YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles defeated the Rays, 2-0, marking their fourth consecutive series-opening win...With a win today, the 0's will be 23 games over .500 for the first time since the end of play on July 9 (57-34)...The Birds tossed their ninth shutout of the season and second this month (9/3 vs. CWS) and have allowed one or no runs in three of five games this month...Orioles starting pitchers have pitched to a 2.11 ERA (15 ER/64.0 IP) against Tampa Bay this season...Dean Kremer picked up his seventh win of the season, bringing his winning streak to a season-high-tying three (2x, last: 4/24-5/5) after tossing 6.0+ scoreless innings on two hits, three walks, and one hit batter with seven strikeouts... Gunnar Henderson crushed his 36th home run of the season to lead off the sixth inning, homering in consecutive games for seventh time this season (last: 8/17-18).

A. Kremer completed a career-high 6.0 no-hit innings before surrendering a single to Junior

Kremer completed a career-high 6.0 no-hit innings before surrendering a single to Junior Caminero leading off the seventh inning; he became the second Orioles pitcher this year to carry a no-hitter into the seventh inning, joining Kyle Bradish (5/26 at CWS, 7.0 IP).

WHAT'S TRENDING: The 0's have won five of their last seven games since August 30 after going 7-10 from August 11-29...The 0rioles have the best record in the AL at 82-60 (.577) and lead the Yankees (.574, 81-60) by a half game in the AL East...Baltimore is 24-22 (.522) since the All-Star break and 29-29 (.500) in the last 58 games since July 1...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 183-121 (.602), the second-best winning percentage in MLB behind the Dodgers (.607, 184-119) during that time.

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles are second in MLB with 210 home runs behind the Yankees (213)...The Dodgers rank third with 191...The 0's have hit 200 home runs in a season for the 13th time in team history and for the first time since 2019 (213)...Baltimore is averaging 1.48 homers per game this season, which would be the third-best mark in team history behind 1996 (1.58) and 2016 (1.56).

① Baltimore has an MLB-best nine players with at least 10 home runs: Anthony Santander (39), Gunnar Henderson (36), Colton Cowser (20), Adley Rutschman and Jordan Westburg (18), Cedric Mullins (14), Ryan Mountcastle and Ryan O'Hearn (13), and Ramón Urías (10); the team record is 10 players, done in 2019, 2000, and 1998.
② Henderson and Santander are one of three duos with at least 30 home runs, along with New York-AL's Aaron Judge (51) and Juan Soto (38) and New York-NL's Pete Alonso (31) and Francisco Lindor (30); Baltimore did not have a player reach 30 homers last season, and this year marks the first time since 2021 that the team has had multiple players with 30+ home runs (Mountcastle, 33 & Mullins, 30).

② The Birds have hit 13 leadoff homers, the most by the club in a single season and tied with the Phillies for the most in MLB; Gunnar Henderson has 10 of those, second most in one year by an Oriole behind Brady Anderson, who hit all 12 in 1996; Colton Cowser (2) and Jordan Westburg (1) have the other three for the 0's in 2024.

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson scored three times on Tuesday to register his 10<sup>th</sup> such game this season, tied for the most in MLB with Cincinnati's Elly De La Cruz...His 17 games of at least three runs scored since the start of 2023 are the most in MLB, five more than Cincinnati's De La Cruz during that time...He ranks tied for third in the AL and for fourth in MLB with 108 runs scored, the most by an Oriole since Jonathan Villar (111) in 2019...Henderson is the sixth player in 0's history (since 1954) to score 100 runs in back-to-back seasons after scoring exactly 100 times last year, joining with Manny Machado (2, 2015-16), Adam Jones (2, 2012-13), Brian Roberts (3, 2007-09), Brady Anderson (2, 1995-96), and Cal Rinken . Ir (3, 1983-85)

2015-16), Adam Jones (2, 2012-13), Brian Roberts (3, 2007-09), Brady Anderson (2, 1995-96), and Cal Ripken, Jr. (3, 1983-85).

A He hit his 35th home run of the season on Wednesday, surpassing Ripken, Jr. (1991) and Miguel Tejada (2004) for the most by an 0's shortstop in a single season in team history.

A Henderson ranks tied with New York-NL's Francisco Lindor for fourth in MLB with 7.3 fWAR; that is the best mark by an Oriole since Ripken, Jr. in 1991 (10.6); eight Orioles (13 occurences) have reached at least 7.0 fWAR in a season.

A He's also among AL leaders in walks (3<sup>rd</sup>, 70), home runs (4<sup>th</sup>, 36), total bases (5<sup>th</sup>, 301), hits (6<sup>th</sup>, 156), extra-base hits (6<sup>th</sup>, 67), on-base percentage (7<sup>th</sup>, .368), OPS (7<sup>th</sup>, .911), and slugging percentage (8<sup>th</sup>, .543).

He's on pace to score 123 times; Roberto Alomar is the only player in team history (since 1954) with more than 122 runs scored in a season, when he set the club record with 132 runs in 1996.

Three players in team history have led the AL in runs scored: Hall of Famer and Orioles legend Frank Robinson in 1966 (122), Ripken, Jr. in 1983 (121), and Don Buford in 1971 (99).

MASHED TATERS: Anthony Santander leads MLB switch-hitters with a career-high 39 home runs, the most by an 0's switch-hitter in team history...Ken Singleton held the previous record when he hit 35 in 1979...The last MLB switch-hitter with 39 homers in a season was Cleveland's José Ramírez in 2018.. Only seven switch-hitters (11 occurrences) in MLB history have hit at least 40 home runs in a season: New York-NL's Carlos Beltrán (2006), Houston's Lance Berkman (2, 2002, 06), Texas' Mark Teixeira (2005), Atlantá's Chipper Jones (1999), New York-NL's Todd Hundley (1996), San Diego's Ken Caminiti (1996), and New York-AL's Mickey Mantle (4, 1956, 58, 60-61)...Mantle is the only switch-hitter in MLB history to hit 50 homers, when he did so in 1956 (52) and 1961 (54).

② Santander has hit 30 home runs since the start of June, trailing Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani and New York-AL's Aaron Judge (31) for the most in MLB during that time; his 39 home runs rank third in MLB behind Ohtani (45) and Judge (51).

③ His 100 home runs since the start of 2022 are tied for the sixth most in MLB during that time and for second most in the AL with Houston's Yordan Alvarez, behind only Judge (150).

③ He's the ninth player in 0's history with multiple 30-homer seasons, joining Manny Machado (3, 2015-17), Chris Davis (4, 2012-13, 15-16), Adam Jones (2, 2012-13), Rafael Palmeiro (4, 1995-98), Hall of Famer and Orioles legend Eddie Murray (5, 1980, 82-83, 85, 87), Orioles Hall of Famer Boog Powell (4, 1964, 66, 69-70), Hall of Famer and Orioles legend Frank Robinson (3, 1966-67, 69), and Orioles Hall of Famer Jim Gentile (2, 1961-62).

③ Santander ranks 14th in team history with 150 home runs, one behind Chris Hoiles for 13th. MASHED TATERS: Anthony Santander leads MLB switch-hitters with a career-high 39 home runs, the

HOLY COWSER: Colton Cowser leads AL rookies and is second among MLB rookies with 20 home runs, trailing San Diego's Jackson Merrill (22)...He's the 10<sup>th</sup> rookie in team history (since 1954) to hit at least 20 homers and the first since Gunnar Henderson (28) last year...He also has 21 doubles, the ninth rookie in 0's history to record 20 doubles and 20 home runs in a season and the first since Henderson (29-2B, 28 HR) in 2023...Cowser leads AL rookies and is tied for second among MLB rookies with 3.5 fWAR with Milwaukee's Jackson Chourio, while trailing Merrill (4.3)...He also ranks among AL rookies in runs scored (1<sup>st</sup>, 69), slugging percentage (2<sup>nd</sup>, .443), extra-base hits (2<sup>nd</sup>, 43), total bases (2<sup>nd</sup>, 191), doubles (2<sup>nd</sup>, 21), RBI(T-2<sup>nd</sup>, 62), OPS (3<sup>nd</sup>, .769), and hits (4<sup>th</sup>, 106).

6. Cowser is slashing .2867.3577.480 (50-for-175) with eight doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 36 runs, 28 RBI, 19 walks, and one hit-by-pitch in 46 games (45 GS) since the All-Star break.
6. His 11 Outs Above Average are more than all other 0's defenders combined, per Statcast; eight of those have come in left field, two behind Toronto's Daulton Varsho for the most among MLB left fielders; the next closest left fielders have four OAA.

HOME SWEET HOME: Baltimore continues a six-game homestand today with the second of three games against the Rays...The 0's went 2-1 against the White Sox to open the homestand before welcoming in the Rays...Tampa Bay will be at Oriole Park through Sunday, marking the final regular season series this year between the two clubs...The 0's are 13-14 (.481) at Camden Yards since the beginning of July...Since the start of 2023, the Orioles have an AL-best 91-63 (.591) record at home.

RAYS UP: The Orioles and Rays continue their season series with the second of a three-game set today at Oriole Park...Baltimore has gone 9-2 (.818) against Tampa Bay so far this season, including 6-1 at the Trop...The Birds won two of three at Oriole Park from May 31 to June 2 in their first series against the Rays at home this year...The 0's have clinched the best winning percentage in one year against the Rays in team bistory.

The Birds have hit 20 homers in 11 games against Tampa Bay this year; the 1.82 home runs per game would be the highest mark in team history against the Rays in one season.

The 0's have posted a 2.02 ERA (22 ER/98.0 IP) against the Rays this season; the 2.02 ERA would be the lowest single-season mark in team history versus the Rays, previously held by the 1998 Orioles who held Tampa Bay to a 3.04 ERA (36 ER/106.2 IP). If the Orioles win the next two games, the 11-2 record (.846) would be their best against a single AL East opponent since also going 11-2 against Milwaukee in 1984; the club went 10-3 (.769) against Toronto last year.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his sixth start with the Orioles and 25th this season today against the Rays...Reinstated from the 15-day Injured List prior to his start on September 1; placed on the IL (right shoulder inflammation) on August 20, retroactive to August 17; marked his second stint on the IL this season after being reinstated on June 5 (lower back inflammation)...Has won all five of his starts to begin his Orioles career, joining Jack Harshman (1958) as the only Orioles to win each of their first five appearances with the club in team history; Eflin is the first to win each of his first five with all of them being starts; with a win today, he would become the first starter to win each of his first six starts with a team since Justin Verlander did so with the Astros (also 6, 9/5/17-3/29/18)...Was acquired by the 0's from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for minor leaguers RHP Jackson Baumeister, INF/OF Mac Horvath, and OF Matthew Etzel on July 26...Became the first MLB pitcher since Andrew Cashner in 2019 to make back-to-back starts against the same opponent with different franchises in the same season (BAL and BOS against TOR), per the Elias Sports Bureau; no pitcher had been acquired by the Orioles in the same season and faced the same opponent he did in his previous start in franchise history (since 1954)... Ranks in the 99th percentile with a 2.7 walk percentage this season, per Statcast... Signed a three-year contract with the Tampa Bays on December 13, 2022...Spent seven seasons with the Phillies, going 36-45 with a 4.49 ERA (329 ER/659.1IP) in 127 outings (115 GS) from 2016-2022... Acquired by Philadelphia from Los Angeles-NL on December 19, 2014 in exchange for Jimmy Rollins and cash considerations...Traded to the Dodgers a day prior as part of a package for Matt Kemp...Originally selected by the Padres in the C-A round (33rd overall) of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft out of Paul J. Hagerty (FL) High School.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned the win on September 1 at Colorado after allowing one run on four hits, one walk, and a wild pitch with a season-high nine strikeouts across 7.0 innings...Took a perfect game into the sixth inning before issuing an infield single to Jake Cave to lead off the inning; it was tied for the longest perfect game bid by a visiting starting pitcher at Coors Field in Rockies history and tied for the longest of his career (5/1/18 at MIA, w/PHI), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...Extended his winning streak to a season-high five games...Threw 85 pitches, 63 strikes.

**AGAINST THE RAYS:** Is 1-1 with a 2.51 ERA (4 ER/14.1 IP) in three career appearances (2 GS) against Tampa Bay and his first to have come away from Tropicana Field... Last faced the club earlier this season on August 9 in Tampa, earning the win after tossing 7.0 shutout innings on four hits and one walk with seven strikeouts.

**BEAT OF THE AL EAST:** Making his  $30^{\text{th}}$  career start ( $32^{\text{nd}}$  appearance) against the AL East; will have faced an AL East opponent in four of his six starts with the Orioles... Has gone 13-9 with a 3.81 ERA (72 ER/170.0 IP) in those games... His last appearance against the division came on August 15 vs. Boston; earned the win after allowing one run on five hits (1 HR) and eight strikeouts in 6.0 innings.

**WALK IT LIKE ITALK IT:** Eflin has issued 16 walks in 142.1 innings this season; his 1.01 BB/9 is the best in MLB among qualified pitchers...His 2.7 walk percentage ranks in the 99<sup>th</sup> percentile in MLB this season, the second-best mark among qualified pitchers, per *Statcast*, trailing only Seattle's Bryan Woo (2.4); the 2.7% walk rate would be his career low; the lowest walk rate by an Oriole in the *Statcast* era is Tommy Hunter (3.3, 2011)...12 of his 24 starts this season have been walkless, tied for the most in MLB; had 13 such starts last year, tied for second most in MLB with St. Louis' Miles Mikolas while trailing Seattle's George Kirby (16).

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Set career highs in starts (31), wins (16), innings (177.2), and strikeouts (186), while also posting his a career low in ERA (3.50) and WHIP (1.02); the 16 wins were tied Toronto's Chris Bassitt for the most in the American League, becoming the third Rays pitcher to lead the AL in wins...Finished sixth in the AL Cy Young award voting...The Rays went 23-8 (.742) in his starts...Recorded a career-low 3.4 percent walk rate, trailing only Seattle's George Kirby (2.5%).

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Eflin is 0-1 with a 5.17 ERA (9 ER/15.2 IP) in 11 career Postseason outings (16S)...Made his first career Postseason start last season, taking the loss in Game 1 of the American League Wild Card series against the Texas Rangers on October 4 at Tropicana Field (w/TB)...Allowed five runs on nine hits (2 HR) and two walks (1 IBB) in 5.0 innings...Appeared in 10 playoff games in relief for the Phillies in 2022, posting a 3.38 ERA (4 ER/10.2 IP) en route to a National League pennant.
