse franchise history, while the Mets finished the six-game series with four wins...Mark Vientos hit three home runs in the victory...He completed his huge afternoon in the ninth, hitting his third home run of the game to provide the final run in the 8-0 victory. Vientos finished 4-for-5 with three home runs, five RBI and three runs scored.

**MILB PITCHER OF THE WEEK:** Congrats to Brooklyn's RHP Ryan Dollar who was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week...In three appearances this week, Dollar tossed 5.0 scoreless innings, allowing three hits and seven strikeouts...He has a combined record of 3-2 with a 2.94 ERA (16 ER/49.0 IP) with 29 walks and 64 strikeouts in 40 appearances between St. Lucie and Brooklyn.

**ZAC ATTACK:** Yesterday, Zac Thornton fired 5.0 innings and allowed two runs while striking out five...Allowed three or fewer earned runs for the 10th consecutive start...He is the first Met with such a streak since Christian Scott had an 11-game streak from July 8, 2024 - June 5, 2026...His streak is tied for the fifth-longest by a rookie in franchise history (also: Rob Gardner 9/5/65 - 5/25/66)...Per Elias...Issued zero walks today and has issued three or fewer walks in each of his first 11 career starts...He is only one of four pitchers in franchise history to do so (also: Masato Yoshii, Steven Matz and Tylor Megill)...He has pitched to a 2.93 ERA (20 ER/61.1 IP) through his first 11 career starts...Is the 14th-best mark through a pitchers first 11 starts in franchise history and is the third-lowest mark by a left-hander.

**THEY'RE OUT OF OUR LEAGUE:** The Mets are in a stretch of nine of 12 games against the American League...They are 2-4 in that span...The Mets have won five of their last nine against the AL...Overall, New York is 18-18 in Interleague Play this year, posting a 3.85 ERA, while slashing .241/.306/.412.

**LINSANITY:** Yesterday, Francisco Lindor led off the game with a solo home run to even the score at 1-1...Marked his second lead-off home run of the season (also: 4/14 at LAD) and the 33rd of his career...Recorded his 155th career home run as a Met, which moved him past Dave Kingman for the sixth-most home runs in franchise history...Was his 15th lead-off homer as a Met, which broke a tie with Brandon Nimmo for sole possession of the third-most lead-off home runs in franchise history.

**RAYS-METS NOTES:** The Mets have lost six straight and 11 of their last 13 to the Rays...The Mets have dropped eight straight games at The Trop.

**GIVE ME A BREAK:** In 40 games following the All-Star break, Francisco Lindor is batting .252/.341/.477 with 24 runs, six doubles, one triple nine homers, 20 walks, 22 RBI and an .818 OPS...This compares to a .216/.298/.373 with 22 runs, three doubles, three triples, five homers, 12 RBI, 16 walks and a .671 OPS in 40 games in the first half of the season.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** The Mets are 11-8 on the road since July 6...Overall, they are 29-37 away from Citi Field this season...They have posted a 4.19 ERA, while batting .240/.305/.400 on the road this year.

**BLAME IT ON THE BENGE:** Over his last 28 games dating back to July 29, Carson Benge has a .339/.383/.536 (38-112) slashline with 11 extra-base hits, 14 RBI, 15 runs and a .952 OPS...Ranks first in the NL in hits during that span...Also leads all qualified NL hitters in average during that span...His 138 hits this season are the sixth-most in a single season by a Mets rookie...Pete Alonso has the rookie record with 155 hits in 2019.

The Mets will also host a 1986 World Series Reunion and Celebration to celebrate the 1986 title today.

**NEW SKIPPER:** Andy Green has been named Interim Manager for the remainder of the 2026 season...Green, who joined the Mets organization in 2023 and previously served as Senior Vice President, Baseball Development, managed the San Diego Padres from 2016-19, guiding the club to a 274-366 (.428) record...The 48-year-old played parts of four Major League seasons with the Diamondbacks (2004-06) and appeared in four games with the Mets in 2009...He will wear #70...The Mets are 27-29 since Green took the helm.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Allowed seven earned runs on a career-high 10 hits on August 26 vs. Milwaukee (4.0 IP, 10 H, 7 ER, 2 BB, 2 K, HR).

**HOT AND COLD:** Has made five starts this season and he is 0-3 with a 7.40 ERA (17 ER/20.2 IP) with 21 strikeouts...In three of his five starts, he has completed at least 4.1 innings and allowed one or zero earned runs while striking out at least four...Over five starts this season he has posted a 9.15 K/9.

**FIRST TIME'S THE CHARM:** Was selected to the Major League Roster prior to their game on August 2 vs. Miami (5.0 IP, 3 H, ER, 4 K, HR) and he fired 5.0 innings and allowed one run on three hits while striking out four...Marked his first Major League appearance since June 8, 2025 at New York-AL while with Boston and his first start since July 20, 2021 at Cincinnati during his first stint with the Mets.

**FAMILIAR FACE:** Prior to this season, he made two appearances for the Mets in 2021...Over two starts in July of 2021, he threw 5.0 innings and allowed three runs while striking out six...Made one appearance for the Mets in Major League Spring Training this season, and he fired 3.0 scoreless innings against Houston on February 26.

**VS. TAMPA BAY:** Made two relief appearances against Tampa Bay while with Boston in 2020 and he allowed 2 ER over 3.0 innings.

**START ME UP:** Eight of his 62 Major League appearances have come as a starter, and he has completed at least 4.0 innings in six of those eight outings...His 5.0 innings on August 2 marked a career-high and he didn't issue a walk for the first time as a starter...Over eight career starts he is 0-5 with a 7.58 ERA (25 ER/29.2 IP) and 30 strikeouts.

**2026:** Was placed on the 60-day Injured List on March 18 and was activated on July 19...Over eight total appearances between High-A Brooklyn (six rehab appearances) and Triple-A Syracuse (two appearances) he has pitched to a 2.91 ERA (7 ER/21.1 IP) with 31 strikeouts...His last minor league appearance came on July 25 in a start for Triple-A Syracuse at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, where he fired 3.2 innings and allowed one run on a season-high 66 pitches.

**CAREER:** In his Major League career, he has pitched in 62 games (eight starts) between San Diego, Boston, Chicago-NL and New York-NL...He has gone 2-7 with a 5.44 ERA (58 ER/96.0 IP) and 98 strikeouts in the big leagues...The 36-year-old Bellevue, Washington Native was originally a Cardinals second-round pick in 2009 out of the University of Southern California.
