**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals continue their final homestand of the season with the third game of a four-game series with the division-rival Pittsburgh Pirates tonight at Busch Stadium ... The Cleveland Guardians visit St. Louis this weekend for the first time since 2021 ... Last night's victory gave St. Louis a winning season series over Pittsburgh for the 21st time in the last 25 years since 2000 (excluding 2008, 2012, 2013, 2023).

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** With 11 games remaining, St. Louis enters today in 3rd place in the National League Central and 7.0 games out of the 3rd and final Wild Card spot ... The Cardinals are eliminated from the National League Central Division, while their postseason elimination number is four ... St. Louis owns tiebreakers over the Padres, Braves, and Cubs.

MCGREEVY RECALLED: Prior to tonight's game, the Cardinals recalled RHP Michael McGreevy from Memphis (AAA) and placed RHP Lance Lynn on the season-ending 15-Day Injured List with right knee inflammation.

- Since making his MLB debut on July 31, McGreevy has gone 4-1 with a 2.88 ERA (40.2 IP) and 42 strikeouts in seven starts for Memphis.
- Overall this season, the 24-year-old is 9-8 with a 4.02 ERA and 138 strikeouts across an organizational-leading 27 starts & 150.0 innings pitched.
- The only other Triple-A pitcher this season with more innings pitched than McGreevy is Tacoma Rainier & former Cardinal Casey Lawrence (160.0 IP).

IT'S ALWAYS SONNY: Sonny Gray is five strikeouts away from becoming the 9th different Cardinal (20th instance) to reach 200 strikeouts in a single season and first to do so since **Jack Flaherty** (231 in 2019) ... Gray's 195 strikeouts are also the 2nd-most by a pitcher in their first season with St. Louis behind **José DeLeón** (208 in 1988).

HELLO OLD FRIEND: Jake Woodford joins Jack Flaherty and Michael Wacha as the third former Cardinals 1st round pick to start against St. Louis this season ... Other previous first round selections to do so include Lance Lynn (2018, 2021), Shelby Miller (2015-16), Braden Looper (2009), Matt Morris (2006-07), Alan Benes (2002), Allen Watson (1996), John Ericks (1995-96), Mike Dunne (1987) and Dan Larson (1976-81)

CARDINALS vs. PIRATES

**HOMEWORK ASSIGNMENT:** The Cardinals are playing a stretch at home for 13 of 16 games from Sept. 6-22 (5-3 record) ... Sunday's home finale (Sept. 22) marks the earliest the Cardinals wrap up their home slate in St. Louis since Sept. 21, 2014 at Busch III and Sept. 21, 2003 at Busch III ... One more Cardinals victory clinches a winning record at Busch Stadium (40-35, .533) for the 17th time in 19 seasons since the stadium was built in 2006.

**ROOKIE MILESTONES:** Rookie **Masyn Winn** tonight makes his 139th appearance at shortstop this season, tying **Pete Kozma** (2013) for the 4th-most games at shortstop by a Cardinals rookie (147g by **Ed Holly** in 1907 is 1st) ... Winn's 93rd game at leadoff tonight matches **Al Shaw** (1908) for 5th-most by a Cardinals rookie in a single season (149g by 1985 ROY **Vince Coleman** is 1st).

HAPPY BIRTHDAY ANDRE: Happy 26th birthday to pitcher Andre Pallante ... Other notables born on this day include former Cardinals instructor Mark DeJohn (71); All-Star pitcher Harvey Haddix (b. 1925); Hall of Famer Ryne Sandberg (65); actors Jason Sudeikis (49) and James Gandolfini (b. 1961); actress Jada Pinkett Smith (53); former basketball player Toni Kukoc (56); and former NHL and St. Louis Blues coach Scotty Bowman (91).

**DONNY, YOU'RE OUT OF YOUR ELEMENT: Brendan Donovan** has hit safely in all 16 home games against the Pirates to begin his career, longest by a Cardinal in MLB history and tied for 5th-longest home hit streak vs. Pittsburgh to begin an MLB career ... **Rafael Furcal** (2000-05) and **Kiddo Davis** (1932-33) share the MLB record with hits in their first 18 home games vs. the Buccos.

MINOR LEAGUE POSTSEASON: After tying the best-of-three series with a 8-4 win last night, the Single-A Palm Beach Cardinals (will play a deciding Game 3 tonight for the Florida State League championship when they host Lakeland (Tigers) at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium starting at 5:30 PM CT ... A win tonight would clinch Palm's Beach third overall league title and first since being named 2017 co-champions ... The Double-A Springfield Cardinals won its first game of the Texas League semifinals yesterday, defeating Arkansas (Mariners) 4-1 in North Little Rock ... Game 2 of the best-of-three series will be played tomorrow (Sept. 19) at Hammons Field in Springfield at 6:35 PM CT.

**Oliver Marmol** was originally selected by Pittsburgh in the 31st Rd. of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Miles Mikolas spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with Jaff Decker to Pittsburgh for Alex Dickerson (Nov. 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers for Chris McGuiness (Dec. 30, 2013).

Cardinals 2024 first round pick **JJ Wetherholt** graduated from Mars Area (Pa.) High School... coached by **Andy Bednar**, father of **David Bednar**.

**Turner Ward** played parts of three seasons (1997-99) with Pittsburgh...managed two seasons in the Pirates minor league organization for the 2006 GCL Pirates and 2007 State College Spikes (SS).

**Nolan Arenado** (2009) and **Paul Skenes** (2020) are graduates of El Toro High School in Lake Forest, Calif.

Willson Contreras (June 17, 2016 at Wrigley Field), Sonny Gray (July 10, 2013 at PNC), Andre Pallante (April 10, 2022 at Busch), Nolan Gorman (May 20, 2022 at PNC), Matthew Liberatore (May 21, 2022 at PNC), and Drew Rom (Aug. 21, 2023 at PNC) made their MLB debuts vs. the Pirates.

**Michael Siani**'s younger brother, **Sammy Siani**, was selected by Pittsburgh with the 37th overall pick in the 2019 MLB Draft and is an outfielder for Altoona (AA) in the Pirates organization.

David Bednar was teammates of Miles Mikolas, Paul Goldschmidt, and Nolan Arenado on Team USA in the 2023 World Baseball Classic. Riley O'Brien's great uncle, Eddie O'Brien played for Pittsburgh as an infielder and also made five pitching appearances (1953, 1955-58)...his granfather Johnny O'Brien, played part fo four seasons with the Pirates (1953, 1955-57).

**Derek Shelton** was born in Carbondale, III...caught four seasons (1989-92) at Southern Illinois Univ.

2024 Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** pitched two seasons in Pittsburgh (2007-08).

- Makes his 28th start of the season and as a member of the Cardinals and his 298th career start (307th appearance).
- Gray's 195 strikeouts are the 2nd-most by a pitcher in their first season with St. Louis behind only José DeLeón's 208 strikeouts in 1988.
- Registering 10.92 strikeouts/9 IP this season (195 SO/160.2 IP), the highest mark in franchise history, surpassing Jack Flaherty (10.59) in 2019 (231 SO/196.1 IP).
- His 195 strikeouts in his first 27 starts with the Cardinals are the most in franchise history. He was the 9th Cardinal in history to record 100+ strikeouts in his first 14 starts of any season. Bob Gibson leads with four such seasons (1965, 1966, 1969, 1970).
- Is five strikeouts away from reaching 200 this season, becoming the 9th pitcher in Cardinals single-season history (20th instance) & first since Jack Flaherty (231 in 2019).
- Is 10 strikeouts shy of tying his single-season career high of 205 with the Reds in 2019.
- After recently beating the Reds, the Diamondbacks and Rockies are the only two remaining MLB teams Gray has never beaten in his career.
- Has allowed one run in each of his last three starts since Aug. 29 (2-0, 1.42 ERA).
- Ranks 3rd in the NL in wins at home (9). With a win tonight, would become the first Cardinal with double-digit wins at home since rookie **Shelby Miller** went 10-3 in 2013.
- Has a 58.0 strikeout pct. on his Sweeper pitch this season (fanning 109 in 188 plate appearances), MLB's best K% of any pitch (minimum 150 plate appearances).
- Gray's 33.1% Put Away Pct. on his sinker is the highest of the pitch and 5th-best of any MLB pitcher's pitch this season. Teammate **Ryan Helsley**'s slider (34.8%) leads MLB.
- Is 13-0 (Cardinals are 16-2) when he receives two or more runs of support (while in the game) this season. Is 0-9 when he receives one or zero.
- Has allowed 21 HR this season, but only five at Busch Stadium.
- His 13 wins this season are his most since a career-high 14 in 2015 with Oakland, part
  of consecutive seasons (2014-15) with 14 wins.
- Since 2014, Gray and teammate **Kyle Gibson** are the only two MLB pitchers with 10 or more seasons with 20 or more starts (2014-19, 2021-24). The 2024 season is his 7th career making 25 or more starts.
- Despite missing first 11 games of season, his 121 strikeouts prior to All-Star break were the most by Cardinal since Carlos Martinez fanned 128 in 2017 (18 starts).

#### LAST TIME OUT

- Earned team-leading 13th win last Thursday at Busch Stadium, limiting the Reds to one run on two hits over 6.0 IP while fanning nine. Held a perfect game through 5.0 innings.
- After beating the Reds, the Diamondbacks and Rockies are the only two remaining MLB teams Gray has never beaten in his career.
