

ATLANTA BRAVES (61-73) vs PHILADELPHIA PHILLIES (77-57)

RHP Bryce Elder (5-9, 6.12 ERA) vs LHP Ranger Suárez (10-6, 3.07 ERA)

- GAME #134 RECAP:** The Phillies defeated Atlanta, 19-4, on a Thursday night in South Philly ... Starter Aaron Nola (W, 3-7) went 6.0 innings and allowed 4 runs on 4 hits with 3 walks and 4 strikeouts ... Kyle Schwarber tied an MLB record with 4 home runs on the night as he set a franchise record with 9 RBI ... Everyone in the starting lineup had a hit as the Phillies tied a franchise record with 7 home runs on the night ... The Phillies had 24 baserunners (20 H, 4 BB) and left only 5 on base.
- THE KYLE SCHWARBER GAME:** Last night, **Kyle Schwarber** tied an MLB record with 4 home runs as he became only the 21st player in history to do so and also set a franchise record with 9 RBI ... Schwarber became the 4th Phillies player ever with 4 homers in a game – and the first to do so in Philadelphia – as he joined Hall-of-Famers Ed Delahanty (7/13/1896 at CHI), Chuck Klein (7/10/1936 at PIT) and Mike Schmidt (4/17/1976 at CHI) ... Schwarber is only the 4th player in MLB history with 4 home runs and 9+ RBI in a single game – he joined HOF Gil Hodges (4 HR/9 RBI on 8/31/1950 vs BOS), Mark Whiten (4 HR/12 RBI on 9/7/93 at CIN) and Scooter Gennett (4 HR/10 RBI on 6/6/17 vs STL).
- THE SUMMER OF SCHWARB:** After last night, **Kyle Schwarber** is up to 49 home runs and 119 RBI with 3 games to go in August (28 total games to go in the season) ... Schwarber's 49 home runs before September ties a franchise record (Ryan Howard in 2006) and should he hit #50 over the next 3 games, Schwarber would become only the 9th player (13th instance) with 50+ home runs before September in MLB history and the first Phillies player ever to do so ... Schwarber currently stands alone in 2nd place in franchise history for home runs in a single season; he trails **Ryan Howard** by 9 (58 in his 2006 MVP season).
- MVP:** **Kyle Schwarber** has played in every game for the Phillies this season – in the 77 wins, he is slashing .283/.415/.731 with a 1.146 OPS – in the 57 losses, he is slashing .201/.305/.393 with a .697 OPS – that is a difference of .449 in OPS between wins and losses ... When Schwarber homers this year, the Phillies are 33-10 (.767 win %) and they have won each of the last 10 games he has gone deep ... Schwarber leads the National League in home runs (49), RBI (109) & Isolated Power (.338) and he ranks 2nd in OPS (.956), SLG (.586), wRC+ (159) & wOBA (.402)
- REMEMBER THE FIGHTINS:** The Phillies enter tonight's game against the Braves with the best series record in MLB at 27-14-2 – Philadelphia's .651 winning percentage in series play is tops, in front of LAD who ranks 2nd (27-14-3, .648) and MIL who ranks 3rd (26-14-3, .643) ... The Phillies lead MLB in total team fWAR at 42.1 (next: NYY, 41.6) and total team bWAR at 41.3 (next: MIL, 41.1).
- THE ELECTRIC FACTORY:** Since last year, the Phillies are 97-48 with an MLB-best .669 winning percentage in their home ballpark (next: LAD, 96-52/.649 at Dodger Stadium) – the Phillies have outscored their opponents 763-600 (+163 run differential) since last season in South Philly ... Over this stretch, the Phils have played 47 series at CBP and have lost only 8 of them (33-8-6 series record at CBP since 2024) ... The Phillies are averaging 41,945 in attendance per game at CBP this year which is 4th in MLB, behind LAD (49,873), SD (42,600) and NYY (42,572) ... Of the 65 games at CBP this season, 35 have been sellouts and 55 have been over 40,000, including 37 of the last 38.
- CITIZENS BANK SPARK:** The Phillies have won 10 of their last 11 series at CBP (since 6/9) and it that span are 24-10 with a .706 winning percentage and +79 run differential (208-129) ... During these 34 games, the Phillies are slashing .296/.358/.521 with an .879 OPS, 59 doubles, 63 home runs and 106 walks while averaging 6.1 runs per game ... On the mound, Phillies starters have combined to post a 3.40 ERA (75 ER, 198.2 IP) with 235 strikeouts against only 41 walks (5.73 SO/BB ratio) ... Philadelphia's 10 series wins during this span have come against CHI (2-1), TOR (3-0), NYM (2-1), SD (2-1), CIN (2-1), BOS (2-1), DET (2-1), BAL (2-1), SEA (3-0) and WSH (2-1) – their lone series loss came against the Angels in mid July (1-2).
- WATCH THE STARS SHINE LATE:** The Phillies have scored 243 runs from the 7th inning on, the most of any team in MLB (next: TOR, 232) ... The Phils rank 1st in MLB with a .448 SLG in the 7th inning or later and they have a .783 OPS which leads the NL and ranks 2nd in MLB, behind only TOR (.790) ... The Phillies have hit 63 HR from the 7th inning on (T-1st in MLB with NYY) ... There are currently 175 qualified hitters in MLB and the Phillies have 5 of the top 32 in OPS from the 7th inning on: **Kyle Schwarber** leads MLB with a 1.169 OPS, **Bryce Harper** ranks 6th (1.005 OPS), **Trea Turner** ranks 21st (.888 OPS), **J.T. Realmuto** ranks T-25th (.882 OPS) and **Harrison Bader** ranks 32nd (.853 OPS).
- HARP ON THIS:** Over his last 43 games (since 7/9), 2-time MVP **Bryce Harper** is slashing .292/.354/.614 with a .969 OPS, 29 runs, 29 XBH (16 2B, 13 HR) and 29 RBI ... Harper has played in 106 games this year – the Phillies are 63-43 with him in the lineup and 14-14 without him ... In the 63 wins, Harper has a .989 OPS and in the 43 losses, he has a .690 OPS ... Harper ranks 13th among NL position players with 2.01 Win Probability Added this year.
- 10+ STRIKEOUTS/0 WALKS:** Sunday, **Ranger Suárez** authored the 12th double-digit, no walk game by a Phillies starting pitcher this season ... The 2025 Phillies rotation ranks T-2nd all time for most 10+ SO/0 BB game in a single season (with the 2018 Astros) – they trail only the 2019 Astros rotation who had 14 such games ... Last year, the Phillies didn't have a single 10+ SO/0 BB game from a starting pitcher.
- ARMS RACE:** The Phillies rotation leads MLB in innings pitched (764.2), strikeout rate (25.7%), SO-BB% (19.0%), SO/BB (3.85), quality starts (72) and strikeouts (813) ... Phils' starters have the lowest average exit velocity of any staff in MLB (88.4 MPH), the lowest Hard Hit rate (37.7%) and the lowest Barrel rate (6.8%) ... Philadelphia's starters have gone at least 7.0 innings in 31 starts, most in MLB (2nd: BOS, 26) and 6.0 innings in 78 starts, most in MLB (2nd: BOS, 67) – as a result, Philadelphia's bullpen has worked the fewest innings of any relief corps in MLB (423.2, next: TB, 456.1) ... Philadelphia's starting rotation has 62 games this season of at least 6.0+ IP and 2 ER or fewer which is 9 more starts than the next closest MLB team (BOS with 53) and they have 17 double-digit strikeout games which is also tops among all rotations in MLB (next: ATL, 13) ... The Phils rotation leads MLB in fWAR at 17.4 (next: CIN, 13.9) and they lead in bWAR at 19.4 (next: CIN, 15.5).
- TAKE A BOW, THOMS:** Since his first game as manager on June 3, 2022, **Rob Thomson** (327 wins, .575 win %) has the Phillies 3rd in wins and winning % among all clubs in MLB, trailing only LAD (352 wins, .619 win %) and ATL (330 wins, .581 win %) ... His .575 career winning % ranks 1st in Phillies history, 24th all time among MLB managers (min. 315 G) and 3rd among active managers, behind only Dave Roberts (.622) & Aaron Boone (.581) ... Thomson is 2nd in club history at 85 games over .500, trailing only **Charlie Manuel** (144 games over) and he ranks 11th in club history with 327 wins, 10 behind **Larry Bowa** who ranks 10th at 337.
