BIRDLAND BITES: Tonight, Baltimore continues a stretch of 13 games in 13 days, returning home from a road trip through Boston (2-1) and Toronto (1-2)...The O's and Mariners are set to meet seven times in the next 11 days, with the Birds headed to Seattle for a three-game set from June 16-18...The O's have won five of eight and 10 of their last 16 games since May 22...They enter play today 1.5 games out of a Wild Card spot and 8.0 games back in the AL East.

👉 **Shane Baz** was a tough-luck loser in yesterday's rubber match in Toronto, allowing five runs (1 ER) on seven hits (1 HR) and one walk with three strikeouts over 5.2 innings... Over his last five starts since May 15, Baz owns a 2.20 ERA (8 ER/32.2 IP).

👉 **Blaze Alexander** registered two doubles for the second time in his career, joining April 19, 2024 at San Francisco.

👉 During the three-game set at Rogers Centre, Baltimore pitching allowed Toronto hitters to go 13-for-35 (.371) with one double, one home run, and seven RBI with two outs.

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to tonight's game, the Orioles recalled **RHP Trey Gibson** from Triple-A Norfolk and placed **RHP Chris Bassitt** (low back discomfort) on the 15-day Injured List, retroactive to June 5.

SUCCESS AGAINST SEATTLE: Since the beginning of the 2023 season, the Orioles are 13-5 (.722) against the Mariners...The .722 winning percentage is the highest mark by any club against Seattle during that period (min. 10 G), ahead of the Yankees (15-7, .682).

👉 **Gunnar Henderson** has reached base safely in 10 of his last 12 games vs. Seattle since May 17, 2024, including a double in three straight, slashing .306/.346/.735 (15-for-49) with four doubles, one triple, five home runs, seven runs, and eight RBI during that stretch.

👉 **Adley Rutschman** went 8-for-21 (.381) with two home runs across five games opposite Seattle in 2025...He opened his career 5-for-56 (.089) with one double, one home run, and four RBI over 14 games against the Mariners.

HOMER HAPPY: The Birds have hit 33 home runs since May 16, tied for the MLB lead along with the Giants and Nationals.

👉 Baltimore has hit multiple home runs in a season-high-tying three straight games (4x, last: 5/20-24 [G1]) and look to do so in a fourth straight game tonight for the first time since a four-game run from April 16-19, 2025.

👉 The O's have homered in nine of their last 11 home games since May 13, tallying 15 long balls during that period.

MOOVING ALONG: **Colton Cowser** is batting .360 (18-for-50) with one double, six home runs, 12 runs, 15 RBI, and five walks across 20 games since May 17.

👉 He has recorded an RBI in a career-high-tying four straight games, joining his four-game stretch from April 9-12, 2024...He is the second Oriole to drive in a run in four straight games this season, joining **Pete Alonso** (2x, 5/5-8 & 5/29-6/2)...Cowser can become the first Bird to accomplish the feat in five straight games since **Gunnar Henderson's** five-game run from August 14-18, 2024.

👉 Over his last 20 games, he is hitting .400 (12-for-30) with one double, three home runs, and a 25.8 percent strikeout rate on breaking and off-speed pitches...Prior to that period, he was 4-for-48 (.083) with zero extra-base hits and a 47.1 percent strikeout rate on such offerings.

👉 His six home runs this season have traveled an average distance of 418 ft., the furthest average home run distance in MLB (min. 5 HR) ahead of HOU's Cam Smith (417 ft.).

👉 Cowser is 9-for-24 (.375) with two doubles, one home run, and four RBI in nine career games against Seattle.

BLAZING THE TRAIL: **Blaze Alexander** is slashing .360/.395/.554 (27-for-75) with six doubles, one triple, two home runs, nine runs, 16 RBI, five walks (1 IBB), and four stolen bases in 30 games since May 1 after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in 21 April games.

👉 His batting average since May 1 is second highest in MLB (min. 75 AB) behind PHI's **Brandon Marsh** (.368).

👉 Over his last eight starts at Camden Yards since May 13, he is 13-for-29 (.448) with two doubles, one home run, and 10 RBI.

PITCHING PROWESS: Oriole starters have posted a 2.98 ERA (33 ER/99.2 IP) in 18 games since May 19, the fourth-lowest mark in the majors behind the Dodgers (2.23), Mariners (2.69), and Yankees (2.88)...Prior to that stretch, Baltimore starters owned a 5.24 ERA, the second-highest clip in the majors ahead of the Rockies (5.62).

CAMDEN CONFINES: The Birds are 10-4 in their last 14 home games since May 10...Baltimore opened the season 9-11 at home.

👉 The Orioles' .751 OPS at home ranks sixth highest in the majors, while their .691 OPS on the road ranks 17th in MLB.

👉 Birds pitching owns a 3.76 ERA at Camden Yards, compared to a 5.52 ERA on the road... The 3.75 home ERA ranks 12th in MLB, while the 5.52 road ERA is tied with the Twins for the highest in MLB.

👉 In 28 home games, **Colton Cowser** in batting .306 (19-for-62) with two doubles, three home runs, and 14 RBI, compared to .185 (12-for-65) with one double, three homers, and eight RBI across 28 road games.

👉 **Adley Rutschman** has reached base safely in 10 straight home games since May 13, drawing 10 walks against four strikeouts during that period.

POLAR BEAR ROARING: Despite seeing his 10-game hitting streak come to an end yesterday, **Pete Alonso** has reached base safely in 14 straight games, his longest run since a 22-game stretch from May 21-June 14, 2025.

👉 He's slashing .305/.366/.512 (25-for-82) with two doubles, five home runs, and 17 RBI over his last 21 games since May 16.

👉 Alonso's 17 RBI since May 16 are tied for third most in the AL.

👉 Eight of his 13 home runs this season have gone to the opposite field, second most in the majors behind WSH's **James Wood** (10).

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (3rd, 56), times on base (T-4th, 118), and on-base percentage (8th, .396).

👉 Ward has seen 1,286 total pitches this season, second most in the majors behind WSH's **James Wood** (1,302).

QUICK HITS: Gibson is scheduled to make his third start of the season (4th appearance) tonight in the series opener vs. Seattle...Made his MLB debut on May 3 at New York-AL, becoming the third Oriole to do so in 2026 along with **Cameron Foster** (4/16 at CLE) and **Anthony Nunez** (3/28 vs. MIN)...He was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk prior to tonight's game...Gibson is rated the No. 1 Orioles prospect by *Baseball America* and the No. 4 Orioles prospect by *MLB Pipeline*, while *Baseball America* tabs him the No. 97 overall prospect in baseball...Signed by the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent on August 9, 2023.

LAST TIME OUT: Gibson earned his first career win on May 27 vs. Tampa Bay, allowing one run on six hits, four walks, and one wild pitch with one strikeout across 5.2 innings pitched...At 24 years, 10 days, became the youngest Oriole to complete at least 5.2 innings and allow one or fewer runs since Grayson Rodriguez on September 27, 2023 vs. Washington (23y, 315d)...Threw 100 pitches, 57 strikes.
 🏆 His last minor league outing came on June 3 for Norfolk, when he threw 6.1 innings of two-run ball on four hits and one walk with six strikeouts at Gwinnett.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Gibson made his MLB debut on May 3 at New York-AL (ND, 4.2 IP, 4 H, 2 HR, 3 R, 2 BB, 2 K), becoming the first Orioles starter in franchise history (since 1954) to make his major league debut at Yankee Stadium and the eighth to do so vs. New York-AL, joining **Dean Kremer** (9/6/20), **Wei-Yin Chen** (4/10/12), **Jake Arrieta** (6/10/10), **Koji Uehara** (4/8/09), **John Parrish** (7/24/00), **John O'Donoghue** (6/27/93), and **Charlie Beamon** (9/26/56).

PITCH MIX: Through three major league appearances, opponents are batting .083 (1-for-12) against Gibson's sinker and .111 (1-for-9) off his slider without extra-base hits on either pitch...Both of the home runs he's allowed have come on his curveball, which batters are slashing .333/.333/1.000 (3-for-9) against.

K ARTIST: Gibson has struck out 11.58 batters per 9.0 innings over 60 minor league games (50 GS) since making his professional debut in 2024, the third-highest mark in the minors during that stretch (min. 230.0 IP), trailing NYM's **Jonah Tong** (13.40) and STL's **Quinn Mathews** (11.81).
 🏆 His 166 strikeouts in 2025 tied for the fourth most in all of Minor League Baseball.

SMALL SAMPLE: Opponents are 10-for-26 (.385) with two doubles and one home run when no one is on compared to a 3-for-22 (.136) mark with one homer when runners are on...Opponents are hitting .320 (8-for-25) their first time through the lineup but only .217 (5-for-23) during their second and third time through.

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Gibson began last season with High-A Aberdeen and made nine appearances (8 GS), striking out 67 batters across 38.2 innings...Promoted to Double-A Chesapeake on June 3 and made 10 starts with the Baysox, going 3-2 with a 1.55 ERA (9 ER/52.1 IP) and 68 strikeouts...Promoted to Triple-A Norfolk on August 12 and made seven starts to close the year, tallying 31 strikeouts over 29.1 innings...Went 5-8 overall with a 4.26 ERA (57 ER/120.1 IP) and 166 strikeouts in 26 appearances (25 GS) over three levels of the Orioles system.
 🏆 Named the 2025 Orioles Jim Palmer Minor League Pitcher of the Year, ranking among Orioles minor leaguers in strikeouts (1st), WHIP (2nd, 1.21), starts (T-2nd), opponent average (3rd, .224), ERA (4th), and innings (4th).
