TODAY'S GAME: Is Game 3 (0-2) of a 3-game series vs **Jo Ganzer's Braves** and the third game (0-2) of a 6-game homestand that includes an upcoming series vs the **Kansas City Royals** (Mon-Wed).

- The Reds enter today's game having lost each of their last 3 games after winning 3 in-a-row from 5/23-5/26.
- Following Wed's game vs **KC** and Thu's off day, the Reds will resume their road schedule with a 6-game trip at **StL** (6/5-6/7) and **SD** (6/8-6/10).

NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM: The Reds today seek to avoid their first losing home sweep since dropping all 3 games to the **Royals** at **Great American Ball Park** from 8/16-8/18, 2024, a run of 40 consecutive series in **Cincinnati** without being swept.

- This current 40 sweepless series streak at home is the team's longest since avoiding the broom in a franchise-record 52 straight home series from 9/19/11-9/25/13.
- The Reds avoided the sweep in all 26 of their series last year at **GABP**... the only other Cin teams to run the home schedule without being swept were the clubs of 1940, 1943, 1944, 1994, and 2012.
- The **Braves** last swept the Reds at **GABP** in 2001 (2g, 7/18-7/19)... they've never swept the Redlegs in a 3 or 4-game series in this ballpark... the **Braves'** last 3-game sweep in **Cincinnati** came in September 1995 at **Riverfront Stadium** (9/15-9/17).

POWER SURGE: The Reds have homered 49 times over their last 34 games (since 4/21 at **TB**), T6th-most in the majors during that time, behind the **White Sox** (55), **Yankees** (54), **Braves** (52), **Mariners** (51), and **Nationals** (50).

- Have hit 2 or more HRs in a game 20 times this season.
- Did not homer in either of their final 2 games in **New York** despite producing a combined 23 hits...in Wed's 7-2 win, none of their 15 hits resulted in a home run...it was the first time a Reds team collected at least 15 hits in a game and didn't homer since 3 years ago to the exact day in 2023 (5/26/23 vs **Chc**, 19h, 0hr).
- Entered the 4/21 game at **TB** ranked T17th in the majors with 22 HR... enter today's game ranked T8th in the majors with 71 HR.
- 113 of their 250 runs scored this year have come via HR (45.2%).

SMART STEERING: OF/INF Spencer Steer has reached safely in a career-high 18 consecutive games dating back to 5/9 vs **Hou**...it matches the longest active streak in the majors (also: **AZ' Nolan Arenado**, 18g).

- Since 4/18, Steer is slashing .301/.384/.444 in 37 games (40-for-133, 4hr, 16rbi, 11xbh, 58 times on base).
- Overall this year, **Steer** has appeared in 26g in LF, 24g at 1B, 15g in RF, 5g at 2B, and 2g at 3B.

NO, THANKS: The Reds are 1 of 5 teams without an ABS challenge from their pitching staff (also: **Diamondbacks**, **Twins**, **Blue Jays**, and **Rays**).

DYN-O-MITE!: In last night's 5-2 loss vs **Atl**, **OF JJ Bleday** homered for the second consecutive game (2-for-4, 2rbi).

- Since being recalled from AAA-Louisville on 4/26, he's slashing .295/.395/.629 with 9 HR, 24 RBI, and 18 walks in 29 games.
- Has hit 9 home runs in a 29-game span for the first time in his career.

APRIL FLOWERS, MAY SHOWERS: The Reds opened the month of May with an 8-game losing streak and lost 13 of the month's first 17 games.

- Haven't had as few as 9 wins in a full calendar month since they went 9-18 in May 2024.
- Went 20-11 (.645) to open the 2026 season...entered this month a season-high 9 games over .500 and in first place in the National League Central Division (+1.0).
- Begin play today in fifth place in the division, trailing first-place **Milwaukee** by 6.0 games.
- The Reds have lost 11 games this season in which they held a lead, 9 of those losses have come this month.

SERIES NOTES: Cin and Atl are meeting for the first time in 2026...the **Braves** won last year's season series, 5 games to 2.

- The **Braves** have won 34 of the last 62 games between the clubs, dating back to 2016...Cin has dropped each of its last 4 series vs **Atl**, including this one.
- The Reds and **Braves** played in last year's inaugural **MLB Speedway Classic** at **Tennessee's Bristol Motor Speedway**...**Atl** won, 4-2... originally scheduled for 8/2, the start of the game was delayed by rain for 2 hours and 17 minutes...when play finally resumed at 9:41 PM, 4 outs were recorded before another rain delay stopped action for 27 minutes...the game was eventually suspended at 10:25 PM with Cin leading 1-0 in the bottom of the 1st inning...it was completed the next day (Sun, 8/3)...before the suspension, the Reds were scheduled to have their first off day on a Sun since 8/20/33.
- The 12-11 **Atl** win on 7/31/25 marked just the third game in Major League history in which both teams scored at least 8 runs in the same inning...the **Braves** plated 8 in the top of the 8th and the Reds answered with 8 runs of their own in the bottom half of the inning.

ELLYTRICITY: Last night vs **Atl**, **SS Elly De La Cruz** went 1-for-4 with his 26th career triple (he raced from home to third in 11.12 seconds).

- Has managed to reach in 47 of his 57 games (86 times on base).
- 5 of his 12 homers this season have come off left-handed pitching (73 PA)...hit 5 HR off lefties last year (210 PA).
- Is 2 stolen bases shy of 150 for his career...aiming to become the youngest Red (currently 24 years, 140 days old) since 1900 to reach the mark (**Eric Davis**, 25 years, 82 days old).

EL CABALLO DE HIERRO: **SS Elly De La Cruz** has appeared in each of Cin's last 276 games, beginning 7/30/24 vs **Chc**...it's the third-longest streak of consecutive team games played by a Red since 1970...is also the third-longest active streak of consecutive games played in the majors, behind only **Matt Olson** (842 w/**Atl**, **Oak**) and **Pete Alonso** (475 w/**NYM**, **Bal**).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the 7-2 win at NYM on Mon, 5/25 (6.0ip, 6h, 1r/1er, 0bb, 7k, 1hr, 2hb, 98TP).

- Was his 32nd career quality start, his first this season and his first since 9/25/25 vs Pit.
- Was his first outing in which he didn't walk a batter since 9/14/25 at Ath (5.1ip).
- 8 of his 25 batters reached.
- Was his first outing in which he hit 2 or more batters since 5/3/25 vs Wsh (2hb).
- Held the Mets scoreless until Marcus Semien led off the bottom of the 6th with a home run...retired the next 3 batters before he was relieved by Brock Burke.

MAY 18 at PHI: Did not factor in the decision in the 5-4 loss at Phi on Mon, 5/18 (5.2ip, 3h, 3r/3er, 5bb, 3k, 1hr, 97TP).

- His 5 walks matched a career high set on 10/1/22 at Chc.
- Reached 96.5 mph for the first time since last June at Cle.
- 9 of his 24 batters reached.
- Threw 25 pitches in the 1st inning...loaded the bases with no outs and allowed 2 runs to score in the frame.
- Faced the minimum in innings 2-4, and pitched a scoreless 5th...faced 5 batters in the 6th (K, HR, HB, LO, BB) before handing it over to Tejay Antone to finish the inning.

MAY 13 vs WSH: Did not factor in the decision in the 10-inning, 8-7 loss vs Wsh on Wed, 5/13 (4.0ip, 6h, 5r/5er, 3bb, 6k, 1hr, 87 TP).

- Had a 5-run lead entering the 2nd inning.
- 10 of his 22 batters reached.
- Issued 3 walks for the first time since 8/22/24 at Pit (3bb).

SEASON DEBUT, MAY 8 vs HOU: In his first ever appearance vs the Astros, suffered the 10-0 loss on Fri, 5/8 (5.1ip, 5h, 4r/4er, 1bb, 2k, 2hr, 1hb, 78TP).

- Was his season debut...activated earlier in the day from the 15-day IL (blister on left index finger).
- Produced 7 swings-and-misses and 17 batted balls in play.
- Allowed 6 hard-hit balls, his most since 7/18/25 at NYM.
- 7 of his 21 batters reached base.
- Began the 6th inning with a groundout, hit batter, a 2-run homer (Yordan Alvarez) and a double (Isaac Paredes) before turning it over to Pierce Johnson who escaped the inning without further damage.
