### SNAKEBITES

THE NL CHAMPS: Last season, the D-backs captured their second NL pennant and made their second trip to the World Series, first since winning it all in 2001, in their seventh Postseason berth ('99, '01, '02, '07, '11, '17, '23).

VS. CUBS: Since 2022, the D-backs are 10-5 vs. Cubs (4-3 @ home, 6-2 on road) and have outscored them 65-52.

♦ Last season, the D-backs faced off vs. Cubs in September with 7 games in 11 days (4 on road and 3 @ home) and took 6 of the 7 matchups, including a sweep at Chase Field.

INNINGS 1-3: In Innings 1-3, the D-backs' .336 AVG, 72 hits and 45 runs lead the Majors:

AVG: D-backs (.336), Brewers (.335), Royals (.305), Red Sox (.289) H: D-backs (72), Royals (67), Brewers (65), Padres (60) **R: D-backs (45)**, Royals (42), Brewers (40), Padres (38)

MIGHTY MERRILL: Merrill Kelly's 33 consecutive starts (since April 6, 2023) of 5.0+ innings is the second longest active streak among starting pitchers, behind Mitch Keller/PIT (35).

♦ He surpassed 700 career strikeouts with his 5 last night vs. Cubs...his 702 career strikeouts rank eighth all-time in franchise history, behind lan Kennedy (705) and Zac Gallen (712).

OH MY, LOURDES: Lourdes Gurriel Jr.'s 18 RBI are tied for third in the Majors (also: Spencer Steer/CIN), behind Marcell Ozuna/ATL (22) and Taylor Ward/LAA (19).

- ♦ Gurriel's 18 RBI thru the team's first 17 games of a season ties for third most by a D-back in the span (also: Mark Trumbo/2014), behind Luis Gonzalez/2001 (21) and Matt Williams/1999 (20).
- This season, Gurriel Jr. is batting .458 (11-for-24)/1.292 OPS with runners in scoring position, with 2 doubles, 2 homers and 15 RBL

LIMITING THE STRIKEOUT: Gabriel Moreno's 7.5 strikeout pct. (53 PA) ranks atop all qualified hitters this season while Corbin Carroll's 8.1% is third...Moreno's drop in strikeout rate from 2023 to 2024 is also the fourth largest while Carroll's is fifth:

BARRELING IT UP: The D-backs' 180 hard hits (No. of batted balls with exit velocity of 95 mph+) rank tied for seventh in MLB (also: Royals), behind the Astros (213), Dodgers (203), Padres (198), Braves (191), Orioles (187) and Giants (182).

- Ketel Marte's 33 hard hits rank third in the Majors. behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (36) and Bobby Witt Jr./KC (34) while Lourdes Gurriel Jr.'s 31 are tied for fourth.
- Christian Walker's 16.3 barrel pct. (percentage of batted balls that are classified as barrels) ranks sixth in the NL, behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (22.2), Michael Busch/CHC (21.6), Joey Gallo/WSH (18.5), Marcell Ozuna/ATL (17.7) and Rhys Hoskins/MIL (16.7).

WHEN SCORING FIRST: The D-backs have scored first in all 8 games they have won this season...they have scored first in a game 12 times, tied for the second most in the Majors (also: Dodgers and Cubs), behind the Red Sox (13) and Royals (13).

FIRST-INNING STRIKERS: The D-backs' 10 games this season with 1+ runs scored in the first inning is tied for the most in the Majors (also: Dodgers).

The D-backs have scored 2+ runs in the first inning in 8 of their 17 games this season...no other team has more than 5 instances so far this season (Angels).

In the opening frame, the D-backs have scored 1 run twice, 2 runs 4 times, 3 runs 3 times and 6 times once. tallying 25 runs with a .424 average (36-for-85)/1.245 OPS and 9 doubles, 7 home runs and 8 walks.

STOPPING THE OPPONENT RUNNING GAME: Through 17 games this season, Gabriel Moreno has held opponents to an MLB-low 2 stolen bases in 4 attempts...Moreno's 39.7 caught-stealing pct. (31-for-78) since 2022 is highest among all active MLB catchers.

- There has been only 4 stolen base attempts against Arizona over 229 stolen base opportunities.
- The 4 stolen base attempts vs. Arizona are the fewest among all MLB teams...the second fewest is 7 stolen base attempts (against Rangers).

OFFENSE ON STARTERS: D-backs hitters, against opposing starting pitchers, are batting .308 (106-for-344)/.845 OPS with 59 runs, 19 doubles, 14 homers and 29 walks. Among all teams' offenses vs. starting pitchers, the D-backs are first with 106 hits and boast the fewest strikeouts (59).

ATTENDANCE BOOST: The 359,772 total home attendance thru the first 11 home games is the largest since 2004 (368,742).

SERIES-LY: The D-backs have won 2 consecutive series (@ COL, vs. STL) and 3 of their 5 on the season.

**WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:** Is making his first career start vs. Cubs...grew up 150 miles from Wrigley Field in Portage, Michigan.

• Has tossed 5.0+ innings with 2 or fewer earned runs allowed and 5+ strikeouts in 2 consecutive starts.

**LAST START:** Took a no-decision on April 10 @ Rockies (ND; 2 ER in 5.0 IP, 6 K).

VS. CUBS: Is making his first career start.

**VS. NL CENTRAL** @ **HOME**: Is 1-1 with a 1.46 ERA (2 ER in 12.1 IP, 10 K) in 2 career starts against NL Central opponents @ home.

**2023 RECAP:** In his first full season with the D-backs, went 5-4 with a 4.15 ERA (41 ER in 89.0 IP) in 17 games (16 starts).

- Began the season with Triple-A Reno, going 1-0 with a 6.33 ERA (15 ER in 21.1 IP) and 22 strikeouts in 4 starts.
- Recalled by the D-backs on April 24.
- On May 27 vs. Red Sox, retired 4 of the 5 batters faced over 1.1 scoreless innings in relief, marking his first professional career appearance out of the bullpen after a combined 66 starts between the Minors and Majors.
- On May 31 vs Rockies, tossed 7.0 scoreless innings for the first time in his career and tied a career high with 7 strikeouts (also: Aug. 19, 2022 vs. Cardinals)...also allowed a career-low 2 hits.
- In his 5 starts in June, Arizona went 5-0 and he recorded 24 strikeouts over 27.1 innings.

**2023 ROAD RECAP:** In 8 road starts in 2023, went 4-2 with a 5.05 ERA (24 R-23 ER in 41.0 IP, 34 K).

From May 22-June 30, 2023, was 3-0 with a 3.63 ERA (9 ER in 22.1 IP, 22 K).

**HOW IT STARTED:** Signed by the D-backs as a Competitive Balance-B selection (74th overall) in the 2019 draft.

- Attended the University of Michigan, where he helped lead the Wolverines to the 2019 College World Series vs. eventual champion Vanderbilt University.
- A Michigan native, attended Portage Northern High School, where he lettered in baseball and basketball.
